TASMANIAN STAR FILLY 'MYSTIC JOURNEY' WINS RICHEST TURF MILE IN WORLD RACING Tasmanian bred - Tasmanian trained

> TASMANIAN trainer Adam Trinder and his stable star Mystic Journey took on the might of Australia's most popular horses in the inaugural All-Star Mile and emerged triumphant to signal the filly's arrival as a superstar of the Australian turf.

> Having just come off an emphatic win in the Australian Guineas to become the first Tasmanian-trained Group 1 winner of the modern era, her connections would not have cared had she been unsuccessful in her All-Star Mile mission.

> But this Tasmanian-bred filly, sired by Armidale Stud's resident stallion Needs Further, is a fighter and it was her incredible will to win that allowed the three-year-old to replicate in the All-Star Mile what she did to take out the Australian Guineas.

For her owner Wayne Roser, who paid only \$11,000 for the filly at the 2017 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling sale, it was a huge payday with the winner's purse of \$2.25 million taking Mystic Journey's career earnings to \$3.26 million.

STAR Tasmanian filly Mystic Journey wrote her name into the record books as the inaugural winner of the \$5 million All-Star Mile at Flemington and in doing so delivered a gift to Tasmania for which no price could be set.

The Adam Trinder-trained three-year-old treated her rivals with contempt as she sat three-wide with little cover for the last 800 metres of the inaugural All-Star Mile at Flemington. When jockey Anthony Darmanin called on the daughter of Needs Further to deliver she did what she does best.

As soon as Mystic Journey caught sight of the leader Hawkshot she set sail for the line and along the way hauled in proven weightfor-age performer Hartnell and hit the line well clear of that horse with quality mare Alizee third.

Trinder was surprisingly calm after the race. "Well, that's it then, she's done it," Trinder said. We set her for the Australian Guineas as her main mission and that would have been enough but today she proved even more. She's done for now and we will look at the future when the dust settles." Mystic Journey was bred at Armidale Stud in Tasmania and being by its resident sire Needs Further, the stud's managing director David Whishaw could hardly speak as the tears flowed freely down his cheeks. "This win and this filly has done so much for Tasmanian racing," Whishaw said.

"We can't put a price on what Mystic Journey has done for our product."

Mystic Journey's owner Wayne Roser was composed before and after the race but he, like most who urged the filly home, knew that the victory was more than just about winning.

Corporate bookmakers reacted swiftly to Mystic Journey's dominant All-Star Mile win by slashing her price to win the Cox Plate from \$15 to \$6 and second-favourite behind the Autumn Sun at \$5.

When trainer Adam Trinder walked away from the Moonee Valley racetrack in October last year after his brilliant filly Mystic Journey had just emerged triumphant in a Group 2 race over 1600m he was adamant she was Group 1 material.

Mystic Journey lived up to those expectations on the largest stage in Australia by blitzing a quality field in the Group 1 Australian Guineas (1600m) at Flemington with her regular rider Anthony Darmanin aboard. The Australian Guineas win meant more to Tasmanian racing than anyone could imagine.

In taking out the Guineas in grand style she became the first Tasmanian-trained horse to secure a Group 1 victory that in turn gave Trinder the bragging rights as the first Tasmanian Group 1 trainer.

It was a magical moment for the connections of the Tasmanian-bred filly, especially her owner Wayne Roser.

Mystic Journey settled sixth on the rails after being bustled early by Darmanin to be in the first half-dozen at the 1000-metre peg. The rider was content to bide his time and wait for an opening to appear when the leaders fanned at the top of the long home straight. Trinder, who watched the race on his own in the owner/trainer bar adjacent to the mounting yard, had a few anxious moments when Darmanin was unable to get the filly to the outside and as he switched course to be hard-up on the rail, he held his breath.

But his anxiety turned to elation when Mystic Journey (\$4 favourite) slipped into overdrive, collared the leader Hawkshot and went on to score by 2-1/4 lengths from Hawkshot with Amphitrite a close third.

Trinder said Mystic Journey has opened up opportunities that may have been considered out of reach had she not been so good.

"Mystic Journey has been great on so many fronts. She has been good for me and her owner Wayne Roser but she has been fantastic for Tasmania.

After her Guineas win there wasn't a racing pundit in the Flemington media room who doubted she would be given a wildcard entry into the \$5M All-Star Mile. She has now taken that opportunity and her win in the inaugural All-Star Mile has made history for Tasmania, her owner, trainer, jockey and breeder.

MYSTIC JOURNEY was bred in Tasmania (foaled at Armidale Stud) and cost only \$11,000 at the Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale. There is no doubt her success leading up to the Australian Guineas had an impact on the 2019 Tasmanian Yearling Sale success.

Armidale Stud general manager David Whishaw stated "The stud went out on a limb when we secured Needs Further but he has been a remarkable addition to our stallion roster.

"He has produced multiple stakes winners with only three of his crops to race and to produce a Group 1 winner is great for everyone concerned.

"Her Group 1 win is the shot in the arm our breeding industry needed."

ANTHONY DARMANIN: Jockey Anthony Darmanin has declared the filly the best he has ridden.

"I haven't ridden a better horse than Mystic Journey. She gave me my first Group 1 win and has now taken me on a magical ride that has only just started. "Really, she does all the work and I just sit there and put her in the right spots to run on."

Darmanin said winning the Australian Guineas or the ALL-STAR MILE won't change him.

"I'm 36 and I have a great role riding trackwork through the week for Lloyd Williams, and I get to go to Tassie every week where I get most of my rides.

"Tassie has been great for me because I've ridden almost every feature race winner in that state and the people are great."

BARGAIN BUY TAKES OUT FEATURE FILLIES' DOUBLE

Plucked from obscurity on the internet for a modest \$3,300 -Now a winner of over \$147,000

Tasmanian Oaks winner Shady Hustle is a genuine rags to riches story. She was plucked from obscurity on the Internet for a modest \$3300 by a very discerning racing tragic and ended up capturing a feature three-year-old fillies' double.

Shady Hustle delivered a top class effort to win the Thousand Guineas (1600m) and while she missed a place in the subsequent Strutt Stakes in Hobart she bounced back to score an incredibly courageous win in the \$150,000 Tasmanian Oaks over 2100m.

The win also was achieved with a replacement jockey after the filly's regular rider Ryan Bishop was taken to hospital as a result of a race fall earlier in the day.

While Bishop was undergoing tests and scans, replacement rider Bulent Muhcu was giving Shady Hustle (\$41) the run of the race before storming to the lead in the home straight.

When the daughter of Hussonet was tackled by the favourites 200 metres from home she refused to wilt and went on to score by over a length from Our Long Sali (\$4.40) with race favourite Rock Dove (\$2.10) a closing third.

It was trainer Stephen Lockhart's biggest win since he arrived in Tasmania eight years ago to embark on his training career.

The former jockey from country NSW said Shady Hustle arrived in his stable at a time when he needed a boost to survive in the game.

"I was once told that you only have to have one really good horse in the barn to survive and we've found that with Shady Hustle," Lockhart said.

Muhcu had Shady Hustle travelling comfortably one off the rails with cover to the home turn where he eased her out three-wide to make his move. At the same time, Our Long Sali's rider Anthony Darmanin made his bid for victory.

The pair collared the leader while Glass Warrior (\$4.40) loomed as a threat as the widest runner.

"I was always confident this filly would run a strong 2100 metres and I reckon she'll be as good if not better at a longer trip later on.

The filly was purchased by long-time Lockhart stable client Peter Kingston who said winning a maiden with the filly last year was enough reward.

"We were rapt that she won a maiden and paid for herself but to come here and race against a really hot field in a Listed race and win is something very, very special," Kingston said.

"The filly is raced by a great bunch of people and to be honest we were all just happy when she had won a race to pretty much cover our initial investment.

"But after that maiden win, Stephen (Lockhart) was adamant she was better than just a maiden horse and he was proven right."



EASTENDERS' TRIPLE CROWN TASMANIAN RACE RECORDS RE-WRITTEN

TALENTED stayer Eastender rewrote the record books when he scored an emphatic win in the Group 3 \$250,000 TAB Launceston Cup over 2400 metres.

The Barry Campbell-trained five-year-old became the first horse since the great Brallos in 1977 to win all three major cups in the same season and the first to include the weight-for-age Summer Cup in the group of four consecutive wins.

After winning the Devonport Cup in January the gelded son of Tickets won the Summer Cup and backed it up with a decisive victory in the Group 3 Hobart Cup. He went into the Launceston Cup sound favourite after Godolphin's interstate raider 'Fabrizio'.

It also was a defining moment for the trainer when Eastender cruised past race leader Fabrizio and hit the line a half-length clear of that horse with Lamborghini a halflength away third and the same margin to outsider Settler's Stone.

"Until today I'd won every feature race worth winning in this state except one and now I've won the lot thanks to this horse." Campbell said.

"I've had a lot of horses that have been able to stay a bit but this one is the real deal.

"He won a St Leger over 2600m at three and it was that win that changed all of our thinking.

"He has gone from strength to strength each season and to do what he has done this season is quite amazing.

The win also netted connections the Tasracing \$100,000 Cups Double Bonus paid to any horse that can win the Hobart and Launceston Cups in the same season.

But there will be no big spend-up with the spoils of the big windfall.

"The bonus is nice and it would be tempting to go on a spending spree but I'm sure we'll just pour it back into the business" said Campbell.







TASBRED STARS HELP BOOST SALES RESULTS

When TASMANIAN BRED stars like Mystic Journey, Mystical Pursuit, Eastender, Palentino and The Cleaner (to name a few) make it onto the big stage in Group and Listed Races, it is easy to see why the Tasmanian Magic Millions Sales continues to go from strength to strength and the 2019 Sale was no exception.

A colt by Fiorente sold for \$115,000 topping a record breaking 2019 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale in Launceston. The colt catalogued as Lot 63 was offered by Armidale Stud and sold to leading Victorian based buyer Brad Spicer.

"He's a lovely staying type of horse," Spicer said. "The Fiorentes are really starting to hit their straps and there's not many opportunities to buy one in the market this year."

"The colt is very similar to a smart Fiorente I have at home called Little Phoenix who has shown good things in two starts with Chris Waller."

"He looks like a horse we could develop into a Derby type. He's from a mare who was third in a Tasmanian Oaks, he's an exciting prospect."

The Fiorente was the Tasmanian sale top seller of a sale which returned an all-time record gross of almost \$3 million and an increased clearance rate of 78 per cent. Local buyer Leigh Winwood has tasted incredible success with past Tasmanian Yearling Sale graduates and he invested \$100,000 to secure Lot 116, the Charge Forward colt from Tara's Spur offered by Grenville Stud.

Winwood has led the ownership groups of previous star sale graduates including Royal Rapture, Kenjorwood and Queen La Diva.

Leading local trainers Scott Brunton (7 lots at \$244,000) and Adam Trinder (5 lots at \$157,500) led the way on the buyers list on spend.

"This sale continues to go from strength to strength," Magic Millions Managing Director Barry Bowditch said. "To again have a record gross here in Tasmania is an amazing result for the breeders."

"It was pleasing to see many of the local buyers support the sale in an unprecedented manner plus the strong interstate and international participation."

"Today's sale reaffirms the recent contract renewal between Tasracing and Magic Millions and our ongoing commitment to Tasmania," Bowditch added.

THE 2018-19 Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival proved to be a bonanza for locallytrained horses with 85% of the feature race prizemoney won by Tasmanian trained horses.

Of the \$2.8 million offered in stakes during the carnival, Tasmanian horses netted \$2.4 million with only \$414,000 heading interstate.

Eastender won all three major cups and two-year-old filly Mystical Pursuit won both \$100,000 Listed juvenile races. The Stephen Lockhart-trained three-year-old filly Shady Hustle caused a boilover to win the \$150,000 Tasmanian Oaks. The Scott Brunton-trained mare Life on the Wire won the \$150,000 Group 3 Bow Mistress while Tasmanian-trained but Victorian-owned Twitchy Frank won the Group 3 Vamos also worth \$150,000.

James Cummings was the only interstate trainer to win feature races with Godolphin three year-olds Cossetot and Rock Dove winning the \$150,000 Tasmanian Derby and the \$100,000 Strutt Stakes respectively.

It was a brilliant outcome for Tasmanianowned and trained horses compared to the previous season when Tasmanian trainers went home with 59% of the prize pool (\$1.4 million) while \$953,000 (41%) headed interstate. 2019 SUMMER RACING CARNIVAL



ELWICK TRACK REDEVELOPMENT PROGRESS UPDATE



WORK on the \$12.5 million redevelopment of the Elwick thoroughbred track is progressing as planned.

The new single 28-metre wide grass track will deliver a quality, consistent racing surface for Southern Tasmania's home of racing.

The decision to build the single track was taken after extensive consultation with industry representatives and clubs, with Tasmanian company StrathAyr chosen as the Head Contractor.

Work commenced on the redevelopment immediately following the running of the 2019 TAB Hobart Cup meeting on 10 February.

All existing services (electrical, irrigation and drainage) have been removed and the exposed 'sub surface' has been 'proof rolled' with soft spots compacted and replaced to bring track levels into alignment.

StrathAyr grass tracks are proven around the world and are highly regarded for their all-weather consistency and durability. The turf to be used in the redevelopment will be a mix of Blue Grass and Rye Grass, with approximately 64,000² metres to be laid.

Racing for the remainder of the 2018-19 season will be shared between Launceston and Devonport, with the Devonport club to host all race meetings between June and mid-September.

Works on the Elwick redevelopment are scheduled to be completed before the running of the 2020 Hobart Cup.

Lena Kamp with new¹ born Alpine Eagle foal



Having never encountered a retired racehorse before, the feelings of frustration were strong! To her credit she worked tirelessly at understanding how the mindset for racing is established by watching racing and talking to trainers.

Her ability to think laterally and stay calm under pressure paid off in a short amount of time and Amelia went on to win Champion Ridden Thoroughbred at her very first show! She also readily accepted trail riding and jumping under Lena's capable guidance.

Keen to establish her new found skills with OTT horses Lena went on to help the OTT team with a Standardbred gelding (Real River) who is under serious training to become a reliable mount for a rider who unfortunately lost an entire leg in an accident. Dollar Dan and Valerius were two more retired Thoroughbreds Lena piloted while they successfully learned to be patient trail mounts.

The Tasracing Off The Track team were grateful for Lena's skills and willingness to think outside the box while helping our beautiful horses transition successfully into their off the track lives.

PROGRAMME NOTES

The structure of the winter calendar has changed significantly with the redevelopment of Hobart beginning instantly after the Hobart Cup.

11 Meetings over the course of 6 months have been transferred to Launceston and Devonport, with the latter set to be exclusively used throughout winter.

Feature Races throughout the period had been altered or brought forward to March in the previous program calendar to compensate for the Hobart redevelopment during this period. The 2YO Tasmanian Sires Produce was brought forward to March to compensate for poor field size whilst the 3YO events remain throughout Autumn with the \$50k 3YO 1400m run at Launceston on April 24th.

The tasBred scheme will conduct the Inaugural tasBred 2YO race on May 19th over 1200m at Launceston worth \$50k to tasBred eligible horses. The race will be run under Set Weights and Penalty conditions with the prizemoney scaled on acceptances.

The restructure of the program throughout April to July has been designed to allow all horses an opportunity to race.

Class 2 and 3 Races have been erased to provide more opportunities in Benchmark grade for the population. These horses will now have multiple options across several benchmarks instead of being limited in their decisions to a graded handicap. Maiden and Class 1 horses will be able to contest their own bracket before going through their grades through benchmarked events.

The Scaled Hcp, which was trialled throughout the Summer Carnival, has seen it well received to offer all horses a target. With the reconstruction of Hobart, the population may vary significantly so gauging what is in work in Tasmania during this time will be difficult. This race type offers all horses to nominate and then re-rates the race on acceptances to give a clearer reflection of the event. (ie – If the top rated accepting horse is 72, the races is scaled as a BM72 Hcp). A Scaled Hcp has been programmed most weeks.

Race Programs later in the month have been limited to 7 races to allow a clearer indication on what to program when horse pool is known. 9 races can be added between April and June due to additional funds available in the stakes pool, but races can be divided if field size and track condition allow any time.

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING OF RACING

AR.1A – TROPHY AND CLASS B RACES Summary:

Racing Australia has determined to increase prizemoney thresholds for Trophy and Class B races as follows:

- Trophy race increased from \$3,500 to \$5,000; and
- Class B race increased from \$10,000 to \$12,500.
- 1. Amend AR.1A as follows: "AR.1A

A Trophy Race is a race in which the prizemoney and/or value of any trophy to the winner does not exceed \$5,000.

- A Class B Race* is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not generated prizes in the aggregate worth more than \$12,500 for wins in races on the flat and have never won a race on the flat outside Australia.
- *The value of the prize to the winner shall not exceed:
- in a Class A Race \$6,000 in a Class B Race - \$12,500. ..."

Date of effect: 7 January 2019 Approved by Tasracing 8th January 2019, effective immediately

AR.14B – REGISTRATION OF HORSES Summary:

Racing Australia has determined to amend AR.14B to provide Racing Australia with a discretion to allow the registration of a horse despite its owners not lodging their Mare Return and Foal Ownership Declaration on time.

This amendment provides Racing Australia with flexibility in its enforcement of the rule, such as where exceptional circumstances for late lodgement exist.

1. Amend AR.14B as follows: "AR.14B

(a) This Rule applies to all Eligible Horses.
 (b) Except where Racing Australia, in its sole and absolute discretion, permits otherwise, an Eligible Horse cannot be registered under these Rules unless:

- (i) a Mare Return has been lodged with the Australian Stud Book in accordance withthe Rules of the Australian Stud Book; and
- (ii) a Foal Ownership Declaration has been lodged by the Manager, or his or herAuthorised Agent, with the Registrar within 60 days of foaling.
 The discretion in this subrule may be exercised by Racing Australia in respect of matters occurring at any time, including prior to the amendment of this subrule.

Date of effect: 7 January 2019 Approved by Tasracing 8th January 2019, effective immediately

AR.54 – LOCATION OF HORSES Summary:

Racing Australia has determined to amend the rule in relation to stable returns to enable racing authorities and Stewards to more accurately understand the true location of a horse at a particular time.

This rule is extremely important as it allows Stewards to track horse movements so they can carry out the necessary stable inspections, drug testing and surveillance.

The amended rule is more in line with the NSW and Victoria local rules, and better captures horse movements from the time of entry until arriving on course to race. These amendments will assist in ensuring the integrity of racing, particularly given the increasing number of horses that travel across state borders to race.

1.Delete AR.54 and replace as follows: "AR.54

- (1) A stable return and any amendment thereto lodged with a Principal Racing Authority(or its agent) is part of any entry for a race at any race meeting.
- (2) A horse trained in Australia may not be entered for a race, official trial or jump-outunless a stable return for that horse is lodged with a Principal Racing Authority (or itsagent):
 - (a) prior to the closing time for entries for the race, official trial or jump-out; or
 - (b) if entries for a race close more than 60 days before the advertised date for therunning of the race, prior to the time for the first declaration of acceptances for therace.
- (3) If a horse trained outside Australia is entered for a race, official trial or jump-out, a stablereturn for that horse must be lodged with a Principal Racing Authority (or its agent) priorto the time for declaration of final acceptances for the race, official trial or jump-out.
- (4) The trainer of a horse must:
 - (a) disclose the location of a horse under his or her care upon request by RacingAustralia (for retirement purposes only) and/or a Principal Racing Authority;
 - (b) lodge a stable return immediately upon a horse joining the trainer's stable;
 - (c) lodge an amendment to a stable return immediately if:
 - (i) any particulars on the stable return have changed; or
 - (ii) a horse leaves or joins the trainer's stable, or moves to another of the trainer'spremises (where the trainer's stable is comprised of more than one premises),with the amendment to disclose the precise location of the horse.

(5) For the purposes of subrule (4):

- (a) if a trainer's stable is comprised of more than one premises, the trainer must disclose at which premises the horse is located;
- (b) when a horse leaves a trainer's stable to spell or otherwise the trainer must disclose the location of the property at which the horse shall be located.
- (6) Where a horse has been entered for a race, from the time of entry to arrival on course prior to racing:
 - (a)except with the permission of the Stewards, the horse must be stabled only at the premises from which the horse's trainer is licensed to train;
 - (b) if the horse is travelling to participate in the race, the horse's trainer must inform the Stewards of the horse's proposed travel plans prior to the horse's departure from the trainer's stable and/or lodge a stable return disclosing the location of the horse (as required by the relevant Principal Racing Authority).
- (7) Any trainer who fails to lodge, in whole or in part, a stable return or any amendment thereof, or fails to provide details of the location or movements of a horse, in accordance with the provisions of this rule may be penalised and the entry of such horse for any race, official trial or jump-out may be rejected or cancelled.
- (8) The Manager (or his or her Authorised Agent) of an Eligible Horse or a Named Horse must, unless otherwise contained in a stable return lodged in accordance with this rule, disclose:
 - (a) the location of that horse upon request by Racing Australia and/or a Principal Racing Authority, including as required under any registration, ownership transfer or other form;

(b) any change in the previously notified location of that horse, to the satisfaction of a Principal Racing Authority, immediately. (9) Any person who fails to provide details in respect of the location of a horse in accordance with the provisions of this rule may be penalised.

Date of effect: 7 January 2019 Approved by Tasracing 8th January 2019, effective immediately

AR.87 – HELMET STANDARDS

Summary:

Racing Australia has determined to amend the helmet standards approved under AR.87 to reflect updated international standards. **1.Amend AR.87 as follows:**

"AR.87

Every licensed or registered person or permit holder shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly affixed helmet which conforms to one of the standards that have been approved by Racing Australia.

Note: Pursuant to AR.87 Racing Australia has ordered that:

- (a)The following standards are approved by Racing Australia:
 - (i) AS/NZS 3838 2006;
 - (ii) EN 1384:2012 or EN 1384:2017;
- (iii) ASTM F11 63-04a (2011), ASTM F1163-13 or ASTM F1163-15;
- (iv) PAS 015:2011;
- (v) VG1 01.040, Recommendation for Use, 12/12/2014.
- (b)All helmets must be fitted with a nylon interlocking chinstrap clip attachment.
- (c) All helmets must be clearly marked with a date of manufacture.
- (d)The use of helmets is subject to the conditions of AR.87AA."

Date of effect: 7 January 2019

Approved by Tasracing 8th January 2019, effective immediately

TOR RULES – APPENDIX 1 AND RULE 6(5) Summary:

A key feature of the Trainer and Owner Reforms (TOR) is that an owner of a horse who has failed to pay their training fees can have certain prizemoney frozen and redirected to the horse's trainer.

However, the term in the TOR Rules that allows this to occur ("prizemoney to which an Owner would otherwise be entitled") may inadvertently restrict a trainer from obtaining prizemoney from a defaulting owner in circumstances where:

- the owner transferred the horse to another trainer before the first trainer became entitledto restrict such a transfer; or
- a majority part owner (who is not in default) transferred the horse to another trainerbefore the first trainer sought the freezing and redirection of prizemoney.

Accordingly, Racing Australia has determined to amend the definition of "prizemoney to which an Owner would otherwise be entitled" to ensure the first trainer can still obtain the relevant prizemoney after the horse has been transferred to another trainer.

A consequence of the amendment is that both trainers may have competing claims for prizemoney if the owner accrues debts with both. To address this potential issue, Racing Australia has determined to insert a new rule to provide that the claims of the trainer who first seeks freezing and redirection of prizemoney will take precedence over the other trainer's claims. If both trainers enforce their rights under the TOR Rules when they arise, precedence will sit with the first trainer. **1.Amend Appendix 1 of the TOR Rules as follows:**

"DEFINITIONS

. . .

Prizemoney to which an Owner would otherwise be entitled means, for the purpose

of these TOR Rules, any prizemoney which, but for these TOR Rules, an Owner would be entitled to receive from Racing Australia or a PRA in relation to the results in a race of a horse or horses owned or part owned by the Owner which is trained by the Trainer (or that received the Training Services). Such prizemoney therefore includes prizemoney earned through results of a horse/s other than the horse/s that received the relevant Training Services the subject of action under these TOR Rules and prizemoney of the horse/s that received the relevant Training Services (even if the Trainer no longer provides Training Services in respect of such horse/s).

Date of effect: 7 January 2019 Approved by Tasracing 8th January 2019, effective immediately

2. Insert a new TOR Rule 6(5) as follows: "TOR Rule 6 – Consequences for a Trainer and Owner if the Presumption of a Training Debt arises

- (5) If, in respect of a horse owned or part owned by an Owner:
 - (a) the horse is transferred from one Trainer to another Trainer;
 - (b) the Owner owes Training Fees and/ or Training Disbursements to both Trainers; and
 - (c) both Trainers have filed an EAA/s pursuant to TOR Rule 6(1)(c), the earlier of the EAA/s filed will take precedence in respect of freezing the payment of prizemoney to which the Owner would otherwise be entitled and directing payment of that prizemoney to the Trainers."



STABLE RETURNS

Trainers are reminded of their obligations regarding stable returns and to ensure they are completed in entirety when horses enter or leave their stables;

LR 7.2 - A trainer is required to lodge a stable return completed in its entirety within seven (7) days of every registered horse entering his stable. However, if any horse is entered for any race or official trial, a stable return completed in its entirety must be lodged no later than two (2) clear working days prior to closing time of entries for such race or trial.

LR 7.5 - Should any trainer any trainer fail to fulfil the requirements of this rule, he may be punished and/or the horse concerned may be withdrawn from its engagement.
