

Who is Tasracing?

Tasracing was established in 2008 by the Tasmanian Government to oversee the operations and future development of the Tasmanian racing industry. The organisation took over governance and administration of the industry from TOTE Tasmania on 1 January 2009.

Tasracing roles and responsibilities

Tasracing is primarily responsible for the administration of racing across the racing codes of thoroughbreds, harness and greyhounds. Duties include race programming, payment of stakes, the creation of racing rules and policies and serving as the leading industry voice for matters of state and national importance.

Tasracing is charged with the development of new products that have greater appeal to local, national and international wagering customers – the further development of the state’s racing product to compete in an increasingly competitive national and international market is a priority.

Tasracing is also responsible for the development of breeding, the funding of clubs, media rights and management of racing venues.

Tasracing works closely with Tasmania’s racing clubs, the integrity services division - Racing Services Tasmania and industry associations and bodies, to achieve its corporate goals. As the state’s principal racing authority, Tasracing also represents the three racing codes on national bodies and forums and ensures the Tasmanian racing industry is abreast important national trends and requirements.
