Wordsmith

Wordsmith produced amazing results as a first season sire with his first crop of two-year-olds winning nine races placing him in the top 10 on Australia's first season sires list.

The son of Testa Rossa delivered a strike rate of 46% which was the best in the country.

LEADING JOCKEY AWARD
Brendon McCoull

Brendon had a remarkable season riding 70 winners despite being sidelined for a total of three months through injury.

In booting home 70 winners he earned for connections just over \$1 million in stakes.

This is Brendon's 13th jockeys' premiership.



1 2YO HORSE OF THE YEAR
Grand Tycoon

Grand Tycoon won 7 of his 8 starts in Tasmania last season. He won every 2YO feature race on the calendar except the Autumn Classic in which he finished second. Owned by Charlie and Wendy Langmaid, he earned over \$200,000 in stakes from his 8 starts.

2 LEADING SIRE AWARD
Savoire Vivre

Savoire Vivre sired 60 winners and 131 placegetters from 528 starters for \$1.172 million in stakes.

3 LEADING TRAINER AWARD
David & Scott Brunton

The David and Scott training partnership ended the season with 78 winners and accrued prizemoney of \$1.129 million and was their third successive premiership.

4 3YO HORSE OF THE YEAR
Mister John

The Royston Carr-trained gelding raced five times in Tasmania last season for three wins and two minor placings with his best effort coming in the Listed Tasmania Guineas in Launceston in which he defeated a star-studded field. The gelded son of Strada is a worthy winner of the three-year-old of the year title.

5 LEADING FILLY OR MARE **Rebel Bride**

Rebel Bride had another outstanding season that was capped with her second successive victory in the Group 3 Bow Mistress.



6 HORSE OF THE YEAR **Norsqui**

Norsqui saved his best performances last season for the national arena.

The Walter McShane trained gelding ventured to South Australia to win the \$400,000 Group 2 Adelaide Cup over 3200 metres and then travelled to NSW where he was a gallant second in the \$500,000 Group 1 Sydney Cup also over 3200 metres.

Norsqui is a worthy winner of the 2012-13 Tasmanian Horse of the Year title.



1 BARRY CAMPBELL

Barry Campbell has earned a reputation as a master trainer and expert horseman. His name will always be synonymous with superstar Tasmanian gallopers Alfa and El Mirada who both went on to Group 1 success interstate, but his record as a trainer goes far beyond the deeds of those two horses.

Campbell has also launched the careers of Sedation and Vetyvere who went on to compete at the highest level in Victoria, while his record in Tasmanian classic races is as good as any trainer of the modern era. Despite having fewer horses in his stable than most of the state's leading trainers, Campbell has seldom been out of the top half dozen on the premiership table and won the title in 1995-96 when he prepared 62 winners.

2 LADY LYNETTE

Lady Lynette makes her way into the Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame as one of the best mares to grace the Tasmanian turf. The mare's record includes multiple feature race wins in her home state including the 2011 Group 3 Bow Mistress Stakes and she retired a three-time winner of the Listed Vamos Stakes over 1400 metres in Launceston which is a record that may never be broken. But it was her sensational record on the national stage that fully showcased her ability. For almost all of her racing career she was trained by David Brunton and in his care she won or was placed in 12 Group races interstate. Lady Lynette was purchased for only \$13,000 at the 2006 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale and at the end of her racing career she was purchased by Gerry Harvey at the 2012 William Inglis Easter Broodmare Sale for \$270,000.

3 PIPING LANE

Piping Lane came to prominence after winning the 1972 Melbourne Cup at odds of 40 to 1. He is only the third Tasmanian bred horse to win a Melbourne Cup along with Malua and Sheet Anchor. Piping Lane was one of the inaugural inductees into the Hall of Fame in 2005 and this year he was upgraded to Legend status.

4 WEASEL WILL

Weasel Will ranks as one of the finest milers produced in Tasmania. The Weasel Clause gelding, owned and raced by the late Peter Burt and his wife Val, raced 47 times for nine wins, nine placings and \$750,000 in stakes. He nearly always competed at the highest level with \$625,000 of his earnings derived from group and listed races. Weasel Will started his career in Tasmania where he won two of his six starts for trainer Graeme McCulloch.

He then went to Bart Cummings in Melbourne and won second-up at Caulfield in July 1999 before being transferred to the Nigel Blackiston stable where he spent the rest of his career. Throughout his career, Weasel Will contested 11 Group 1 races but his biggest wins came in the Group 2 Waterford Crystal Mile at Moonee Valley which he won in 2000 and 2001.

5 TOM WRAGG

Tom Wragg's career as a bookmaker in Tasmania spanned over 50 years. As an off-course bookmaker he was considered courageous and earned a reputation as a bookie who was prepared to take the punters on at all costs. He worked alongside other famous bookmakers of his era including Ken Dick and Trevor "Dizzy" Campbell. Tom's service to bookmaking was recognised by life membership of the Tasmanian Bookmaker's Association. He also served as president of the Association.

6 BERNIE MCKAY

Bernie McKay's long association with racing as a steward, handicapper and historian earned him the respect and friendship of countless people in the thoroughbred industry. His outstanding work as a steward in Tasmania resulted in his appointment as chief steward in Malaysia. He returned to Tasmania to take up a role as handicapper and was also relied upon by the media as the unofficial Tasmanian thoroughbred historian. Upon his death in 2012 one of Tasmania's most respected racing administrators, the late Rod Thirkell-Johnston, described him as "a wonderful person, a pleasure to work with and, in my opinion, the best chief steward we have had in Tasmania in my time."

7 CRAIG NEWITT

With so much success at Group level in Australia and abroad, Craig Newitt is a worthy inductee into the Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame despite his tender age of 28. In his first year of riding in Tasmania Craig won the apprentices title despite having only ridden for the last seven months of the season. In the following season he won the apprentices and senior title and that effort launched his career on the national stage. Since 2002, Craig has regularly been in the top 10 riders in Victoria and has enjoyed success on the international stage winning at Group 1 level at Royal Ascot aboard Miss Andretti. At the time of receiving the award his latest Group 1 victory came courtesy of a brilliant ride on Shamexpress in the 2013 Newmarket Handicap at Flemington.

President steps aside after more than 2 decades in role ...



At the Australian Trainers' Association (ATA) Tasmanian Branch Annual General Meeting held on Wednesday 2 October, Walter McShane decided to step aside as President, after serving more than two decades in the role.

Walter is widely acknowledged as a tireless and committed representative of Tasmanian trainers and has performed his role with distinction both as Tasmanian ATA President and as a negotiator with Governing Bodies in the State and State Governments.

A highly successful racehorse trainer both in Tasmania and on the mainland, Walter is also a successful breeder, and through this success has helped promote the Tasmanian bred racehorse.

Walter's service, experience, knowledge and efforts will continue to benefit local trainers as he has agreed to remain on the Committee of the ATA Tasmanian Branch in the capacity of Vice-President, and will also remain a Member of the ATA Federal Executive. Walter's in-depth knowledge of local and national racing issues will ensure that the ATA and the State and National racing industries will be the beneficiary of his expertise.

Leading Tasmanian Trainer, David Brunton has been elected as President with Christine Crook to remain in the role of Secretary.



Consequence

... the amazing story of one woman and her love of a retired thoroughbred racehorse.

THOROUGHBRED mare AL Shiraz tried valiantly to be a racehorse but despite a number of solid performances and encouragement from Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame trainer Barry Campbell she couldn't quite measure up.

Al Shiraz was bred by prominent thoroughbred owner-breeders Terry Clayton and Peter Thomas but when Campbell delivered the news in 2005 that she wasn't up to advancing her career in racing they sold her as a potential pony club hack.

Al Shiraz (Aliocha-Maglieri) ended her racing career with one win and three minor placings from 14 starts.

"The mare tried hard but she just wasn't quick enough to go any further as a racehorse," Campbell said.

The mare ended up at Sheffield but she proved to be a bit too frisky for her young owner and that's when experienced equestrian rider Tania Hay took a chance and invested all of her savings to buy the mare.

Hay parted with \$9000 for the mare that was located in a number of shoe boxes and other storage containers and stashed away for a rainy day at her and her partner Laurie Smith's property at Orielson.

"There's no doubt we took a big risk," Hay said.

"But somehow I knew deep down that this mare had that something special," she said.

Al Shiraz had her name changed to Consequence which, as Hay explained, had some significance.

"When we handed over the \$9000 we were flat broke and that was the consequence of buying the mare," she said.

Hay, who has been involved in showing horses for more than two decades, had longed to own one that could deliver the goods at the highest level.

Consequence has delivered that outcome and has proven to be the best \$9000 Hay has ever spent.

Consequence responded well to Hay's education process and before she knew it the mare was collecting ribbons at major shows around Tasmania with a Reserve Champion title at the 2006 Royal Hobart Show at her first attempt a sign of things to come.

Hay said she knew for sure that she had something special in the mare's first year in the show ring (2006).

As well as winning Reserve Champion at Royal Hobart Show, Consequence also won Equestrian Australia Newcomer Hack of the Year and overall EA Newcomer Exhibit of the Year.

She was also the Pritchard Spalding best lightweight hack exhibit for thoroughbreds at the Royal Hobart Show.

If that wasn't enough to convince all and sundry that a new star had emerged in the show ring, Consequence also won Show Horse Council of Tasmania Newcomer Hack of the Year; Show Horse Council (SHC) overall Newcomer Horse of the Year and Open Hack of the Year.

In only her second year (2007) in the ring Hay took Consequence to Victoria for the Barastoc Horse of the Year which, according to Hay, is "the biggest show in Australasia."

"I took a huge punt on taking her to Barastoc because she was only a newcomer horse in only her first season of showing but much to my surprise she was named Runner-Up Hack of the Year," she said.

The mare went from strength to strength and has taken Hay on the ride of her life.

"This mare has taken me to places I only ever dreamed of so she is definitely cherished in more ways than one," she said.

Consequence and Hay are almost inseparable and while the mare can still do things that wind her owner-trainer up, Hay can also irritate Consequence by changing her training regime.

"I knew the mare would be competitive from the outset because she was a very quick learner and she just thrived on the work that we put into getting her ready for equestrian life," Hay said.

"She is a very clever horse and she sometimes has her own way of thinking things through and maybe not always the way that I want her to do things but eventually we get the desired results."

Just recently Hay was offered a substantial amount of money for Consequence but she said no amount of money could wrest the mare away from her.

"I have told everyone who has wanted to buy her that she is not for sale at any price," she said.

"This horse is more like a child to me and that's probably one of the reasons why she has done so well."

Hay works fulltime with Tasmania Police, often working late shifts and that's when her partner takes responsibility for the mare's welfare.

"If I'm working late and I see the weather report says there are high winds in our area I ring Laurie and tell him to put the mare inside because she just hates the wind."

"There's no doubt the mare rules our lives but I wouldn't have it any other way," she said.

Consequence is in her eighth season of equestrian competition and while the mare has endured a slight tendon issue she is expected to again make her presence felt in all the major shows in Tasmania in 2013-14.

When Paul and Elizabeth Geard lost their stallion Atlantis Prince to cancer just over four years ago they were left with the task of finding a suitable replacement.

Atlantis Prince served almost 100 mares in his four seasons at stud and up until the end of the 2012 season of all those to make it to the racetrack only four were unsuccessful.

Paul Geard is a big fan of Testa Rossa as a sire so when he saw a former Sandown Guineas placegetter by that sire in a William Inglis catalogue he set his sights on acquiring the flashy chestnut named Wordsmith.

Geard doesn't always get his own way, just ask Elizabeth, but he was very keen to secure Wordsmith.

Wordsmith (Testa Rossa-Way With Words x Yeats) won the \$200,000 Group 2 Debonair over 1200 metres and he was placed third in the Group 3 Sandown Guineas in 2007.

Forced to retire through injury, he was put through the ring at the Inglis Great Southern Bloodstock Sale but was passed in.

"I originally had my eyes on Written Tycoon at the sale but Simon Vivien from Inglis said that unless I had \$500,000 I should try and look elsewhere and he suggested Wordsmith," Geard said.

"I liked Testa Rossa as a racehorse and stallion so when he was passed in at \$24,000 I put in an offer of \$26,000 after the sale and it was accepted," he said.

It has proven to be one of the best investments made by the popular owner-breeders.

Wordsmith's first crop raced last season as two-year-olds and he ended with six individual winners that notched nine wins:

- Geeges Hot Hussie (3 wins)
- Gee Gees Style (2 wins)
- Geeges Hawkeye (1 win)
- Geeges Joker (1 win)
- Geeges Red Rock (1 win) and
- Geeges Velvet (1 win)

Geegees Style won the \$50,000 Autumn Classic defeating star 2YO Grand Tycoon that had won his previous seven outings.

Wordsmith finished in the top 10 on the Australian first season sire list with his progeny having amassed just over \$180,000 in stakes.

The only reason he wasn't awarded the Tasmanian leading juvenile sire award is that award is categorised as a combination of two and three-year-olds.

However, if Wordsmith's progeny perform as well this season then he is an odds-on favourite to win the Tasmanian Leading Juvenile Stallion title in 2013-14.

The Geards admitted Wordsmith was originally intended to stand at their Gee Gee Horse Stud to serve only their own mares but so strong was the inquiry from owners and breeders statewide and interstate that the chestnut stallion is likely to have a full book that could include up to 30 outside mares.

Tasracing is also very pleased to announce that the 2014 running of the Vamos Stakes on Wednesday 19 February, will for the first time be conducted at Group 3 level with an increased purse of \$125,000, following the approval of the Australian Pattern Committee.

It underlines the recent strength of the TSRC and in particular highlights the quality mares races that the \$150,000 TRC Bow Mistress Trophy and the TTC Vamos Stakes, have developed into. The attractiveness of the Bow Mistress and Vamos black type program for fillies and mares, is highly sought by stables throughout Australia.

Post the TSRC the program has been reduced by two meetings in early March, both of which were previously held immediately following the Launceston Cup (the DRC on the first Sunday in March and the Launceston night meeting on the Wednesday night). The average field size over these two meetings in 2013 was only 7.7 runners per race, well below the Tasmanian average.

This held a negative effect on turnover and was recognised as a "changeover" period within local racing stables whereby horses that had been competing through the TSRC finished their campaigns and horses set for the autumn and winter periods were returning.

Vamos upgraded to Group 3



THE Vamos Stakes has long been regarded as one of the best weight-for-age races for fillies and mares in Tasmania so it is fitting that strong negotiating by Tasracing has seen the Pattern Committee agree to upgrade the race from a Listed event to Group 3 status.

It is the first time in the history of Tasmania racing that a feature race has been upgraded on merit.

Two years ago the state's other weight-for-age fillies and mares race the Bow Mistress (1200m) was upgraded from Listed to Group 3 but that was in a trade-off with the Tasmanian Derby that was downgraded from Group 3 to Listed.

The Vamos Stakes, run over 1400 metres at the TOTE Racing Centre at Mowbray on Launceston Cup Day, has also received a prizemoney boost to \$125,000.

Tasmania's premier stud Armidale has taken up the naming rights sponsorship of the Tasmanian Turf Club's premier fillies and mares race.

The Armidale Stud Vamos Stakes has been won by some great horses over the years but none have made an impact on the race as much as three-time winner Lady Lynette bred by Armidale Stud.

The race is named after quality mare Vamos one of Tasmania's best staying mares during her time on the racetrack in the 1950s that was inducted three years ago into the Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame.

The mare shone over long distances winning back-to-back Launceston Cups in 1954-55 to join only six other greats to have achieved the feat including fellow TRHOF inductee Brallos.

Vamos (Beau Son-Imshi) was trained in Launceston by Ken Evans and owned in partnership by good friends Tom Johnston and Harry Johnston who were not related.

Champion jockey Bill Dunstone rode Vamos to victory in all of her feature race wins.

The mare had the distinction of winning from 1200 metres to 2600 metres and still holds the record for carrying the most weight to win a Launceston Cup of 61.5kg (9st-10lb) in 1955.

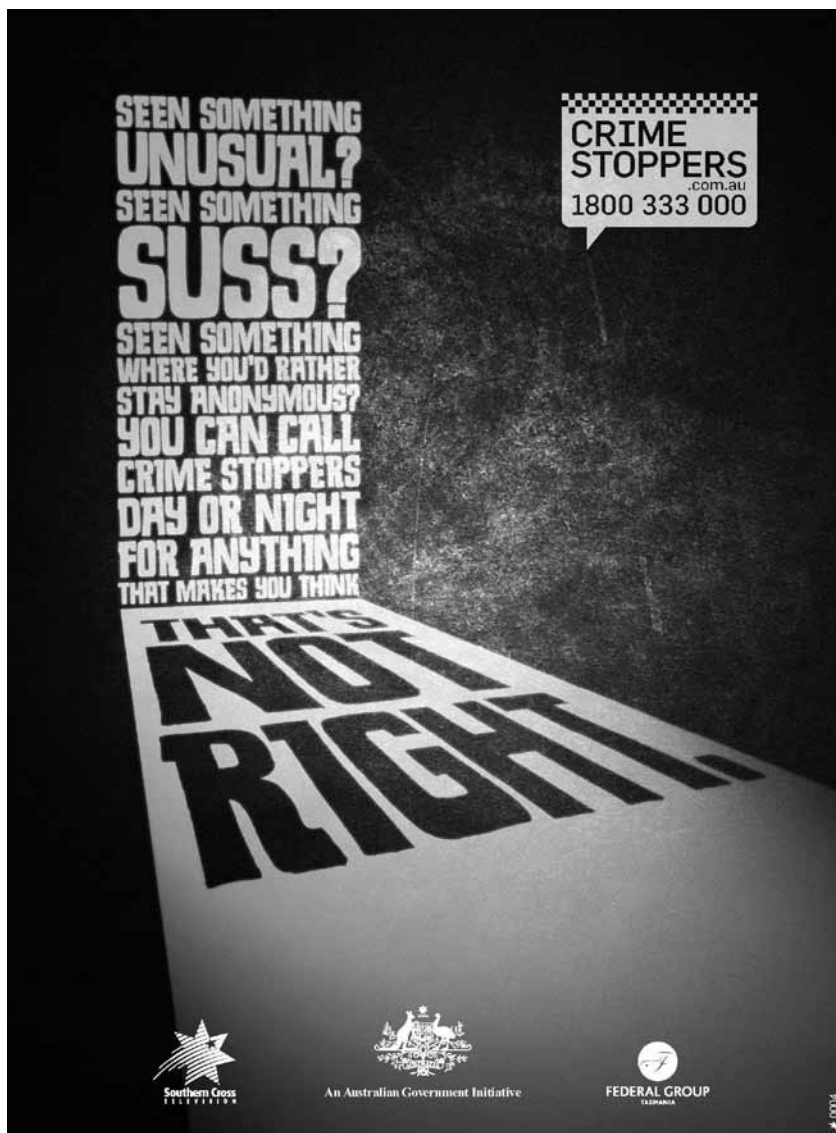

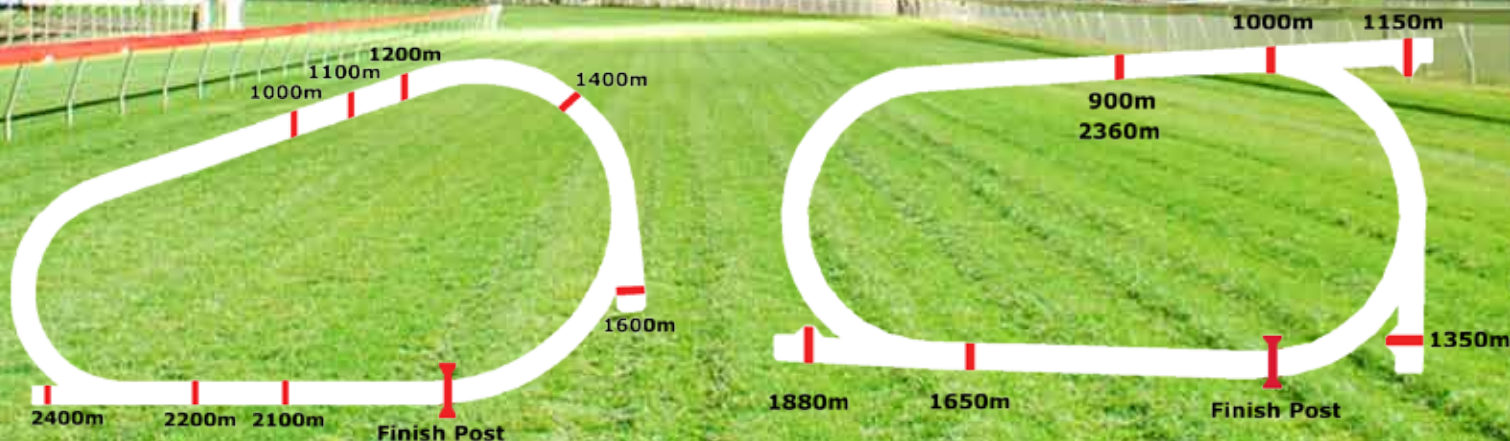

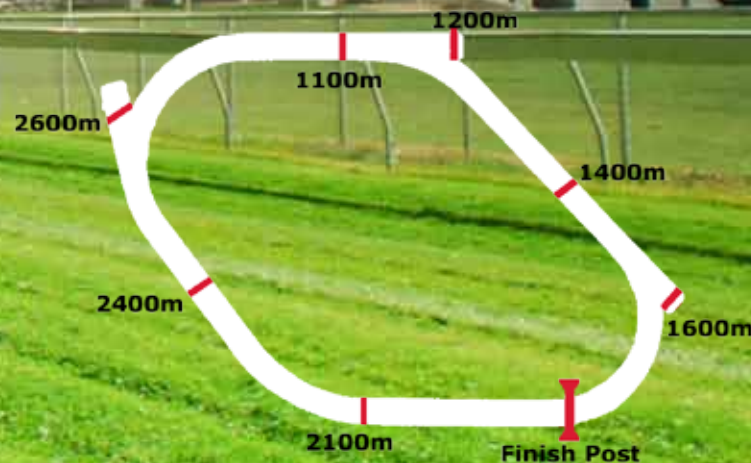


Image: Night Racing at the TOTE Racing Centre at Launceston

- 9.4 Prior to the declaration of Acceptance the Handicapper may adjust the weight of any horse whose weight as published was incorrect:
- (a) because of a clerical error; or
 - (b) because of an error or misunderstanding on the Handicapper's part as to the status, age or sex of the horse.

TASRACING POLICY

ADDITIONAL RIDING FEE

1 OBJECTIVE

The objective of this policy is to clearly define the eligibility requirements for an additional riding fee.

2 POLICY

Eligibility

A rider may be eligible for an additional riding fee:

- 2.1 If the riders originally declared ride is scratched and the rider accepts an additional ride on an emergency that has gained a start after official scratching time or in the case where the nominated rider has become unavailable.
- 2.2 Interstate riders will only become eligible for an additional riding fee if there are no local riders available.

3 PROCESS

- 3.1 Riders eligible for an additional riding fee must submit their request to Tasracing within 48 hours after the official race meeting scratching time.
- 3.2 The additional riding fee must be approved by Tasracing.
- 3.3 The amount will be paid directly into the jockey's prescribed bank account within ten working days of the race meeting.

Date of Effect: 1.9.2013

TASMANIAN RULES OF RACING

ADDITION - DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE

LR10.13 At the close of acceptances if the highest weighted horse at acceptance time has less than 58kg, excluding Group and Listed races, its weight shall be raised to 58kg and horses weighted above the minimum will have their weight increased by the same amount. Where a horse is weighted on the declared minimum weight and would otherwise be allotted a lesser weight in the absence of the required minimum that horse will remain on the minimum weight 54kg.

Date of Effect: 1.9.2013

STEWARDS SEGMENT

Trainers should be aware that over the past few months stewards have been actively checking the location and identity of horses that are engaged in upcoming races and also any others listed on stable returns. The provisions of AR80(f) state:

AR.80F. (1) A trainer shall not, without having made written application and obtained the consent of the stewards, stable any horse trained by him in any location other than his registered stable address as notified on his current licence renewal or application form. [Amended 1.8.08]

(2) Any person found in breach of this rule may be penalised and the nomination of the horse concerned may be refused.

NOTIFICATION OF RIDERS

Trainers are reminded of the importance of submitting their riders on time.

Stewards will not contact trainers who do not have riders after the closing time has expired. If a trainer is experiencing difficulties in obtaining a rider they should contact the stewards. If the stewards are not contacted a trainer may be fined for declaring a late rider.

FOOTWEAR

With the warmer weather approaching all licensed persons who attend or are in the vicinity of horses are reminded of the requirement to wear footwear that covers their entire foot.

IDENTIFICATION BADGES

All licensed persons are reminded of the requirement to display their identification badges when entering a racecourse.

Stewards will conduct random checks at horse gates to ensure that badges are being displayed to gain admittance to the course.

AUSTRALIAN RACING BOARD

NOTICE TO ALL LICENSED PERSONS

The Australian Racing Board (ARB) hereby gives notice that approval of the Tipperary Ride Lite Vest Standard M6 Issue 5 for use by licensed jockeys riding in races or trials is suspended by the ARB Board effective immediately under Australian Rule of Racing 87B due to safety concerns, pending further investigation. Further, the use of such vest is suspended for use by all track riders and stable hands effective 1 October, 2013.

These concerns have arisen as a consequence of the ARB receiving expert reports concerning non-compliance of the Tipperary Ride Lite Vest with the SATRA Jockey Vest Standard. Two samples of vests were tested for the purpose of these reports: the first sample comprised used, second-hand vests and the second comprised new, unused vests. In respect of both samples, the expert engaged by the ARB found a failure to meet the safety standards prescribed by order of the ARB.

As a consequence, the Tipperary Ride Lite Vest may be not worn by:

1. Any licensed jockey in a race or trial at any time effective immediately.
2. Any track rider or stable hand in any capacity or for any activity of any kind effective 1 October, 2013. In the interim, track riders and stable hands should consider acquiring or wearing alternative vests if available prior to 1 October, 2013.

Penalties will accrue for any continued use of the Tipperary Ride Lite Vest by any licensed person beyond the dates specified above.

The ARB takes this action in the interests of jockey and rider safety which are paramount in the discharge of its duties and responsibilities.

The ARB is continuing to work with the manufacturer of the Tipperary Ride Lite Vest to address these safety concerns.

New definition to AR.1

Addition to AR.1 as follows:

“Clear Day” means a 24 hour period from 12.01am to 12 midnight.”

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

Addition of New Rule 8(z)

Please insert the following:

“(z) Notwithstanding anything contained within these Rules, and not in limitation of any power conferred by these Rules, where a person has been charged with a breach of these Rules (or a local rule of a Principal Racing Authority) or a person has been charged with the commission of an indictable criminal offence, the Stewards pursuant to the authority delegated by the Principal Racing Authority, if of the opinion that the continued participation of that person in racing might pose an unacceptable risk to, prejudice or undermine the image, interests or integrity of racing, may:

- (a) suspend any licence, registration, right, or privilege granted under these Rules to that person;
- (b) prevent any horse owned (or part-owned) or leased by that person from participating in any race or official trial;
- (c) order that any registration of the transfer of ownership and/or training of a horse related to that person not be effected;
- (d) make any other direction or order related to the person which is in the interests of racing, pending the hearing and determination of the charge under these Rules, the relevant local rule or the relevant criminal charge.”

Date of Effect: 1st October 2013

New Rule AR.59

Please insert the following:

“AR.59. (1) The trainer of a horse and/or the trainer’s authorised representative must ensure, including by reference to the horse’s Thoroughbred Identity Card, that where a horse is engaged to run in any race or official trial, the horse that:

- (a) is brought to the racecourse;
- (b) is presented to start in the relevant race or official trial; or
- (c) starts in the relevant race or official trial, is the correct horse.

(2) A trainer and/or the trainer’s authorised representative who fails to comply with AR.59(1) commits an offence and may be penalised.”

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

Note: As a consequence of the introduction of a new AR.59 please delete AR.59A(3) and AR.59A(4).

Amendment to AR.64G

Please delete rule and insert the following:

“AR.64G. (1) No person, without the permission of the Stewards, may stomach-tube, attempt to stomach-tube, cause to be stomach-tubed or be a party to the stomach-tubing of a horse which is engaged to be run in:

- (a) a race: at any time on the day of the race prior to the start of that race or during the one Clear Day prior to the day of the race; or
- (b) an official trial or jump-out: at any time on the day of official trial or jump-out prior to the start of that event or during the one Clear Day prior to the day of the official trial or jump-out.

For the purpose of this rule, “stomach-tubed” and variations of that term means any application to a horse of a nasogastric tube.

(2) Any horse that has been stomach-tubed contrary to the provisions of AR.64G(1)(a) or (b) may be prohibited from starting in any relevant race, official trial or jump-out.

(3) Any horse that has been stomach-tubed contrary to the provisions of AR.64G(1)(a) may be disqualified from the relevant race in which it started.”

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

Amendment to Rule 140

Please delete rule and insert the following:
"AR.140. (a) The trainer of a horse that is included in the final acceptors for a race must:

- (i) ensure that such horse is fit and properly conditioned to race; and
 - (ii) report to the Stewards:
 - (a) by acceptance time, any occurrence, condition, or treatment that may affect or impact on the horse's performance in the race where the occurrence takes place, condition is present or treatment is administered before acceptance time;
 - (b) as soon as is practicable, any occurrence, condition, or treatment that may affect or impact on the horse's performance in the race where the occurrence takes place, condition is present or treatment is administered after acceptance time.
 - (b) The owner and/or trainer and/or rider shall report to the Stewards as soon as practicable anything which might have affected the running of their horse in a race.
 - (c) If, after a horse which has raced has left the racecourse, the trainer of the horse becomes aware of any condition or injury which may have affected or impacted on the horse's performance in the relevant race, the trainer must report the condition or injury to the Stewards as soon as practicable and no later than acceptance time for its next race engagement.
 - (d) Any loss or breakage of gear during a race, or any unusual happening in connection therewith, shall be reported by the owner and/or trainer and/or rider to the Stewards immediately after the race.
 - (e) Any person who fails to comply with any provision of AR 140 commits an offence and may be penalised."
- Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

Amendment to Rule 140A

Please delete rule and insert the following:
"AR.140A. (1) The trainer of a horse is at all times responsible for the proper saddling and application and fitting of all gear to a horse presented for a race, official trial, jump-out or track work.
(2) The trainer of a horse that is presented for a race, official trial, jump-out or track work and that has not been properly saddled or had all its gear fitted or correctly

applied commits an offence and may be penalised.

(3) Notwithstanding AR.140A(1) or AR.140A(2), any person, other than the trainer of the horse, who fails to properly saddle or fit or correctly apply required gear to a horse presented for a race, official trial, jump-out or track work commits an offence and may be penalised."

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

New Rule 178AA

Please insert new rule 178AA:

"AR.178AA. (1) A person must not administer an alkalinising agent, in any manner, to a horse which is engaged to run in any race, official trial or jump-out:

- (a) at any time on the day of the scheduled race, official trial or jump out and prior to the start of such event; and
 - (b) at any time during the one Clear Day prior to 12.01am on the day of the scheduled race, official trial, or jump out.
- (2) Any person who:
- (a) administers an alkalinising agent;
 - (b) attempts to administer an alkalinising agent;
 - (c) causes an alkalinising agent to be administered; and/or
 - (d) is a party to the administration of, or an attempt to administer, an alkalinising agent, contrary to AR.178AA(1) commits an offence and may be penalised.
- (3) Where the Stewards are satisfied that a horse has, or is likely to have been, administered any alkalinising agent contrary to AR.178AA(1), the Stewards may prevent the horse from starting in any relevant race, official trial or jump-out.
- (4) Where a horse has been administered any alkalinising agent contrary to AR.178AA(1), the horse may be disqualified from any relevant race in which the horse competed.
- (5) For the purposes of AR.178AA, 'alkalinising agent':
- (a) means any substance that may elevate the plasma total carbon dioxide (TCO₂) of a horse when administered by any route;
 - (b) includes but is not limited to substances that are bicarbonates, citrates, succinates, acetates, propionates, maleates, lactates and trometamol (THAM, Tris Buffer or Trometamine) and also include products marketed as urinary alkalinisers and hind gut buffers;

(c) does not include substances:

- (i) that are alkalinising agents which are contained in commercial feeds and/or balanced commercial electrolyte supplements which when fed and consumed according to the manufacturers' recommendations for normal daily use have a negligible effect on plasma TCO₂; and
- (ii) in respect of which the Stewards have granted an express exemption from the operation of AR.178AA, provided that any exemption from the definition of alkalinising agent granted under this rule does not constitute a defence to a charge laid against a person following the detection by an Official Racing Laboratory of a TCO₂ concentration in a horse in excess of the threshold prescribed by AR.178C(1)(a)."

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

Amendment to Rule 178F(3)

Please delete Rule 178F(3) and replace with the following:

"(3) Where directed by the Stewards, a person, including a trainer or a trainer's representative, must provide any record of treatment kept in accordance with AR.178F(1):

- (a) immediately following the issue of the Stewards' direction; or
- (b) at any other time as required by the Stewards."

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

New Rule 196(6)

Please insert new rule as follows:

"(6)(a) Any person or body authorised by these Rules to suspend or disqualify any trainer may defer the commencement of the period of suspension or disqualification for no more than seven Clear Days following the day on which the suspension or disqualification was imposed, and upon such terms and conditions as seen fit.

- (b) Notwithstanding that the commencement of a period of disqualification may be deferred pursuant to AR.196(6)(a), a trainer must not start a horse in any race from the time of the decision to disqualify that trainer until the expiration of the period of disqualification."

Date of Effect: 1st September 2013

EXPLANATION OF THE RULES

The definition of a "Clear Day"

A "Clear Day" is defined within the Rules to mean a 24 hour period from 12:01am to 12 midnight. For practical purposes, a clear day restriction means that the calculation of the number of days for which the procedure/treatment is banned does not take into account the time of day of the treatment.

The restriction on both stomach-tubing and the administration of alkalinising agents is one clear day prior to racing or competing in an official trial or jump-out. This means that if a horse is racing on a Saturday, the last time it may be stomach-tubed or be administered alkalinising agents is 11:59 pm on the Thursday night. In this case, the clear day is the Friday. A clear day is not just the 24 hour period prior to the time of racing.

What is considered to be an alkalinising agent?

For the purposes of AR.178AA, an alkalinising agent is any substance that may elevate the plasma TCO₂ of a horse when administered by any route with the exception of balanced, commercial electrolyte supplements which may contain some alkalinising agents but which can be demonstrated to have negligible effects on plasma TCO₂ when administered according to the manufacturers' recommendations for normal daily use.

AR.178AA prohibits the administration of alkalinising agents by any route within the one clear day of racing, including in feed.

Alkalinising agents that must not be administered within the one clear day prior to racing or competing in an official trial or jump-out include, but are not limited to, bicarbonates, citrates, succinates, acetates, propionates, maleates, lactates and trometamol (THAM, tris buffer or trometamine) and also include products marketed as urinary alkalinisers and hind gut buffers.

Products that contain alkalinising agents and which fall within the definition include proprietary formulations such as: Sodium Bicarbonate ("bicarb"), Baladene®, Lang's Solution® for intravenous use, Neutra-Syrup®, Neutralka®, Neutrolene®, Neutrolene Plus® and Neutradox® and any other products that are marketed as lactic acid buffering or neutralising products. These products must not be administered within one clear day prior to racing or prior to competing in an official trial or jump-out.

Balanced electrolyte supplements and potassium supplements that contain electrolytes may be administered or fed in normally recommended amounts within the one clear day. Examples of normal balanced electrolyte products would include such proprietary preparations as Applyte Gel®, Electromix®, Electro Paste®, Electrovite Paste®, Endura-Max®, Endura-Max Paste®, Equicharge®, Horsport® Humidimix®, KelatoLYTE Electrolyte Replacer®, Ranvet Electrolytes®, Recharge®, Restore® and Vetsense®.

Commercial electrolyte supplements which may contain some alkalinising agents but which should have negligible effects on plasma TCO₂ when administered in feed according to the manufacturers' recommendations for normal daily use include Equilyte®, Race Electrolyte®, and Salkavite®. Examples of commercial balanced intravenous solutions that can be used up to and including the day prior to racing but not pre-race on the day of the race include Darrow's Solution®, Hartmann's Solution® and Lactated Ringers.
