A FEW eyebrows were raised when prominent Tasmanian standardbred owner Mick Maxfield paid a record \$245,000 for a colt at the 2017 Sydney Yearling Sale but the wily owner-breeder has had the last laugh.

This month Max Delight (Bettors Delight-Lady Euthenia) was named Australian 3YO of the year with some of his wins including the Group 1 \$200,000 NSW Derby, Tasmanian Derby, a heat and semi-final of the NSW Breeders Challenge and the Group 1 \$200,000 Breeders Crown 3YO final for colts and geldings.

So far, the colt has won half of his 24 career starts as well as four minor placings form \$324,000 in stakes. Max Delight clocked a mile rate of 1.51.5 when he won the NSW Derby which is a world record for a pacer over 2400 metres, shaving 1.2 seconds off the previous best held jointly by Smolda and Demon Delight.

That's when Maxfield knew for sure he had made the right decision in paying a record price for the son of Bettors Delight.

After winning a 2YO event on debut at Goulburn with Darren Hancock in the sulky, he had four more starts in NSW before heading home to Tasmania to win the Golden Slipper and a Breeders Crown heat.

Unfortunately, things didn't pan out in the Breeders Crown final in which he finished 10th of 12, due to a mishap in the run. Maxfield delivered the horse to Victorian trainer David Aiken for whom the colt had six starts for three wins and a fifth in the Victorian Derby final.

Maxfield has long been an avid harness fan and has enjoyed great success with many of the pacers he's bred or purchased but he had as gut feeling about this acquisition.

As a multiple Group 1-winning 3YO colt he has a residual stud value higher than any other Maxfield purchase, something the astute owner had hoped for when he first started dabbling in horse ownership.

Max Delight is having a wellearned spell with everyone waiting to see what he might do as a four-year-old.

#### **FEATURE RACE CONDITIONS**

#### AUSTRALIAN DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIPS RACE CONDITIONS - Saturday 9 November

The 30 to 84 national ratings nominations will be divided into 7 races which will be non-penalty races and form the heats of the Australian Drivers Championship.

The races will be formed by selecting the horses from the highest national rating down as starters for each race. The horse named as emergency in one race shall be the included in the next lower race as a starter. In the event of horses on the same rating having to be split, the horse with the highest field selection points shall be deemed the highest rating and then the horse with the highest number of Life Time Wins and then by random draw.

Emergencies which gain a start are required to contest that race and be scratched from the other event in which they are engaged. If there are insufficient nominations for seven races, the nominations shall be extended and should there be at least 6 but less than 12 acceptors for a race after the extension, the race will be conducted but will not be a heat of the Australian Driver Championship and will not be a penalty free race.

If nominations are extended then the original nominations shall be first selected and if excess nominations above what is required are received during the extension period, then the extended nominations shall be selected on the same basis as the original nominations.

#### TASSIE GOLDEN APPLE RACE CONDITIONS - Saturday 21 December 2019

A standing start event to be conducted in two heats and a final at Launceston over 2200 metres.

The series will be a conditioned handicap with a Random Barrier Draw as follows:

NR 80-86 - Front

NR 87-93 - 10 metres

NR 94-104 - 20 Metres

NR 105 or more - 30 metres

No mare or driver concessions apply to this series.


A field limit of 12 horses applies to both the heats and the final.

In the event of more than 24 nominations for the heats, the selection of the fields will be done on the highest National Rating to the lowest National Rating. In the case of horses with equal National Ratings the horses will be selected on Field Selection Points from highest to lowest and if still equal a random ballot between those horses shall then be conducted.

The allocation of horses to each heat shall be manual allocation based on the National Rating of each horse selected to participate as follows:

The horse with the highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 1, the horse with the second highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 2, the horse with the third highest National Rating will be allocated to heat 1, the horse with the fourth highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 2 etc In the case of horses with equal National Ratings the horses will be allocated on Field Selection Points from highest to lowest and if still equal a random ballot between those horses shall then be conducted.

The first six horses finishing in each heat shall be deem qualified for the Final with the seventh placed horse in the fastest heat being named as the emergency. Horses qualifying for the Final shall start from the same handicap as in the heat.

In races where the draw is (or is in part) a PBD/NR, horses eligible by way of their claiming price shall be drawn at the end of each rating. For example, horses with a claiming price up to \$5000 will be eligible for a 65 to 70 rating race if the conditions permit and horses with a claiming price up to \$4000 will be drawn after the 65 rating horses, but before the 66 rating horses and the horses with a claiming price of \$5000 will be drawn after the 70 rating horses.

HRA approved 1 September 2019

Approved and adopted by Tasracing 27 August 2019



#### 5. HORSES

#### Eligibility for registration

•Amend Rule 93 (2)

93.(2) Save and except for embryo transfer or some other procedure approved by the Controlling Body a horse shall not be eligible for naming and/or registration and entry in the Australian Stud Book if it is the produce of genetic engineering procedures including but not limited to cloning, embryo freezing or oocyte collection.

#### 12. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

#### Determination of prohibited substance

•Amend Rule 188A(1)(b)

188A. (1) The following are prohibited substances:

(b) Substances falling within, but not limited to, the following categories:acidifying agents adrenergic blocking agents adrenergic stimulants

metabolism alcohols

alkalinising agents anabolic agents anaesthetic agents

analgesics

#### **Out of Competition Testing**

**190A** (2) For the purposes of sub-rule (1), the following substances are specified as prohibited substances:-

- (s) unregistered bisphosphonates;
- (t) metabolites, artifacts and isomers of any of the substances specified in paragraphs (a) to (s);

#### **Bisphosphonates**

- New heading
- New Rule 190AB

**190AB.** (1) A horse must not at any time be administered an unregistered bisphosphonate.

- (2) Any person who:-
  - (a) Administers an unregistered bisphosphonate
  - (b) Attempts to administer an unregistered bisphosphonate
  - (c) Causes an unregistered bisphosphonate to be administered and/or
  - (d) Is a party to the administration of or an attempt to administer any unregistered bisphosphonate to a horse is guilty of an offence.
- (3) Where the Stewards are satisfied that a horse has, or is likely to have been, administered an unregistered bisphosphonate contrary to this rule, the Stewards may prevent the horse from starting in any relevant race.
- (4) When a sample taken from a horse aged less than four years has detected in it a bisphosphonate the horse is not permitted to start in any race for a minimum period of twelve months from the date of the collection of the sample in which the bisphosphonate was detected.
- (5) When a sample taken from a horse aged four years or older has detected in it
  - (a) A registered bisphosphonate the horse is not permitted to start in any race for a minimum period of thirty days from the date of the collection of the sample in which the bisphosphonate was detected.

- (b) An unregistered bisphosphonate the horse is not permitted to start in any race for a minimum period of twelve months from the date of the collection of the sample in which the bisphosphonate was detected.
- (6) When a sample taken from a horse has detected in it a bisphosphonate in breach of sub-rules (1), (4) or (5) the trainer and any other person who is in charge of such horse at the relevant time shall be guilty of an offence

# 14. GENERAL OFFENCES Blood Doping

- New heading
- New Rule 254A

254A. (1) Subject to sub-rule (2) a person shall not either directly or indirectly withdraw from a horse, manipulate and reinfuse into a horse homologous, heterologous or autologous blood products or blood cells.

- (2) A registered veterinary surgeon may for lifesaving purposes or through use of veterinary regenerative therapies for the treatment of musculoskeletal injury withdraw from a horse, manipulate and reinfuse into a horse homologous, heterologous or autologous blood products or blood cells.
- (3) A horse that is treated in accordance with sub-rule (2) shall not be permitted to start in any race for a period of eight clear days from the date of the treatment.
- (4) A person who fails to comply with sub-rules (1), (2) or (3) is guilty of an offence.


