

## **HOBART GREYHOUND FIELDS Thursday (Night) 10 July 2014**

### **Race 1 - 07:38 - BETFAIR.COM Juvenile 461m**

- 1 213 ENFIELD MASK (Graeme Barber): Fair beginning railer; lacks speed but does run on well late, has a chance.
- 2 35 NOT FUSSED (Leon Brazendale): Slow beginning railer; found trouble at only try here, looks an improver.
- 3 SUPERFICIAL (Edward Medhurst): First starter in top kennel, watch market.
- 4 432 IT'S CRUNCH TIME (Graeme Moate): Slow beginning railer; runs on best late and looks some hope.
- 5 AEROPLANE RITZY (Rodney Ransley): Nicely bred first starter in good hands, market best guide.
- 6 876 KINLOCH DEE (David Polley): Slow beginning centre runner and is not over strong, looks tested.
- 7 YEAH RIGHT (Edward Medhurst): First starter in top kennel, watch market.
- 8 753 HURRICANE NELL (Rachael Moate): Fair beginning railer; has some speed but does tire a bit late, place hope.
- 9 424 SOUL SISTER Res. (Gary Fahey): Good beginning railer; battles fairly but must find the rails, some hope.
- 10 16 CLASSIC JOEL Res. (Anthony Bullock): Fair beginning railer; battles fairly but must settle close, place show.

**TOP PICK:** ENFIELD MASK (1) will be outpaced early but might be hard to hold out in the run home.

**DANGERS:** IT'S CRUNCH TIME (4) will be slow away but does run on well and could be hard to hold out.

**ROUGHIE:** HURRICANE NELL (8) looks a good chance of leading this field and could be hard to run down.

- 1 117 FIFTH TURTLE (Nicholas Howard): Fair beginning railer; is fairly strong over the shorter trips, looks a chance.
- 2 46 LASHING HOLLY (Allan Anderson): Slow beginning centre runner; big step up in distance, looks tested.
- 3 555 MISS FLOSS (Wayne Williams): Slow beginning wide runner; does best late but only looks a place chance.
- 4 531 AREBA MISS (Susan Gittus): Fair beginning railer; battles fairly and might run this distance well, some hope.
- 5 211 IRELAND'S FORCE (Russell Watts): Fair beginning railer and is quite strong, will be hard to beat.
- 6 345 LASHING PHIL (Allan Anderson): Slow beginning railer; battled fairly at Launceston but is only a place hope.
- 7 458 LIL' CAPABLE (Wayne Williams): Slow beginning railer; can run on at times but is only a rough place hope.
- 8 64T KHAL DROGO (Leon Brazendale): Ex Vic performer with 4 placing's from 11 starts, looks tested.
- 9 488 FLYING ROCKET Res. (Leon Brazendale): Slow beginning centre runner; has ran fairly this trip, place chance.
- 10 576 PRINCESS PARIS Res. (Dennis Wood): Slow beginning centre runner and struggled at Devonport this trip.

**TOP PICK:** IRELAND'S FORCE (5) will be one of the leaders and looks a bit too good for this field.

**DANGERS:** FIFTH TURTLE (1) might be able to hold the lead from this box and could be hard to run down.

**ROUGHIE:** AREBA MISS (4) should settle close to the lead and looks like this distance may suit.

- 1 GET IT RIGHT (Edward Medhurst): First starter in top kennel drawn nicely, watch market closely.
- 2 63 BIG JET LEGS (Kenneth Mayne): Fair beginning railer but is not over strong, looks tested.
- 3 623 TOUCH OF VENUS (Gary Fahey): Good beginning railer; has some speed and battles fairly, has a chance.
- 4 241 TERROCOTTA GIRL (Butch Deverell): Good beginning railer; has some speed and battles fairly, some hope.
- 5 321 IRISH GIFT (Russell Watts): Risky beginning railer but does battle fairly well, chance but must settle close.
- 6 8 SHANLYN TOBY (Graeme Moate): Slow beginning railer and is not over strong, looks tested from this box.
- 7 617 COVEY (Anthony Bullock): Slow beginning wide runner; battles fairly well and won nicely at Devonport.

**TOP PICK:** TOUCH OF VENUS (3) will be one of the leaders and might be hard to run down.

**DANGERS:** IRISH GIFT (5) should settle just behind the leaders and might be hard to hold out.

**ROUGHIE:** COVEY (7) will be slow away but was a strong Devonport winner from box 8, looks a chance.

- 3 523 HARD AS NAILS (Anthony Bullock): Fast beginning railer; has speed and battles well, is a chance.
- 4 354 WOODLEIGH DOLL (Dennis Wood): Fair beginning railer; has speed and battles well, will need to jump.
- 5 816 HONEST TO ROD (Anthony Bullock): Good beginning railer; has good speed and battles fairly, is some hope.

**ROUGHIE:** LOVING LUCY (7) can begin well at times and has the speed to be a real threat.
