naugurated in 2008, the National Apprentice Jockey Series draws together apprentice jockeys from across the country to represent the state in which they are registered.

The series gives young riders the opportunity to compete against some of the best young jockeys in the country.

2018 NATIONAL APPRENTICE JOCKEY DEVUES WRAP

THE FORMAT

State selected apprentices compete in five races including four races interstate of which two are conducted at metropolitan level in Victoria and Western Australia. The state that accrues the most points from the five race series is deemed the winner with seven points allocated for first, five for second, three for third and two for fourth with one point to the remaining unplaced runners. This years Tasmanian representatives were Sherry Barr, Chris Graham and Teagan Voorham.

THE TASMANIAN LEG

Sherry represented in the first race of the series held at the Tasmanian Turf Club, finishing third to Alexandra Bryan (Vic) who delivered a classy performance to win aboard the John Blacker trained horse Jupiter's Moon. Sherry's mount Gemini started from a wide draw at odds of \$51, but with a great front running ride battled on gamely to finish third. It was Sherry's last day of riding as an apprentice jockey before completing her indenture.

THE VICTORIAN LEG

The second leg of the series was held in Victoria with Tasmania's leading apprentice Chris Graham conjuring up a third place with a brilliant ride on longshot Romanesque who started as an outsider in the field at odds of \$31. It was Chris' first opportunity to ride at a metropolitan race meeting and his demonstration of good skills and technique gave his mount every chance, securing valuable points against Australia's leading apprentices.

THE QUEENSLAND/SOUTH AUSTRALIAN LEG

The Queensland leg of the series was moved to South Australia after the Queensland meeting was abandoned, which allowed Tasmanian apprentice Teagan Voorham the opportunity to compete in both the Queensland and South Australian legs held at the Gawler Racecourse just 40 minutes north of Adelaide. Teagan made an impressive start as an apprentice notching up four winners at one race meeting early in her career and is now strongly on the heels of Chris Graham in the Apprentice Jockey premiership. Although it was the first time she has ridden outside of Tasmania Teagan produced an excellent ride to win the Queensland race and followed up with a close second in the South Australian leg.

THE WEST AUSTRALIAN LEG

Teagan again represented Tasmania in the Western Australia leg, riding at her first metropolitan race meeting and finishing with a fourth on Wavehill Spur at odds of \$12.

THE RESULTS

Tasmania finished the series in second position overall with Victoria taking out the series by just four points. The National Apprentice Jockey series provides all participating apprentices with valuable experience, which significantly benefits their riding skills and racing confidence. CHRIS GRAHAM Age 26 Claims - 1.5kgs

Irish born and apprenticed to Adam Trinder, Chris commenced riding in Tasmania in August 2014. In 2016-17 he won the Tasmanian Apprentice School 'Dux' Award. His biggest race win is on 'Overplay' in the 2018 Listed Tasmanian Guineas.



SHERRY BARR Age 30

Sherry commenced race riding in 2014. Career highlights include winning the Longford Cup on 'Miss It and a Bit' in 2016, the Listed George Adams WFA and a Sheffield Cup.



Apprentice Jockey Coach STEPHEN MASKIELL

has achieved more than most people dare to dream. Winner of 8 Tasmanian Jockey Premierships, has ridden 3 Hobart Cup winners, 3 Launceston Cup winners and 8 winners in the Newmarket Handicap. He has ridden in Macau, Singapore, Malaysia and Mauritius and has been inducted into the Tasmamian Racing Hall of Fame. Stephen is now in charge of Tasmania's young apprentices.



TEAGAN VOORHAM Age 22 Claims – 2kgs

Apprenticed to trainer Nigel Schurring, Teagan has enjoyed a stellar start to her career riding four winners at one race meeting and currently sitting 2nd on the Tasmanian Apprentice Premiership. Her best win is on 'Vandermeer' in the 2018 Longford Cup.

"He's the best horse I've ever had, he's a gun." Glenn Stevenson

Boom Tasmanian sprinter I'm Wesley will be given the chance to prove himself against some of the country's best horses when he resumes racing this spring.

I'm Wesley is currently enjoying some R and R before heading back to the stables of his Wesley Vale based trainer Glenn Stevenson.

"He's out on the farm, in a paddock right on the beach with another horse on ten acres, he will probably have a couple more weeks and then back into work." Stevenson told Tasracing.

I'm Wesley will resume in the Auries Star, an 1100 metre pipe opener to the Spring Carnival run down the famous straight at Flemington. From there, it's up to the horse to determine where he goes.

"He'll start off in that and if he shows that he's going well enough we'll stay there and if not we'll come home and set our sights on some of the Tassie races."

I'm Wesley has always been a more than handy galloper but to many he

was a synthetic track specialist, having won seven times on the Devonport Tapeta surface.

That all changed last November when he blitzed a smart field in the Listed Newmarket Handicap in Launceston where he holds the track record of 1.08.05, for 1200 metres, a mark he set in a Benchmark 82, two weeks earlier.

"We always had the Newmarket (1200 metres) in the back of our minds but we knew he had to keep stepping up and when he broke the track record we were pretty confident."

Ridden by former Devonport, now Adelaide based apprentice Raquel Clark, I'm Wesley enjoyed a sweet trial just off the pace before bursting to the lead in the straight defeating Lord Da Vinci and Gee Gee Red Prince.

The Newmarket win was his fifth win in succession. He then went on to make it six in a row a few weeks later in the Weight For Age Conquering Stakes over 1400 metres, beating Hellova Street and Gee Gees Top Notch, in the process setting another track record.

The I'm Wesley story dates back six years to when Stevenson purchased two horses at a weaning sale, one to race and one to sell.

"There were eight I Am Invincible's there and they all looked magnificent, strong running types, and at that stage he hadn't had a runner and I think we'd had him (I'm Wesley) six months when the first I Am Invincible won in New Zealand and they just kept on winning. We were lucky, you can't buy them now."

I'm Wesley is raced by some of Stevenson's friends, all with a connection to the Wesley Vale Football Club.

"There's my old footy coach Leon Perry and his wife Bronwyn, and my mate Benny Holland who I've always played football with and his dad so it's just sort of a local crew from Wesley Vale."

"We've had enormous fun. There have been golf trips and trips away just on what he's won for us. If he's running in a good race we always make a target, it's either King Island for golf or somewhere else, so if he wins a decent race there's always a trip."

Stevenson says he always thought he had something special from the moment the bay horse arrived at his stables.

"From the first time we gave him a few gallops, some people thought he wasn't much good but as soon as it came to a competitive gallop he showed it and he's always shown it but he had a few little immaturity issues and that's why we didn't race him as a two year old."

"He knows he good, don't worry about that! If you put him with another horse in a vard, he just dominates, he's got that air about him, he knows he's good."

Like all good horses, I'm Wesley knows when it's time to excel.

"He's not a great track worker but he knows when it's race day and when it's race time and he tries his guts out. You know when you go to the races he will give it everything and when he finishes his race he's always having a blow because he's a trier."

Following his record breaking Tasmanian campaign prior to Christmas, I'm Wesley had a few months off before heading interstate where he started three times. He didn't win but he lost no admirers. I'm Weslev was placed at Flemington and Mornington in Listed company before heading to Adelaide where he ran a game fourth in the Group Three McKay Stakes over 1100 metres.

"He was super in Melbourne and then Adelaide he handled the travel well but then the only time he went bad was an hour before the race, it was just so claustrophobic for him. I couldn't stop him sweating and he'd run his race before he started. To finish fourth I thought was huge."

"On that trip he was beaten by some really good horses so we will head back with some confidence."

As it stands, I'm Wesley (I Am Invincible -Daniela) has had 30 starts for 11 wins and 10 minor placings, his stake earnings stand at \$313.000.

"If we manage him right, he should race on for a couple of years and touch wood, everything has been fine with him so far."

Stevenson has no hesitation when asked where I'm Wesley rates.

"He's the best horse I've ever had, he's a gun."

LIFE AFTER RACING IS RICH FOR RICHOMAN

WHEN trainer Mark Ganderton's former handy stayer Richoman was retired from racing four years ago, his life partner and the horse's regular trackwork rider Stephanie Rogers felt as if she was losing a close friend.

But as luck would have it, Richoman's owner John Stewart, gifted the horse to Rogers on the condition that she could offer the then seven-year-old gelding a home for life.

Rogers accepted the offer and these days they are inseparable, with both horse and rider on the verge of carving names for themselves in the show jumping arena.

"I regard 'Richo' as my best friend and together we are a good team," Rogers said.

"He is quirky and has a special way about him and I'm sure he has the same affection for me.

"I used to ride the horse in trackwork when he was racing and I was pretty much the only one who got along with him and he became my favourite horse.

"It's not uncommon for horse and rider to form that sort of bond but he is the only horse to have had that effect on me." Richoman began his racing career in Victoria where he performed admirably before making his way to Ganderton's stables in January 2013.

"John (Stewart) sent the horse to me because he wanted him to be in a small stable where he could be in more of a oneon-one training environment," Ganderton said.

His first win came at his fourth Tasmanian start in a benchmark 68 in Hobart before he went on to win three in succession that culminated in arguably the best win of his career in the 2013 Tasmanian St Leger over 2100 metres.

Richoman went up against Tasmanian champion Geegees Blackflash when that horse was racing at his peak as he had won the Group 3 Launceston Cup two starts prior and went into the St Leger on the back of an impressive win in an open handicap over 1600m in Hobart.

The champ was asked to carry 60 kilograms in the St Leger with Richoman thrown in at the weights on 54.5kg but "The Flash" was sent out the \$1.20 favourite while Richoman supporters were offered as much as \$5. "He is quirky and has a special way about him and I'm sure he has the same affection for me.

In a slogging finish Richoman poked his nose out where it counted and won the race and Rogers remembers the event well.

"I know everyone associated with the stable was very excited when Richo's number was posted and I can still remember the feeling when he was being led back to the winner's stall."

Richoman was immediately dispatched to South Australia to race with the Tony McEvoy stable and Rogers was fortunate enough to travel with the horse.

"I went to SA and it was a great experience being around the McEvoy stable and that Richo performed well made the experience more enjoyable."

Richoman collected three minor placings from his four starts at Morphettville before being sent back to Tasmania.

Ganderton trialed the gelding in December 2014 but when the horse was being unsaddled the trainer noticed some slight swelling in the horse's near foreleg.

"I had the vet look at the leg and he told me that if the horse was retired there and then he should be fine but more racing might run the risk of him breaking down," Ganderton said.

"I contacted the owner and he immediately retired the horse.

"John (Stewart) arranged for Richoman to return to his property in Victoria and after about six months in the paddock he sent him back to Tassie for Stephanie to have as a show horse."

Rogers, 27, who is a nurse at the Launceston General Hospital, has been riding since she was 10 and has spent the last 15 years competing at pony clubs.

But when Richoman arrived at her property at Westbury she contemplated progressing to show

jumping and Richoman has proven to be the perfect partner.

"It took Richo a while to come to terms with not being in a racing environment but after a couple of years he's finally settled into his new way of life.

When Richoman was racing his greatest asset was his endeavor every time he lined up. The gelded son of Golden Snake has carried that into his show jumping career.

"His work ethic is amazing. He tries his hardest at whatever he does and that says a lot about the horse's character.

"He has a terrific personality and that too makes him fun to be around."

About 18 months ago Rogers opted to seek the services of astute equestrian riding coach Merindah Thomson to help her progress to a higher level in competition.


"The move to take lessons from Merindah was the best thing I ever did because it not only improved me as a rider it also helped Richo go to another level.

Richoman has been competing in the show arena for almost three years without any wins but Rogers says her "best mate" is about to make his move.

"I'd say he is coming to his top and I'm sure all the work we've done will pay off this coming season."

The show jumping season starts in late September and Rogers says she and Richoman will be back into full training for that in June.

STEWARDS SEGMENT

TREATMENT RECORD

Trainers are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that any treatment/medication that is administered to their horses in accordance to AR.178F is recorded accurately. AR.178F. (1) A trainer must record treatment and medication administered to each horse in his or her care by midnight on the day on which the administration was given, and each record must include the following information:

- (a) the name of the horse;
- (b) the date and time of administration of the treatment or medication;
- (c) the name of the treatment or medication administered (brand name or active constituent);
- (d) the route of administration including by injection, stomach tube, paste, topical application or inhalation);
- (e) the amount of medication given (if applicable);
- (f) the duration of a treatment (if applicable);
- (g) the name and signature of person or persons administering and/or authorizing the administration of the treatment or medication.
- (2) For the purposes of this rule:
- (a) "treatment" includes:
 - (i) shock wave therapy;
 - (ii) acupuncture (including laser treatment);
 - (iii) chiropractic treatment;
 - (iv) the use of any electrical stimulation device (including transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation (TENS);
 - (v) magnetic field therapy;

(vi) ultrasound;

- (vii) any form of oxygen therapy, including hyperbaric oxygen therapy; and(b) "medication" includes:
 - (i) all Controlled Drugs (Schedule 8) administered by a veterinarian:
 - (ii) all Prescription Animal Remedies
 (Schedule 4), including those listed in AR.178C(2);
 - (iii) all Prescription Only Medicines (Schedule 4), prescribed and/or dispensed by a veterinarian for offlabel use;
 - (iv) all injectable veterinary medicines (intravenous, intramuscular, subcutaneous, intra-articular) not already included above;
 - (v) all Pharmacist Only (Schedule 3) and Pharmacy Only (Schedule 2) medicines;
 - (vi) all veterinary and other medicines containing other scheduled and unscheduled prohibited substances;
 - (vii) all alkalinising agents;(viii) all herbal preparations.
- (3) All records required to be kept in accordance with this AR.178F must be retained by the trainer for not less than two years.
- (4) When requested, a trainer must make available to the Stewards the record of any administration of a treatment and/or medication required by sub-rule (1).
- (5) A trainer who fails to comply with any provision of AR.178F commits a breach of this Rule and may be penalised.

Trainers are advised to be extremely cautious allowing horses access to/administering products that contain arsenic close to racing as this may inadvertently lead to a rise in urinary arsenic levels. Access includes the ability to lick, chew and ingest arsenic treated timber that may be in the horse's environment including the stable/paddock/yard construct. Horse's that are known to regularly 'wood chew' are advised to be kept in stables/fields with fences made from substances other than arsenic-treated timber.

An inorganic form of arsenic is used as an insecticide in the timber treatment chromated copper arsenate (CCA). CCA has been used to treat wood for many decades. Inorganic arsenic is more toxic than organic arsenic and can affect the skin, respiratory, immune, urinary, reproductive, gastrointestinal and nervous systems of mammals.

The presence of arsenic above a mass concentration of 0.30 milligrams per litre (mg/L) in a raceday equine urine sample is a prohibited substance.

Other products that contain arsenic include, but are not limited to, Ferrocyl, Jurocyl, and Invigorate injections. Arsenic can also be present in some seaweed based nutritional supplements. It is the responsibility of each trainer to carefully consider access to any sources of prohibited substances and the use of any supplements/additives to ensure that the horse is presented for racing free of any prohibited substance.

Trainers are put on notice that environmental contamination (through CCA timber or other means) will not necessarily be considered a significant penalty mitigating factor for presentation of a horse with urinary concentrations above the arsenic threshold in the future. Trainers are advised to take measures to ensure that racing horses do not have access to environmental sources of arsenic including treated timber products.
