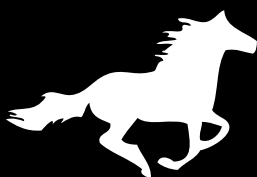

Programme Notes

The programme was delivered following consultation with industry delegates, this occurred following the completion of the initial draft grid supplied by the RVL programming department.

The Summer 2012 Calendar features the Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival (TSRC), the pinnacle of thoroughbred racing events in Tasmania.

The Summer calendar also marks the first of the newly formatted four-month programme grids, covering from December '12 to March '13. Tasracing recognises the importance of producing a programme that allows trainers and owners greater information and transparency to facilitate the programming of their horses preparations.

The December '12 – March '13 grid sees a number of minor initiatives which are predominantly centered around the TSRC and brought about to enhance diversity in options for owners. These include:

- The running of the Alexandra Plate on Sunday 16 December and Alfa Bowl on Wednesday 16 January, providing a more realistic lead in time to the major 2YO features in February, the Elwick Stakes and Gold Sovereign Stakes.
- The inclusion of a 1400m 3YO set weights race Wednesday 19 December, providing better continuity for 3YO's heading into the Tasmanian Guineas on 2 January and beyond to the Tasmanian Derby and Oaks.
- With the Tasmanian Stakes programmed for Sunday 16 December, there is the inclusion of a 1600m Quality Handicap on Wednesday 2 January for horses progressing to the major staying feature Cups.
- The Summer programme sees the reintroduction of \$15,000 Premium staked races, this is centered around the supporting races on feature days, assisting the promotion the TSRC feature races.
- The elevation of the 1100m Fillies & Mares on Sunday 20 January to \$25,000 set weights and penalties, as a recognised lead in to the Group 3 Bow Mistress Trophy.
- The elevation of the 2100m (ballot free to Launceston Cup) on Wednesday 13 February to the \$20,000 Night Cup.
- Another initiative is the programming of 7 races (with 8 race times allocated by Sky Channel) on Sunday meetings following a Wednesday night meeting. This is to allow greater opportunity for divided races and additional races to best meet the demands of the racing population.

tasBonus Scheme



Eligibility

Yearlings that qualify for the scheme are:

- Tasmanian-sired (Tasmanian-based sire)
- Tasmanian-bred (mare must be Tasmanian-owned), based on Australian Stud Book registered breeder location
- Catalogued for sale at the Tasmanian Yearling Sale (any breeding)

Costs

Breeder Nomination: \$220 (incl GST)

Owner Nomination: \$330 (incl GST)

A horse may be only breeder nominated or only owner nominated or both.

A once-off fee is paid to Tasracing when the horse is a yearling and the horse then becomes eligible for a bonus whilst it is a 2, 3 and 4 year old, for its maiden win or for one of any special bonus races.

Special Bonus Races

In addition, owners and breeders will receive an additional \$4,000 (\$3,000 owner/\$1,000 breeder) bonus for non-maiden horses winning specified 2YO and 3YO races (under \$50,000). A maiden winning a specified race will however only be eligible for its maiden bonus (i.e. The special race bonus will not apply). Australian Racing Board NOTICE TO RACING CALENDARS

JOCKEY HELMETS

The Australian Racing Board is releasing a new standard for jockey helmets after five years of research and development. The wearing of helmets is governed by Australian Rule of Racing 87 wherein only approved helmets may be worn.

Notice is hereby given that ARB HS 2012 will become the new standard to satisfy the requirements of AR.87 at a point in time 9 months after a manufacturer first produces a helmet which meets ARB HS 2012. At such point in time, the Australian Racing Board will amend AR.87 to comply with ARB HS 2012.

ARB Helmet Safety Standard 2012 (29 August 2012)

incorporating ARB Higher Performance Safety Requirements 2012

Shortform Name: ARB HS 2012

ELEMENTS OF ARB HS 2012

Helmets must:

- (A) Conform to one of these standards
- (a) AS/NZS 3838 2006:
 - (b) United States (US) ASTM F11 63-01;
 - (c) British Standards (BS) EN 1384/1996 onwards.
 - (d) United States (US) ASTM F11 63-04a (reapproved 2011) ; and

(B) Meet the additional performance requirements specified below.

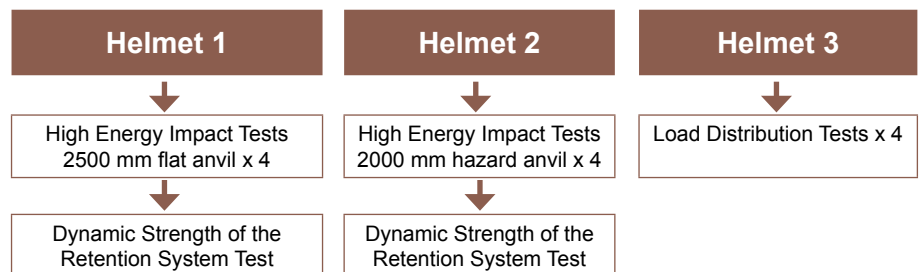
ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

The helmet¹, in all sizes offered for use in horse racing, shall meet the following additional performance requirements

- (i). Impact Energy Attenuation
1. Test Sites as per section 7.9.1 AS/NZS 3838: 2006 [selection of the tests sites is at the discretion of the testing body]
 2. Helmet Conditioning: Helmets will be tested in the ambient condition.
 3. Requirement High Energy Impact Test: When the helmet is tested in accordance with AS/NZS 2512.3.1 or equivalent method from a free-fall height (or equivalent impact energy for specific headform) of (1) 2500 +30, -5 mm for the flat anvil and (2) 2000 +30, -5 mm for the Hazard V-anvil (as specified in standards A(a), A(b) or A(d)) the headform acceleration shall not exceed 250g_n peak. In addition, the cumulative duration of the acceleration shall not exceed (a) 3.0 ms for accelerations greater than 200g_n and (b) 6.0 ms for accelerations greater than 150g_n. The anvil shall not make contact with the surface of the headform.

Note: g_n signifies an acceleration due to gravity of 9.81 m/s².

- (ii) Dynamic Strength of the Retention System. The helmet shall meet a relevant test in the standards referred to in sub rule A(b), A(c) and A(d)² or when tested in accordance with AS/NZS 2512.5.2 with a drop height of 0.25 m, the dynamic displacement shall not exceed 30 mm.
- (iii) Load Distribution. When tested in accordance to AS/NZS 2512.9 with a drop height of 1m, the localised load shall not exceed 250 N. The anvil shall not make contact with the surface of the headform.
- (iv) Test Sequence and Number of Helmets. Three helmets for each helmet size are required. Helmet one will be subjected to four 2500 mm flat anvil high energy impact tests followed by the dynamic strength of the retention system test. Helmet two will be subjected to four 2000 mm hazard anvil high energy impacts tests followed by the dynamic strength of the retention system test. All load distribution tests will be conducted on helmet three. The following represents the test pathway:



- (C) all helmets must be fitted with a nylon interlocking chinstrap clip attachment.
- (D) all helmets must be clearly marked with a date of manufacture.
- (E) the use of helmets is subject to the conditions of Australian Rule of Racing 87AA.

¹ The "helmet" is the complete helmet as offered for sale including any attachments

² Prevents duplication of testing. The dynamic strength test is absent from AS/NZS 3838.

SCREENING LIMITS POLICY

Over time, ongoing research and development and the introduction of new technologies by racing laboratories means that analytical equipment and methods improve, resulting in increased sensitivity of analysis in the testing of prohibited substances, and therefore lower limits of detection. Increased sensitivity of analysis means that a substance present in a sample at a certain concentration which was not able to be detected in the year 2000 may be able to be detected using the analytical equipment and methods available in 2012.

In the case of illicit performance-modifying substances which have no legitimate role or accepted therapeutic use in racehorses, increased sensitivity of analysis is a positive development. It is vital that the racing laboratories harness the full capabilities of modern science to detect the presence of such substances at any level.

However, as a matter of policy the Australian Racing Board does not believe it is necessary to employ highly sensitive methods of analysis for those therapeutic substances which do have a legitimate place in the racing industry, including for welfare reasons.

It is for this reason, as well as the desire for objectivity, transparency and international harmonisation that the concept of screening limits for certain therapeutic substances has been developed. The therapeutic substances assigned screening limits are some commonly-used equine medications representing a range of therapeutic classes, including nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, corticosteroids, local anaesthetics and tranquilisers.

AR 87AA.

- (1) Every rider shall be responsible for the care and condition of his helmet.
- (2) A helmet is not regarded as serviceable and must be immediately replaced by the rider when –
 - (a) a period of 5 years has expired since its date of manufacture, or
 - (b) it sustains a severe impact, or
 - (c) the wearer suffers from concussion following a fall.
- (3) The Stewards may at any time take possession of a helmet for inspection and may at their absolute discretion confiscate any helmet that does not comply with the requirements of this rule and/ or the requirements of AR 87.

Notes:

- i) Flat anvil – the flat anvil defined in all four standards referred to in (A) is virtually the same.
- ii) Equestrian Hazard V anvil - there are minor differences between AS/NZS 3838 and the ASTM standards referred to in (A). Helmets can be tested against either anvil.
- iii) Headforms – the standards in (A) all refer to ISO headforms.
- iv) Drop rig for impact energy attenuation – there are three different potential drop rigs described in the standards referred to in (A). AS/NZS 3838 and ASTM refer to a 2-wire drop rig. ASTM also refers to a monorail system. EN 1384 refers to a 3-wire system with a free headform. Helmets can be tested using one of these three systems as long as the impact energy is maintained (drop height x drop mass x gravity).
- v) Dynamic Stability – Differences exist between all standards referred to in (A). The helmet shall meet a dynamic stability test in one of the standards referred to in (A).

- vi) Dynamic Strength - Differences exist between all standards referred to in (A). The helmet shall meet a dynamic strength test in one of the standards referred to in (A).

Along with most other international racing jurisdictions, the Australian Racing Board has approved the development of formal screening limits for certain therapeutic substances. These therapeutic substances include phenylbutazone, flunixin and lignocaine as examples. The screening limit is the concentration of a particular therapeutic substance (or its metabolite) in urine or plasma above which the racing laboratory will call the sample positive. Their adoption will be facilitated by the introduction of new Rule AR.178EA on 1 October 2012.

Each screening limit has been derived from previous administration studies involving horses, followed by a risk analysis consisting of two components: a risk assessment (evaluation of the effect of the substance and factors related to its control) and a risk management (decision step for harmonisation). Screening limits are harmonised detection limits agreed following input by international consensus and are conveyed by instruction from racing authorities to their racing laboratories. The screening limits are simply the detection limits to be used by the laboratories when screening for certain specified therapeutic substances; they are not international thresholds. When the screening procedure in the first laboratory indicates the screening limit for the particular substance has been exceeded, all that is required is qualitative confirmatory analysis (usually by mass spectrometry) to confirm the presence of the prohibited substance. Similarly, when the reserve portion of the sample is referred to the second (referee) laboratory, all that is required is qualitative confirmatory analysis to confirm the presence of the prohibited substance.

SCREENING LIMITS DO NOT AFFECT LIABILITY

The implementation of screening limits in racing is not intended and does not operate to mean that for the purpose of the Rules of Racing the therapeutic substance only becomes a prohibited substance if and when the screening limit is exceeded.

It shall not be a defence to any charge under AR.177, AR.177A or AR.178 that the result of any initial screening test should have been below the screening limit for the therapeutic substance in question.

Advice of detection periods

Industry participants are advised that more information on the detection periods for many of the therapeutic drugs assigned screening limits will be shortly made available. It is anticipated that a series of "Fact Sheets" will be produced by the consortium that was responsible for the 2012 RIRDC research publication entitled "The Pharmacokinetics of Equine Medications" for those therapeutic substances studied that have a screening limit.

In making any decision regarding the administration of a prohibited substance to a horse that is entered to race, industry participants are reminded of their responsibilities in undertaking the appropriate level of due diligence and risk analysis in researching the available information on detection periods, including the seeking of veterinary advice and adding an adequate safety margin. Participants are advised to take a conservative approach, and consider all variables such as dose, length of treatment and route of administration, when calculating withdrawal times for therapeutic substances where information on detection times is available.

Participants are also advised that a best-practice approach would dictate that no medication, irrespective of its detection period, should be given within 2 clear days of racing.

SCREENING LIMITS

For the purpose of AR.178EA, it is hereby notified that screening limits applicable to the following therapeutic substances, as approved by the Australian Racing Board, are set out as follows:

- acepromazine – 10 nanograms per millilitre (ng/ml) of the 2-(1-hydroxyethyl) promazine sulphoxide metabolite in urine
- betamethasone - 0.20ng/ml in urine
- carprofen – 100ng/ml in urine
- detomidine - 2ng/ml of the 3'-hydroxydetomidine metabolite in urine
- diclofenac – 50ng/ml in urine
- dipyron – 1000ng/ml of the 4-methylaminoantipyrine metabolite in urine
- eltenac – 50ng/ml in urine
- flunixin – 100ng/ml in urine
- frusemide – 50ng/ml in urine
- hyoscine butylbromide (or n-butylscopolammonium) - 25ng/ml in urine
- ipratropium - 0.25ng/ml in urine
- ketoprofen - 100ng/ml in urine
- lignocaine – 10ng/ml of the 3'-hydroxylignocaine metabolite in urine
- meclofenamic acid – 250ng/ml in urine
- meloxicam – 10ng/ml in urine
- mepivacaine – 10ng/ml of the 3'-hydroxymepivacaine metabolite in urine
- naproxen – 250ng/ml in urine
- phenylbutazone – 100ng/ml in urine
- triamcinolone acetonide - 0.5ng/ml in urine
- vedaprofen – 50ng/ml in urine

Delete “Official Racing Laboratory” from AR.1 and replace with the following:

“Official Racing Laboratory” means an analytical racing laboratory that is accredited by the National Association of Testing Authorities or by a similar authority in an overseas country, and is approved by the Australian Racing Board and published in the Racing Calendar.

A. AMENDMENT TO AR.1A

Delete Existing Rule and replace with the following:

“AR.1A. A Maiden Race is one restricted to horses which at the time of starting have never won on the flat a race at a registered meeting or any advertised race in any country.

A Trophy Race is a race in which the prizemoney and/or value of any trophy to the winner does not exceed \$3,500. [added 1.10.00] [amended 20.11.02 & 9.5.07]

A Class A Race* is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not generated prizes in the aggregate worth more than \$6,000 for wins in races on the flat and have never won a race on the flat outside Australia. [amended 9.5.07]

A Class B Race* is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not generated prizes in the aggregate worth more than \$10,000 for wins in races on the flat and have never won a race on the flat outside Australia. *The value of the prize to the winner shall not exceed: in a Class A Race - \$6,000 in a Class B Race - \$10,000.

Provided that Class A and/or Class B races shall not be programmed for TAB meetings, except in the Northern Territory, King Island and approved country areas of Western Australia, and that each Principal Racing Authority should restrict Class A and Class B races to “remote/minor” race meetings, as determined by the Principal Racing Authority.

For the purposes of determining the value of the prize to the winner and the eligibility of any horse for any Class A or Class B race, no account shall be taken of prizes won after 30th September 1991 which were not, at the time of entry for a race or series of races, available to be won by every horse eligible to be entered therein.

For the purposes of determining the eligibility of any horse for any Class 1 to Class 6 race, no account shall be taken of any wins in the former Class C or Class D races run before 1st August 2003 other than a win as a Maiden Horse. [amended 9.5.07]

[Note: Former Class A-D Races replaced by Class A and Class B Races on 1st August 2003]

[Note: Provisions for Class One to Class Six Races; and for definitions of “Special Condition Race” and “Restricted Race” replaced 1.9.04; and for the amendment of Class One to Class Six Races & the deletion of definitions of “Special Condition Race” & “Restricted Race on 1.1.08]

A CLASS ONE RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than one race on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse. Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of any Group or Listed race shall be ineligible.

A CLASS TWO RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than two races on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse. Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of any Group or Listed race shall be ineligible.

A CLASS THREE RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than three races on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse. Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of any Group or Listed race shall be ineligible.

A CLASS FOUR RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than four races on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse. Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of any Group or Listed race shall be ineligible.

A CLASS FIVE RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than five races on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse.

Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of either of the following races shall be ineligible:

- (a) Any Group Race; or
- (b) Any Listed Race in which horses older than 2yo could run.

A CLASS SIX RACE is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not won more than six races on the flat, provided that in determining the eligibility of any horse no account shall be taken of any wins in Class A, Class B or Trophy races, other than a win as a Maiden horse. Further provided that, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the winner of the following races shall be ineligible:

- (a) Any Group Race; or
- (b) Any Listed Race in which horses older than 2yo could run; or
- (c) More than one Listed Race in which 2yos only could run."

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012

A. AMENDMENT TO AR.135A

Delete Existing Rule and replace with the following:

"135A. When by or on behalf of a trainer, any instruction is given to, or arrangement made with the rider of a horse engaged in a race that the horse be ridden in the race in a manner different from the manner in which the horse was ridden at its most recent start or starts, it shall be the responsibility of the trainer or his duly authorised agent to notify the Stewards of any such instruction or arrangement as early as practicable but not later than 30 minutes prior to the race. Upon receipt of that notification the Stewards may make any public release in respect thereof as they deem to be appropriate."

Date of Effect: 1st October 2012

A. AMENDMENT TO RULE 177:

Delete Existing Rule and replace with the following:

"177. Subject to AR 177C, any horse that has been brought to a racecourse and a prohibited substance is detected in any sample taken from it

prior to or following its running in any race must be disqualified from any race in which it started on that day."

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012

B. ADDITION OF RULE 177C:

Insert new Rule as follows:

"177C. In the case of the presence of testosterone (including both free testosterone and testosterone liberated from its conjugates) above a mass concentration of 20 micrograms per litre being detected in a urine sample taken from a gelding prior to or following its running in any race it is open to the Stewards to find that the provisions of AR.177 do not apply if on the basis of the scientific and analytical evidence available to them they are satisfied that the detected level in the sample was of endogenous origin or as a result of endogenous activity."

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012

C. AMENDMENT TO RULE 178:

Delete Existing Rule and replace with the following:

"178. Subject to AR.178G, when any horse that has been brought to a racecourse for the purpose of engaging in a race and a prohibited substance is detected in any sample taken from it prior to or following its running in any race, the trainer and any other person who was in charge of such horse at any relevant time may be penalised."

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012

D. ADDITION OF RULE 178G:

Insert new rule as follows:

"178G. In the case of the presence of testosterone (including both free testosterone and testosterone liberated from its conjugates) above a mass concentration of 20 micrograms per litre being detected in a urine sample taken from a gelding prior to or following its running in any race it is open to the

Stewards to find that the provisions of AR178 do not apply if on the basis of the scientific and analytical evidence available to them they are satisfied that the detected level in the sample was of endogenous origin or as a result of endogenous activity."

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012

E. ADDITION OF RULE 200A:

Insert new rule as follows:

"200A. As at the date on which AR177C and AR178G take effect, all urine samples taken from horses prior to that date which have not been adjudicated upon by the Stewards shall be dealt with subject to those new Rules."

A. ADDITION OF NEW RULE 178EA:

Please insert new rule as follows:

"AR.178EA

- (1) In relation to the testing for the presence of a therapeutic substance in a sample taken at any time from a horse there must be an initial screening test or screening analysis of the sample.
- (2) As a minimum requirement, the initial screening test or screening analysis is to be conducted as follows:

- (a) A biological matrix, equivalent in volume to the sample, is to have added to it a quantity of the therapeutic substance, or its specified metabolite, sufficient to bring its concentration to the screening limit specified for that therapeutic substance. This is known as the spiked sample and is to be analysed concurrently with the sample.

- (b) The sample is then to be tested to ascertain whether or not it contains a quantity of the therapeutic substance, or its specified metabolite, that exceeds that screening limit by making a direct comparison with the spiked sample.
 - (c) If the screening limit is not exceeded, the detection of the therapeutic substance is not to be reported.
 - (d) If the screening limit is exceeded then the sample is to be further tested in accordance with normal laboratory procedures designed to certify the presence of the therapeutic substance in the sample.
- (3) A therapeutic substance for the purpose of this Rule and the screening limit applicable to it or its specified metabolite shall be promulgated from time to time by the Australian Racing Board and published in the Racing Calendar.
- (4) The screening limit testing provided for in this Rule is not intended and does not operate to mean that for the purpose of the Rules the therapeutic substance only becomes a prohibited substance if and when the screening limit is exceeded.
- (5) It shall not be a defence to any charge under AR.177, AR.177A or AR.178 that the result of any initial screening test or screening analysis should have been below the screening limit for the therapeutic substance in question."

B. NEW AR.1 DEFINITION:

Please insert new Definition as follows:

"Therapeutic substance" means a prohibited substance to which a screening limit applies, and which is promulgated as such from time to time by the Australian Racing Board and published in the Racing Calendar.

C. NEW AR.1 DEFINITION:

Please insert new Definition as follows:

"Screening limit" means the concentration of a therapeutic substance or its specified metabolite present in a sample during a screening test or analysis as specified in AR.178EA(2), above which the therapeutic substance will be notified as a prohibited substance.

Date of Effect: 1st October, 2012



WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY REMINDERS

Track Work Riders and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Trainers that employ Trackwork riders, Jockeys and Apprentice Jockeys to train thoroughbred horses are considered to be employers and therefore must comply to the Workplace Health and Safety Act 1995 and the Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998.

Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998 – Division 5 – Personal Protective Equipment

58. (1) An accountable person must ensure that any personal protective equipment or clothing required to be provided by these regulations –
- (a) meets the requirements of any relevant standard issued by a prescribed authority; and
 - (b) is hygienically maintained and used so as to provide the protection for which it is designed.
- (2) A person provided with personal protective equipment or clothing must –
- (a) wear the equipment or clothing at any time, and in any area, required by an accountable person; and
 - (b) take reasonable care of the equipment or clothing; and
 - (c) not deliberately damage or misuse the equipment or clothing.
- (3) A person who becomes aware of any damage to, or defect in, any personal protective equipment or clothing must immediately notify the accountable person.

In short the accountable person (trainer or trainers representative) has a duty of care to ensure that their employees (including trackwork riders, jockeys and apprentice jockeys undertaking the riding of a thoroughbred for the purpose of training) are wearing the appropriate personal protective equipment required by the Australian Racing Board and the state principle racing authority and that the personal protective equipment is in good condition.

A jockey, apprentice jockey and trackwork rider have a duty of care to wear and maintain in good condition their personal protective equipment (helmets, protective vest and high visibility vests).

Fines and penalties apply for the breaches of the Australian Rules of Racing and Workplace Health and Safety Regulation 1998.

Weighing less than 70 grams, the tracker is carried in the saddle cloth of each horse. It uses a combination of GPS and movement sensors to capture detailed information about each horse's performance.

The device provides a wealth of information that would have previously only been available in a university testing environment. Tasracing understands that this is the first time that this type of information is being collected and made available anywhere in the world.

Tasracing has launched a revolutionary new sectional timing device which provides a way of collecting performance information of horses during races. Working closely with the developer, Tasracing launched the StrideMASTER system in July 2011.

For the first time, sectional timing information is available for all Tasmanian races for the entirety of the race, tracking each individual horse.

As well as collecting speed, sectional times and positions in running, it is the first system that has been implemented that captures biometric data on each horse's stride.

This includes stride length, stride count and stride duration.

When the stride data is combined with speed information, the system can provide a measure of each horse's stride efficiency. Stride efficiency looks at how stride length, stride duration and speed compare to known performance benchmarks.

The data from StrideMASTER enables trainers, owners, jockeys and punters to better understand a horse's performance, its level of fitness and its athletic potential.

The data is amassed quickly and reports can be generated within a few minutes of the finish of a race,

providing extremely detailed insights into individual horse performance.

StrideMASTER has the potential to assist with race day integrity functions (utilising GPS information), as a research tool and as a veterinary diagnostic device. Being able to collect large amounts of actual racing data will allow statistically powerful studies examining correlation between biometric data and racehorse performance.

In time, StrideMASTER data will greatly assist in the identification and quantification of a superior athlete or a potential superior athlete.

StrideMASTER – tracker case

The StrideMASTER Tracker Case is a portable mobile hub which houses the StrideMASTER trackers. Three sets of trackers are housed in the hub, with each set of trackers used once every three races. When the hub is connected to the StrideMASTER laptop, trackers are assigned for each horse in the upcoming race. After each race the data is downloaded from each tracker back to the StrideMASTER laptop from which reports can be subsequently generated. The hub also charges the trackers continuously throughout the day.

POSITION IN RUNNING

Position in running is the horse's actual position during the race at each designated 200 metre section. Margins reflect the actual distance from the lead horse (measured in lengths).

SECTIONAL TIME (Seconds)

Time taken between two points on the track, 200 metres apart.

CUMULATIVE TIME (Seconds)

The cumulative time taken at each sectional marker in the race.

SPEED (Metres per Second)

Average speed measured over each 200 metre section.

STRIDE LENGTH (Metres)

Stride length is the individual length of a horse's stride. The figure presented is an average stride length for each 200m section. [Stride Length = 200m ÷ Stride Count]

STRIDE DURATION (Seconds)

Stride Duration is the time taken for the horse to take each stride. The figure presented is an average stride duration for each 200m section. [Stride Duration = Sectional Time ÷ Stride Count]

STRIDE EFFICIENCY (%)

Compares stride length, stride duration and speed to an elite racehorse running 11 second 200m sections. The benchmark for stride length, stride duration and speed are 8m, 0.44s and 18.18 metres per second respectively.

STRIDE COUNT

Stride Count is the total number of strides taken in each 200m section. [Stride Count = Number of Strides]

How To Interpret StrideMASTER Data

These figures reflect the total or average of the horse's overall performance for the race. For example this horse had an average stride length of 6.87m throughout the race.

Stewards Segment

Trainers should be aware that over the past few months Stewards have been actively checking the location and identity of horses that are engaged in upcoming races and also any others listed on stable returns. The provisions of AR 80(F) state:

AR.80F. (1) A trainer shall not, without having made written application and obtained the consent of the Stewards, stable any horse trained by him in any location other than his registered stable address as notified on his current licence renewal or application form. [amended 1.8.08]

(2) Any person found in breach of this rule may be penalised and the nomination of the horse concerned may be refused.

Stable Inspections

As at the start of the current racing season all racing stables have had their annual inspection. On the whole the standards have been maintained and improved. It is required that stable premises will be kept accordingly throughout the season.

Treatment Log Books

During the course of annual stable inspections treatment books must be presented for scrutiny by the inspecting stewards and also at any other time in accordance with AR 178(F)(1)(3). It has been noted that some of these are sub-standard, either in that they have not been comprehensively filled in or have not been kept current. These matters will be referred to the steward's panel for further action or subject to a mandatory fine.

AR.178F

(1) A trainer must keep, and retain for a period of twelve months, a record of any treatment administered to any horse in his care. Each record of treatment must, as a minimum requirement, include the following information:

- (a) name of the horse;
- (b) date of administration of the treatment;

- (c) name of the treatment (brand name or active constituent);
- (d) route of administration;
- (e) amount given;
- (f) name and signature of person or persons administering and/or authorising treatment.

(2) For the purposes of this rule "treatment" includes:

- (a) all Controlled Drugs (Schedule 8) administered by a veterinarian;
- (b) all Prescription Animal Remedies (Schedule 4), including those listed in AR.178C(2);
- (c) all Prescription Only Medicines (Schedule 4), prescribed and/or dispensed by a veterinarian for off-label use;
- (d) all injectable veterinary medicines (intravenous, intramuscular, subcutaneous, intraarticular) not already included above;
- (e) all Pharmacist Only (Schedule 3) and Pharmacy Only (Schedule 2) medicines;
- (f) all veterinary and other medicines containing other scheduled and unscheduled prohibited substances;
- (g) all alkalinising agents;
- (h) all herbal preparations.

(3) When requested, the records of treatment kept by trainers in accordance with the provisions of subrule (1) must be made available to the Stewards. [rule added 1.9.09]

Plating

A variety of work shoes and plates have been collected from training centres that are obviously worn to the point where they have fallen off. They are not only unsafe for galloping horses but pose risks to riders from horses stumbling or the plate becoming a sharp edged projectile when cast. Some worn plates indicate that the condition of the horses hoof must have also been subject to damage.
