National Greyhound Finals History In Hobart



Tasmania is no stranger to hosting the finals of the National Greyhound Championships.

The National Distance Final was held at the old venue named "TCA" on Hobart's Domain area in 1971 and 1978 and at the Royal Hobart Showgrounds in 1983. The Launceston Greyhound Racing Club (LGRC) hosted the Distance Final in 1981, 1985 and 2000 at White City and the 2006 series at The TOTE Racing Centre.

The prestigious National Sprint Final was held at the Royal Showgrounds in Hobart in 1987, when the Western Australian Freemantle Echo ran down the "queen" of Tasmanian greyhounds and red hot favourite True Vintage. Launceston hosted the 2000 Final in which NSW star Placard overpowered the Ted Medhurst Tasmanian speedster Kialdu D'or. The LGRC also hosted the Final in 2006 when NSW chaser Immortal Love set a new track record of 29.52.

Tasmanian chasers have gone so close to winning the National's Distance Final. At the TCA in 1971, Tassie's finest in Old Hobbs and Summer Idol ran second and third respectively to the wonderful track record breaking Victorian Saki Dasher. Coven Vista ran second for Larry Tanner and Hilda Williamson behind the legendary Woolley Wong in 1977. Butch Deverell's Miss Coroneagh ran third to Shamrock Jewel at White City in 1981. Also on home soil, Gary Fahey's Lygon Leader just failed to pick up the Victorian Ten Guitars in 1983. Level Charm for Pat McClenaghan was third at White City behind Melmade Gazza in 1985 and Eskimo Chevaux, Go Johnny Go

and Sitka last year all ran third as well. Classic Xena for Anthony Bullock and Kevin Tolputt was runner up to Osti's Joker at White City in 2000, whilst the Shane Whitney bitch Fallen Zorro was third to Mantra Lad at Wentworth Park in 2008.


Tasmania's finest National's moment came in 1984 when the mighty Busy Vintage, trained by David Crosswell easily defeated Victoria's Australian Cup winner Eaglehawk Star, in the National Sprint Final at Harold Park in Sydney. He led every step from box two to score by three lengths. He remains our sole National winner to this point, although his daughter and Tasmanian Hall of Famer, True Vintage went so close when second at Hobart in 1987. Our other National Sprint place-getters were Leo Burnett's great chaser Just Brilliant, which ran third to Jessica Casey at Wentworth Park in 1991 and the Stuart Genge trained Tombstone Jack which ran third last year.

The spacious Hobart track at Tattersall's Park is widely regarded as one of the best and fairest greyhound circuits in the country, evident by the strong mainland participation in the Hobart Thousand each year, with the likes of Darren McDonald, Graeme Bate and Robert Britton being regular visitors to Hobart.

The new 710 metre trip will be a searching test of stamina, whilst we have not seen a one turn National Sprint Final since Hobart last hosted this event in 1987.

Guests will be picked up from Hobart Airport or Hotel by coach and transported on the Convict Trail to historic Port Arthur.

Port Arthur is one of Australia's top tourism destinations, every building and every feature of this historic site has a story to tell. Intriguing and powerful, a visit to Port Arthur is unforgettable.

Darkness descends and another side of Port Arthur emerges. It is a different place when night falls, full of mystery and intrigue. Vivid stories challenge your grasp of what happens when the past collides with the present. In the glow of soft lights and the silence of night, those long gone feel close at hand.

Tuesday morning will give you free time to walk through the gift shop and visitor centre.

Leaving Port Arthur for Hobart, a stop at the Federation Chocolate Factory will delight all tourists as they specialise in hand made chocolate with 17 delicious flavours to taste - there is something for everyone. Viewing windows show the making process and for the history buffs there is a Heritage Museum showcasing antiques used by pioneering families.



Mona - Museum Of Old And New Art Friday 24 August 2012

This extraordinary museum, created by David Walsh, cost \$80 million dollars to build into the sand stone cliff which houses a private art collection valued at more than \$100 million dollars.

The museum will open your eyes and thoughts on art to a completely new level. It is exciting, educational, emotional, confronting - just brilliant. It is the sensational way that the art is displayed that gives the drama to the artwork.

The Master Centrepiece is the Sydney Nolan Rainbow Serpent Snake at 46 metres long and 9 metres high - it is made up of 1620 individual panels. Like most things at MONA what you think you see will change and the

snake is no different - you can stand on a landing and take it in as a whole and then go down the stairs and get up close and discover so much more. Sitting alongside this is an Egyptian mummy case, coins dated BC and a 5000 year old basalt alter.

Any visiting tourist should not miss the MONA experience.
