## **OVERVIEW**

Trotting is the world gait of harness racing. The racing of trotters has a rich history both Australia and across the world. As of 1 July 2018, trotting will be reintroduced to Tasmania.

The information in this document outlines the implementation program.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

- Trial will be programmed to commence from Saturday May 5<sup>th</sup>
- > Tasracing will program at least one race per week from 1 July 2018.





## CYCLE OF RACES

The export of trotting product to international jurisdictions has been agreed, therefore the July program will consist of;

- > Wednesday 11 July Launceston Pacing Club
  - o T0 or better Discretionary, SS, 2698, PBD/T, \$8,100
  - o T0/T1, MS, 2200, PBD, \$5,500
- > Wednesday 18 July Tasmanian Pacing Club
  - o T0 or Better, SS, 2579, RBD, \$8,100
  - o T0/T1, MS, 2090, RBD, \$5,500
- Sunday 22 July Launceston Pacing Club
  - o T0 or Better, MS, 1609, PBD/T, \$5,500
- > Friday 27 July Tasmanian Pacing Club
  - o T0/T1, MS, 2090, PBD/T, \$3,500

## TASRACING COMMITMENT

The first Year program minimum number of races available will be:

- ➤ 12 races @ \$8,100
- ➤ 12 races @ \$5,500
- > 24 races @ \$3,500;
- > 3 races @ \$10,000;
- ➤ 1 race @ \$14,000

Trotting races will be conducted with 5 or more runners for the first 3 months. A yearly feature \$14k race will be scheduled to coincide with a feature meeting.

• Program is subject to change pending international agreements.
