

Why must this form be lodged?

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, this form must be lodged upon the retirement of a racehorse (AR 51) or the death of a racehorse (AR 52).

Lodgment of this form helps Racing Australia (RA) and the Principal Racing Authorities (PRAs) track horses following their racing career.

When should Part B - Retirement of Racehorse be completed?

Within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse.

When should Part C - Death of Racehorse be completed?

- Named horses within 24 hours of the horse's death.
- Unnamed horses within 48 hours of the horse's death.

Note: A horse must not be disposed of without the written approval of the relevant PRA unless a veterinary certificate as to cause of death is provided to that PRA (as per AR 52(1)(b)).

How can I lodge this form?

Completed forms can be lodged with RA:

- · online (from April 2019) at www.myhorseracing.horse; or
- in paper form by post to Racing Australia Service Centre, Level 1, 400 Epsom Road, Flemington VIC 3031; or by email (subject line: Retired Racehorse) to customerservice@racingaustralia.horse.

The manager of the horse or his/her authorised agent is responsible for lodging the form with RA in accordance with the requirements above.

RETIREMENT OF RACEHORSES OR DEATH NOTIFICATION FORM

Privacy and personal information

The personal information collected by RA during the horse retirement/death notification process includes an owner's name, address, email and mobile. This information is required to:

- (a) identify owners;
- (b) facilitate the administration of racing, and
- (c) communicate with owners.

Where information is not provided, processing may be delayed until the required information is provided.

An owner's personal information may also be used or disclosed by RA in accordance with RA's Privacy Policy. The Privacy Policy also sets out how owners can access and seek correction of their personal information, as well as how to make complaints regarding RA's handling of their personal information.
