Strong procurement process

- Works must comply with current Australian Standards and Tasmanian Workplace
 Standards and be carried out by qualified people.
- Engagement of local contractors and suppliers
- Ensuring works are completed to a suitable standard
- Contractors must have necessary qualifications and hold current and adequate insurance coverage.
- Engagement of contractors and suppliers should be at arm's length and <u>all</u> conflicts of interest should be disclosed.
