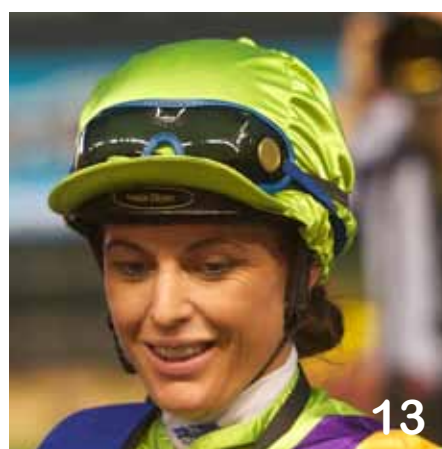
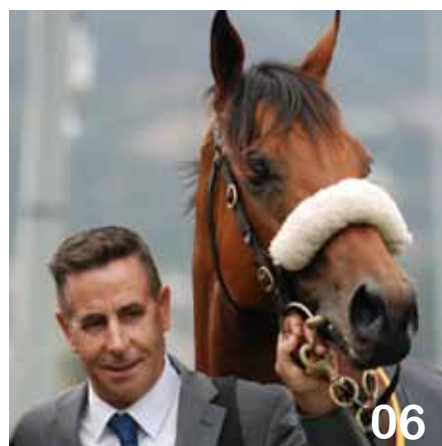

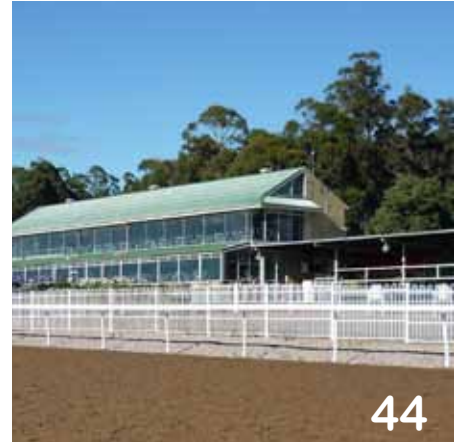

## Epingle joins elite group in winning the 2014 Betfair Launceston Cup

TALENTED mare Epingle joined an elite group when she stormed home to win the \$225,000 Betfair Launceston Cup over 2400 metres at The TOTE Racing Centre on the last Wednesday in February.

It was the second leg of Tasmania's feature cups double and only three horses before her had captured the Hobart-Launceston Cup double in the same season.



## rare feat

Only achieved four times in the history of the Hobart and Launceston Cups, Epingle took out both cups in the same racing year.

Brallos achieved the feat twice (1976 and 1977), St Andrews did it in 2002 and the Peter Moody trained Zacielo was successful in 2004 with Tasmanian born jockey Craig Newitt in the saddle.

The Mick Kent-trained mare won the Hobart Cup with authority with Craig Williams aboard but she was even more emphatic in the Launceston Cup despite having to lug an extra two kilograms that the handicapper gave her for winning in Hobart with 54kg.

From her outside gate (12) Williams opted to let the six-year-old drop out to last and that's where she stayed until the internationally acclaimed rider let her loose about 600m from home.

Temajim collared the leader but the swoopers began their charges with Geegees Blackflash and another interstate invader Go To Gold making their runs together.

Epingle was the widest runner into the home straight and when Williams called on her for the supreme effort she responded magnificently and went on to score comfortably from Go To Gold with Geegees Blackflash a game third in advance of his half-sister Gee Gees La Quita.

Kent was thrilled with the win and lauded the Mowbray track.

"This mare deserved to win at Group level and she's done it twice in the space of two starts here in Tassie," Kent said.

"We came here to Tassie instead of going to the Mornington Cup and it's proven to be the best decision we have made with this mare," he said.

Epingle had always shown promise as a stayer and Kent believes her Tasmanian experience will hold her in good stead for the future.

"She is a lightly raced stayer by Pins out of a Zabeel mare (Etoile Du Nord) that is only just starting to come of age.

"This is only her third try at beyond a mile and a quarter (2000 metres) so given what she's done to win both of these cups I am confident about her future.

"I am sure she will take a lot out of this trip and I am very hopeful of bringing her back to Tassie next year."

Kent took Epingle to Sydney for the Championships Carnival and the mare acquitted herself well at her first assignment finishing third to Intimate Moment and Any Day Will Do in the \$150,000 Percy Sykes Tribute Stakes over 1900 metres for fillies and mares at Rosehill.



## Mare secures TattsBet Cups Double Bonus for owner and trainer

**QUALITY** Victorian mare Epingle gave her trainer Mick Kent his biggest pay day when she powered home to win the Betfair Launceston Cup in February.

The win secured the \$100,000 TattsBet Cups Double bonus of which \$50,000 found its way into the trainer's bank account while the owner pocketed the remaining half.

The Cups Double Bonus, an initiative of sports betting provider TattsBet, was an added attraction for interstate connections to have a tilt at both events.

The introduction of the TattsBet Cups Double Bonus in 2013 created plenty of interest and it was almost taken out in its inaugural year by local star Geegees Blackflash that placed second to Hurdy Gurdy Man in the Hobart Cup before





winning the Launceston Cup. Epingle's trainer summed up the bonus in typical Mick Kent fashion.

"The TattsBet Bonus is not the reason why we came here with Epingle but I believe it is a great add-on for the Tasmanian carnival and I am very pleased to be taking home an extra \$50, 000," Kent said.

"Any cash bonus scheme for trainers and owners is good, no matter where you go to race.

Epingle became the first horse in a decade to complete the Tassie double, with Zacielo (2004) and St Andrews (2002) the only successful horses since Brallos did consecutively in 1976 and 1977.

TattsBet's Mick Edwards said the company was delighted to see Epingle's connections rewarded for making the journey across the Strait.

"As a proud supporter of Tasmanian racing, it's fantastic to see the positive impact this initiative has had on the profile of the two feature races, with some of the strongest fields in recent years," Edwards said.

"There was significant interstate interest from trainers and owners in the racing carnival and nine out of 25 acceptors across the two Cups had interstate connections."

Tasracing chief executive officer Dr Eliot Forbes said the race meetings, in terms of field sizes and field quality, was excellent.

"It was one of the best days of thoroughbred racing in Tasmania for many years, attracting strong interstate and local interest," he said.

"The \$100,000 TattsBet bonus certainly played a key role in this and trainer Mick Kent and Epingle demonstrated that with the right horse, the Hobart and Launceston cups double in the one year is achievable.

"I expect that Tasmanian and interstate-based trainers will now be taking a long hard look at the cups double in future years," Forbes said.

Edwards added that the increased profile of the event didn't just benefit the racing industry.

## Admiral salutes in Sires to stake claim on title

STAR Tasmanian two-year-old Admiral ended his season on a high with an emphatic win in the \$50,000 Sires Produce Stakes over 1400 metres at The TOTE Racing Centre in Launceston in late May.

The win took the Barry Campbell-trained gelding's career record to six wins from seven starts with his total stake earnings close to \$200,000.

Admiral (Mossman-Reunification) won both of the feature two-year-old races during the Belfair Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival starting with the \$100,000 Listed Elwick Stakes on Derby Day in Hobart followed by the \$100,000 Listed Gold Sovereign Stakes in Launceston on Cup day.

He also captured the Debutante Plate on debut, the Alfa Bowl (1100 metres) in Launceston and the \$30,000 Wakeful Club Autumn 2YO in Hobart.

In the Sires Produce there was a query on whether the Mossman gelding would handle the rain-affected track. It was also his first try beyond 1200 metres and he had to lug 60 kilograms, but he made light of the task.

Campbell rates the gelding as probably the best juvenile he has trained, which is a huge call, given he also prepared Alfa that took all before him in Tasmania before heading interstate to be trained by Bart Cummings who prepared him to win multiple Group races.

Campbell trained the state's best two-year-old the previous season in Grand Tycoon and while the trainer has a high regard for that pint-sized sprinting machine he admitted after Admiral won the Sires, that he was probably the best.

Admiral was bred by the late Dudley Clark from a mare, Reunification, that he purchased for \$30,000 at the end of her racing career.

Clark put her to Mossman in her second season at stud but when Clark became quite ill he opted to sell most of his equine stock and Bruno Calabro and a group-of friends purchased Reunification in foal.

Admiral was sent to the spelling paddock straight after his Sires Produce win and he is expected to resume racing in the spring.

## Tasmania competitive in National Apprentice Series

TASMANIA continued its association with the National Apprentice Series this season with the state's apprentices once again given the chance to showcase their riding talent at home and interstate.

Launched in 2008 for the purpose of providing opportunities to apprentices to improve their skill levels, the series draws together apprentices from around Australia to represent their State in races across the seven states and territories.

In each leg of the series, points are awarded to the top five placings, ranging from seven points for first, down to one point for fifth, with the state that accumulates the most points crowned the winner.

The series began in Doomben (QLD) with Devonport-based apprentice Chantal Willis sent north to ride for Kelly Doughty aboard four-year-old mare Lonyx on March 12.

The mare finished unplaced behind subsequent Group 3 winner Hopfgarten, but still managed to earn Tasmania a point for the series.

Leg two was closer to home a few days later (March 14) with Sigrid "Siggie" Carr successful aboard Beach Front for Brent Stanley under lights at Moonee Valley earning maximum points courtesy of a well-judged ride on the pace.

Tasmania hosted the third leg of the series also under lights in Launceston on March 19 with many of the country's top apprentices descending on the Tri-Code complex at Mowbray.

Ben Paterson (WA), Anthony Allen (QLD), Caitlin Jones (SA), Melanie Tyndall (NT) and Josh Cartwright (VIC) were the interstate representatives while Tyson Buck represented Tasmania.

Tasmania was once again successful with Tyson giving the Leon Wells-trained Jypsiere a perfect run in front to add another seven points to Tasmania's tally.

After taking the overall series lead after victories to Sigrid Carr and Tyson Buck, leg four was west, and after a few problems with flights, Turkish apprentice Ismail Toker arrived in

Perth just in time to get to Ascot to ride Chilli Deva to a fourth place for Darryn Pateman on April 16.

Millie Whitehouse-Summers was the fourth apprentice to travel interstate and went to Gawler in South Australia for the fifth leg of the series.

Unfortunately Millie's mount was scratched from the series but she did have another ride earlier in the day for a midfield finish.

Riding in the penultimate leg, Rasit Yetimova got the chance to experience the Alice Springs Cup on May 5 guiding the Lisa Lehoe gelding into a sixth place which was his first time riding on dirt.

As this publication goes to press leading apprentice Bulent Muchu is set to compete in the last heat at Hawkesbury on July 20.

South Australia has an unassailable lead in the series but Bulent will be doing his best for Tassie to finish second overall in the series.



# NEVER say NEVER

WHEN talented jockey Terry McAllister had his riding career tragically ended in a fall 10 years ago he was left to ponder a future without doing the thing that gave him the most pleasure – riding horses. The fall from Gold Mint in a trial at Elwick in June 2004 left him an incomplete quadriplegic, restricted to a wheelchair and void of normal mobility. Having his livelihood taken away from him in the twilight of his riding career was unfair but McAllister has always been a glass half-full type of person who lived by the motto “**Never Say Never**”.

When it came time to assess how he would spend the rest of his years he searched for the positives and concentrated on how to make the most of what he had left. With his wife Leanne by his side every step of the way Terry rose above his disability, though at times depression would try to eat away at his endeavor to celebrate the shiny moments during convalescence.

Two years ago Terry threw caution to the wind and made enquiries about getting back in the saddle. He had heard of the Riding for the Disabled Association (RDA). He made the trek to the Tasmanian branch of RDA Australia, located at Kalang Avenue in Glenorchy and it was a visit that would change his life.

“I had heard of the RDA program and I was keen to see what it was all about and from the moment I stepped foot in the place I knew I was onto something special,” McAllister said.

Terry’s reintroduction to horses has been a long, drawn-out process but like everything else he has tackled in his life he has emerged triumphant because of his determination to succeed.

“I went through a few stages of recovery and while I am riddled with arthritis and I have tubes permanently extruding from my abdominal region I knew that getting back on a horse would give me that special something I needed to curb depression,” he said.

Depression has been just one of a number of problems the former top rider has endured in the past decade including contracting septicaemia that almost took his life, but he prefers to hone in on the good things that have happened since the accident.

“When I was first diagnosed as a quadriplegic I was naturally devastated, but once I got over being sorry for myself the good things started to happen,” he said.

Terry worked hard during rehabilitation but when he returned home from a three-month stint at rehab in Victoria he was told that it would be impossible for him and wife Leanne to start a family.

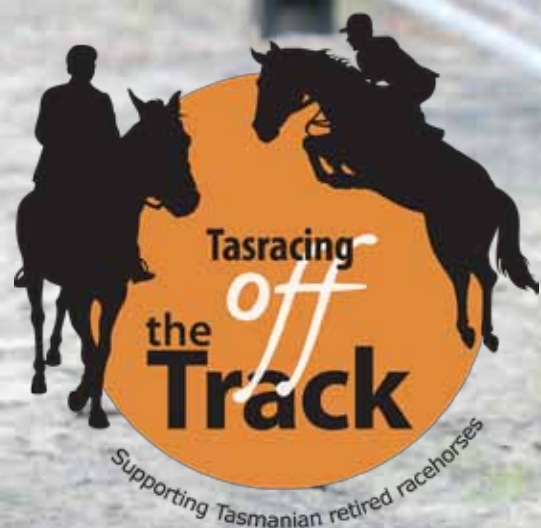
“When the doctors told us we would never be able to naturally conceive a child it was just another kick in the guts,” he said.

“But I proved them wrong again because the first night back at home our beautiful daughter Bonnie was conceived and she is now the light of our lives.”

Just when Terry was starting to get some normality back into his life Leanne was diagnosed with breast cancer which required a full mastectomy and a serious amount of chemotherapy.

“When Leanne was diagnosed with cancer we just tackled it head-on and tried to focus on the positives – what else can you do,” he said.









## “Never Say Never” Continued

With Leanne in full remission and their eight-year-old daughter Bonnie in good health and doing well at school the McAllisters are enjoying life and Terry heads to Kalang Avenue every Wednesday for what he calls his “fun time”.

His regular partner at RDA Tasmania is a former pacer named Buddy and according to Terry they have become “good mates”. “I can hardly wait for Wednesdays to come around. It gives me something extra to look forward to and the exercise is good for me,” he said.

Terry can manage to stand up and with the aid of a crutch he can walk a few metres at a time but his mobility remains very limited.

He competed in his first competition this year at RDA’s annual competition and he was rewarded for his efforts with a first, second and a third in various disciplines.

There was talk of him competing at the national championships but he admits that is a long way off. “What I am able to do on a horse at present is still quite basic and I will have to go to a much higher level before I can look at competing on the national stage but I am determined to get there,” he said.

### **Riding for the Disabled Association of Tasmania (RDA TAS)**

RDA TAS is an entirely voluntary, not for profit organisation that aims to provide horse riding and carriage driving to people of all ages with disabilities.

RDA operates five centres, from Burnie and Launceston in the north, St Helens on the east coast and two centres in the Hobart suburbs in the South. It caters for more than 76 participants to enjoy safe, stimulating, healthy therapeutic activities and is supported by more than 80 volunteers and 14 nationally accredited coaches. These volunteers and coaches ensure that everyone receives personal guidance and instruction during their weekly sessions.

RDA TAS is part of a worldwide movement and is affiliated to Riding for the Disabled Association of Australia Ltd (RDAA).

# programme notes

The Tasmanian Winter-Spring Program presents several initiatives, which will provide excellent opportunities for participants throughout the latter part of Winter and into the Spring.

This will commence with the showcase of Tapeta Park, Devonport through the month of August with the inaugural staging of the Tapeta Series.

The **Tapeta Series** consists of four events providing opportunity to both sprinters and stayers.

- Sunday 10 August  
\$20,000 Sprint Prelude 1000m
- Sunday 17 August  
\$20,000 Distance Prelude 1650m
- Saturday 23 August  
\$25,000 Sprint Final 1150m
- Sunday 31 August  
\$25,000 Distance Final 1880m

A trial throughout August and September will see an alteration to the benchmark bands with Benchmark 72 and Benchmark 82 being run and the number of Open handicaps restricted to the 4 races outlined within the Tapeta Series.

In past seasons the period in question, August and September, has witnessed a lack of genuine open class gallopers, with the majority focussing their preparations towards the summer racing season.

The implementation of this initiative is to improve the distribution of the population across programmed races, increasing breadth of distribution of prize money and also help ensure better field sizes to improve wagering.

Tasracing will review all key metrics - racing population distribution, race nomination numbers, average race field sizes and average race wagering turnover, throughout this time to gauge the effectiveness of the winter program.

November is the traditional starting point for the feature race program and 2014 will again provide opportunities for the quality gallopers to start their campaigns for the Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival (TSRC), with some adjustment to the previous years' schedule.

The Feature Race program for 2014/15 has undergone noticeable alteration to accommodate the introduction of a Friday twilight fixture for the Tasmanian Race Club (TRC) Tasmanian Derby meeting on 6 February, which will compliment the Hobart Cup on Monday 9 February.

TSRC 2014/15 will also see the Tasmanian Turf Club (TTC) Tasmanian Oaks run on 'Ladies Day' Sunday 22 February, three days prior to the Launceston Cup.

Tasracing has assisted both the TRC and TTC in restructuring the schedule so to present an opportunity to deliver 'Mini Carnival' race days. The 'Mini Carnival' race days are focused on strategically placing events around the TSRC major races, to maximise opportunity for the race clubs to enhance public attendance.

In doing so, the following changes to the feature race program have been required to best fit the needs of horses and participants, whilst also accommodating restrictions with SKY broadcast availability.

## Tasmanian Racing Club (TRC)

- Hobart Cup Day reverts from Sunday to Monday 9 February (Regatta Day Public Holiday)
- Tasmanian Derby & Bow Mistress Trophy to Friday Twilight 6 February, from the preceding Sunday
- Hobart Guineas Day to Sunday 25 January, a week later than 2013 - to accommodate flow into Tasmanian Derby Day
- Tasmanian Guineas (Listed Race) moves from TTC (Swap for Tasmanian Stakes (Listed Race) to Sunday 11 January – to accommodate flow into Tasmanian Derby day
- Winzenberg Trophy & Alexandra Plate to be run on a Friday Twilight meeting 19 December, in lieu of traditional Sunday fixture
- Goodwood Hcp & 2YO Debutante to Sunday November 16 from Sunday 20 October in 2013 to facilitate desired program coordination into TTC Newmarket Hcp

## Tasmanian Turf Club (TTC)

- Tasmanian Oaks to Sunday 22 February, placing it between Wednesday meetings for Vamos Stakes and Launceston Cup, from Wednesday 18 February
- Night Cup to Wednesday 18 February to bolster Vamos Stakes meeting, from Wednesday 11 February
- Tasmanian Stakes (Listed Race) WFA from TRC (Swap for Tasmanian Guineas (Listed Race) to Wednesday 31 December

## HANDICAPPING NOTES

### Unraced Horses Rating 59:


The RV Handicappers have examined, the standard employed for the base rating of unraced horses throughout Australia, and as a result of this observation it was concluded that the current rating of 61 for Tasmanian horses on a relative basis was too high.

As an example, unraced horses in Victoria start at a rating 61 and the depth of maiden winners generally is stronger than in Tasmania. As of 1 August 2014 the rating of unraced horses in Tasmania will be reduced to 59. This will provide better opportunity for the lightly raced horses to progress through their grades and deliver a more equitable rating in relation to the remainder of Australia.

### Quality Handicaps 61kg Maximum Top Weight:

Since the promotion of the 54kg minimum weight across Australia, the weight structure of Quality Handicaps has shifted to advantage horses that have established a high rating through their performance profile.

With an additional kilogram added to ensure a maximum top weight of 61kg, the races will still be an attractive proposition for the established horses, whilst having seven kilograms between top and bottom weights will assist in making these races more competitive.

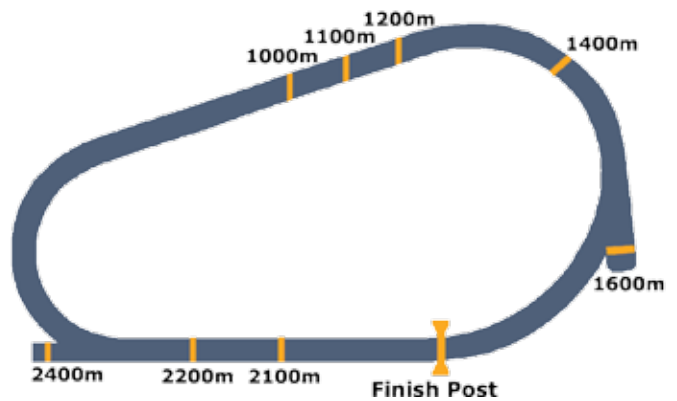

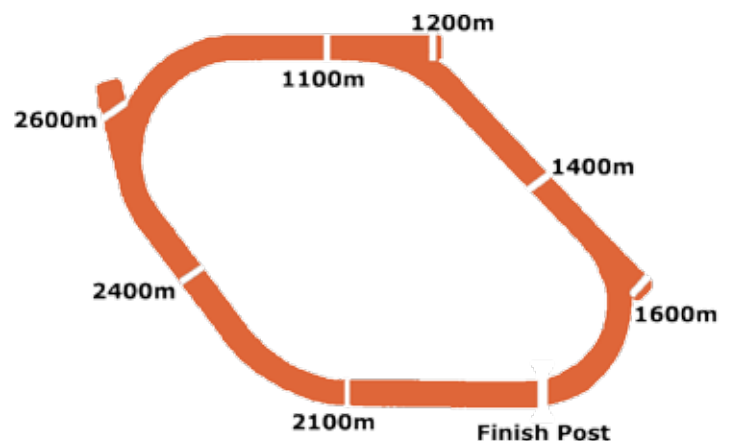

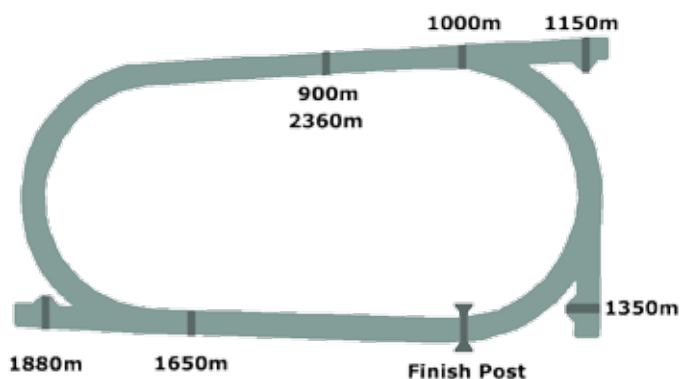

The ARB Board April quarterly meeting decided issues of importance to the industry including the following three issues:

**1. INTRA-ARTICULAR CORTICOSTEROIDS**

Australia needs to introduce a rule defining the length of time before a horse can race after an intra-articular administration of corticosteroids. The Board, having regard to extensive veterinary and scientific advice, has decided that the Stand Down Period will be 10 days (8 Clear Days) from administration to racing. The Board consulted with the various stakeholder groups and took into account their views. The Board made its decision in the best interests of the welfare of the horse and safety of riders whilst cognizant of Australian racing conditions.

A new rule to introduce a 10 day (8 Clear Days) Stand Down Period will be introduced on 1 August, 2014.

**2. NEW TRACK RATINGS SCALE**

The Board decided to modernize the language for track ratings to be more easily understood by punters especially young people. The ARB issued a revised scale in January and called for public and industry input. Retention of the numerical scale of 1-10 was strongly endorsed by punters whilst most of the submissions centred on the proposed ratings.

**The new Track Ratings Scale is:**

Rating	Numerical Rating	Description of Numerical Rating
Firm	1	Dry hard track
Firm	2	Firm track with reasonable grass coverage
Good	3	Track with good grass coverage and cushion
Good	4	Track with some give in it
Soft	5	Track with a reasonable amount of give in it
Soft	6	Moist but not a badly affected track
Soft	7	More rain-affected track that will chop out
Heavy	8	Rain affected track that horses will get into
Heavy	9	Wet track getting into a squelchy area
Heavy	10	Heaviest category track, very wet, towards saturation.

**The new ratings will come into effect on 1 December, 2014** as extensive changes are required to the IT systems and data feeds of RISA and their commercial customers. The delay in introduction is due to the need to backdate track conditions so as to accurately record a horse's performance. The historical data is essential information to punters.

**3. AR.178AA –ONE CLEAR DAY PROHIBITION ON ALKALINIZING AGENTS**

Following the withdrawal of El Roca at Rosehill Gardens on 1 March, 2014 as it had been intravenously administered a hypertonic saline and alkalinizing solution within One Clear Day before race day, the ARB Board resolved to amend AR.178AA to ensure uniformity and certainty of application across all jurisdictions:

- (i) AR.178AA(5)(c)(i) will be amended so that in future it will be the ARB and not stewards who must be satisfied which alkalinizing agents contained in commercial feeds and balanced electrolyte supplements have a negligible effect on plasma TCO<sub>2</sub>.
- (ii) The ARB advised in an Industry Notice of 26 August, 2013 which alkalinizing agents have a negligible effect when contained in commercial feeds and balanced electrolyte supplements. Lang's IV is expressly prohibited in that Industry Notice.
- (iii) All jurisdictions agree to be bound by the Industry Notice of the 26 August, 2013. However it is open to any jurisdiction to seek to amend the Industry Notice.
- (iv) Any request to amend the Industry Notice will be considered by the ARB's Veterinary and Analysts Committee (VAC). In considering such a request, VAC will apply the same criteria as before consistent with the ARB's policy of prohibiting alkalinizing agents One Clear Day before race day other than those which have a negligible effect on TCO<sub>2</sub> in commercial feeds and balanced electrolyte supplements.

## AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

### SUMMARY OF AMENDED ARR ON RETIREMENT OF A HORSE

The ARB has decided to introduce a new rule making it compulsory for owners to notify RISA on the retirement of their horse. The form specifically designed for this purpose will require the owner to indicate where the horse is destined (public auction, a paddock, a pony club, etc.).

The current system only requires a stable return for when a horse leaves a stable and approximately half of horses exiting a stable go to other trainers so we have no exact knowledge of the destination of ex-racehorses or even how many there are.

The ARB has identified the retirement of racehorses as a vitally important welfare issue and PRAs have adopted a number of rehoming programs to this end. The statistical data sought is an essential element in tracking retired racehorses. Amendment to AR.64J

#### Please delete AR.64J and replace with the following:

##### “AR.64J

- (1) Upon the death of a horse which had not been retired, the trainer or his or her authorised agent must report the occurrence to the relevant Principal Racing Authority or their agent as soon as practicable.
- (2) In the event of the deceased horse being included in a current stable return the trainer must as soon as practicable lodge an amended stable return in relation to the death.
- (3) Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of sub-rules (1) or (2) commits a breach of these Rules unless he or she proves to the satisfaction of the Stewards that he or she was not aware, and could not reasonably have been aware, of the death of the horse.”

**Date of effect: 1st July 2014**

### NEW RULE AR.64JA

#### Please insert the following:

##### “AR.64JA

- (1) Where a horse has been retired from racing, the Manager (as defined in AR.1) of the horse at time of its retirement must, within one month of the horse's retirement, notify the Registrar by lodging the relevant form prescribed by the Registrar.

- (2) Where a form has been lodged in accordance with AR.64JA(1), the retired horse will cease to be registered and is ineligible to race unless it is re-registered.
- (3) Where a horse ceases to be registered under this Rule, the horse may not be re-registered except with the express permission of the Stewards.
- (4) Any person who fails to comply with AR.64JA(1) commits a breach of these Rules and may be penalised.”

**Date of effect: 1st July 2014**

### SUMMARY OF NEW ARR ON DRUG & ALCOHOL TESTING OF HORSE HANDLERS

These new rules stem from both a safety and an integrity viewpoint and after lengthy consultation from within and outside of the industry. A horse handler affected by an illicit substance or alcohol poses a significant safety risk in the work place to other workers and to horses in their care.

#### The major components of the new Rules are:

1. The power for Stewards to conduct drug and alcohol testing operations for the purpose of testing horse handlers is set out in the new Rule AR8(jjj). Further, as a condition of licence, horse handlers undertake to submit to tests that are intended to detect substances banned under these Rules.
2. The Rules relevant to the offence are outlined in new Rule AR.81AA.
3. AR.81BB categorises the banned substances when found in a urine sample of a horse handler. They are broadly grouped into the following:
  - Alcohol (at a concentration in excess of .05% on a breath analyser)
  - Cannabis
  - Amphetamines
  - Ecstasy
  - Cocaine

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON BANNED SUBSTANCES – HERBAL REMEDIES

Riders and stable employees are warned against taking herbal and other “over the counter” medicines without firstly making thorough enquiries as to whether ingredients of such products are regarded as a banned substance. The fact that a medicine is herbal or indeed “non-prescription” does not at all guarantee that it does not contain a banned substance. In particular, there is a need to be wary of products where ingredients are not fully listed or herbal products where ingredients may vary between batches.

Just a few examples of these products that are available “over the counter” or via the internet that fall within the definition of a banned substance include:

1. Reductil: a weight reduction pill containing sibutramine;
2. Citrus aurantium (bitter orange) extract: containing the weight loss agent synephrine;
3. Coca tea derived from the coca plant: containing the illegal stimulant cocaine;
4. Thermo-lift classic formula: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine; and
5. Ephedra sinica (ma huang) extract: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine.

Breaches of the banned substance Rules attract substantial penalties which necessarily must contain elements of both specific and general deterrence.

### RE-TESTING OF DRUG OFFENDERS BEFORE RESUMPTION

Under AR.81AA(4) a horse handler incurring a penalty under this rule must not resume handling horses, unless otherwise authorised by the Stewards, until he delivers a sample as directed by the Stewards that is free of any substance banned by AR.81BB

### AMENDMENT TO AR.1

#### Addition to AR.1 as follows:

““Horse handler” means any licensed or any person who handles any horse at any meetings, trial, jump out or in training and includes but is not limited to stable hands, trainers, veterinarians, farriers and barrier attendants.”

**ADDITION OF RULE 8(jjj)**

**Please insert the following:**

“(jjj) To take or cause to be taken any sample from any horse handler either prior to or after handling any horse at any race meeting, official trial, jump out or in training, provided that this power may only be exercised where a Steward reasonably suspects that a horse handler is affected by a substance banned by AR.81BB. Reasonably suspects means suspects on grounds which are reasonable in the circumstances.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**ADDITION OF RULE 8(jjjj)**

**Please insert the following:**

“(jjjj) to make or cause to be made any test to determine whether any substance banned by AR.81BB is present in a sample taken pursuant to (jjj) above.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**ADDITION OF RULE 81AA**

**Please insert the following:**

“AR.81AA. (1) Any Horse Handler commits an offence and may be penalised if:

- (a) A sample taken from him is found upon analysis to contain a substance banned by AR.81BB; or
- (b) He refuses or fails to deliver a sample as directed by the Stewards, or tampers with or in any way hinders the collection of such sample.

(2) Any Horse Handler may be prevented by the Stewards from handling any horse in training, based on any information, their own observations or on medical or other competent advice that his faculties may be impaired by any substance banned by AR.81BB.

(3) In the event of any analysis or a preliminary analysis of a sample taken from a horse handler pursuant to AR.8(jjj) indicating the presence of a substance banned by AR.81BB, or if a Horse Handler refuses or fails to deliver a sample when directed to do so, the Stewards may forthwith, pending the determination of any inquiry or other proceeding, or the result of any other analysis, stand down such person from handling horses.

(4) In the event of a Horse Handler incurring a penalty under this rule or being stood down from handling horses he shall not unless otherwise authorised by the Stewards resume handling horses until he delivers a sample as directed by the Stewards that is found upon analysis to be free of any substance banned by AR.81BB.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**ADDITION OF RULE 81BB**

**Please insert the following:**

“AR.81BB. The following substances and/or their metabolites, artefacts and isomers are declared as banned substances in horse handlers when present in a urine sample (unless otherwise stated) at a concentration above the applicable cut-off level:

- Lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) (0µg/L);
- All barbiturates (0µg/L);
- Cannabinoids (11-Nor-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid) (15µg/L);
- Alcohol (at a concentration in excess of 0.05% on a breath analyser);
- All stimulants – substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, Amphetamine (150µg/L);
- Methylamphetamine (150µg/L);
- Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA) (150µg/L);
- Methylenedioxymethylamphetamine (MDEA) (150µg/L);
- Methedioxymethylamphetamine (MDMA) (150µg/L);
- Methylphenidate (0µg/L);
- Modafinil (0µg/L);
- Cocaine (100µg/L);
- Ephedrine (10,000µg/L).

*Substances in this group*

*excluded are:* Levo-amphetamine; Levo-methylamphetamine; Phenylpropanolamine; Pseudoephedrine.

*All opiates and opioids – substances in this group include, but are not restricted to,*

- Morphine (0µg/L, save as specified by AR.81C);
- Codeine (0µg/L, save as specified in AR.81C);
- Oxycodone (0µg/L);
- Fentanyl (0µg/L);
- Alfentanil (0µg/L);
- Pethidine (0µg/L);
- Methadone (0µg/L);
- Heroin (0µg/L);
- Monoacetylmorphine (0µg/L);
- Hydromorphone (0µg/L);
- Buprenorphine (0µg/L).

*Substances in this group excluded are:* Dihydrocodeine; Dextromethorphan; Pholcodine; Propoxyphene; Tramadol.

*All dissociative anaesthetics and related substances – substance in this group include, but are not restricted to:* Ketamine (0µg/L); Phencyclidine (0µg/L); Tiletamine (0µg/L).

*All benzodiazepines – substances in this group include, but are not restricted to:*

Diazepam (200µg/L); Nordiazepam (200µg/L); Oxazepam (200µg/L); Temazepam (200µg/L); Alprazolam (100µg/L) as alpha-hydroxyalprazolam); Clonazepam (100µg/L, as 7-aminoclonazepam); Flunitrazepam (100µg/L, as 7-aminoflunitrazepam); Nitrazepam (100µg/L, as 7-aminonitrazepam); Bromazepam (0µg/L); Clobazam (0µg/L); Flumazenil (0µg/L); Lorazepam (0µg/L); Midazolam (0µg/L); Triazolam (0µg/L); and substances with similar structure or pharmacological activity – benzodiazepine receptor agonists (zalplon: zolpidem; zopiclone).”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**AMENDMENT TO RULE 81C**

Please delete Rule 81C and replace with the following:

“AR.81C. Notwithstanding the provisions of AR.81B and AR.81BB, when codeine and/or morphine are detected in a sample taken from a rider or a horse handler then the sample shall be deemed not to contain codeine and morphine if:

- (a) The total codeine and morphine concentration is less than 2,000Sg/L; or
- (b) The total codeine and morphine concentration achieved in confirmatory testing is in the range 2,000 to 15,000µg/L inclusive and at least one of the following applies:
  - (i) The codeine to morphine ratio contained in the sample is greater than 1.0; or
  - (ii) The rider or Horse Handler satisfies the Stewards that there is no illegal use of opiates or opioids by the rider or Horse Handler.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**AMENDMENT TO RULE 81D**

Please delete Rule 81D and replace with the following:

“AR.81D. The Stewards may stay in whole or in part, and for such period and under such terms and conditions as they think fit, the operation of any penalty imposed for a

breach of AR.81A or AR.81AA. Provided that, in the event of any failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of the stay, the Stewards may order that the penalty take effect.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**AMENDMENT TO RULE 81E**

Please delete Rule 81E and replace with the following:

“AR.81E. Notwithstanding the provisions of AR.81A and AR.81AA, a Principal Racing Authority may permit a rider or horse handler to receive a specified banned substance, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The medication must be essential treatment for a substantial illness, condition or ailment suffered by the rider or horse handler;
- (b) The medication must be prescribed by a medical practitioner who is a recognised specialist in the relevant field of medicine;
- (c) The specialist medical practitioner must certify:
  - (i) the nature of the illness, condition or ailment being suffered by the rider or horse handler.
  - (ii) that no alternative, non-banned substance would serve the same purpose for the illness, condition or ailment concerned.
  - (iii) that the medication would not affect the rider in a race, trial or trackwork to the extent that it could in any way constitute a danger to other riders.
  - (iv) that the medication would not affect the horse handler in the carrying out of his duties and/or constitute a danger to himself or to others.
- (d) The rider or the horse handler must if requested submit to medical examination by a specialist medical practitioner appointed by a Principal Racing Authority to advise it on the matters referred to in subparagraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of paragraph (c) of this rule.
- (e) The rider or horse handler must:
  - (i) Before riding or handling any horse make application to the Principal Racing Authority for permission to ride or handle a horse with a specifically prescribed banned substance in his system.

- (ii) Adhere strictly to his prescribed medication, and must report to the Stewards immediately he forms the intention to discontinue or in any way vary his prescribed medication;
- (iii) Report to the Stewards immediately he believes that either his illness, condition or ailment or his medication may have some influence on his ability to ride or handle a horse effectively and/or safely.
- (iv) Renew his application for exemption on each occasion on which he applies for the renewal of his licence, registration, permit or other qualification.”

**Date of Effect: 1st July 2014**

**SUMMARY OF AMENDED ARR ON SAFETY VESTS**

The ARB approved changes to the Rules governing the certification of jockey safety vests following the banning of the Tipperary Vest for failing to meet its certified standard.

In the interests of rider safety, the ARB has decided to amend AR.87B to incorporate the following enhancements to Safety Vests:

1. Delete the SATRA standard from the prescribed standards as it is unreliable and not used in any other major racing jurisdiction.
2. Continue with only two prescribed standards being the ARB Standard and the European Standard EN 13158 as proven and reliable safety standards.
3. Establish a list of Approved Vests in addition to the two prescribed standards as an added safeguard against self-certification or substandard vests.
4. Permit the use of heavier level 2 vests (raceday vests are usually the lighter level 1 category) which may provide a higher level of protection for track work.

**AMENDMENT TO AR.87B**

**Please delete AR.87B and replace with the following:**

“AR.87B. (1) Every rider shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly fastened Approved or permitted safety vest the standard of which has been prescribed by Order of the Board. Provided that every such Approved or permitted safety vest

shall be in a satisfactory condition and shall have attached to it a manufacturer’s label that states that it complies with the relevant standard prescribed by the Board.

- (2) Notwithstanding compliance with subrule (1), no safety vest may be worn in a race, official trial or jumpout unless it is an Approved safety vest. Such Approved Level 1 safety vests are: Hows Racesafe, Ozvest, Racelite Pro and Vipa.
- (3) The Stewards may confiscate or order the satisfactory repair of any safety vest that does not comply with the requirements of subrules (1) and (2).

Note: Pursuant to AR.87B, the Australian Racing Board has ordered that the following two standards of safety vests only are prescribed: ARB Standard 1.1998 and European Standard EN 13158.”

**Date of effect: 1st July 2014**

**AMENDMENT TO AR.87D**

Please delete AR.87D and replace with the following:

“AR.87D. Any rider required by these rules to wear an Approved safety vest may be penalised if he wears or has in his possession any safety vest that does not conform with a standard which has been prescribed by the Board or which has been modified in any way.”

**Date of effect: 1st July 2014**

**AMENDMENT TO AR.118C**

Please delete AR.118C and replace with the following:

“AR.118C. It shall be an offence for any rider -

- (a) to in any way manipulate or attempt to manipulate the wearing of a safety vest to gain an unfair weight advantage in a race; or
- (b) to weigh-out or attempt to weigh-out for a race or ride in any race when wearing an Approved safety vest that has been modified in any way.
- (c) to weigh-out or attempt to weigh-out or ride in any race unless he is wearing an Approved safety vest.”

**Date of effect: 1st July 2014**

## AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL RULES OF RACING

### LOCAL RULE 14 SCRATCHINGS AND TIME TO BE AT RACECOURSE

#### 14.3 Saddling Paddock

- (a) Further to the provisions of AR 117 unless otherwise directed by the Chairman of Stewards all horses intended to be run in any race shall be brought into the saddling paddock at least one and a half hours before the time appointed for the starting of such race. **(Amended effective 1.3.2014)**
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of 14.3(a), horses intended to be run in the first race are to be brought into the saddling paddock at least one hour before the time appointed for the starting of such race. **(New rule effective 1.3.2014)**
- (c) No horse, which has been brought into the saddling paddock, shall be removed without the permission of the Stewards. **(Previously rule 14.3(b))**

### LOCAL RULE 16 JOCKEYS, APPRENTICES AND APPROVED TRIALS RIDERS

- 16.1. No person shall ride in a race at any race meeting or at official trials held within the State of Tasmania (unless such meeting has been exempted from the operation of this Rule) unless he or she is:
- (a) licensed as a Jockey by the Director, or
  - (b) an Apprentice indentured under an agreement with Tasracing and has obtained a permit from RST to ride in races, or
  - (c) In the case of an apprentice indentured with another recognised racing authority the Director may grant permission for such apprentice to ride if they are satisfied that he has the sanctions required by the Racing Rules and Regulations in force where he is indentured and submitted a Visiting Apprentice Notification, current medical examination report and letter from his/her Master granting approval to ride, or
  - (d) licensed as an Approved Trials Rider by the Director.
  - (e) licensed with Racing Victoria as a Jumps Jockey A or Jumps Jockey B and has made application to be licensed as a jockey in Tasmania and therefore may ride at any trial, jump out or trackwork held within the state of Tasmania. **(New rule effective 1.3.2014)**
- 16.5. As a pre requisite to the granting of a licence a jockey, apprentice or approved trial rider must supply Next of Kin details and emergency medical information to Racing Services Tasmania on the prescribed forms and undertaken cognitive testing. **(Amended effective 1.3.2014)**

# Stewards Segment

## STABLE INSPECTIONS

Most trainers would have had a visit from the Racing Services Tasmania Investigative Unit. These visits can and will occur at any time and their main focus is to examine horses and articles which are mainly applicable to race day activities. For the past 12 months the unit has provided advice to trainers on matters that relate to the adherence of treatment books, medication, storing of medication, location of horses, stable security etc.

Trainers should now be aware that the unit will now deal with matters on the spot and refer more serious rule breach matters to the Stewards for determination.

## JOCKEY'S RIDING OVERWEIGHT

During their regular consultation meetings the Racing Services Tasmania Stewards, Tasracing and the Tasmanian Jockeys Association have resolved that the Stewards will alter their current policy and grant permission for riders to ride ½ kilogram over their handicapped weight up to 55 Kg.

Permission will only be given provided that the connections of the horse that will be affected are consulted by the rider and they agree that their horse will carry ½ kilogram extra.

When assessing to alter the policy the Stewards were mindful of other jurisdictions rules and policies that relate to this matter and that this will allow connections to have a wider range of options when deciding on a rider for their horse.

## STABLEHAND IDENTIFICATION CARDS

Tasmanian Local Rule of Racing 19.1(b)(vii) states – “A registered Stable Employee Attendant with a horse at any race meeting or trial meeting must visibly display the photographic identity card current for the present racing year issued by Racing Services Tasmania. Any registered Stable Employee who fails to comply with this rule may be punished and may not be permitted to attend horses at that race meeting.”

It is the Stewards' intention to vigilantly apply this rule. It is recommended if you have lost or misplaced your card you should contact Racing Services Tasmania to arrange a replacement.

## CHANGE OF TACTICS NOTIFICATION

Australian Rule of Racing 135A states – “When by or on behalf of a trainer, any instruction is given to, or arrangement made with the rider of a horse engaged in a race that the horse be ridden in the race in a manner different from the manner in which the horse was ridden at its most recent start or starts, it shall be the responsibility of the trainer or his duly authorised agent to notify the Stewards of any such instruction or arrangement as early as practicable but not later than 30 minutes prior to the race. Upon receipt of that notification the Stewards may make any public release in respect thereof as they deem to be appropriate.”

Trainers/Owners must be aware of the requirement of this rule and duly notify Stewards if there is going to be a change of tactics that differ markedly from the horse's most recent runs.
