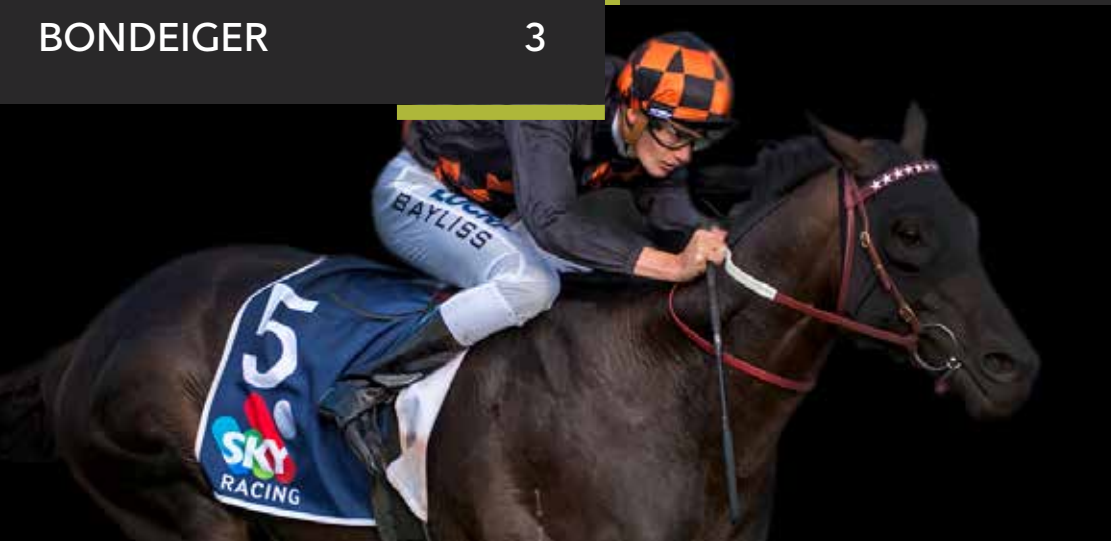

BONDEIGER

Story by Peter Staples

THE BONDEIGER STORY is one of patience from his owners, and trainer Darren Weir's ability to identify issues that prevent a horse from realising its potential.

VICTORIAN trainer Darren Weir's dominance of feature races during the Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival came to a climax in Launceston where his rejuvenated six-year-old Bondeiger scored a game win in the \$250,000 Group 3 Sky Racing Launceston Cup over 2400 metres.

Bondeiger produced a powerful finishing burst along the rails to nab local hope Fastnet Dragon in the shadows of the post to give Weir his fifth Tasmanian feature race triumph inside three weeks. In winning Bondeiger also claimed the track record [02:29:56] in the process.

The leading Victorian trainer prepared Wolfendale to win the \$100,000 Hobart Guineas before his talented colt Civil Disobedience toyed with his rivals to win the \$150,000 Tasmanian Derby. Then his smart three-year-old filly Pleasuring captured the \$100,000 Strutt Stakes in Hobart before winning the \$150,000 Tasmanian Oaks.

Andrea Mantegna finished second in the Hobart Cup but there is little doubt Weir's greatest training feat was

Bondeiger's Launceston Cup triumph.

Weir has long been a strong supporter of the Tasmanian carnival and his presence in the state's feature races has ensured strong national exposure of Tasmania's racing product.

The Bondeiger story is one of patience from his owners and Weir's ability to identify issues that are preventing a horse from realising its potential.

Bondeiger was an exciting three-year-old finishing second in a VRC Derby but the horse lost his way and it was only when Weir took over and persevered with different training techniques and training locations that he finally hit on the right formula.

Bondeiger had not won in over three years when he delivered the goods at Moonee Valley on Australia Day over 2400m and just before making the trip to Launceston he won at his subsequent start at Morphettville Park (SA) over 2500m.

Lawrence Eales, of Eales Racing Pty Ltd, who is managing owner of the syndicate that races the six-year-old entire, has lived the high life as an owner. Eales owned 2009 Melbourne Cup winner Shocking and he also had a share in Whobegotyou that won multiple Group 1 races.

He explained why winning a Group 3 race in Launceston meant so much to him and his fellow owners.

“We waited a long time for this horse to regain form and we put our trust in Darren Weir and he’s done the job,” said Eales.

“I’ve had my share of success over the years but this horse regaining form and winning today is one of my most special moments as an owner.”

While Bondeiger was a deserving winner there was a lot to like about the effort of local hope Fastnet Dragon that swept to the lead in the home straight and was being hailed the likely winner until Bondeiger staked his claim.

When Bayliss called on his mount for the supreme effort he dug deep and went on to defeat Fastnet Dragon by a half-length, with Pretty Punk doing her best work late to grab third a length away and just ahead of Bondeiger’s stablemate Andrea Mantegna who started favourite.

The Barry Campbell trained Eastender settled last in the field of 16 then crept into the race from the 800-metre mark and when Craig Newitt called on the gelding for the big effort the lightly raced four-year-old ran home resolutely.

There is no doubt that if Eastender stays sound he will be a force to be reckoned with in next season’s major cups.

South Australian trainers Leon Macdonald and Andrew Gluyas also made an impact with their classy staying mare Pretty Punk winning the Sky Racing Hobart Cup and then finished a luckless third in the Launceston Cup.

The well credentialed training partnership also saddled up Gogo Grace to easily win the Group 3 Bow Mistress in Hobart before heading to Launceston for the Vamos where the mare had no luck and missed a place.

The 2018 TSRC also unearthed some quality two-year-olds and none more so than the Adam Trinder trained Mystic Journey who won three in succession, including the \$100,000 Elwick Stakes in Hobart before ending her campaign in the \$150,000 Gold

Sovereign in which she finished a game fourth on Launceston Cup day.

Our Long Sali emerged as a potential star by winning the 2YO Tasmanian Magic Millions Classic and the Ken and Tanya Hanson-trained Tiesto also looks to have a bright future following his win in the \$150,000 Gold Sovereign.

Gee Gee Secondover was placed in both Listed features and he is expected to shine at three.

Once again reigning Tasmanian horse of the year Hellova Street delivered the goods in the two feature weight-for-age events, the Thomas Lyons over 1400m in Hobart and the Mowbray Stakes (1600m) on the last day of the carnival in Launceston. Hellova Street is only a couple of feature race wins away from cracking the \$1 million prizemoney barrier.

MILLER

MAKES HER MARK!

When Imogen Miller started out in the Tasmanian racing industry 18 years ago she had no intentions of one day becoming a trainer.

Miller, 33, was content to potter about working with her beloved equines and when the opportunity first presented itself she balked at the idea of obtaining a trainer's licence.

But she didn't balk the second time around and it led to her becoming one of the state's most promising trainers including interstate success in recent times with her stable star Tshahitsi, earning her kudos from respected pundits.

"Like most little girls I was infatuated with ponies and would spend more time thinking about horses than anything else," Miller said.

"I wanted to find a job working with horses so when I finished year 10 in Launceston I went to work for Graeme McCulloch and that's where working in the racing industry started for me."

Already a dab hand in the saddle through her experience at pony clubs and leisure riding, Miller quickly became a valuable asset at McCulloch's stables at Whitmore.

"I started out as a stablehand and then rode track work and I suppose like any young teenager who loves horses I could hardly wait to get up each morning to go to work.

"I went to Victoria to work for Cliff Brown at Narbethong way out in the sticks and that was a great experience.

"When I came back home I worked for Dave Brunton and that's where I learnt a great deal."

Miller was content to stroll through life at a comfortable pace raising two children, Millie and Angus, the result of a lengthy relationship with reigning premier Tasmanian trainer Scott Brunton.

When that relationship broke down Miller moved on and was content earning her living as a horse breaker and pre-trainer.

She struck a strong working relationship with trainer Christine Crook and after being prompted by some well-respected owners she applied for her trainer's licence and formed a training partnership with Crook.

"I was breaking horses in and some of the owners kept telling me that I should get a licence and that they would give me a horse to train and eventually I decided to give it a go."



Together they have developed a strong team at Crook's Campania training complex and in the past two years they have been a part of the juggernaut that is outstanding sprinter-miler Tshahitsi.

Every stable hopes to one day have a very good horse walk into their yard and Tshahitsi fits that bill.

After the gelding won the 2016 Newmarket Handicap Tshahitsi has gone from strength to strength winning multiple Listed races in Victoria and has helped stamp Miller's credentials as a talented trainer.

Miller's partner, multiple premiership winning jockey Brendon McCoull has been aboard Tshahitsi for all his interstate feature wins.

McCoull and Miller spend most of their days working together and that's something they both appreciate.

When they take their horses onto the sand at Seven Mile Beach they chat as they walk their steeds and they both agree it is their quality time together.

"Brendon and I enjoy each other's company. When we are walking the horses, it is a kind of bonding time for us."

McCoull says his racing life is different today than it was two years ago when his sole focus was riding.

"There is no doubt that Imogen and my relationship has changed my direction," McCoull said.

"I am a lot more focused on the overall aspect of racing than just riding and that is very different to what I was doing three years ago.

"The environment in which we work horses here at the beach makes it a nice way of being for us and the horses.

We are fortunate enough to have a few horses but enough that allows us to do exactly what we want to do with them and that's a real bonus."

McCoull has struggled with his weight for the past year which has deprived him from a higher percentage of rides, which suggests he is probably closer to hanging up his riding boots sooner, rather than later.

"What Imogen and I are doing now has given me a good insight into what I might expect should I decide to train after I stop race riding.

"But I've still got a big focus on riding and even though I'm not getting the rides I used to get I believe I am riding as well as ever so while I have that desire I'll keep doing it."

Meanwhile Miller and Crook will continue to expand their training partnership and they are both looking forward to Tshahitsi's next preparation.

When Tshahitsi failed to flatter at his first attempt at a Group 1 race in the C. F Orr Stakes at Caulfield, he followed up with a disappointing effort in a Group 3 event. But blood tests revealed all was not right with the gelding.

"His last start was so poor there had to be something wrong and the blood test showed us that, so he is heading to a decent spell and hopefully he can come back and rekindle the form he showed us earlier this season."

Miller is content to develop the training partnership with Crook.

"Christine and I get on really well and it is a very good arrangement, so I'm a big fan of the adage - if it isn't broken don't fix it."

WRAP UP

The 2018 Tasmanian Magic Millions sale returned a record gross of almost \$2.8 million – a remarkable result considering the 2014 figure was \$1 million. The average price of \$29,729 is up 24% on last year's record. The clearance rate rounded out at 74%.

"To have a sale that has produced a record gross and average is a phenomenal result for the Tasmanian breeders and vendors," Magic Millions Managing Director Barry Bowditch said.

"Credit to our vendors because over recent years their product and presentation have gone to another level."

"It was great to see so many familiar faces from the mainland participating at the sale led by the likes of Ellerton Zahra Racing and Australian Bloodstock."

"We thank Tasracing for their continued support and we look forward to the new TasBred incentive scheme taking shape and rewarding those who support local breeders," Bowditch added.

A colt by exciting Darley stallion Epaulette topped the record-breaking 2018 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale at Launceston. Offered early in the afternoon as Lot 6, the Armidale Stud consigned youngster was knocked down to Melbourne horseman Simon Zahra and will join Ellerton Zahra Racing at Flemington.

The colt is a half-brother to three winners and is from the eleven-time winning and stakes performed Savoie Vivre mare With Decorum. The colt inspired a bidding frenzy but when Zahra entered his six-figure bid it shut out the opposition.

"I was very impressed with this colt because he walked out well and was very correct but he had a presence about him that set him apart from all the others I inspected," Zahra said.

"He is by a very fashionable sire so I'm sure I won't have any trouble finding owners."

Ellerton and Zahra have been regulars at the Tasmanian sale for the past five years.

"We make a point of coming to the Tasmanian sale because it offers great value and today was no exception."

Ellerton Zahra Racing rounded out the sale as leading buyer on spend with four purchases at an outlay of \$245,000.

Three of the top four sellers on the day were on the account of the Whishaw family's Armidale Stud – the farm which sold both of this year's Magic Millions Race Night's feature winners in Launceston. "It's been a great couple of days," Armidale's Robyn Whishaw said. "We are very happy with our sale results and we enjoyed a great clearance."

The top-selling filly was the sister to Magic Millions Tasmanian 2YO Classic winner Our Long Sali, also offered by Armidale.

The Needs Further filly was purchased by Joe O'Neill's Prime Thoroughbreds for \$95,000 and will join the stables of her exciting sister with trainer Stuart Gandy.

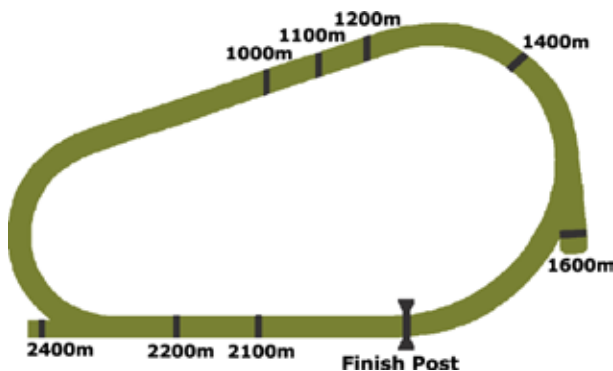

- In the event of a rail having to be moved or for any other safety reason, the Chairman of Stewards may re-assess the field limits accordingly.
- Field limits for all 2YO events programmed between the first day of the current racing season (1st August) and the last day of the calendar year (31st Dec) inclusive, will be reduced by two (2) runners. (Excluding 1000 metre starts).

NOTE: When the moveable rail is not in the true position, Tasracing may opt to run races at approximate distances. This will permit the barrier stalls to be placed at the farthest distance from turns. In such cases, field limits may be reassessed by Stewards.

Amendments to the Rules of Racing



REGISTRATION OF HORSES

Summary:

This amendment seeks to clarify the Australian Rules of Racing in respect of the time permitted to lodge a Mare Return and a Foal Ownership Declaration (FOD) after a foal is born.

Under the current Rules of Racing (i) a Mare Return is required to be lodged within 30 days of foaling; and (ii) a horse cannot be registered unless a FOD is lodged within 30 days of a Mare Return being lodged.

The amendment requires (i) a Mare Return to be lodged in accordance with the Australian Stud Book rules; and (ii) a FOD to be lodged within 60 days of foaling.

The overall effect of the proposed rule changes is that a Mare Return must be lodged within 30 days of foaling and a FOD must be lodged within 60 days of foaling, whereby a horse will not be registered under the Rules of Racing and therefore not permitted to race if both the Mare Return and FOD have not been lodged within a maximum of 120 days of foaling.

1. Amend sub-paragraphs of AR.14B as follows:
 - “(b) An Eligible Horse cannot be registered under these Rules unless:
 - (i) a Mare Return has been lodged with the Australian Stud Book in accordance with the Rules of the Australian Stud Book; and
 - (ii) a Foal Ownership Declaration has been lodged by the Manager, or his or her Authorised Agent, with the Registrar within 60 days of foaling.
 - (c) Save that in its sole and absolute discretion the Registrar may extend the time specified in subrule (b)(ii) to no greater than 120 days including but not limited to a case where a legally qualified veterinary surgeon certifies in writing that such extension is in the best interests of the health of the Eligible Horse.
 - (d) Between the time specified in subrule (b) (ii) (or any extension of same) and the time an Eligible Horse is first registered under these Rules, all transfers of ownership of such Eligible Horse must be submitted by the transferee, within four weeks of each such transfer taking place, by lodging the prescribed form and paying the prescribed fee.”

Date of Effect: 1 January, 2018
