



When star Tasmanian middle distance galloper The Cleaner burst into the national limelight with his courageous front running style of racing that enabled him to win multiple feature races in Melbourne, his trainer Mick Burles was calmly going through the motions without ever thinking beyond the next race for his stable star.

But when the seven-year-old qualified for a berth in this year's W. S Cox Plate by winning the Dato Tan Chin Nam Stakes at Moonee Valley and he followed up with a win in the Group 3 JRA Cup over the Plate distance (2040m), Burles' world was turned upside down.

"Before he won the JRA Cup, running in the Cox Plate was probably a bit of a pipe dream," Burles said.

"But when he beat some fairly good horses in the JRA Cup, even though he was under done for that race, all of a sudden winning a Cox Plate became more than just a dream," he said. While all the national media has focused on The Cleaner there also has been growing national interest in the seven-year-old gelding's trainer.

Burles has led a fascinating life and his journey to becoming a talented horse trainer is not only interesting, but also one that has taken more than the odd twist or turn.

He was born at Koonya on Tasmania's Tasman Peninsula where he spent his formative years living a meagre existence with his mother and siblings on a small farm speckled with dairy cows.

Burles has always had an affinity with horses and recalls riding one for the first time when he was six.

"I had my first smoke when I was six and I sat on a horse for the first time at the same age, and they are both still a part of my life," Burles said.

Burles' parents separated when he was only one and he admits to having no recollection of his natural father. "I suppose I had it tough as a young kid because I never knew my real father and was pretty much raised by my grandmother, Sissy Nichols," he said

"She was a hard woman who worked very hard and expected everyone else in the household to do the same."

Burles was one of four children by his natural father but he also has two step-sisters and two step-brothers.

"I went to school with one of my natural brothers, Dennis, and my sister, Rhonda, but the eldest boy, Robert went with Dad when I was only a year old and I've only ever seen him once in my life and that was when I was 16," Burles said.

As a teenager on a country farm, Burles was a typical boy who spent his leisure time fishing, shooting and playing sport.

He was a handy footballer and he became an avid Hawthorn supporter from 1964.

"I loved the Hawks and still do, so when they won the flag the day after The Cleaner won the JRA Cup I don't reckon I've had a better weekend," he said.

He played football up until he was 46, competing in the Northern Districts League in Tasmania where he ended his career having played 494 games.

"I couldn't quite crack it for 500 games, but I had to give it away because the body was starting to feel the strain and another six games probably would have killed me," he said.

When Burles left Nubeena Area School after completing year 10 he worked on share farms including the family plot.

"I quite enjoyed share farming because it was honest work and I got to spend time with animals, in particular horses, and that was the bonus for me," Burles said.

Burles was called up for National Service when he turned 18. He was going to be married upon his return from his stint at Puckapunyal (army training camp), but that didn't work out as he expected.

"When I got home from National Service the girl I was going to marry gave me the flick and Mum and Dad (step-father) had moved to Burnie on the North-West Coast," Burles said.

"I decided to head to Burnie, and I got a job at the pulp mill and that's where I met the love of my life.

"Lyn and I were married and we had four children (three boys – Kim, Damian and Dion and a daughter, Karissa) and we were a very happy family unit." Burles gave up share farming for about 12 years to become a truck driver carting fruit and vegetables to and from Queensland.

"I enjoyed driving the trucks but I gave it away in the end because I spent too much time away from home," he said.

He found his way back to share farming and in 1989, his love of horses, and in particular thoroughbreds, led him to make inquiries with the view of buying a racehorse.

"I had been helping out in stables for a number of years working with trainers such as Larry Dalco and Allan Stubbs, so I thought I'd like to race one of my own."

"I had always been around horses on the farms. We had draught horses or sheepgathering horses and I rode them all."

"I just grew to love horses, and later on I was particularly keen on racehorses."

Burles had an opportunity to buy a well bred filly as his first racehorse, but her antics prevented the sale.

"I had a share farm at Bowthorpe (thoroughbred breeding property at Longford) that was owned by Don Lowe and he'd taken a filly to the sales but she wasn't sold" Burles said.

"When he brought her back home, she made her way into my farm lot, and she used to bite me on the backside every chance she got.

"When Lowe found out I was in the market for a racehorse, he offered to sell me the filly that was in my paddock, but I told him in no uncertain terms what I thought of her and that was the end of it."

"I ended up buying one called Robin's Gamble for \$1000 that went on to win a maiden but nothing else, and the filly offered to me by Lowe that was eventually sold for \$5000 turned out to be Bow Mistress and she went on to win at weight-for-age wherever she raced in Australia."

"That's pretty much been the story of my life."

Burles said he had to use all of his cunning to secure a horse to race.

"My late wife hated racing but I outsmarted her by putting the first horse I bought in her name," he said.

"When Robin's Gamble won, my wife was rapt and I was the greatest bloke on Earth, but I never saw any of the prizemoney.

"But Robin's Gamble never won another race so the wife said, 'we better go out and buy another one' which I did, but it was no good at all."

Burles and his family had settled at George Town where he enjoyed life on a small property that housed a few stables, so he decided to have a crack at training in 1994.

"I had a workplace accident when working for Chris Hazell at Comalco and suffered multiple broken bones in my back that laid me up for the best part of 18 months," Burles said.

"It was during that time my lawyer, Chris Dockeray, offered me a package of horses that he had for sale. There were four in all and I bought the lot.

"There were two young ones that had to be broken in and a mare (Irish Fleece) that was in foal."



"The foal inside the mare turned out to be the first horse I trained in my own right named Irish Reaction, and he won by about eight lengths as my first starter as a trainer," he said.

Over the years Burles has had some handy horses and probably the best until The Cleaner came along was Miewa's Quest that won eight races for Burles. Today the gelding still holds the 1200-metre track record in Launceston.

"Miewa's Quest was definitely the best sprinter I've trained and he won eight for me and two for Alan Stubbs," he said.

Burles was close to Stubbs and when that trainer was diagnosed with cancer Burles pitched in to do whatever he could to help out while Stubbs received treatment.

Eight-years-ago Burles' wife died from the disease and three months later, Stubbs passed away.

Within the space of 12 weeks Burles had lost two of the most important people in his life.

"It wasn't easy to cope when Lyn died because she meant everything to me and then on top of that, Alan left us and he was my closest mate" Burles said.

"I immersed myself into the horses when they died, and I ended up training about a dozen for Hobart owner John Farrell.

"John owned Vivre La Nett, an outstanding filly that went on to win multiple races including the Tasmanian Guineas against the best colts of that time."

With a handy size stable behind him Burles ventured to the 2009 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale with the hope of finding his next stable star. He had one lot in mind and it was a son of Savoire Vivre from top producing mare Dash of Scotch.

"I liked Savoire Vivre as a stallion, and I knew Dash of Scotch and that Gary White (Hobart-based trainer) had bought all of the mare's previous foals, which made me even more interested in looking at the yearling," Burles said.

"I looked at the horse three or four times and he looked better each time.

"I bought the horse for \$10,000 and we named him The Cleaner."

But not long after the sale Burles' major owner, Farrell called him to say he was going to extract all of his horses from the stable because he wanted them trained in Hobart.

"Owners change stables all the time and John (Farrell) genuinely wanted his horses moved so that he could see them more often while they were in training. I understood that but all of a sudden I was going to struggler to pay for the yearling," Burles said.

Burles eventually went to his golfing buddies, Bill Fawdry, Paul Burt and Jim Lowish and they came to the party but he never kept a share for himself.

"Not keeping a share in the horse is probably my biggest regret, but the owners are great mates and I'm content just to be his trainer." Burles said.

The Cleaner was sent to a Victorian trainer last season, but that was an unsuccessful mission as the horse couldn't settle and didn't adapt to a different training regime.

"The horse came back to me and it was one of the happiest days of my life because he's not just a horse he is my mate." Whenever Burles is confronted by the media, in particular a television camera, the commentator only has to mention the rapport Burles has with The Cleaner and the tears start to appear.

"The horse is special and that he happens to be one good enough to have earned a berth in a Cox Plate is just a bonus," Burles said.

Burles and The Cleaner have become a racing phenomenon simply because of the horse's catch-me-if-you-can racing style, but Burles' story also has touched the hearts of even the most hardened racing addict.

In the Cox Plate, The Cleaner not only carried the weight allotted to him under the weight-for-age scale but he also carried the hopes of every Tasmanian.

All the 50-cent punters who have fallen in love with the Longford Lion were either trackside or glued to a television around the nation hoping Tasmania's equine cult hero would realise the fairytale.

The race didn't pan out as they all hoped it would, but The Cleaner will live to fight another day.

1) Industry Recognition Award - Stephen Maskiell

Stephen Maskiell, one of Tasmania's most successful jockeys announced his retirement at the end of the 2013-14 racing season. To honour his achievements, he was recognised as the recipient of the TattsBet Industry Recognition Award for his services to racing in Tasmania.

Maskiell has been considered one of Tasmania's best riders for more than two decades and it was fitting that he should end his riding career with a winner, Westering Home at Mowbray on Launceston Cup day, at his last ride.









2) Leading Jockey Brendon McCoull

Brendon McCoull has dominated Tasmania's riding ranks for nearly two decades. Last season's premiership, his 14th, was secured by his haul of 80 winners. He snared multiple feature race wins but two that had previously eluded him, the Newmarket and Tasmanian Oaks, were achieved with masterful rides aboard Black 'n' Tough and Iggimacool respectively.

3) Leading Apprentice Jockey Bulent Muhcu

Turkish-born rider Bulent Muhcu was a clear winner of the Tasmanian Apprentices title. He notched 52 winners with his brilliant front-running ride aboard Red Eagle to win the Devonport Cup, one of his best efforts in the saddle.

4) Leading Owner - Paul and Elizabeth Geard

Paul and Elizabeth Geard were clearly Tasmania's leading owners with their stock of Gee Gee named horses notching 37 wins from 24 individual winners.

The Geards had 457 acceptors that produced stakes of \$393,000 and they provided just under 8 per cent of the starters for season 2013-14.

5) Leading Trainer - David and Scott Brunton

The father and son training team of David and Scott Brunton emerged triumphant in the trainers' premiership for the third year in succession with 68 winners.

Team Brunton again dominated with many of it's horses winning feature events.













1) Leading Tasmanian Juvenile Stallion - Wordsmith

Wordsmith, by Testa Rossa, from the Yeates mare Way with Words, produced 17 winners during the 2013-14 season comprising seven two-year-old and 10 three-year-old wins. Talented two-year-old Geegees Doublejay accounted for three of his sire's winners and three-year-old filly Geegees Velvet won twice, as well as being placed in feature races. Wordsmith stands at Paul and Elizabeth Geard's Gee Gee Horse Stud at Broadmarsh where he will be standing his sixth season at stud in 2014.

2) 2YO Horse of the Year Admiral

Admiral trained by Barry Campbell, was a clear winner of the Tasmanian 2YO of the year title, winning seven of his eight starts including multiple feature races. Admiral is one of the most exciting gallopers to step into Campbell's stable, and he expects to be even better at three.

3) Leading Broodmare of the Year - La Quita


La Quita was Tasmanian's top broodmare for the 2013-14 season. La Quita (by Grand Lodge) is a multiple winner of this award that last season produced four individual winners that grossed nine wins. Geegees Blackflash won four, Geegees Velvet and Gee Gees La Quita won two each, and juvenile Geegees Golden Girl broke her maiden status with a win at her last outing for the season.

4) 3YO Horse of the Year Iggimacool

Iggimacool was a popular winner of the 3YO of the year title. The Bill Ryan-trained filly won the Thousand Guineas before being placed on unsuitable rain-affected ground in the Strutt Stakes and then easily winning the Tasmanian Oaks.

5) Leading Filly or Mare Isibaeva

Isibaeva is the recipient of the Leading Filly or Mare award voted by the committee of TasBreeders. Isibaeva was outstanding last season, winning the Group 3 Bow Mistress Trophy as well as two other feature fillies and mares races, and she was a game third in the Group 3 Vamos Stakes. The Ian Hay-trained and bred mare had eight starts last season for three wins, four seconds and a third for \$148,000 in stakes.



6) Leading Tasmanian Based Sire - Savoire Vivre

Savoire Vivre was clearly Tasmania's leading sire for season 2013-14. The progeny of the ill-fated stallion won 65 races and produced winners in three states – Tasmania, NSW and Victoria. The 47 wins in Tasmania were produced by 21 individual winners. The star performer was his three-year-old filly, Iggimacool, that won five times, including the Listed Tasmanian Oaks and her stablemate Sh'bourne Spirit also won five races.

7) Horse of the Year Black'n'Tough

Black'n'Tough's season was capped when she was named Tasmanian Horse of The Year. The mare's win in the Newmarket Handicap and weight-for-age Kevin Sharkie was enough to sway the judges over her stablemate, Rebel Bride that won the Group 3 Vamos, two weight-for-age races and the Goodwood Handicap. Both horses were owned by Chris and Sharon Wickham.

TASMANIAN THOROUGHBRED HALL OF FAME AWARDS



Charlie Goggin was one of the inaugural inductees into the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Racing Hall of Fame in 2005, a place earned due to his impeccable record as a trainer.

Charlie won his first Tasmanian trainer's premiership in 1991-92 and proceeded to win seven of the next eight premierships. He won another three in succession from 2002 to 2004 and snared his 12th title training 48 winners in 2008-09.

Over the years Charlie has excelled as a trainer, not only in Tasmania but interstate and overseas.

His gallant mare, Sunny Lane, won a Werribee Cup and went on to contest the 1997 Melbourne Cup. She was also placed in a Group race in Hong Kong while in Charlie's care.

Charlie prepared the outstanding filly, Cafeteria, that was regarded as one of the best juveniles to grace the Tasmanian turf. Conquering, a horse bred by Runnymede Stud, also won multiple Listed races in Tasmania and interstate that guaranteed the gelding a place in the Hall of Fame.

Charlie has since formed a partnership with his daughter, Luella Meaburn, and together they remain a force in Tasmania's training ranks.

Charlie has won almost every feature race on the Tasmanian calendar, with only the Launceston Cup and Tasmanian Derby to elude him since he started training in 1988.

HALL OF FAME TRAINER INDUCTEE DAVID BRUNTON



HALL OF FAME ASSOCIATE INDUCTEE GRAEME McCULLOCH

Grame McCulloch has made an outstanding contribution to Tasmanian racing as a trainer, breeder and owner, as well as serving on the committees of race clubs and breeder organisations. At the time of his induction he has been the state's leading trainer and leading owner and won most of the major races, as well as standing some of the most successful sires ever to be based in Tasmania.

Graeme first started training as a hobby and had immediate success, preparing two-year-old of the year Flagon Lady and the talented Showlita who was later to produce one of his best ever horses in Southern States. In only his third season as a professional trainer, he won the 1979-80 premiership, and he went on to win four premierships in succession.

It was the deeds of the great Hannekes Gentleman that placed Graeme in the headlines. Nicknamed Hank the Tank, the horse won the 1981 Devonport Cup breaking Brallos' track record and went on to win a string of races.

Graeme's CV includes wins in most of Tasmania's major races including the Hobart Cup, Devonport Cup, Newmarket Handicap, Tasmanian Oaks, Strutt Stakes and Gold Sovereign Stakes. He founded Grenville Stud at Whitemore in the late 1970s. His early stallions included Theus and Bold Mayo, but perhaps his most notable investments have been perennial Tasmanian champion sire West Quest and the ill-fated Exit Five B.

Graeme has served on the executive of Tasbreeders, and he has represented the state on the Thoroughbred Breeders Australia committee.

HALL OF FAME TRAINER INDUCTEE DAVID BRUNTON

David Brunton arrived in Tasmania in 1994 with the hope of making a new start in his training career. He spent years working with his much admired mentor, the late Noel Kelly, at Ballarat, whose untimely death led David to branch out on his own. He had immediate success training metropolitan winners in Melbourne with only a small team of horses.

With a young family, David and wife, Julie, set about building a new life in Tasmania. It was his work ethic and innate understanding of equines that set him on a course to the top of the trainers' tree in Tasmania.

David won his first Tasmanian trainer's premiership in 2005-06 with 57 winners and he replicated the feat the following season preparing 67 horses to win the title clearly. Two seasons later he formed a partnership with his youngest son, Scott, and together they have won five consecutive premierships up to season 2013-14.

The best horse so far to make its way into David's care was Lady Lynette, that became the first Tasmanian-bred and trained mare to top \$1 million in prizemoney. The ill-fated Rumcorp had the potential to be his greatest performer but the promising stayer's career was cut short courtesy of a freak accident on the training track in Melbourne.

He has prepared multiple feature race winners including Prevailing (2012 Gr3 Launceston Cup), Life to the Full (Listed TTC Newmarket, George Adams and Balaklava Cup), Obstinado (TTC Newmarket) and Banca Mo, winner of the 2013 Warrnambool Cup, Pakenham Cup and mtultiple Melbourne metropolitan winners

A masterstroke by David was to relocate his training enterprise to Seven Mile Beach, which he describes as "Horse Heaven".

HALL OF FAME JOCKEY INDUCTEE BRIAN PULBROOK

Brian Pulbrook arrived in Tasmania soon after he completed his apprenticeship in Victoria in the early 1960s and he quickly established himself as one of Tasmania's top riders. He snared his first jockeys' premiership in 1965-66 with 46 winners and he won the title again in 1976-77 with 45 winners.

Brian was considered a master horseman when riding against arguably the best group of jockeys in the state, including Geoff Prouse, Max Baker and Gary King, all of whom are members of the Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame. He rode multiple feature race winners during his time in the saddle, including a Launceston Cup, Tasmanian Derby, three Tasmanian Oaks and two Tasmanian Guineas.

Brian was lured to the state by Hall of

Fame trainer Brian Lomasney for whom he was stable rider for five years. During this time he was always in the top three on the jockeys' premiership list. Brian also had a great association with Bastille Beggar winning multiple weight-for-age races on the Walter McShane trained galloper.

As an apprentice, Brian won a Lightning Stakes aboard at Flemington in 1959 aboard Ritmar, leading to Melbourne media pundits hailing him a star on the rise. Brian Maxwell Pulbrook was considered a popular and likeable character. He was extremely competitive and renowned for his fondness of horses.

HALL OF FAME HORSE INDUCTEE WATNEY

Tasmanian-bred and trained in Melbourne by Kel Chapman, Watney was one of the best sprinters of his era.

He won 11 races including three Group 1s in three states in the one season - the 1980 Pure Pak Stakes at Flemington, 1981 All Aged Stakes at Randwick and 1981 Stradbroke Handicap at Eagle Farm. In all three Group 1 wins, he was ridden by Robert Heffernan. The Pure Pak Stakes has had many name changes over the years and is now known as the VRC Sprint Classic.

Watney's name sits alongside several very famous past winners of the same race including Vain, Dual Choice, Century, Maybe Mahal, Special, Hareeba, Takeover Target, Miss Andretti and Black Caviar.

Watney was also placed in the Group 1 Invitation Stakes and Toorak Handicap, both at Caulfield, and the then Group 2 William Reid Stakes at Moonee Valley (behind Manikato).

Watney was sired by Tasmania's 1970 Caulfield Cup winner Beer Street, who stood at Mrs. Sybil Wilson's Harpley Stud at East Devonport. His dam, Shoecream, was based, at the time, at John Lyne's Leighton Stud at Evandale. Both Beer Street and Shoecream were owned by Melbourne solicitor Jim Merralls who also raced Watney in a partnership. Watney stood at stud on his retirement but like Beer Street, was not greatly patronised. His best progeny was Double Gin, a five-time stakes winner that won 18 races in total and was also second in the Adelaide Cup and SAJC Derby.

HALL OF FAME ASSOCIATE INDUCTEE IAMES MUNTING

James Munting is one of the truly unsung heroes of Tasmania's thoroughbred racing industry. Born in 1855 into a farming family he was quick to find his niche with horses and it was his love of the equine species that led him to find his way to Calstock, which was regarded as the most successful thoroughbred stud in Australia of its time. He spent 41 years working for Calstock and remained domiciled on the property until his death in 1942.

Jimmy rode with success throughout Tasmania in the late 1800s, scoring multiple wins aboard The Rake on the flat and over hurdles. He won four races in succession aboard The Rake in the space of six days, winning twice on New Year Day in 1880 at Deloraine, firstly over 2400 metres and later over 1200 metres.

In 1887 Jimmy rode winners at Flemington in consecutive meetings aboard Pearson, and he partnered Thomas to victory in Adelaide the following month on Adelaide Cup day. He was also was regarded as an astute trainer with a keen eye for a horse.

Jimmy's horse husbandry and training skills are demonstrated by his ability to train both sprinters and stayers with success in both flat and hurdle racing. His involvement spanned more than 70 years, during which time he not only rode and trained but was a mentor, advisor, guide and friend to many.

His obituary published in The Advocate newspaper in 1942 described Jimmy Munting as Tasmanian turf's best known and most colourful characters.

HALL OF FAME HORSE INDUCTEE SOVEREIGN NOTION

Soverign Notion arrived in Tasmania in 1985, having spent most of his previous racing life in the care of top Victorian trainer Colin Hayes, who trained the gelding for Robert Sangster. He was purchased sight unseen for \$18,000 and was raced in Tasmania by Brian Heffernan, Peter Gardiner, Kevin Estcourt and the late Bernie Gorman.

The gelding performed well in his first season in the care of astute Tasmanian trainer Stafford Devine, but it was in the summer of the 1986-87 season that he excelled. During that season he won four weight-for-age races in the space of five starts over eight weeks to take his season tally to eight wins, earning him the Horse of the Year title.

Sovereign Notion collected a track record in winning the weight-for-age Mowbray Stakes over 1600m, and he went close to repeating that feat in the Tasmanian Stakes. He was entered for the Hobart Cup but failed to run out the distance, but so talented was he that Devine prepared him to win a weight-for-age race over 1100 metres at his subsequent start three weeks later. Sovereign Notion had to be well managed by his trainer owing to a nearside foreleg tendon problem. Most pundits of the era claimed he could have been a world beater had he been fully sound.

TASMANIAN BREEDING INDUSTRY

When Armidale Stud took the chance on standing another stallion in Tasmania after the tragic passing of Savoire Vivre, little did it know that the events in Sydney during the spring would help lift the profile of its new stallion Needs Further.

At the time of writing, star colt Hallowed Crown (Street Sense) was further enhancing his half brother's stallion credentials. Firstly, when the colt stormed home to win the Group 1 Golden Rose over 1400m, which in turn has led to a 50 per cent purchase by Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud securing Hallowed Crown's own future at stud.

Hallowed Crown and Needs Further (x Encosta De Lago) are from the Golden Slipper runner-up Crowned Glory (x Danehill) who, during a short racing career, showed that she was blessed with plenty of natural talent.

A winner on debut at two at Mornington, Crowned Glory progressed quickly through the classes, being stakes placed at her second outing before winning at her subsequent outing in the Group 3 Bloodhorse Breeders' Stakes over 1200m at Flemington in March 2000.

In Sydney, she was fourth to Belle du Jour's in the Reisling Slipper Trial (Group 2, 1200m) before a gallant second to the same filly in an especially memorable running of the Golden Slipper Stakes (Group 1, 1200m).

At stud, Crowned Glory produced three winners from her first four foals, but it was not until her fifth foal that she delivered a black type runner when Needs Further won the Group 3 Carbine Club Stakes at Randwick

Needs Further was a highly talented galloper which won three of his five lifetime starts before a joint issue curtailed his racing career.

Needs Further won accolades from all those associated with him.

His trainer Gai Waterhouse said:

"He's a very exciting horse in the making ... he was to be my Doncaster horse (2012), that's how highly I rated his ability as a racehorse."

Andrew Baddock, Gooree Stud Manager said:

"From birth he was always a bit of a standout. He's a lovely big strong type and I have no doubt he can make the grade as a sire."

Needs Further only raced once as a 2 year old. Based on his impressive 5 3/4 length barrier trial win at Randwick two weeks earlier and Blake Shinn's pre-race comment to the press "We think he is one of our (Waterhouse stable) top two-year-olds".

The bookmakers installed him as an odds-on-favourite at his debut. He bungled the start badly missing vital lengths, but still managed to run third to subsequent 2 year old Group 1 winner Skilled. Highly respected Sydney racing journalist Ken Callander wrote in the following Monday's "Daily Telegraph", "Forget it ran. After being used up, it was a big effort to finish as close as he did."

At three, Needs Further won three in succession, culminating in the AJC Group 3 Carbine Club Stakes over 1600m at Randwick, prompting his rider Nash Rawiller to say, "This is a really serious horse."

On the same day Needs Further won his Group 3, super mare Black Caviar notched one of her great wins, coming from behind to defeat Hay List.

Needs Further ran home quicker than Black Caviar with a final 200m in 11.93s, according to ANZ Bloodstock Sectional Times Weekly.

There is no doubt he was fast, but he also possessed great acceleration and an incredible will to win.

The three horses that finished behind Needs Further in the Carbine Club all went on to either win or place in Group 1 races.

Trainer Gai Waterhouse was confident she had a Group 1 horse in the making, but unfortunately, after two unsuccessful attempts to return him to the racetrack, a niggling joint issue finished his racing career.

Needs Further is bred in the purple being by champion sire Encosta de Lago, from a brilliant daughter of Danehill.

Such is its regard for Needs Further, breeders Gooree Stud has retained breeding rights in the stallion.

Armidale Stud's co-director David Whishaw commented on the new stallion acquisition.

"We have been on the lookout for a replacement for our very successful sire Savoire Vivre (GB), and have been conscious that the market demands precocious types.

"We were offered a number of potential stallions, but this is the only horse that really got us excited and ticked all our boxes." Needs Further stands at Armidale Stud in Tasmania at \$3,300 (incl GST).

He has been well supported by local and interstate breeders who appreciate Needs Further's brilliant pedigree.

Need Further already has some lovely types on the ground including:

Fillies out of Gehenna (2YO of the Year) and the dam of Melbourne winner Happy As Hell and the stakes placed Buzzing Along, who was second behind the Queen of Tasmanian Racing - Lady Lynette in the 2012 Listed Vamos Stakes.





The Tapeta Series

THE decision to stage a winter series on the Tapeta track at Spreyton has been hailed a huge success by industry participants. \$20,000 Sprint and Distance preludes, which led into \$25,000 finals, were the features over the five-week series. The series produced capacity fields in all races on most days, with the five-meeting series culminating with the running of the \$25,000 distance final over 1880 metres on Sunday 31 August 2014.

The Alana Fulton-trained Savabeel mare Landstar emerged triumphant in the inaugural Tapeta Winter Series Stayers Final over another highly promising stayer in Adam Trinder's Big Time. Big Time, who had won the \$20,000 Distance prelude in the lead up to the event was gallant in defeat. Both horses are now set for a tilt at major honours in the summer, with the \$100,000 Devonport Cup as Landstar's main mission this season.

The Sprint final was won by Innocent Gamble, who completed a clean sweep of the Sprint features having won the Sprint Prelude two weeks earlier.

Innocent Gamble stalked race leader Loaded Owners to the home turn and when stable apprentice Ismail Toker called on the gelded son of Elvstroem for the supreme effort, he powered past the

leader and went on to win comfortably from the fastfinishing Iggimacool. Loaded Owners finished a close-up third.

It was Innocent Gamble's sixth win from nine tries on the synthetic surface and Toker's seventh win on the gelding that was formerly trained by Mark Riley in Melbourne. It was Riley who prepared the hose to win a Blue Diamond Preview as a two-year-old.

The Barry Campbell-trained gelding is now in the paddock and will be brought back for the \$20,000 sprint race on his home track on Devonport Cup day.

The 2014 winter racing season at Tapeta Park has once again unearthed a number of highly promising prospects, just as it did in 2013 with Star Mare Black 'n' Tough.

Lightly raced five-yearold Tennessee Drive, confirming his status as one of the state's most promising sprinters. The Troy Blacker trained gelding powered his way in a track record time of 58.37 seconds to eclipse Arenzano's previous best of 58.51 that she set in June last year.

Trainer Bill Ryan and owner Maurice Mace added to their quality string with the emergence of promising stayer Genuine Lad, who made it three wins in succession on the synthetic track in June and will now be aimed at the major cups next season. In doing so,Genuine Lad bettered 2013 Devonport Cup winner Red Eagles' previous track record over 1880m, registering a time of 1:56.26

programme notes

The Tasmanian Summer Program presents several initiatives, which will provide excellent opportunities for participants throughout the feature summer racing period.

Noticeably, December 1 will see the introduction of increased base level stakes in Maiden, Class 1 and Benchmark 62 races by \$1,500 to \$14,000 to ensure Tasmanian prize money levels remain comparable to Victorian provincial meetings.

To maintain balance in the tiered stakes structure Class 2 and Benchmark 72 race stakes will also be increased by \$1,000 to \$15,000 and Class 4 by \$1,000 to \$16,000.

In addition, the Hobart Guineas, the Tasmanian Guineas, the Tasmanian Stakes and the Newmarket Handicap received a \$10,000 increase to \$100,000. This ensures that all black type races in Tasmania are run at a minimum stake level of \$100,000.

The Feature Race program for Summer 2014/15 has undergone noticeable alteration to accommodate the introduction of a Friday twilight fixture for the TRC Tasmanian Derby meeting on 6 February, which will complement by the Hobart Cup on Monday 9 February.

TSRC 2014/15 will also see the TTC Tasmanian Oaks run on 'Ladies Day' Sunday 22 February, three days prior to the Launceston Cup.

Tasracing has assisted both the TRC and TTC in restructuring the schedule so to present an opportunity to deliver 'Mini Carnival' race days. The 'Mini Carnival' race days are focused on strategically placing events around the TSRC major races, to maximise opportunity for the race clubs to enhance public attendance.

In doing so, the following changes to the feature race program have been required to best fit the needs of horses and participants, whilst also accommodating restrictions with SKY broadcast availability.

- Hobart Cup Day reverts from Sunday to Monday 9 February (Regatta Day Public Holiday)
- Tasmanian Derby & Bow Mistress
 Trophy to Friday Twilight 6th
 February, from the preceding Sunday
- Hobart Guineas Day to Sunday 25th January, a week later than 2013 - to accommodate flow into Tasmanian Derby Day







In 1892 the winner's cheque was paid in wallaby skins, a form of currency in those days. These days, they fly in the stewards, jockeys and bookmakers.

Come September, as the sun unfolds over Bass Strait, it is not just the dairy farmers that are out and about, 80 odd horses are in work, preparing for the summer carnival.

Rather uniquely, King Island's race programs are dual code; a mix of gallopers and pacers which both race on the one mile grass track. A number of clubs throughout the world could lay claim to staging dual meets, but it is unlikely that many would have them both running on grass.

The main thrust of King Island racing is having fun. Always has been. Our race club would not have survived the past century if racegoers didn't have one helluva time!

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING ... Continued

INTRA-ARTICULAR CORTICOSTEROID TREATMENT STAND-DOWN PERIOD

Trainers and veterinarians should note the introduction of an Australian Rule of Racing that prohibits the administration of an intra-articular ("into the joint") corticosteroid preparation to a Thoroughbred racehorse within 8 Clear Days of racing. This Rule is effective from 1st August 2014.

The Australian Racing Board has made this decision in the best interests of the welfare of the horse and safety of riders whilst being cognisant of Australian racing conditions.

The Rule reads as follows: "AR.64M. A horse that has been subjected to an intra-articular administration of a corticosteroid preparation, whether the preparation is administered alone or in combination with other preparations, is ineligible to participate in any race, official trial or jumpout at any time during the 8 Clear Days (as defined in AR.1) following midnight on the day of the administration."

Note: A Clear Day is defined within the Rule to mean a twenty-four hour period from 12:01 a.m. to 12 midnight. For practical purposes, a clear day restriction means that the calculation of the number of days for which the procedure/treatment is banned does not take into account the day of treatment nor the day of racing.

As such a stand down time of 8 clear days equates to 10 regular days when including the day of administration and the day of racing.

For the purpose of AR.64M and by way of example, if a horse was subjected to an intra-articular administration of a corticosteroid at any time on a Monday (1st day of the month), that horse would be ineligible to race until the Wednesday of the following week (10th day of the month). Similarly, a horse treated with an intra-articular

corticosteroid on a Thursday is ineligible to race until the 2nd Saturday after treatment.

Corticosteroid preparations that are subject to this rule include, but are not limited to: triamcinolone (Kenacort, Triamolone Forte), betamethasone (Celestone Chronodose), dexamethasone and methylprednisolone (Depo-Medrol) preparations. Thev are all Schedule 4 Prescription Medicines or Prescription Animal Remedies, and in the case of an intra-articular administration, must be administered by a veterinarian.

The minimum stand down time is intended as a minimum period before racing within which any corticosteroid preparation must not be administered intra-articularly, including the shorter-acting corticosteroids. This stand down period must not be confused with the "withdrawal" recommended time of the particular drug used. The "withdrawal" period for a prohibited substance is calculated to ensure a horse is presented clear of the prohibited substance when sampled. In certain situations, specifically for longer acting corticosteroid preparations such as methylprednisolone and for injections into low volume joints such as the lower hock joints, the recommended "withdrawal" period may be much longer than the minimum stand down time prescribed by AR.64M, and as such must continue to be observed.

Note: The administration of intra-articular corticosteroids is "treatment" according to AR.178F and therefore must be recorded by a trainer and/ or their veterinarian as required by this Rule. Examination of treatment records will be one of the tools used by the Stewards to ensure trainer compliance with AR.64M.

AMENDMENT TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING AR.64J

Summary

The ARB has decided to introduce a new rule making it compulsory for owners to notify RISA on the retirement of their horse. The form specifically designed for this purpose will require the owner to indicate where the horse is destined (public auction, a paddock, a pony club, etc.).

The current system only requires a stable return for when a horse leaves a stable and approximately half of horses exiting a stable go to other trainers so we have no exact knowledge of the destination of ex-racehorses or even how many there are.

The ARB has identified the retirement of racehorses as a vitally important welfare issue and PRAs have adopted a number of rehoming programs to this end. The statistical data sought is an essential element in tracking retired racehorses.

AMENDMENT TO AR.64J

Please delete AR.64J and replace with the following: "AR.64J

- (1) Upon the death of a horse which had not been retired, the trainer or his or her authorised agent must report the occurrence to the relevant Principal Racing Authority or their agent as soon as practicable.
- (2) In the event of the deceased horse being included in a current stable return the trainer must as soon as practicable lodge an amended stable return in relation to the death.
- (3) Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of sub-rules (1) or (2) commits a breach of these Rules unless he or she proves to the satisfaction of the Stewards that he or she was not aware, and could not reasonably have been aware, of the death of the horse."

Date of effect: 1st July 2014

NEW RULE AR.64JA

Please insert the following: "AR.64JA

- (1) Where a horse has been retired from racing, the Manager (as defined in AR.1) of the horse at time of its retirement must, within one month of the horse's retirement, notify the Registrar by lodging the relevant form prescribed by the Registrar.
- (2) Where a form has been lodged in accordance with AR.64JA(1), the retired horse will cease to be registered and is ineligible to race unless it is reregistered.
- (3) Where a horse ceases to be registered under this Rule, the horse may not be re-registered except with the express permission of the Stewards.
- (4) Any person who fails to comply with AR.64JA(1) commits a breach of these Rules and may be penalised."

Date of effect: 1st July 2014

SUMMARY OF NEW ARR ON DRUG & ALCOHOL TESTING OF HORSE HANDLERS

These new rules stem from both a safety and an integrity viewpoint and after lengthy consultation from within and outside of the industry. A horse handler affected by an illicit substance or alcohol poses a significant safety risk in the work place to other workers and to horses in their care.

The major components of the new Rules are:

- The power for Stewards to conduct drug and alcohol testing operations for the purpose of testing horse handlers is set out in the new Rule AR8(jjj). Further, as a condition of licence, horse handlers undertake to submit to tests that are intended to detect substances banned under these Rules.
- The Rules relevant to the offence are outlined in new Rule AR.81AA.



AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING ... Continued

- AR.81BB categorises the banned substances when found in a urine sample of a horse handler. They are broadly grouped into the following:
 - Alcohol (at a concentration in excess of .05% on a breath analyser)
 - Cannabis
 - Amphetamines
 - Ecstasy
 - Cocaine

Additional Information on Banned Substances – Herbal Remedies

Riders and stable employees are warned against taking herbal and other "over the counter" medicines without firstly making thorough enquiries as to whether ingredients of such products are regarded as a banned substance. The fact that a medicine is herbal indeed "non-prescription" does not at all quarantee that is does not contain a banned substance. In particular, there is a need to be wary of products where ingredients are not fully listed or herbal products where ingredients may vary between batches.

Just a few examples of these products that are available "over the counter" or via the internet that fall within the definition of a banned substance include:

- 1. Reductil: a weight reduction pill containing sibutramine;
- Citrus aurantium (bitter orange) extract: containing the weight loss agent synephrine;
- Coca tea derived from the coca plant: containing the illegal stimulant cocaine;
- Thermo-lift classic formula: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine; and
- 5. Ephedra sinica (ma huang) extract: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine.

Breaches of the banned substance Rules attract substantial penalties which necessarily must contain elements of both specific and general deterrence.

Re-testing of Drug Offenders before resumption

Under AR.81AA(4) a horse handler incurring a penalty under this rule must not resume handling horses, unless otherwise authorised by the Stewards, until he delivers a sample as directed by the Stewards that is free of any substance banned by AR.81BB.

AMENDMENT TO AR.1

Addition to AR.1 as follows:

""Horse handler" means any licensed or any person who handles any horse at any meetings, trial, jump out or in training and includes but is not limited to stable hands, trainers, veterinarians, farriers and barrier attendants."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

ADDITION OF RULE 8(JJJ)

Please insert the following:

"(jjj) To take or cause to be taken any sample from any horse handler either prior to or after handling any horse at any race meeting, official trial, jump out or in training, provided that this power may only be exercised where a Steward reasonably suspects that a horse handler is affected by a substance banned by AR.81BB. Reasonably suspects means suspects grounds which on are reasonable in the circumstances."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

ADDITION OF RULE 8(JJJJ)

Please insert the following:

"(jjjj) to make or cause to be made any test to determine whether any substance banned by AR.81BB is present in a sample taken pursuant to (jjj) above."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

ADDITION OF RULE 81AA

Please insert the following: "AR.81AA. (1) Any Horse Handler commits an offence and may be penalised if:

(a) A sample taken from him is found upon

- analysis to contain a substance banned by AR.81BB; or
- (b) He refuses or fails to deliver a sample as directed by the Stewards, or tampers with or in any way hinders the collection of such sample.
- (2) Any Horse Handler may be prevented by the Stewards from handling any horse in training, based on any information, their own observations or on medical or other competent advice that his faculties may be impaired by any substance banned by AR.81BB.
 - In the event of any analysis or a preliminary analysis of a sample taken from a horse handler pursuant to AR.8(jjj) indicating the presence of a substance banned by AR.81BB, or if a Horse Handler refuses or fails to deliver a sample when directed to do so, the Stewards may forthwith, pending the determination of any inquiry or other proceeding, or the result of any other analysis, stand down such person from handling horses.
- (4) In the event of a Horse Handler incurring a penalty under this rule or being stood down from handling horses he shall not unless otherwise authorised by the Stewards resume handling horses until he delivers a sample as directed by the Stewards that is found upon analysis to be free of any substance banned by AR.81BB."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

ADDITION OF RULE 81BB

Please insert the following: "AR.81BB. The following substances and/or their metabolites. artefacts and isomers are declared as banned substances in horse handlers when present in a urine sample (unless otherwise stated) at a concentration above the applicable cut-off level:

(LSD) (0µg/L); All barbiturates (0µg/L); Cannabinoids (11-Nor-delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9carboxylic acid) (15µg/L); Alcohol (at a concentration in excess of 0.05% on a breath analyser); All stimulants - substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, Amphetamine $(150\mu g/L)$; Methylamphetamine (150µg/L): Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA) $(150 \mu g/L)$; vlenedioxmyethylamphetamine (MDEA) (150µg/L): etheledioxymethylamphetamine (MDMA) (150µg/L): Methylphenidate (0µg/L): Modafinil (0µg/L): Cocaine (100µg/L):

Substances in this group excluded are: Levoamphetamine: Levomethylamphetamine: Phenylpropanolamine: Pseudoephedrine.

All opiates and opioids substances in this group include, but are not restricted to, Morphine (0µg/L, save as specified by AR.81C): Codeine (0µg/L, save as specified in AR.81C): Oxycodone (0µg/L): Fentanyl (0µg/L): Alfentanil (0µg/L): Pethidine (0µg/L): Methadone (0µg/L): Heroin (0µg/L): Monoacetylmorphine (0µg/L): Hvdromorphone (0µg/L): Buprenorphine (0µg/L).

- (a) The total codeine and morphine concentration is less than 2,000Sg/L; or
- (b) The total codeine and morphine concentration achieved in confirmatory testing is in the range 2,000 to 15,000µg/L inclusive and at least one of the following applies:
 - (i) The codeine to morphine ratio contained in the sample is greater than 1.0; or
 - (ii) The rider or Horse Handler satisfies the Stewards that there is no illegal use of opiates or opioids by the rider or Horse Handler."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

AMENDMENT TO RULE 81D

Please delete Rule 81D and replace with the following: "AR.81D. The Stewards may stay in whole or in part, and for

such period and under such terms and conditions as they think fit, the operation of any penalty imposed for a breach of AR.81A or AR.81AA. Provided that, in the event of any failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions of the stay, the Stewards may order that the penalty take effect."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

AMENDMENT TO RULE 81E

Please delete Rule 81E and replace with the following:

"AR.81E. Notwithstanding the provisions of AR.81A and AR.81AA, a Principal Racing Authority may permit a rider or horse handler to receive a specified banned substance, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The medication must be essential treatment for a substantial illness, condition or ailment suffered by the rider or horse handler;
- (b) The medication must be prescribed by a medical practitioner who is a recognised specialist in the relevant field of medicine;
- (c) The specialist medical practitioner must certify:
 - the nature of the illness, condition or ailment being suffered by the rider or horse handler
 - (ii) that no alternative, non-banned substance would serve the same purpose for the illness, condition or ailment concerned.
 - (iii) that the medication would not affect the rider in a race, trial or trackwork to the extent that it could in any way constitute a danger to other riders.
 - (iv) That the medication would not affect the horse handler in the carrying out of his duties and/or constitute a danger to himself or to others.
- (d) The rider or the horse handler must if requested submit to medical examination by a specialist medical practitioner

- appointed by a Principal Racing Authority to advise it on the matters referred to in subparagraphs (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of paragraph (c) of this rule.
- (e) The rider or horse handler must:
 - riding Before handling any horse make application to the Principal Racing Authority for permission to ride or handle a horse with a specifically prescribed banned substance in his system.
 - (ii) Adhere strictly to his prescribed medication, and must report to the Stewards immediately he forms the intention to discontinue or in any way vary his prescribed medication;
 - (iii) Report to the Stewards immediately he believes that either his illness, condition or ailment or his medication may have some influence on his ability to ride or handle a horse effectively and/ or safely.
 - (iv) Renew his application for exemption on each occasion on which he applies for the renewal of his licence, registration, permit or other qualification."

Date of Effect: 1st July 2014

SUMMARY OF AMENDED ARR ON SAFETY VESTS

The ARB approved changes to the Rules governing the certification of jockey safety vests following the banning of the Tipperary Vest for failing to meet its certified standard.

In the interests of rider safety, the ARB has decided to amendment AR.87B to incorporate the following enhancements to Safety Vests:

- Delete the SATRA standard from the prescribed standards as it is unreliable and not used in any other major racing jurisdiction.
- Continue with only two prescribed standards being

- the ARB Standard and the European Standard EN 13158 as proven and reliable safety standards.
- Establish a list of Approved Vests in addition to the two prescribed standards as an added safeguard against self-certification or substandard vests.
- Permit the use of heavier level 2 vests (raceday vests are usually the lighter level 1 category) which may provide a higher level of protection for track work.

AMENDMENT TO AR.87B

Please delete AR.87B and replace with the following: "AR.87B. (1) Every rider shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly fastened Approved or permitted safety vest the standard of which has been prescribed by Order of the Board.

Provided that every such Approved or permitted safety vest shall be in a satisfactory condition and shall have attached to it a manufacturer's label that states that it complies with the relevant standard prescribed by the Board.

- (2) Notwithstanding compliance with subrule (1), no safety vest may be worn in a race, official trial or jumpout unless it is an Approved safety vest. Such Approved Level 1 safety vests are: Hows Racesafe, Ozvest, Racelite Pro and Vipa.
- (3) The Stewards may confiscate or order the satisfactory repair of any safety vest that does not comply with the requirements of subrules (1) and (2).

Note: Pursuant to AR.87B, the Australian Racing Board has ordered that the following two standards of safety vests only are prescribed: ARB Standard 1.1998 and European Standard EN 13158."

Date of effect: 1st July 2014

AMENDMENT TO AR.87D

Please delete AR.87D and replace with the following: "AR.87D. Any rider required by these rules to wear an Approved safety vest may be penalised if he wears or has

in his possession any safety vest that does not conform with a standard which has been prescribed by the Board or which has been modified in any way."

Date of effect: 1st July 2014

AMENDMENT TO AR.118C

Please delete AR.118C and replace with the following: "AR.118C. It shall be an offence for any rider -

- (a) to in any way manipulate or attempt to manipulate the wearing of a safety vest to gain an unfair weight advantage in a race; or
- (b) to weigh-out or attempt to weigh-out for a race or ride in any race when wearing an Approved safety vest that has been modified in any way.
- (c) to weigh-out or attempt to weigh-out or ride in any race unless he is wearing an Approved safety vest."

Date of effect: 1st July 2014

AMENDMENT TO RULE 87B(2)

Summary

The Australian Racing Board has recently introduced a requirement that safety vests also be an Approved vest in addition to meeting either the European Standard EN 13158 or the ARB Standard 1.1998.

In deciding whether to grant Approved status to a safety vest, the ARB will apply a public interest test.

As a result of satisfying both requirements, the USG Flexi Race vest has now been added to the Approved list and can be worn by riders from 1st August, 2014.

Please amend AR.87B(2) as follows:

"(2) Notwithstanding compliance with subrule (1), no safety vest may be worn in a race, official trial or jumpout unless it is an Approved safety vest. Such Approved Level 1 safety vests are: Hows Racesafe, Ozvest, Racelite Pro, Vipa and USG Flexi Race.

Date of effect: 1st August, 2014

AMENDMENT TO RULE 178C(1)(G)

Summary

The Executive Council of the International Federation Horseracing Authorities (IFHA) has approved the addition of a threshold level for free testosterone in blood plasma from geldings. This threshold level has been derived from collaborative international studies that included input from Australia. The threshold of 100 picograms per milliliter of free testosterone in gelding plasma has been recommended for inclusion in AR.178C(1)(g) by the ARB's Veterinary and Analysts Committee (VAC). As conjugated testosterone is not an entity in plasma, AR.178C(1) (q) has been redrafted accordingly.

Please amend AR.178C(1)(g) to read as follows:

- (1) The following prohibited substances when present at or below the concentrations respectively set out are excepted from the provisions of AR.178B and AR.178H:-
 - (g) Testosterone:
 - (i) in geldings: free testosterone and testosterone and testosteron its conjugates at a mass concentration of 20 micrograms per litre in urine;
 - (ii) in fillies and mares:
 free testosterone
 and testosterone
 liberated from its
 conjugates at a
 mass concentration
 of 55 micrograms
 per litre in urine;
 - (iii) in fillies and mares that have been notified as pregnant pursuant to the requirements of AR.64E(2): free testosterone testosterone liberated from its conjugates at any concentration in urine;
 - (iv) in geldings: free testosterone at a mass concentration

of 100 picograms per millilitre in plasma.

Date of effect: 1st January, 2015

- frusemide 50ng/ml in urine
- hyoscine butylbromide (or n-butylscopolammonium) -25ng/ml in urine
- ipratropium 0.25ng/ml in urine
- ketoprofen 100ng/ml in urine
- lignocaine 10ng/ml of the 3'-hydroxylignocaine metabolite in urine
- meclofenamic acid 250ng/ ml in urine
- meloxicam 10ng/ml in urine
- mepivacaine 10ng/ml of the 3'-hydroxymepivacaine metabolite in urine

AMENDMENT TO RULE 178F

Summary

Following recent cases, the Chairman of Stewards Committee (COSC) believes that AR.178F needs to cover treatments such as shock wave, acupuncture, vaccinations and others rather than just administrations of substances. Furthermore, there is no time requirement in the rule for when treatments need to be recorded. The COSC believes that there is a need to amend AR.178F so that such treatments are recorded and that all records should be up to date on a daily basis.

The rationale for changes to AR.178F are as follows:

- To make it more clear that the rule applies to the administration of treatments and medications. What is meant by a treatment and medication is set out in more detail in AR.178F(2). Consequential amendments to the sub-rule have also been made to improve readability.
- To provide that each treatment or medication must be recorded "by midnight on the day on which the administration was given". This makes it clear that treatment/medication administrations must be recorded on the same day as which they are given. By referring to "midnight" it is anticipated that arguments will be avoided about recording within a 24 hour (or "one day") period from administration.
- To slightly restructure the rule to move the requirement to keep records to a separate sub-rule (AR.178F(3)).
- To require the production of records relating to "treatment and/or medication".
- To introduce a new sub-rule AR.178F(5) which makes it clear that a failure to comply with any provision of AR.178F is a breach of the rule and that the trainer may be penalised

Please delete AR.178F and replace with the following:

- (1) A trainer must record treatment and medication administered to each horse in his or her care by midnight on the day on which the administration was given, and each record must include the following information:
 - (a) the name of the horse;
 - (b) the date and time of administration of the treatment or medication;
 - (c) the name of the treatment or medication administered (brand name or active constituent);
 - (d) the route of administration including by injection, stomach tube, paste, topical application or inhalation);
 - (e) the amount of medication given (if applicable);
 - (f) the duration of a treatment (if applicable);
 - (g) the name and signature of person or persons administering and/or authorizing the administration of the treatment or medication.
- (2) For the purposes of this rule:
 - (a) "treatment" includes:
 - (i) shock wave therapy;
 - (ii) acupuncture (including laser treatment);
 - (iii) chiropractic treatment;
 - (iv) the use of any electrical stimulation device (including transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation (TENS));
 - (v) magnetic field therapy;
 - (vi) ultrasound;
 - (vii)any form of oxygen therapy, including hyperbaric oxygen therapy; and
 - (b) "medication" includes:
 - (i) all Controlled Drugs (Schedule 8) administered by a veterinarian;
 - (ii) all Prescription Animal Remedies

- (Schedule 4), including those listed in AR.178C(2);
- (iii) all Prescription
 Only Medicines
 (Schedule 4), prescribed and/or dispensed by a veterinarian for off-label use;
- (iv) all injectable veterinary medicines (intravenous, intramuscular, subcutaneous, intra-articular) not already included above;
- (v) all Pharmacist Only (Schedule 3) and Pharmacy Only (Schedule 2) medicines;
- (vi) all veterinary and other medicines containing other scheduled and unscheduled prohibited substances;
- (vii) all alkalinising agents;
- (viii) all herbal prepara-
- (3) All records required to be kept in accordance with this AR.178F must be retained by the trainer for not less than two years.
- (4) When requested, a trainer must make available to the Stewards the record of any administration of a treatment and/or medication required by sub-rule (1).
- (5) A trainer who fails to comply with any provision of AR.178F commits a breach of this Rule and may be penalised

Date of Effect: 1st January, 2015

AMENDMENT TO RULE AR.195A

Summary

The ARB Board on 11th June 2014 approved amendments to AR.195A so as to put beyond doubt that disqualified persons were bound by the Rules of Racing during their period of disqualification.

Please delete AR.195A and insert the following:

- "(1) Subject to AR.195A(2), if a licensed person is disqualified his or her licence immediately ceases and determines and he or she must make application to the Principal Racing Authority to be relicensed.
- (2) A disqualified person is and remains bound by, and subject to, the Rules for the period of his or her disqualification."

NEW HORSE HANDLER RULES

The ARB has introduced new rules from 1 July which give stewards powers to test any trainer, strapper, vet, barrier attendant or other horse handler they suspect of being drug or alcohol affected.

These new rules stem from a safety viewpoint and have been formulated after two years consultation with industry bodies. A horse handler impaired by an illicit substance or alcohol, poses a significant safety risk in the workplace to other workers and to horses in their care.

As a condition of their licence, horse handlers undertake to submit to tests that are intended to detect substances banned under the new Rule AR.81AA.

The banned substances when found in a urine sample are broadly grouped into the following:

- Alcohol (in excess of .05%)
- Cannabis
- Amphetamines
- Ecstasy
- Cocaine

Stewards have further issued a warning to riders, trainers and stable employees against taking herbal and other "over the counter" medicines without firstly making thorough enquiries as to whether ingredients of such products

are regarded as a banned substance. The fact that a medicine is herbal or indeed "non-prescription" does not guarantee that is does not contain a banned substance.

Just a few examples of these products that are available "over the counter" or via the internet that fall within the definition of a banned substance include:

- Reductil: a weight reduction pill containing sibutramine:
- Citrus aurantium (bitter orange) extract: containing the weight loss agent synephrine;
- Coca tea derived from the coca plant: containing the illegal stimulant cocaine;
- Thermo-lift classic formula: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine; and
- 5. Ephedra sinica (ma huang) extract: an appetite suppressant containing ephedrine.

Breaches of the banned substance Rules attract substantial penalties which necessarily must contain elements of both specific and general deterrence.

The ARB believes that mandatory testing for drug and alcohol is necessary in the interestsof workplace safety, but also accepts the need to provide information and support to industry participants.

For this reason, in early 2013 the ARB commissioned the Centre of Law Enforcement and Public Health (CLEPH) to interview trainers' organizations, individual trainers, stablehands and the AWU on drug and alcohol issues. All available data was analysed by leading counsellors and practitioners in this field resulting in a

landmark report of immense value to the industry.

The report, titled "Reducing the Risk", identified the extent of drug and alcohol problems and the resultant OH&S issues due to the high risk elements of stable work. As a result, Principal Racing Authorities (PRAs) will introduce the Australian Drua Foundation's Drug Awareness program which handlers horse must complete online before obtaining a licence. The program is progressively being rolled out across the country.

Other support measures include a wallet card being distributed to all horse handlers which will contain key messages and contact numbers for drug and alcohol information or assistance.

Additionally, SMS messages of reinforcement will regularly be sent reminding horse handlers of the Drug Awareness Program, mandatory testing and sources of assistance.

Drug and alcohol use is widespread in the community and racing is no exception to societal trends. Racing Authorities have a zero tolerance policy to drugs in the workplace, but understand the need to educate horse handlers of the inherent dangers not least of all to their own health.

THOROUGHBRED PARTICIPANTS LICENCE CATEGORIES & ENTITLEMENTS

The following list explains what the entitlements are in relation to each category of licence. Participants should ensure they are appropriately licensed to perform any activity associated with thoroughbred racing.

CATEGORY ENTITLEMENTS

OAILOOKI LIKI	THE ELIMENT O
Trainer A	Permitted to train any registered thoroughbred horse. Not permitted to ride any registered racehorse unless also registered as a trackwork rider.
Trainer-Open Permit	Permitted to train any registered thoroughbred horse. Not permitted to ride any registered racehorse unless also registered as a trackwork rider.
Owner-Trainer	Permitted to only train registered thoroughbred horses owned or leased by the trainer solely or in partnership with his or her spouse, de facto spouse, their children over 18 years, father, mother, sisters and brothers. Not permitted to train for syndicates. Not permitted to ride any registered racehorse unless also registered as a trackwork rider.
Pre-Trainer	Permitted to break in, prepare and educate a registered thoroughbred horse prior to the horse being sent to a trainer for official training and/or racing. Not permitted to trial or nominate any horse for racing.
Stable Foreman	Permitted, under the supervision or instructions of a licensed trainer, to assist with the training, management, care and control of horses and assist with pre-race preparation of, and post-race procedures affecting a horse. Not permitted to ride any registered racehorse unless also registered as a trackwork rider.
Jockey A	Permitted to ride at any race meeting, trial, jump out or trackwork held within the State of Tasmania.
Victorian Licensed Jumps Jockey A or B	If licensed with RVL may apply for Tasmanian licence and be permitted to ride in trials, jump outs or trackwork.
Apprentice Jockey	Once approved to do so permitted to ride in any race meeting, trial, jump out or trackwork held within the State of Tasmania.
Approved Trial Rider	Permitted to ride trackwork, jumpouts and official trials within the State of Tasmania. Must also be licensed as a Stable Employee if intending to work in the stables of any trainer or assist on race day.
Stable Employee	Permitted, under the supervision or instructions of a licensed trainer, to assist with the training, management, care and control of horses and assist with pre-race preparation of, and post-race procedures affecting a horse. Not permitted to ride any registered racehorse unless also registered as a trackwork rider.
Trackwork Rider	Permitted to perform trackwork duties for any licensed trainer. Must also be licensed as a Stable Employee if intending to work in the stables of any trainer or assist on race day.
Riders' Agent	Permitted to register agreements with no more than 3 Jockeys inclusive of the master of any apprentice who ride regularly in Tasmania.
Farrier	Permitted to shoe and plate horses for himself or other owners or trainers.
Restricted Plating	Permitted to only shoe horses owned and/or trained by themselves.



RACING SERVICES TASMANIA STEWARDS SEGMENT

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RACING PARTICIPANTS

STABLE RETURNS

Recently Racing Services Tasmania (RST) has noticed an increase of stable returns being lodged without all details being completed. The missing information then has to be entered by this office and the trainer or authorised representative is seemingly unaware that they have failed to include all the required information because the missing details have been entered by this office. The Stewards direct trainers to Australian Rule 56 which requires the trainer/nominator to ensure they enter all relevant details. If trainers continue to exclude the required information they may be penalised under the rules.

THOROUGHBRED IDENTITY CARD

All persons licensed/registered to participate in thoroughbred, harness or greyhound racing within Tasmania have been issued with a Racing Services Tasmania photo identification licence card. Your card relevant to the current racing season should be visibly displayed at all times when you are on a registered race track.

It is the Stewards' intention to undertake random checks of licence cards. Action may be taken if a person does not comply with this requirement or is found to be undertaking activities for which they do not hold the appropriate licence.

If you have lost or misplaced your card you should contact Racing Services Tasmania on 6777 1900 to arrange a replacement.

NB: A replacement fee of \$25 may be imposed.

HORSES ATTENDED ON COURSE

It is a requirement that any horse that is competing or has competed in a race on race day be attended by a licensed person whilst on the racecourse.

HORSES TO REMAIN ON COURSE

All horses which have competed **MUST** remain on course for a period of not less than half an hour from the finish of their race.

TIME TO BE IN MOUNTING YARD

Trainers are reminded that with the night racing season it is vitally important that horses are presented in the mounting yard no later than 15 minutes before the start of the race. The Stewards accept that sometimes due to circumstances beyond the trainers control this cannot be achieved. However, the Stewards will be vigilant to assist that this can be achieved as when races are not started on time it does affect how our product is presented to the wider racing community and at times we are unable to receive the full visual media coverage that our product deserves.
