





LAUNCESTON CUP

CUPS DOUBLE TO UP CUPS

Hall of Fame trainer David Brunton is no stranger to winning feature races but to do it with a horse that is bush-bred and was close to being retired to a life as a pony club horse is an amazing feat.

WHEN locally-bred gelding Up Cups produced his most courageous performance to win the \$200,000 Group 3 Betfair Exchange Launceston Cup on a heavy track in February, it was a red letter day for his trainer David Brunton.

The victory not only etched the locally-bred gelding's name in the record books as one of an elite group to have won the Hobart and Launceston Cups in the same season but it gave him a record that had not been completed in the modern era.

There are two traditional lead-up races to the Hobart Cup and they are the Jockey Club Cup and the weight-for-age Summer Cup and Up Cups won them both.

Winning both major cups also earned for his connections the UBET Cups Double Bonus of \$100,000 to be shared equally between the trainer and owner.

Hall of Fame trainer David Brunton is no stranger to winning feature races but to do it with a horse that is bush-bred and was close to being retired to a life as a pony club horse is an amazing feat.

"This horse is an absolute ripper and who would have thought that we were close to giving him away when he'd lost all form," Brunton said.

Up Cups was sent to Longford on New Year's Day 2015 to contest a modest lower class race in which he was expected to lead but he missed the start by three lengths and was still last turning for home. He stormed home to win and that's when his racing life changed forever.

"All of a sudden we worked out how to ride him and his form improved dramatically. We gave him a good spell and this season he has been truly magnificent", Brunton said.

Up Cups was a big drifter in betting easing from \$4.50 to start at \$8.10 on Launceston Cup day, most likely because of the constant rain that turned the track rating from a Good 4 to a Heavy 8 by cup start time.

"We weren't worried about the rain because we knew he could handle rain-affected ground but it was a wide barrier. David (Pires) managed to get him into a great spot early and the horse did the rest," Brunton said.

Up Cups was able to settle better than midfield and one-off the rails with cover while Ollie's Gold set the pace with the well-backed Gladstone on the heels of the leader.

Gladstone, prepared by David's son Scott Brunton, hit the front at the top of the home straight but Up Cups powered home and had

enough in reserve to stave off a late bid by Victorian mare Arianne to score by a half neck with another Victorian Schockermohle almost two lengths away third.

"Every local jockey wants to win one of the major cups and this horse gave me both in the space of two weeks," Pires said.

Up Cups was bred by the horse's owners Rick and Tina Polley and they were thrilled with the result.

"Who would have thought a year ago that this horse would be taking out the Hobart-Launceston Cup double," Polley said. Others might have thought this horse was at the end of his game 12 months ago but I always had faith in him."


Up Cups ventured to South Australia to contest the Adelaide Cup over 3200 metres in March and while he was unable to find a spot in the placings he was still game in defeat.

Travel arrangements to Adelaide were far from ideal after the plane that was to take him to South Australia was cancelled at the last minute.

"It might have been a different story had everything gone to plan with the travel arrangements but he ran a good race all the same and he arrived home safe and sound so that's the main thing," Brunton said.

2015 Tasmanian Jockey Premiership winner David Pires

ABOUT 14 years ago David Pires was wondering if he had made the right choice to pursue a career as a jockey in Victoria, but when he received an invitation from Longford trainer Ian Hay to try his luck in Tasmania it changed his life.

When he arrived at Hay's stables he carried with him a nothing-to-lose attitude that eventually established him as one of the state's best riders.

"I was 20 and almost ready to pull the pin when Ian Hay invited me to Tassie so I had my indentures transferred to him and that's where my riding career really took off," he said.

"My association with his former great mare Dragila opened the doors for me to make it in Tasmania. Dragila won the Newmarket, Tattersall's Stakes and Bow Mistress in the

same season so she was definitely a big stepping stone in my career."

Despite his success Pires took time out to reassess his career so he moved back to Melbourne where he spent about six months contemplating his future.

"I had reached a stage in my life where I wasn't sure what I wanted to do beyond 30. I'd been riding since I was 15 and there's no doubt I was struggling with the lifestyle that is very taxing on your personal life."

Pires ended up in Queensland but when equine influenza arrived and shut down racing in that state in 2007, he moved back to Tasmania.

Last season Pires completed another milestone in his career by winning his first jockeys' premierships by booting home 74 winners.

"Winning the premierships was great and there's no doubt the opportunity to team up with Scott and David Brunton has been the best career move since I've been in Tasmania. I pretty much call myself a Tasmanian now because this state has given me all I have ever wanted from racing, especially this season."

ONE of the highlights of the Betfair Exchange Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival was the performances of talented two-year-old Hot Dipped.

The Brendan McShane trained filly was unbeaten in Tasmania. She won a maiden on debut followed by an awesome display to take out the 2YO Tasmanian Magic Millions Classic over 1200 metres at the UBET Racing Centre in Launceston. If that was not enough to convince the doubters she delivered the best of her three Tasmanian efforts by winning the \$100,000 Steve's Liquor Gold Sovereign Stakes on Launceston Cup day.

The Gold Sovereign win was so emphatic that rider Bulent Muhcu had time to sit up and give her a congratulatory pat on the neck as she crossed the line many lengths clear of interstate invader Hussy's Glow and another local star in Gee Gee Double Dee, who was unbeaten from four starts prior to the Gold Sovereign.

While her season ended with a missed place in the Group 2 \$200,000 Sires Produce Stakes at Flemington over 1400 metres, she remained the stand-out juvenile for the season.

"The filly did a marvellous job here in Tasmania and she deserved the

opportunity to be tested across the water," McShane said.

"It was important that she be given the opportunity to travel away from the state because if she develops as I expect much of her racing will be interstate," he said.

Hot Dipped handled the trip away like a seasoned professional and her efforts in the Sires Produce was full of merit.

In the Sires the filly settled midfield and looked to be a winning chance turning for home but her run ended 200 metres out, yet she battled gamely to finish fifth and five lengths from the winner Seaburge.

Hot Dipped was bred by Tasbreeders president Rob Dixon from his Reibey Lodge property in Northern Tasmania. The filly is by Written Tycoon from Dixon's former smart mare Galvanized, who was a winner of the 2004 Listed Strutt Stakes.

Galvanized was a Melbourne winner before suffering an injury that sent her into retirement with career statistics of three wins and eight minor placings from only 16 starts for \$160,975 in prizemoney.

Hot Dipped was purchased at the 2015 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale for \$33,000.

QUALITY Victorian mare I Love It continued her love affair with Tasmanian racing when she delivered another great performance to win the Group 3 Vamos Stakes over 1400 metres in Launceston in February.

I Love It won the Group 3 Bow Mistress Trophy in Hobart at her first start in Tasmania last year and she returned to tackle the same race this season only to be beaten in a head-bobbing finish by the Nikki Burke trained Nautical.

But in the Vamos the John Salanitri trained mare came of age as a sprinter when she powered her way to an emphatic win at Group level and broke Lady Lynette's track record along the way.

I Love It (Artie Schiller-Not That Innocent) stopped the clock at 1m.22.67s which was quicker than Lady Lynette's 1.23 that she set in the same race in 2009.

I Love It's regular rider Stephen Baster settled the mare third behind the leader Sh'bourne Spirit until the home turn where he eased her off the rails to challenge and she quickly put the end result beyond doubt.

It was an emphatic win, scoring by almost a length from the Heath Connor's trained mare Boundary with Tasmanian mare Sh'bourne Spirit a close-up third.

"The Vamos win definitely made up for being beaten narrowly in the Bow Mistress," said Salanitri stable manager Frank Salanitri.

"This mare means so much to our family and every time she races in one of these big races she always gives everything," he said.

I Love It is owned by members of the Salanitri family and a group of friends including talented thoroughbred racing photographer Sharon Chapman.

VICTORIAN trainer Robert Smerdon celebrated another Tasmanian feature race win when his filly three-year-old Chabaud scored an emphatic win in the \$100,000 Listed Tasmanian Oaks over 2100 metres, in the colours of owner, the late Phil Sly.

With Mark Zahra in the saddle, Chabaud was snagged back to last from her wide barrier and she was still at the rear 700 metres out.

Zahra set the filly alight at the 600-metre peg and so quickly did she sprint that she had the field covered at the top of the home straight.

She went on to defeat the Gai Waterhouse trained Sweet Redemption

(\$3.10 favourite) by just under a length with Electric Aura (\$28) a close-up third just a head of Alamonteel (\$16) for an all Victorian finish.

Genuine Art from the Scott Brunton stable was the first Tasmanian horse home in fifth place.

Chabaud was well backed to win the race, firming from \$6 to start the second elect at \$4.40.

Smerdon's filly went on to finish a game fifth in the \$1 million Group 1 ATC Oaks in Sydney beaten only 1.6 lengths by Sofia Rose.

LONGFORD trainer John Blacker predicted a bright future for Blaze Forth after the gelded son of Court Command won a 2YO maiden on the synthetic at Devonport in July last year.

He spelled the gelding after that win and was confident Blaze Forth would pay his way as a three-year-old.

While the gelding didn't quite live up to expectations he well and truly paid his way with his only win coming in the \$50,000 Tasbreeders Magic Millions 3YO Classic in Launceston over 1200 metres.

Blaze Forth produced a barnstorming finish to emerge triumphant by more than a length from stablemate Jazzy's Choice and the Barry Campbell trained Teriki.

"He picked the right race to do his best and that it was a \$50,000 race made up for some other races that I thought he might have won," Blacker said.

After he won the Magic Millions race Blacker backed him up a week later in a \$30,000 3YO event on Launceston Cup day in which he finished fifth of eight behind Gee Gee Red Prince on an unsuitable heavy track.

He was just behind the placegetters at his three subsequent starts before finishing a game third to Gee Gee Red Prince in the 3YO Autumn Classic over 1100m in Hobart at the end of April.

ADMIRAL

4YO Bay Gelding
by MOSSMAN from REUNIFICATION

Winner of the GEORGE ADAMS

STAR Tasmanian galloper Admiral is on the verge of creating history following another outstanding season on Tasmanian tracks.

Admiral was Tasmanian 2YO of the Year and followed up with the 3YO title last season and could become the first to win 2YO, 3YO and open age horse of the year awards in consecutive seasons.

This season he made a clean sweep of all the weight-for-age races run over distances between 1200-1600 metres, of which four were \$100,000 Listed events.

He will be rivalled by Up Cups, that after winning the Jockey Club Cup and Summer Cup went on to win both the Group 3 Hobart and Launceston Cups.

With the exception of the Newmarket Handicap, in which he finished fifth when first-up from a lengthy spell, he was undefeated in Tasmania from five subsequent outings.

He began with victory in the \$100,000 Listed Conquering Stakes over 1400m in Launceston, followed by victory in the Listed Tasmanian Stakes over 1600m on the same track.

After dropping back significantly in distance to take out the \$50,000

UBET.com Stakes over 1200m he ventured to his least favourite track in Hobart to win the \$100,000 Listed Thomas Lyons over 1400m.

Admiral ended his Tasmanian campaign with victory in the Listed George Adams Plate over 1600m which was arguably his best win of the season.

He gave the leader Miss It And Bit four lengths with 150 metres remaining and looked to be floundering on a heavy track ... but as good horses do, he found a way to win.

PALENTINO CONTINUES 'THE BRED IN TASMANIA' SUCCESS STORY

Tasmania offers a unique environment to rear and raise horses in one of the cleanest, green and pristine environments in the world ... and Tasmanian breeders continue to showcase their success on the interstate stage.

WHEN Tasmanian-bred three-year-old Palentino powered his way to victory in the \$750,000 Group 1 Australian Guineas (1600m) at Flemington it earmarked the son of Teofilo as a potential super sire.

Palentino went from winning a maiden at his second start in October last year to winning a \$150,000 Listed race at Flemington during the VRC Spring Carnival in November.

Trainer Darren Weir sent him for a spell and made plans to set him for the Australian Guineas with the Group 3 CS Hayes Stakes to serve as entrée to the main course along the way.

Palentino went into the CS Hayes Stakes as favourite and was first across the line but lost the race in the stewards' room.

But he was to deliver a sterling performance to take out the Australian Guineas at his next start defeating another potential superstar Tarzino but again the official result was delayed pending a stewards' inquiry.

However, this time the pendulum swung in favour of the Tasmanian-bred colt, much to the delight of his swarm of owners who are enjoying the ride of a lifetime.

Palentino ended his three-year-old season with a second to Tally in the Group 2 Alister Clark Stakes at Moonee Valley but his minor placing stake took his career earnings to \$622,210 from

seven starts that comprise three wins and as many minor placings.

That's not a bad return so far for a horse that topped the Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale in 2014 when knocked down to Weir for \$85,000.

Palentino was bred in Tasmania by Jenny Watson of Macleay Thoroughbreds situated at Westwood in the north of the state.

Weir attended the sale with the sole purpose of seeking out and buying the flashy chestnut colt.

"I found him in Tasmania. I'd trained his mother (Palatine Hill) and went over and saw him and loved the horse. He's certainly proven to be a tough bugger," Weir said.

Connections sold a half share in Palentino to Sun Stud (formerly Eliza Park International) with the colt to continue racing through the spring of 2016 before heading for stud duties next year.

At the recent 2016 Tasmanian Yearling Sale young Victorian trainer Matthew Brown was able to secure Palentino's half-sister by Tough Speed for \$28,000.

Both are from Palatine Hill, a Moonee Valley winning daughter of Palace Music who is a half-sister to stakes winners Rather Grand and Sublimity.



PALENTINO CONTINUES 'THE BRED IN TASMANIA' SUCCESS STORY

Tasmanian breeder Jenny Watson runs a boutique stud on the outskirts of Launceston and is the breeding success story behind Palentino

Jenny has worked with thoroughbreds for the past 35 years, working on stud farms in Western Australia, New South Wales, Victoria and Tasmania, preparing yearlings for sale in virtually every state. She graduated with a Diploma in Equine Stud management at Murek Agricultural College in West Australia before marrying and moving back to Tassie in 1986 where she and her husband developed Macleay Thoroughbred Stud in the Meander Valley.

Jenny breeds around four to five horses per season at their 62 hectare property farm at Westwood Northern Tasmania, about 20 kilometres from Launceston. The area is well-known in Tasmania for breeding thoroughbred horses and has gained national and overseas recognition for breeding Group 1 winner Mongolian Khan, and Group 2 winner The Cleaner.

Palentino, a striking chestnut colt was foaled on October 18, 2012 and according to Jenny was always destined for success. Palentino comes from a distinguished British family, his classic placed fourth dam Shellshock (Salvo) being a half-sister to champion filly Dibidale (Aggressor) (Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) and Yorkshire Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) and herself dam of nine winners, among them stakes winners Missionary Ridge (Caerleon) and Seismic Wave (Youth).

The 2016 Australian Guineas winner is one of 52 stakes winners for his sire Teofilo (Galileo) whose tenth Group One winner, Special Fighter, came up in Dubai just hours after Palentino's victory in Melbourne.

In 2014 Palentino was the talk of the Tasmanian Magic Millions sale, having topped the sale at \$85,000, being sold to Victorian trainer Darren Weir.

To-date his earnings have reached in excess of \$650,00, and after conclusion of the 2016 spring racing season he will be joining the Sun Stud stallion roster in 2017.

INDUCTED INTO

AUSTRALIAN RACING HALL OF FAME

SYDESTON, arguably the greatest Tasmanian-bred and owned galloper to leave our shores in the modern era, was this year inducted into the Australian Racing Hall of Fame.

Not since Malua who raced in the 1880s has a Tasmanian horse been inducted into the Australian Racing Hall of Fame.

The former star of the turf who made his mark on the national stage in the late 1980s and early '90s was inducted into the elite club at a gala function at the Adelaide Convention Centre in South Australia in May.

Sydeston was a versatile horse who could sprint and stay. Bred and raced by the late David Yaxley, the gelding won seven races in Tasmania in


the care of the late Len Dixon who, along with Sydeston were inaugural inductees into the Tasmanian Racing Hall of Fame.

Sydeston was transferred to the care of master Victorian trainer Bob Hoysted, who prepared him to win the 1989 Moonee Valley and Sandown Cups in his first season on the mainland which also included a fast finishing sixth in the 1989 Melbourne Cup won by Tawriffic (NZ).

He went on to win four Group 1 races, the 1990 BMW and 1990 Queen Elizabeth Stakes 1991 Caulfield Stakes and 1991 Caulfield Cup. Sydeston started 25 times at the elite level for four wins and six placings which included a second and a third in the weight for age championship of Australia, the Cox Plate.

Sydeston was sired by St. Briavels (GB) who stood at Armidale Stud in northern Tasmania. St Briavels was a Dual Listed winner in the United Kingdom before coming to Tasmania in 1984. He would go on to sire five stakes winners who combined to win 14 stakes races. Sydeston was responsible for nine off these wins. St Briavel's would also sire Tripsacum which ran third in the 1985 Melbourne Cup behind What A Nuisance.

Sydeston's dam Convatrice had seven foals with Sydeston being the best offspring. Sydeston's half-sister Donvertrice (Blessington) did produce a stakes winner in Jugahtrice which took out the 1994 Listed Barton stakes.

LIKE a fine wine, superstar Tasmanian horse Sydeston just got better with age.

They are the memories of former jockey Pat Allan, who had the good fortune to ride the 1990 Caulfield Cup winner in his early days.

Sydeston passed away aged 30, the same day his owner, the late David Yaxley, was inducted into the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Racing Hall of Fame.

Allan rode the gelding for two of its 19 career wins, with the highlight being the triumph in the St Leger at Mowbray in March 1989.

He remembers Sydeston, who finished with prizemoney of \$3,105,545, as a honest horse who wasn't overly remarkable in his early days.

"As a two-year-old he was very lazy and you didn't think he was going to get anywhere," Allan said.

"But just before he turned three, he come right, pretty much overnight, and showed us everything. The older he got, the more he improved.

"There was a couple of times I never rode him because I thought David had another horse better, but that one only had three starts before dropping dead on the track one day."

Even one of Australia's leading jockeys at the time told Tasmanian trainer Len Dixon and Yaxley to look somewhere else.

"Malcolm Johnston (rider of Kingston Town) was on him one day in Hobart and told Lenny and David that they were wasting their time with him - and Malcolm was usually a pretty good judge."

But a move to Melbourne after the St Leger win, and to the stables of Bob Hoystead, soon paid off, with

Sydeston rounding off 1989 with five wins, including the Moonee Valley and Sandown Cups.

It was in 1990 however that his star was at its peak, winning group 1 races the BMW and the Queen Elizabeth, before backing up in consecutive weeks to win the Caulfield Stakes and the Caulfield Cup.

Allan still has memories of watching the Caulfield Cup run and being filled with satisfaction every time Sydeston saluted.

"I can still picture Mick Dittman (jockey) coming to the corner and looking for the run, and when he got it, he just left the rest of them," Allan said.

"There was always a sense of pride that we educated him and got him up to where he was."



Campari won his first trial before deciding that racing wasn't fun, so finished pretty much dead last in his next four races before being retired as a three year old.

"I'm very honoured we won the OTT award and we will aim higher again next season and hopefully make it to competing elementary at next year's Championships with my son Jasper taking him up the grades in eventing. Leo would have to be the kindest most willing horse ever, though a tad lazy at times! "

Dr Gertie Nijborg - Campari Soda

GERTIE NIJBORG

Born in the Netherlands, Gertie was obsessed with horses since the day she could walk. Living in a small country town there was room for a pony. One pony became two ponies and then there were more. Gertie joined ponyclub and had several quite succesful showjumpers, jumping at national level before later becoming interested in dressage where she trained a young foal to Prix St George Dressage ... then life became too busy with university studies.

"I did some travelling and ended up in Australia, married with two sons. Once they were old enough, a pony came along, and you know the story ... they multiply, so now there are five. I got an interest in eventing and started competing in one day events (ODE) three years ago," stated Gertie.

CAMPARI SODA (Leo)

Leo was given to Gertie two years ago as a three year old. He had been retired after a very short unsuccessful racing career.

Campari Soda competed in his first unofficial dressage competition three months after she got him and he won both tests, then went on to win every ODE he entered in that season (at age four). He won not only EVA65 eventer of the year 2015 but also highest performing dressage horse in eventing across all grades.

Gertie and Campari Soda were runner up in the amateur series preliminary in 2014 and then decided to go up a notch and train novice. By that stage, Gertie had handed the reins to her son Jasper, who now events him in grade 3.

Although this means he didn't get to do many dressage competitions this season he managed to qualify just in time for the 2016 state championships, the first ever championship both he and Gertie competed together in. As usual, Leo was a star and pulled everything out of the bag, to get a third and sixth in the novice tests behind some well-seasoned flashy moving warmbloods.

"Being awarded winner of the OTT award was just so unexpected, amazing! I'm more than proud of the big boy and feel so honoured to have received this award. It proves that thoroughbreds can do more than race and event ... and have a career after racing."

programme notes

The August to November 2016 grid continues the stakes reset program implemented 1 October 2015, as part of Tasracing sustainability measures.

In the most recent April to July grid management, following consultation with industry, Tasracing introduced on trial a revised structure of the Class system, with the introduction of Class 3 and Class 5 races, replacing Class 2 and Class 4.

This has been well received, though some participants have expressed a desire to have a pure Class 2 option periodically still available within the grid.

With Class 3 races increasing the available cohort (Class 2 & Class 3 based horses) to in excess of 20% of the population, it has led to an increase in average field and increased the number of viable programming opportunities.

In incorporating feedback and metrics the August to November program, Tasracing has included Class 2 races on programs that have Class 5 races, thus not seeing potential erosion of field from having

Class 2 and Class 3 races programmed at the same meeting.

It is envisaged that this would see ongoing class race opportunities for approximately 90% of the racing population in Tasmania, encouraging the racing of progressive horses and presenting a product that is attractive to wagering customers.

The inclusion of Class 3 1600m and Maiden 1600m races has been well received, as another means of presenting variation and encouraging the elevation of progressive staying horses and has been continued in the latest program grid.

The program also contains the first of the Feature race programs for the 2016/17 Tasmanian Summer racing Carnival.

Kicking off with the TRC Goodwood Handicap to be conducted on Melbourne Cup day in Hobart, taking advantage of SKY racing coverage of the meeting.

The Goodwood Handicap then leads into the State's premier sprint, the TTC Newmarket Handicap on Wednesday 16 November.

Upon review of the public holiday dates in January and February, it soon became apparent that the gazetted public holiday dates in 2017 would severely impact the flow of all feature races. This is mainly due to Devonport Cup half-day holiday being a week later than 2016 and Regatta day and Launceston Cup public holiday dates only being nine days apart instead of 16 days in 2016.

With the majority of Feature Races between the Hobart and Launceston Carnivals having only 9 days or less between fixtures, alternative dates were explored.

In April Tasracing in consultation with the TRC determined that the 2017 Hobart Cup be brought back a week to be conducted on Sunday 5th February with Tasmanian Derby and Bow Mistress twilight meeting on Friday 3 February.

This allows suitable time between some of the main carnival races.

- Goodwood Handicap and the 2YO Debutante to Melbourne Cup day (with SKY2 coverage) on Tuesday 1 November, with the Goodwood to be run at 1100m, to facilitate desired program coordination into TTC Newmarket Handicap.

TASMANIAN TURF CLUB

- Maintenance of the three weeks between Newmarket Handicap (16 November) to the Conquering WFA (7 December).
- Magic Millions (MM) race night remains on Wednesday 15 February, with Yearling sales on Thursday 16 February. Produces a highlight meeting to kick off Launceston Cup week.
- Vamos Stakes and Tasmanian Oaks day meeting on Sunday 19 February, between MM race night and Launceston Cup on Wednesday 25 February.
- Due to the UBET sponsorship agreement concluding, the George Adams Stakes will revert back to its registered name of the Mowbray Stakes.

- Three feature summer race meetings remain as per 2016/17: Golden Mile, Sheffield Cup and the Devonport Cup.

TRAINING TRACKS

The Stewards are concerned that the training track regulations that govern horses being worked at Brighton, Longford and Spreyton are not being fully adhered to by participants. Whilst on most occasions the track Steward responsible for the management of the training facility will regulate training track activity the Stewards will encourage the Track Stewards to make a report to them if a participant fails to heed the advice given to them by the Track Steward.

Please familiarise yourself with the local training track rules together with the provisions contained within Local Rule 25.

HORSES TO BE ATTENDED WHILST ON COURSE

Participants are reminded that a horse needs to be attended at

all times whilst it is on course, this requirement is inclusive of when the horse has competed in its race.

BANNED SUBSTANCES THAT ARE APPLICABLE TO HORSE HANDLERS AND RIDERS

Australian Racing Rules AR 81B and AR 81BB outline the substances that are banned and cannot be present with a person's system when working.

It is the Stewards intention to increase the amount of testing that is conducted at race meetings, trials and trackwork.

LODGEMENT OF STABLE RETURNS

Recently there has been an increase in the amount of Stable Returns being lodged with incomplete information especially ownership details.

CHANGES TO LICENCING REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION

INSURANCE / WORKERS COMPENSATION INFORMATION

- The following information is provided to all trainers
 1. Trainers employing staff or contractors must have an appropriate current workers compensation policy.
 2. Trainers if utilising persons in a voluntary role must have an appropriate policy that covers volunteers.
 3. Workers compensation insurance policies in most cases do not cover the trainer for injury.
- Tasracing strongly recommends that Trainers discuss with their insurance brokers obtaining the appropriate level of cover to ensure they are suitably covered in the event of an incident.
- The following information will be provided to all trackwork riders on the application form:
 1. Trainers and/or track work riders must negotiate an employment arrangement to ensure an employer/employee relationship is in place.
 2. Any track work rider who is self-employed or does not have an employment arrangement or a contract with a trainer, will need to ensure they have an appropriate level of cover to ensure they are protected in the event of an accident.

INTRODUCTION OF MINIMUM RIDES REQUIREMENT BEFORE BEING RELICENCED JOCKEYS, APPRENTICES AND TRIAL RIDERS

Tasracing has approved the introduction of a minimum rides clause for jockeys and apprentices, whereby for licence renewal riders must have ridden in a minimum of 10 races over the preceding 12 month period, unless special circumstances can be demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Director. This is in line with the minimum rides clause introduced to Official Trial riders licence in 2015/16.

THOROUGHBRED – STABLE EMPLOYEE TRACKWORK/NON-TRACKWORK RIDER

Tasracing has amended changes to the licensing procedures for stable employees and track riders. In 2016/17 stable employees can either apply for a *stable employee - track work* or *stable employee – non trackwork*.

STABLE EMPLOYEE (TRACKWORK RIDER)

The holder of a *Stable Employee licence* may, under the supervision or instructions of a licensed trainer, assist with his training, management, care and control of horses and assist with pre-race preparation of, and post-race procedures affecting a horse. Stable Employees are **not permitted** to mount any registered racehorse either on the trainer's property or any registered racecourse unless also registered for trackwork riding duties.

A *Stable Employee licence* is issued at the discretion of the Director of Racing to a person who has:

- Attained the age of fourteen (14) years. (Parental consent required for applicants under the age of 18 years.)
- Lodged a completed application form with the prescribed fee.
- For persons over the age of eighteen (18) years, submitted a Statutory Declaration with respect to Criminal History Record.
- Lodged a completed Stable Employee Induction Assessment form.
- Provided a Birth Certificate or an extract of same or other evidence of identity. (New applicants only if not previously provided to ORI or any other racing jurisdiction)
- For a licence renewal, submitted a Statement of Attainment for the following units if not previously provided.
 - RGRPSH201A Handle Horses
 - RGRCMN201A Follow OHS procedures and observe environmental work practices
- For new applicants, completed the training and submitted a Statement of Attainment for the following units within six (6) months of being licensed.
 - RGRPSH201A Handle Horses
 - RGRCMN201A Follow OHS procedures and observe environmental work practices
- Successfully completed the Australian Drug Foundation "Aware Program".

STABLE EMPLOYEE (NON TRACKWORK RIDER)

The holder of a *Stable Employee (Trackwork Rider) Licence* may under the supervision or instructions of a licensed trainer, assist with his training, management, care and control of horses and assist with pre-race preparation of, and post-race procedures affecting a horse. The holder of this licence may also perform trackwork duties for any licensed trainer.

A *Stable Employee (Trackwork Rider) licence* is issued at the discretion of the Director of Racing to a person who has:

- Attained the age of fourteen (14) years. (Parental consent required for applicants under the age of 18 years.)
- Lodged a completed application form with the prescribed fee.
- For persons over the age of eighteen (18) years, submitted a Statutory Declaration with respect to Criminal History Record.
- Lodged a completed Stable Employee Induction Assessment form.
- Provided a Birth Certificate or an extract of same or other evidence of identity. (New applicants only if not previously provided to ORI or any other racing jurisdiction)
- For a licence renewal, submitted a Statement of Attainment for the following units if not previously provided.
 - RGRPSH201A Handle Horses
 - RGRCMN201A Follow OHS procedures and observe environmental work practices
- For new applicants, completed the training and submitted a Statement of Attainment for the following units within six (6) months of being licensed.
 - RGRPSH201A Handle Horses
 - RGRCMN201A Follow OHS procedures and observe environmental work practices
- Submitted a full medical examination report showing appropriate fitness to ride. The Director of Racing reserves the right to request a medical report from an applicant at any time if considered necessary.
- Undertaken a riding ability assessment to satisfaction of Stewards. Wherever practical, this assessment should be conducted by a full time ORI Steward.

AMENDMENTS TO TASMANIAN LOCAL RULES OF RACING

11.1 (d) (i)

11.1 (d) (i) In TWO-YEAR-OLD RACES prior to 1 February the horses shall be eliminated in the following order: **(amended rule effective 26/05/2016)**

FIRST - Horses which have not been placed first to fourth inclusive in a race and have not been placed first to third inclusive in an official trial.

SECOND - Unraced horses which have not been placed first to third inclusive in an official trial.

THIRD - Horses which have not been placed first to fourth inclusive in a race but which have been placed first to third inclusive in an official trial.

FOURTH - Horses which have not won a race.

(ii) In TWO-YEAR-OLD RACES (UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED) horses will be eliminated as per LR11.1(e) Ratings Based Handicapping Balloting.

AMENDMENTS TO TASMANIAN LOCAL RULES OF RACING

16.1 Jockeys, Apprentices and Approved Trials Riders

16.1. No person shall ride in a race at any race meeting or at official trials held within the State of Tasmania (unless such meeting has been exempted from the operation of this Rule) unless he or she is:

- licensed as a Jockey by the Director, or
- an Apprentice indentured under an agreement with Tasracing and has obtained a permit from ORI to ride in races, or
- In the case of an apprentice indentured with another recognised racing authority the Director may grant permission for such apprentice to ride if they are satisfied that he has the sanctions required by the Racing Rules and Regulations in force where he is indentured and submitted a Visiting Apprentice Notification, current medical examination report and letter from his/her Master granting approval to ride, or
- licensed as an Approved Trials Rider by the Director.
- licensed with Racing Victoria as a Jumps Jockey A may apply for a licence in Tasmania and be permitted to ride in trials, jump outs and trackwork and in any races excluding Group or Listed. **(amended rule effective 26/05/2016)**
- Jumps Jockey B and has made application to be licensed as a jockey in Tasmania and therefore may ride at any trial, jump out or trackwork held within the state of Tasmania. **(amended rule effective 26/05/2016)**

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING AR.87

Jockey Helmets

Summary:

European authorities have approved VG 01.040 and PAS 015:2011 standards necessitating additions to the list of approved helmet standards in Australian Rule of Racing 87.

Amend AR.87 as follows:

“AR.87. Every licensed or registered person or permit holder shall when mounted on a horse wear a properly affixed helmet which conforms to one of the standards that have been approved by the Australian Racing Board.

Note: Pursuant to AR.87 the Australian Racing Board has ordered that –

- The following standards are approved by the Australian Racing Board:
 - AS/NZS 3838 2006;
 - United States (US) ASTM F11 63-01;
 - British Standards (BS) EN 1384/1996 onwards;
 - United States (US) ASTM F11 63-04a (reapproved 2011);
 - PAS 015:2011;
 - VG 01.040, Recommendation for Use, 12/12/2014.
- all helmets must be fitted with a nylon interlocking chinstrap clip attachment.
- all helmets must be clearly marked with a date of manufacture.
- the use of helmets is subject to the conditions of Australian Rule of Racing 87AA.”


