- 1 BLUE FIREBALL (Philip Cassidy): Nicely bred first starter, watch market.
- 2 24 FERARO ELI (Susan Gittus): Slow beginning railer, has some speed and battles fairly, looks a chance.
- 3 363 UNDERCLASS HERO (Michael Stringer): Slow beginning railer, battles best late and is improving, rough.
- 4 7 TOPLINE PANDA (Rodney Callinan): Slow beginning centre runner and tired at only try, looks tested.
- 5 263 IRELAND'S FORCE (Russell Watts): Slow beginning railer, battles fairly well and has a chance in this.
- 6 VALDES (Keith Nichols): First starter, market best guide.
