

Hobart 4th January 2015

RACE 1 : This is for the two year olds to kick off the night's racing. They all had their first starts last week at Launceston. CHICA BELLA (2) drew out the back and paced roughly and lost a bit of ground but then had the tenacity to hit the line as strong as any of them for a fast closing third. She draws much better here so will take plenty of beating. SULTAN FELLA (3) started favourite in that race in where he faced the breeze and was going to be in the finish before breaking in the straight so if his on his best behaviour he will be right in the finish. ORIGIN CRONK (2) done everything right in that race which enabled him to finish second so he has to a chance as well. HILLVIEW JAKE (1) draws the pole here so if he can take advantage of it he will be right in the finish.

TOP PICK : CHICA BELLA (2) will take plenty of beating.

DANGERS : SULTAN FELLA (3) he will be a huge danger along with HILLVIEW JAKE (1).

ROUGHIE : ORIGIN CRONK (4) beat all these home last week but will go around as the outsider here and can win.

RATINGS : 2 – 1 3 – 4

RACE 2 : This will be a very competitive C4/C6. MAYBE RAMA (5) is racing in career best form and was dominant winning last start after doing all the work and winning well. He will find this slightly stronger but I'm sure his up to the task. WHISPER JET (6) is a very handy mare who is having her second start in the state. She will be suited by the small field so get every chance to win. VANDE VELDE (3) is racing very well and will get the right run here so has a chance. CISKEI (2) and DAMITSAM (4) are more than capable with the right run so are a must for the exotics.

TOP PICK : MAYBE RAMA (5) will take plenty of beating here.

DANGERS : WHISPER JET (6) loom's as the danger along with VANDE VELDE (3).

ROUGHIE : DAMITSAM (4) will go around at good odds and can win if produces best.

RATINGS : 5 – 3 6 – 2 4 - 1

RACE 3 : This is a three year old and older non winners. NO SPRING SECRETS (4) resumes into a very winnable race here. He showed good ability as a two year old and has trialled up well for this so is sure to be the hardest to beat. BLACKJACKHANOVER (5) is a handy type himself and will find this a little easier than latest run. He will have a dip for the lead and if got across will take running down. JOKERS WILD CARD (10) did show ability as an early 2yo. She has had a good break and resumes here so has to be included as an e/w chance. NOTEWORTHY LOMBO (9) draws to get a good run through so will settle handy so is a must for the exotics at odds. GOTTA GO AMIGO (6) is having his first local

run and has trialled ok so is a must include for the exotics as well. BLITZEMGAMBLE (1), FIRE UP FRANCO (3) and TWISTED MISS (8) are next best.

TOP PICK : NO SPRING SECRETS (4) will take plenty of beating here.

DANGERS : BLACKJACKHANOVER (5) is the clear danger along with NOTEWORTHY LOMBO (9).

ROUGHIE : GOTTA GO AMIGO (6) can run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 4 – 5 – 6 9 10 – 1 3 8 – 11 – 2 7

RACE 4 : This is a C1 only. RUSTY RED COMET (7) broke through for a well overdue win last start. He draws the top off the track here so will have to do a bit of work in the run but is clearly the one to beat. MAJOR CALLUM (6) is a very consistent type who will push forward early and look for the breeze and will keep battling to the line so is a good hope. VILLAGE ME (8) was disappointing at his first local run but is much better driven with a sit so can improve. ROBERT MOREAU (12) has been racing well so if he can get the right run into the race has a chance at odds as does TINKERS TAXI (13) who draws out the back with him. VANDER JENKINS (5) , IVE GOT OOMPH (9) , OUR SPUNKY MONKEY (10) and SMOKIN MUSTARD (11) all have claims for the exotics.

TOP PICK : RUSTY RED COMET (7) will be the hardest to beat.

DANGERS : MAJOR CALLUM (6) is clearly the danger along with VILLAGE ME (8).

ROUGHIE : ROBERT MOREAU (12) can run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 7 – 6 – 5 8 9 10 11 12 13 – 1 2 3 4

RACE 5 : This is the another heat of the Hobart Pacing Cup. STAR CHAMBER (10) was a brilliant winner of the Tasmania Cup last start when everything fell into place perfectly. He is 20m here but does begin like a bullet so will be the one to beat. MOTU CRUSADER (12) resumed in the Tasmania Cup when had a very tough run as held the breeze and dropped out to beaten along way. He will be much better suited here as has proven he can win off 40m mark as he did the Easter Cup so is well placed here off the same mark. WHODEANI (3) was super impressive winning seven on the trot last time in. He resumes here off an injury enforced break so has to be kept very safe. TRULY BLISSFULL (1) will ensure there is a solid tempo as loves to bowl along and will give cheek at odds so is a must for the exotics. REMEMBER JOE (8) and OUR CHAIN OF COMMAND (11) are proven stand performers who are a must for the multiples at odds. RYLOV LEIS (5) , CALL THE MARSHALL (7) and BENEDICTION (9) are very handy at their best so are a must include for the multiples as well.

TOP PICK : STAR CHAMBER (10) is the one to beat in a very tough race.

DANGERS : WHODEANI (3) is sure to be primed for this so is the danger along with MOTU CRUSADER (12).

ROUGHIE : TRULY BLISSFULL (1) will give cheek at odds.

RATINGS : 10 – 3 12 – 1 5 7 8 9 11 – 2 4 6

RACE 6 : This is a race for the three year olds. TALES OF THE CITY (5) is having his first start and does come off a good trial. He will push forward early to look for the breeze then from there will get every chance. JOHN SNOW (8) has had a bit of a freshen up after his first up run so if his right he will be in the finish. LU WAY LORD (2) has been racing well and look's the leader so can give some cheek. IDEN MAKIN TIME (3) will strip much fitter for her first up run last week and draws well so has a good hope. ORIGIN BILLY (1) will get a good run behind the speed so is a must for the multiples as is racing well. BERTILS BLISS (6) is a consistent type who has to be included in the multiples. GIFTED COURAGE (10) resumes here and did run against some of best youngsters as a two year old so has to be kept safe.

TOP PICK : TALES OF THE CITY (5) will be hard to beat here.

DANGERS : JOHN SNOW (8) has the ability to be a huge danger along with LU WAY LORD (2).

ROUGHIE : IDEN MAKIN TIME (3) will run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 5 –1 2 3 8 – 6 10 – 4 7 9

RACE 7 : This is a C2/C3 with plenty of chances. BOLTNMACH (10) was super impressive winning last start when found the lead and won well. He draws the back row here but if he can get around them early will be hard to beat. JABBER JAWZZZ (6) has had no luck of late so will pay to go on previous form in where he would be very hard to beat here. FAITHFUL JET (5) is another racing well who will push forward early so will get every chance here. DOUBLE DEE (11) has been good at his past starts so if can work into the race he will be in the finish at odds. ROCKBANK DANCER (1) draws well here so is a must for the multiples at odds. INGLIS (2) is new to the state and draws well so will have to be kept safe. THE DIP (7) was much better last week so is another that can place at odds.

TOP PICK : BOLTNMACH (10) will be e/w odds and has a good hope.

DANGERS : JABBER JAWZZZ (6) is racing well so is the danger along with FAITHFUL JET (5).

ROUGHIE : DOUBLE DEE (11) will run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 10 – 5 6 – 1 11 – 2 7 – 3 4 9 12 - 8

RACE 8 : This is a very good race. MISTER LENNOX (7) is a very smart type but does draw the top of the track in a race that has a bit of depth. He will look to push forward so will be on the speed throughout so is the one to beat. DANCING DA VINCI (3) ran a very brave second to the favourite last start when made ground on him. He draws inside him here so is sure to get every change and the stable is in great form at present. METRO DIGBY (5) has always shown promise but I'm just not sure

where he is at present but is a must include for the multiples. STONER RAINBOW (8) will get a good run through early so is a must include for the multiples as well. EMS CHOICE (1) draws ideally to run a place at odds.

TOP PICK : MISTER LENNOX (7) is the one to beat.

DANGERS : DANCING DA VINCI (3) is a huge danger along with METRO DIGBY (5).

ROUGHIE : STONER RAINBOW (8) will run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 7 – 3 – 5 8 – 1 – 2 4 6

RACE 9 : This is a CO/C1 for the mares. SWEET PEA JASPER (1) is very well placed here from the draw as look's the leader so is the hardest to beat. REALLY FAYFAY (5) was very impressive last start when driven aggressively to lead and won well so with similar tactics here will make her a danger. LA EBONY KITA (8) is a handy mare who draws to get a good run through so if they go hard up front she can get over the top of them. REALLY FIESTY (6) has been consistent of late so with any luck from the draw can run a race at odds. EBABE (2) , BOUTIQUE ART (3) , PHAROAHS WRATH (4) and TERROR JONES (7) are all capable of running a place at odds with the right run.

TOP PICK : SWEET PEA JASPER (1) will be the hardest to beat here.

DANGERS : REALLY FAYFAY (5) with a repeat effort will be the danger along with LA EBONY KITA (8).

ROUGHIE : PHAROAHS WRATH (4) will run a race at odds.

RATINGS : 1 – 5 8 – 4 6 – 2 3 7

RACE 10 : This is the claimer to finish of the night. SKY TOWER (6) was super impressive winning a heat of the Hobart pacing cup last start. He draws inside his major rival here so will be very hard to beat. SAAB QUALITY (7) has been winning the claimer's of late but this is by far his toughest one his been in so from the draw will have to spot on to win. MELPARK MAESTRO (4) will be hoping to get to the pegs first and if does will give them something to chase. MISTER PINJARRA (8) is a tough type who will get a good run through so is a must for the exotics. BLENDED FAMILY (5) is the third of the Zeke Slater runners who has fair form so has to be kept safe. GIVITANAME (2) and SHANGHAI KNIGHT (3) are next best.

TOP PICK : SKY TOWER (6) will take plenty of beating on last run

DANGERS : SAAB QUALITY (7) is the obvious danger along with MELPARK MAESTRO (4).

ROUGHIE : GIVITANAME (2) will improve here.

RATINGS : 6 – 7 – 4 5 8 – 2 3 -1
