WAYNE ROSER

REAPING REWARDS BEYOND HIS WILDEST DREAMS

Having had moderate success with his first dabble as a joint shareholder in a horse called Not Guilty, his decision to branch out

on his own and settle on Spreyton-based trainer Adam Trinder has reaped rewards beyond his wildest dreams.

In March this year, just over two years after he purchased a yearling by Needs Further from a modestly performed broodmare White Gold, the filly won the Group 1 Australian Guineas (1600m) and a couple of weeks later she delivered a career best effort to win the inaugural \$5 million All-Star Mile.

In just those two outings the filly's efforts sent \$2.426 million into his bank account.

At the time of this publication going to press, Mystic Journey had won 11 times from 15 starts for career stake earnings of \$3.5 million.

Not bad spoils for a horse that cost a paltry \$11,000 at the 2017 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling sale.

But at the time of purchase Roser was feeling the pinch as an owner, having committed to buying a number of yearlings that year and with a stable full of horses that at the time were performing moderately.

WAYNE ROSER has been riding the crest of a wave that he never thought possible when he first started investing thoroughbreds 11 years ago.

In this game an owner has to be prepared to take the good with the bad or in more sensitive terms - the slowest with the fastest.

"Before Mystic Journey I've had some slow ones that are now performing well at pony club events." Roser said.

"I've learned over the years that this is not a game for the faint hearted.

"Everyone goes into buying racehorses with the same objectives and that is the hope they make the racetrack and that they can win a race or two to pay their way.

"But it's hard, bloody hard and there were times when I thought that I might have to rethink my involvement.

"I can recall a two-year-old race in Hobart on New Year's Eve 2017 and we had Mystic Journey and Magic Whaler in the same 2YO race and we thought Magic Whaler was our best winning chance.

"I recall saying to the rider of Mystic Journey, Anthony Darmanin, that we were desperately in need of a winner and I wasn't telling a fib.

"Mystic Journey won and Magic Whaler ran a creditable third but I felt something that day that was a bit different to any other win to which I'd been associated."

"It was when Mystic Journey was coming back to the mounting yard and something came

over me that I'd never experienced before. It passed but I remembered the feeling."

That was, pardon the pun, the start of Roser's mystical journey that has taken him to the top of the tree as an owner and on the verge of anxiously awaiting the outcome of the 2019 Cox Plate in which his beloved "Betty" is favourite.

Roser's first good horse was Valiant Warrior, another Tasmanian yearling sale buy that was more than just a good money spinner for the likeable owner.

Valiant Warrior was named in honour of Roser's first grandchild who tragically didn't survive to see his first birthday.

His grandchild fought to stay alive and so it was fitting that Valiant Warrior lived up to his name and went on to win 10 races from 36 starts for almost \$250,000 in prizemoney.

Valiant Warrior also gave Roser his first Victorian metropolitan winner after the gelding won at Moonee Valley.

"Valiant Warrior was a very special horse to me for many reasons but in particular why he was so named."

During his working life Roser was a battler who left school at the age of 14 and did many things to earn a living, which was a grounding that was to serve him well in the horse racing world.

With an analytical brain and a deep desire to become the best he possibly could, Roser took himself off to night school and that led to high enough marks for him to be accepted into the Australian National University where he studied law.

He worked in a service station at night to help pay his way through university.

Roser eventually passed the bar exam and as a solicitor, opened his own practice in Martin Place, Sydney.

He went on to become one of the most successful and influential barristers in New South Wales. His ability to deal with the pressure that goes with handling high-profile cases became a handy skill.

"Being able to deal with the pressures of being a racehorse owner all comes back to my professional background.

"I call on experiences I had in a different environment and that allows me to handle stress or tension better than some others but it all comes down to self-confidence."

Roser's confidence around a sale ring, or in delivering an acceptance speech, (something to which he has become accustomed thanks to Mystic Journey's feats), didn't come to him by accident.

It comes from his experience in successfully defending high-profile criminals and heading up cases for the prosecution in some of the biggest cases that played out in courts around Australia.

Roser, as senior counsel for the Commonwealth Department of Public Prosecution, made the headlines over his prosecution of Federal Court judge Marcus Enfield.

He also defended one of the major players in the Milperra Bikie Massacre in the early 1980s.

"In my other life I suppose my time defending or prosecuting ended up at a ratio of about 50-50."



He has no secret to finding his Group 1 horse but he insists the best way to give yourself that chance is to associate with professionals and he says Trinder and his partner, former top jockey, Leah Goodrick, both wear that tag.

"As we wander through life we meet people and assess them to see whether they fit into your culture.

"You inadvertently strike up a relationship based on first impressions and that's how Adam and my relationship started." When Roser attends a yearling sale he knows that all the ground work has been done by Trinder and Goodrick.

"I'm quite calm when a horse that we have marked to buy goes under the hammer.

"I know all the ground work has been done by the ones who know what they are looking for and all I have to do is agree to buy the horse.

"We have missed some horses we were keen to buy because they have passed the price Adam had placed on them but we haven't missed many."

Adam and I have a very similar personality in that we are both very loyal to people unless they do something adverse to us and we definitely don't listen to what other people say."

"In this racing game everyone has an opinion, so it is very important that neither of us get involved with what we call outside noise."

Roser says his involvement with Trinder is both business and personal.

"I employ Adam as a trainer and I have total confidence in decisions he makes concerning my horses, so I don't interfere with that process at all, other than to say we discuss things from time to time.

"But on a more personal level the relationship between Adam and I is probably a bit deeper than being just based on business.


After having spent over a decade racing horses with Trinder as his trainer, Roser is looking forward to at least another decade of the same, although finding another Mystic Journey could prove the ultimate challenge.

"Mystic Journey is definitely one out of the box but in life you should always expect the unexpected.

"I am holding onto the hope that another Mystic Journey could be just around the corner, maybe at next year's Tasmanian yearling sale."

TEAM BRUNTON

Scott Brunton ... A successful trainer with nine Tasmanian Trainers premierships (including four in partnership with his father and five in his own right).

After 30 years of honing his craft, Scott reveals the highs and lows of being a trainer, running a business, and how his family and team are responsible for helping him achieve his goals.

"The horses will come and go but family is forever." Scott Brunton



PREMIER Tasmanian trainer Scott Brunton has earned a reputation as a bit of a larrikin and knockabout bloke who speaks his mind and often lets his emotions get the better of him.

But exposure on the national stage through the efforts of stable stars such as Hellova Street, Mandela Effect and more recently The Inevitable, Brunton is learning to curb the enthusiasm and deliver a more focused side of his character in front of the media.

"I'm a person who prefers to tell it as it is, rather than hedge around the edges, but it got to the point where I needed to evaluate what my words and actions were doing to my business," Brunton said.

"I don't apologise for who I am and never will, but it was just a case of being more mindful of who I am talking to and who is listening."

With that aside, Brunton is a master horseman who has spent over 30 years honing his craft and learning from many of the best horsemen in Australia, most of all his dad, Dave Brunton.

He shared a training partnership with David that resulted in four Tasmanian trainer's premierships and he has delivered five consecutive titles in his own right.

But in the past three years Brunton has endured hardships of which few would be aware.

Battling against diminishing self-confidence and a business that was under pressure financially, the talented trainer came close to walking away.

But through a strong support base and advice from a couple of astute businessmen, he emerged on the right side of the fence and steered his life and his business in the right direction. The appointment of Neil Walsh as the stable's racing manager was a big step forward and acquiring a professional accounting firm to run the books moulded the business's finances into shape.

Jessie Bazan is Brunton's second in charge at the stables and she keeps things rolling whenever Brunton needs to travel interstate with horses racing on the mainland.

"Nobody knows what I went through and nobody needs to know, but there was a time, about three years ago, when I thought I would just give it all away and do something else with my life.

"But thankfully I had some great people there to help me through it and many of those people are still by my side.

"I have a great bunch of people working at the stable at Seven Mile Beach and while we have had a few come and go, the ones who have been with me a long time are cherished staff.


"My life partner Tegan (Keys) is my rock and I love her to bits and she is the one who helps me steady the ship if it goes off course."

"Tegan's Dad, John Keys, moved mountains to help us acquire this training complex and for that Tegan and I will be eternally grateful.

"My children are also a driving force behind me and they too help to keep me balanced."

"The horses will come and go but family is forever."

Brunton says Hellova Street was the catalyst on which he built a reputation interstate and he has renamed his training complex Hellova Stables in honour of his warhorse that topped \$1 million in career stake earnings last season. Now he has a new bright light coming through in The Inevitable that will embark on a Sydney campaign BRUN that will hopefully culminate in RACI a start in the inaugural \$7.5 million Golden Eagle at Rosehill in Sydney on the first Saturday in November. "The Inevitable is a very good horse and hopefully he gets to show everyone how good he is in Sydney." Brunton also expects Mandela Effect to make an impact when he resumes racing in feature races in Victoria this season. 

A MUSTERING **MARE**

Owned and bred by well known Tasmanian identity RJ Foster, Lola Belle was born in 2005 and was guided through her racing career at Gary White's stables.


By Planchet, a sire standing in South Australia, her dam is Light Of My Life (by Fearless Pride). Light Of My Life graced the track on 45 occasions for nine wins and 15 places, setting her up to have a career as a broodmare.

After 15 starts Lola Belle had notched up one win, so retirement to recreation became her destiny.

Post racing she resided in a paddock for a few years but she had been etched into the mind of farrier Roderick Lefevre who loved her temperament and knew she would be a fabulous mount for his mother, Judi Lefevre.

Once she moved to Judi's property she had a few unavoidable issues taking a couple of years to resolve, after which she embarked on her camp drafting career. Steering cattle around obstacles proved to be her forte as she won top scoring Thoroughbred in 2016 (her first season) and Top Scoring OTT in 2018.

While Lola has competed in show jumping, mustering sheep or cattle, as well as camp drafting are this pairs preferred activities. They help out with serious mustering on large properties such as Clairveaux, Redside and Cleveland which also includes Victoria Valley.

As far as show jumping goes, Judi and Lola competed in the Australian Masters Games in 2017. Judi laughed about the fact they didn't do very well, but it was great fun.

Judi was blessed with a father who was a horseman in the mid 1900's. In those days there were some wild horses that roamed the country around Yolla. When breakers were needed he would muster these horses into makeshift yards and pick what was required.

In the 1930's he would ride from Wynyard to Burnie to compete in the show jumping at the Burnie show.

Judi learned her horse skills from her father which enabled to her to start pony club at aged 5 in 1965. That was the beginning of a strong association with pony club at various levels right through until 2004.

Once she finished as a junior she became a coach and eventually the state chief instructor taking Tasmania to compete successfully on the mainland. As Judi especially loves working with children, she was also the state examiner for the pony club A and B tests.

In the 70's and 80's particularly, Judi was competing in eventing at intermediate level and B grade show jumping.

Both her sons are farriers and keen riders. Geoff is now working on a property in Queensland but Roderick is in Tasmania and is well known as a farrier in the racing industry.

Judi, Roderick and Geoff have always had OTT's. Roderick's first horse at age three, was a Swallowtail son, Gemtail. This horse was truly a "gem" and taught many children to ride over many years

Their two best known OTT's in the competition world would be Shatterproof and Dapper Duke (competing as Mister Wendel). The latter paired with Roderick to gain third in the 2001 Australian show jumping championships.

Among their thoroughbred OTT's is also one lovely Standardbred they cannot bear to part with! Its pretty certain that the Lefrevre's lifelong commitment to off the track horses is not going to change any time soon.

ELWICK TRACK REDEVELOPMENT

PROGRESS UPDATE



WORKS on the upgrade of the Elwick thoroughbred track continued uninterrupted during August and September with the project on target for completion in time for racing in late January 2020.

A group of 20 full-time project personnel have ensured the project stays on time and budget with an additional 50 part-time personnel contributing to the track rebuild.

Sub-track profile works including the new stormwater connector mains and pits are installed and are fully operational.


All cross-track drainage is complete and operational with recent rain events demonstrating that the new race track stormwater re-use irrigation system is functioning as planned.

Project partner StrathAyr have ensured that the highest quality of materials available have been utilised during project construction, with wholesale harvesting and washing of the new turf underway at their Coal River Valley farm.

The installation of the new track sub-surface profiles and perimeter security fencing has continued sequentially around the track.

The new Toro thoroughbred racetrack irrigation system is in full operation and irrigating the new turf as it is laid.

Approximately 20,000 square metres of new turf has now been installed and is growing and bedding in at an excellent rate thanks to ideal weather conditions.

Special bonus races will offer owners and breeders an additional \$4,000 (\$3,000 owner/\$1,000 breeder) bonus for non-maiden horses winning specified 2YO and 3YO races (of \$50,000 or less). These will include selected 2YO and 3YO feature races and 2YO and 3YO handicap races. A maiden winning a specified race will however only be eligible for its maiden bonus (i.e. The special race bonus will not apply).

COSTS

Breeder Nomination: \$220 (incl GST) Owner Nomination: \$330 (incl GST)

A horse may be only breeder nominated or only owner nominated or both. A once-off fee is paid to Tasracing when the horse is a yearling and the horse then becomes eligible for a bonus whilst it is a 2, 3 and 4 year old, for its maiden win or for one of any special bonus races.

DOUBLE UP SALE VOUCHER OPTION

The scheme will also provide a "Double Up Sale Voucher" facility for owners (this does not apply to breeders). This will allow the winning owners of specified races, as designated by Tasracing, the option of converting their \$3,000 cash bonus into a \$6,000 sale credit. This credit must be redeemed at the subsequent Tasmanian Yearling Sale.

Owners will be given 14 days to notify whether they would like their \$3,000 cash bonus converted into a \$6,000 sale credit.

TASRACING - AMENDMENTS LOCAL RULES & POLICIES

ADDITIONAL RIDING FEE - TPOL0028

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this policy is to clearly define the eligibility requirements for an additional riding fee.

2. POLICY

Eligibility

A rider maybe eligible for an additional riding fee of \$100:

- 2.1 If the riders originally declared ride is scratched and the rider accepts an additional ride on an emergency that has gained a start after official scratching time or in the case where the nominated rider has become unavailable.
- 2.2 Interstate riders will only become eligible for an additional riding fee if there are no local riders available.

3. PROCESS

- 3.1 Riders eligible for an additional riding fee must submit their request to Tasracing (racing@tasracing.com.au) within 48 hours after the official race meeting scratching time.
- 3.2 The additional riding fee must be approved by Tasracing
- 3.3 The amount will be paid directly into the jockey's prescribed bank account within ten working days of the race meeting.

EXTENDED NOMINATIONS - TPOL0006

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this policy is to clearly define the criteria under which nominations can be extended beyond the prescribed closing time.

2. POLICY

2.1 Undivided Races

If, for any race, at the prescribed closing time of nominations, there are fewer nominations than the track safety limit for that race, then nominations can be extended for that race, (refer Thoroughbred Deleted Race Policy) or the race deleted at the discretion of Tasracing. Trainers will be advised via SMS of the extension or deletion of a race with the extended nomination closing time.

Extended nominations will rank below original nominations in the race ballot order.

2.2 Divided Races

If it is determined under the Thoroughbred Race Divide Policy that a race is to be divided into two or more divisions, nominations will be extended if there are fewer nominations than the track safety limit multiplied by the number of divisions. Trainers will be advised via SMS of the extension and the extended nomination closing time.

Extended nominations will rank below original nominations in the race ballot order.

2.3 Feature races over \$50,000

Races staked at over \$50,000 will only be extended at the discretion of Tasracing after consultation with the club concerned.

LOCAL JOCKEY TRAVEL SUBSIDY - TPOL0028

1. OBJECTIVE

1.1 The objective of this policy is to clearly define the criteria for determining whether or not a travel subsidy is payable to Tasmanian based rider due to an abandoned or postponed meeting.

2. POLICY

2.1 If part of a meeting is abandoned or postponed at any stage during a race meeting, then Tasmanian based riders will be paid a riding fee based on the relevant Riding Benefits Agreement as per the below table.

Rides	(Riding Fee)
1	1 x Riding Fee
2	2 x Riding Fee

- 2.2 Tasmanian based riders are excluded from receiving a subsidy under clause 2.1 as a result of any of the following circumstances:
 - a. Tasmanian based rider travelling to King Island race meetings;
 - b. Tasmanian based rider that has completed 3 or more rides and will be paid 3 or more riding fees, or has won a feature race worth \$25,000 or more;
 - c. An apprentice jockey that is not the holder of a current driver's license will, in this circumstance, have their subsidy paid to their master.
- 2.3 Abandoned or Postponed race meeting subsidy If a race meeting is abandoned or postponed, between the time stipulated in clause 2.3.1 and one hour prior to the official start time for the first race, a subsidy of \$60 will be paid.
 - 2.3.1 Day meetings before 7:30am on race day.

 Night meetings before 12noon on race day.
- 2.4 Subsidy amounts will be paid directly into the jockey's prescribed bank account within ten working days of the race meeting.

THE OFFICE OF RACING INTEGRITY

STEWARDS' NOTICES

STABLE RETURNS:

Trainers are reminded of their obligations pursuant to AR 103, which imposes a responsibility on trainers to lodge stable returns. In particular AR 103(4) provides that;

- (4) The trainer of a horse must:
 - (a) Disclose the location of a horse under his or her care upon request by Racing Australia (for retirement purposes only) and/or a PRA;
 - (b) Lodge a Stable Return immediately upon a horse joining the trainer's stable;
 - (c) Lodge an amendment to a Stable Return immediately if:
 - (i) Any particulars on the Stable Return have changed; or
 - (ii) A horse leaves or joins the trainer's stable, or moves to another of the trainer's premises (where the trainer's stable is comprised of more than one premises), with the amendment to disclose the precise location of the horse

Pursuant to AR 103(4) trainers have a responsibility to;

- Disclose the location of a horse once retired.
- Lodge a stable return upon a horse immediately joining their stable,
- Amending the stable return if the horse has been:
 - o retired
 - o spelled
 - o re-located for the purpose of engaging active non-stable training and;
- Update the location of the horse when trainer's stable is comprised of more than one premises.

Non-compliance with the relevant provisions of AR104 may result in the stewards invoking AR104(7), which allows for rejection or cancellation of entries for relevant horses. Stewards' will be conducting an audit of stable returns and identifying discrepancies.

TREATMENT BOOKS:

Trainers are reminded of their obligations to record any medication or treatment administered to any horse by **midnight on the day** on which the administration was given. (AR104(1)).

AR 104(2) provides that the record of administration must include:

- (1) each record of administration must include the following information:
 - (a) The name of the horse;
 - (b) The date and time of administration of the treatment or medication;
 - (c) The name of the treatment or medication administered (brand name or active constituent);
 - (d) The route of administration including by injection, stomach tube, paste, topical application or inhalation;
 - (e) the amount of medication given (if applicable);
 - (f) the duration of treatment (if applicable);
 - (g) The name and signature of the person/s administering and/or authorising the administration of the treatment or medication.

AR104 (3) and (4) specify what 'treatment' and 'medication' are defined as including for the purposes of compliance with AR104(1)).

Please refer to AR104 (3) and (4) or contact ORI Stewards for clarification on treatments or medications that need to be recorded.

UNSUITABLE / UNSAFE RACING GEAR:

Trainers are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that all shoes, racing plates, equipment or gear used on a horse have been approved by the Chairman of stewards and is listed in the national gear register. (AR206)

Further to this requirement, stewards. Pursuant to AR232(f) may penalise any person who;


(f) Use on a horse any shoes, racing plates, equipment or gear which has not been approved, or which in the opinion of the Stewards is unsuitable or unsafe;


Stewards will be monitoring and ensuring the quality and safety of gear used in the training, racing and handling of horses. Trainers are reminded to ensure that gear is of good quality and is safe to use.
