## Harness Policies | Harness Penalty Races - Barrier Draw

## 1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this policy is to outline the process to determine the barrier draw for Graduation Penalty races.

## 2. BACKGROUND

2.1 A Graduation Penalty race is a race with stakemoney greater than \$1,500 but not exceeding \$3,000. A Graduation Penalty race is often referred to as a restricted penalty race as wins in these races do not affect a pacer's career penalty assessment.

Occasionally \$3,000 Graduation Penalty races are added to race meetings after acceptances have been received. This occurs when:

- A two year old race with four or five acceptors is reduced to \$3,000
- Sufficient acceptors are received to program a \$3,000 race for the balloted horses.

## 3. POLICY

- 3.1 In the event of any race being reduced to a graduation penalty race (\$1,501 \$3,000) after acceptances have closed, or a new graduation penalty race being programmed from the acceptances received, the barrier draw will remain the same as advertised for the race the horses originally accepted for.
- 3.2 In the event of a \$3,000 race for ballots comprising ballots from two or more advertised races involving two or three C classes, the barrier draw will be PBD/C.
