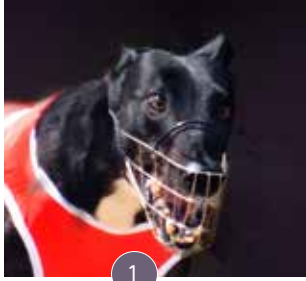
since racing resumed. Our broadcast and digital audiences, along with wagering turnover suggest our customers missed our greyhound racing as much as we did.

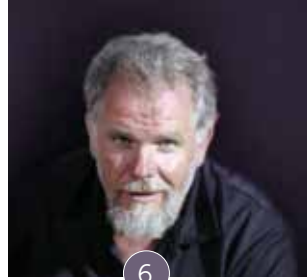

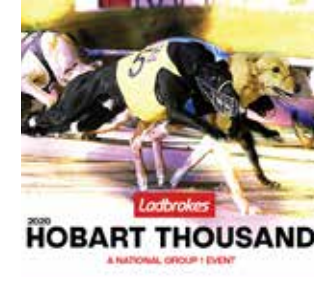

It is anticipated that 8 Heats will be conducted with the winner of each Heat qualifying for the Final.

LADBROKES TASMANIAN SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP - H.G.R.C.

An open Best 8 (with no residential restrictions) to be conducted over 461 metres.

GREG FAHEY MID DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP - H.G.R.C.

A Free-to-All race to be conducted over 599 metres.

HGRC MEMBERS YOUNG STAR CLASSIC - H.G.R.C.

A best series restricted to greyhounds whelped on or after 1/8/2018 to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 461 metres.

It is anticipated that 4 Heats will be conducted with the first two placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

TASBRED BONUS SERIES 39 – L.G.R.C

A best series restricted to Tasmanian bred Grade 5 (sprint) greyhounds at Launceston to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 515 metres.

It is anticipated that 2 Heats will be conducted with the first four placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

A payment shall be made to the breeder of the first three placegetters in the Final.

DIANNE & BOTTLEY GREEN MEMORIAL MAIDEN – H.G.R.C.

A best 8 race restricted to Maiden greyhounds over the age of 2 years to be conducted over 461 metres.

CUSTOM RESOURCES & RECRUITMENT TASMANIAN BREEDERS CLASSIC – N.W.G.R.C.

A series for Tasmanian bred greyhounds whelped on or after 1/9/2018 to be conducted in Qualifying Heats, Semi Finals and a Final over 452 metres.

16 non-penalty Qualifying Heats shall be conducted provided there are 33 or more greyhounds nominated and eligible for the Series.

The first two placegetters

in each Qualifying Heat shall qualify for the Semi Finals (4) and then the first two placegetters in each Semi Final shall qualify for the Final.

Trainers may request to be in the first race of each group of four heats for the Breeders Classic series. The request is subject to the Steward's approval and must be lodged in writing with the Office of Racing Integrity by 4pm on the day prior to the closing of nominations for the heats. The second condition of the request is that, if granted, the greyhound shall not be permitted to participate in a stir-up in either the semi-final or the final of the series.

Every effort will be made to accommodate the requests approved to be in the first race of each group of heats,

however should there be more approved requests than the number of greyhounds in the fields for the first race of each group of heats, then a greyhound may be placed in the second race of a group and then in the third race in a group until all requests are catered for. In this case a random draw shall be conducted from all the requests to determine which greyhounds are placed in the first heats and then the second heats and then the third heats (as required).

A greyhound must contest and finish in a race in the series or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the race at the time the race was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field of a further race in the series.

Should there be fewer than 33 greyhounds nominated and eligible for the Series then Qualifying Heats will not be conducted and the eligible greyhounds nominated shall be deemed qualified and selected for the Semi Finals. Sufficient Semi Finals will be conducted to cater for all greyhounds.

In the case of the Breeder being a disqualified or warned off person at the time a breeders bonus for this series is won the bonus will be forfeited. In the case of a partnership then only the percentage of the bonus which is payable to the disqualified or warned off breeder shall be forfeited.

A greyhound which has won a Final of a Breeders Classic Series is not eligible to compete in this series.

STEVE KING LADIES BRACELET - L.G.R.C.

A best series restricted to bitches to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 515 metres.

It is anticipated that 2 Heats will be conducted with the first four placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

NOEL VINCE MEMORIAL - H.G.R.C.

An open best 8 race to be conducted over 461 metres.

SIRES ON ICE TASMANIAN OAKS - L.G.R.C.

A best series restricted to bitches whelped on or after 1/1/2018, to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 515 metres.

It is anticipated that 4 Heats will be conducted with the first two placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

GREYHOUND DATA TASMANIAN DERBY - L.G.R.C.

A best series restricted to dogs whelped on or after 1/1/2018, to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 515 metres.

It is anticipated that 4 Heats will be conducted with the first two placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

16 non-penalty Qualifying Heats shall be conducted provided there are 33 or more greyhounds nominated and eligible for the Series.

The first two placegetters in each Qualifying Heat shall qualify for the Semi Finals (4) and then the first two placegetters in each Semi Final shall qualify for the Final.

Trainers may request to be in the first race of each group of four heats for the Breeders Classic series. The request is subject to the Steward's approval and must be lodged in writing with the Office of Racing Integrity by 4pm on the day prior to the closing of nominations for the heats. The second condition of the request is that, if granted, the greyhound shall not be permitted to participate in a stir-up in either the semi-final or the final of the series.

Every effort will be made to accommodate the requests approved to be in the first race of each group of heats,

however should there be more approved requests than the number of greyhounds in the fields for the first race of each group of heats, then a greyhound may be placed in the second race of a group and then in the third race in a group until all requests are catered for. In this case a random draw shall be conducted from all the requests to determine which greyhounds are placed in the first heats and then the second heats and then the third heats (as required).

A greyhound must contest and finish in a race in the series or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to

contest the race at the time the race was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field of a further race in the series.

Should there be fewer than 33 greyhounds nominated and eligible for the Series then Qualifying Heats will not be conducted and the eligible greyhounds nominated shall be deemed qualified and selected for the Semi Finals. Sufficient Semi Finals will be conducted to cater for all greyhounds.

In the case of the Breeder being a disqualified or warned off person at the time a breeders bonus for this series is won the bonus will be forfeited. In the case of a partnership then only the percentage of the bonus which is payable to the disqualified or warned off breeder shall be forfeited.

A greyhound which has won a Final of a Breeders Classic Series is not eligible to compete in this series.

It is anticipated that 4 Heats will be conducted with the first two placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

TASMANIAN DERBY - L.G.R.C.

A best series restricted to dogs whelped on or after 1/1/2019, to be conducted in Heats and a Final over 515 metres.

It is anticipated that 4 Heats will be conducted with the first two placegetters in each Heat qualifying for the Final.

GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP WINTER STAKES - L.G.R.C.

A free-to-all race over 600 metres.

R.L. FOLEY PERPETUAL STAKES - L.G.R.C.

A best 8 race restricted to Grade 5 and Grade 6 (distance) greyhounds at Launceston to be conducted over 720 metres.

TASRACING FEATURE EVENTS POLICY

FEATURE EVENT CONDITIONS

1. OBJECTIVE

- 1.1 The objective of this policy is to document the Special Conditions (minimum number of nominations/heats to be programmed) for feature events.

2. POLICY

2.1. SHORT SPRINT AND SPRINT RACES

2.1.1. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A SERIES CONDUCTED IN HEATS, SEMI FINALS AND A FINAL

- 2.1.1.1. Any series conducted in Heats, Semi Finals and Finals (excluding Breeders Classics and Maiden Thousand) shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the following:

Number of Heats	Semi Finals	Final
7 or more	4	1
5 or 6	3	1
3 or 4	2	1

- 2.1.1.2. In the event of insufficient nominations to conduct at least 3 Heats with at least 7 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats will be conducted. In this case two Semi Finals and a Final will be conducted on the dates advertised provided there are at least 7 eligible first preference heat nominations for each Semi Final. The fields for the Semi Finals shall be selected from those greyhounds with a first preference nomination for the Heats with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the Semi Finals are drawn.
- 2.1.1.3. If there are insufficient eligible first preference nominations to conduct Heats or Semi Finals then a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final. Provided there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the Heats, the field for the "Final Only" shall be selected from those greyhounds with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the Heats, then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.
- 2.1.1.4. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/Nominations table.
- 2.1.1.5. A greyhound must contest and finish in a race in a series or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the race at the time the race was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field of a further race in the series.

2.1.2. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A SERIES CONDUCTED IN HEATS AND A FINAL

- 2.1.2.1. Any series conducted in Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 7 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted.
- 2.1.2.2. If Heats are not conducted, then a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final. If there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the heats, then the field for the "Final Only" shall be selected from those greyhounds with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the heats, then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.
- 2.1.2.3. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/Nominations table.
- 2.1.2.4. A greyhound must contest and finish in a heat or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

2.1.3. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A SERIES CONDUCTED IN TWO SETS OF HEATS AND FINAL

- 2.1.3.1. Any series conducted in two sets of Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 8 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted on the first day of the series.
- 2.1.3.2. If Heats are not conducted on the first day of the Series, then the Series shall be conducted as a Heats and Final Series only under the grades and distances laid down for the second series of Heats and the Final and connections must re-nominate for the new "Heats and Final" only series. The Special Conditions for a Series conducted in Heats and a Final as defined in Clause 2.1.2 then apply to the new series.
- 2.1.3.3. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced to provide at least 8 eligible first preference nominations for each Heat.
- 2.1.3.4. A greyhound must contest both sets of heats or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", to be eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

2.1.4 SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A FEATURE EVENT CONDUCTED WITHOUT HEATS

- 2.1.4.1 Any Feature Event scheduled to be conducted without Heats shall only be conducted provided there are at least 7 eligible nominations unless Tasracing, in exceptional circumstances, grants approval for the event to be conducted with fewer eligible nominations.

2.2. MID DISTANCE AND DISTANCE RACES

2.2.1. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A SERIES CONDUCTED IN HEATS AND A FINAL

- 2.2.1.1. Any series conducted in Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 6 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted.
- 2.2.1.2. If Heats are not conducted for a Mid Distance or Distance series (not being Free-to-All heats) then an event for the same grade as the heats will be programmed provided there are at least 6 eligible nominations that have stipulated a second choice for the grade of the heats over that distance. Provided there are at least 6 eligible first preference nominations for the heats those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for the Final only and the Final shall be selected from those nominations with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 6 eligible first preference nominations for the heats, then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.
- 2.2.1.3. If Heats are not conducted for a Free-to-All Mid Distance or Free-to-All Distance series then, provided there are 6 or more eligible nominations, those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for a Free-to-All race over the distance of the Heats. If there are 6 or more eligible first preference nominations those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for the Final only and the Final shall be selected from those nominations with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 6 eligible first preference nominations for the heats, no race shall be scheduled on the day of the heats and new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.
- 2.2.1.4. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/Nominations table.
- 2.2.1.5. A greyhound must contest and finish in a heat or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

2.2.2. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR A SERIES CONDUCTED IN TWO SETS OF HEATS AND FINAL

- 2.2.2.1. Any series conducted in two sets of Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 8 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted on the first day of the series.
- 2.2.2.2. If Heats are not conducted on the first day of the Series, then the Series shall be conducted as a Heats and Final Series only under the grades and distances laid down for the second series of Heats and the Final and connections must re-nominate for the new "Heats and Final" only series. The Special Conditions for a Series conducted in Heats and a Final as defined in Clause 2.2.1 then apply to the new series.
- 2.2.2.3. In the case of Mid Distance or Long Distance Heats (not being Free-to-All Heats) not being conducted on the first day of the Series then an event for the same grade as the heats will be programmed provided there are at least 6 eligible nominations that have stipulated a second choice for the grade of the heats over that distance.
- 2.2.2.4. In the case of Free-to-All Mid Distance or Free-to-All Distance heats not being conducted on the first day of the Series then, provided there are 6 or more eligible nominations, those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for a Free-to-All race over the distance of the Heats at that meeting.
- 2.2.2.5. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced to provide at least 8 eligible first preference nominations for each Heat.
- 2.2.2.6. A greyhound must contest both sets of heats or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", to be eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

ABOUT GAP

Established by Tasracing in 2009, the Greyhound Adoption Program (GAP) Tasmania finds permanent homes for these loveable dogs when they have retired from racing.

Every greyhound that enters the GAP Tasmania is temperament assessed and undertakes an individualised enrichment program to prepare for pet life. The greyhounds spend their days socialising with different breeds of dog and completing their numerous enrichment activities such as stair training, lounge room behaviour training and learning to get in and out of a station wagon (backseat and boot). The greyhounds can also spend three weeks with GAP volunteer Foster Carers who help prepare them for pet life, while also gathering important information about each dog's personality to help GAP staff match the right dog with the right home.

While in the Program, the greyhounds participate in community activities including regular walks with the Parkside Foundation and visits to nursing homes. The dogs also attend different events throughout the year such as Agfest, The Myer Christmas Pageant, community markets, Dogs Day Out and The Great Global Greyhound Walk. Greyhound Adoption Program Tasmania also hold a Christmas Party for all adopted greyhounds and their owners and facilitate regular walks.

All greyhounds enter their new homes de-sexed, and with up to date flea and worm treatment, a current C5 vaccination, teeth polished, nails trimmed and microchip registered to their new owner.

The Greyhound Adoption Program Tasmania is operated by Tasracing as a not-for-profit program, run by a dedicated team of animal lovers.

Dexter is part of the GAP team and helps in training retired greyhounds with socialising.

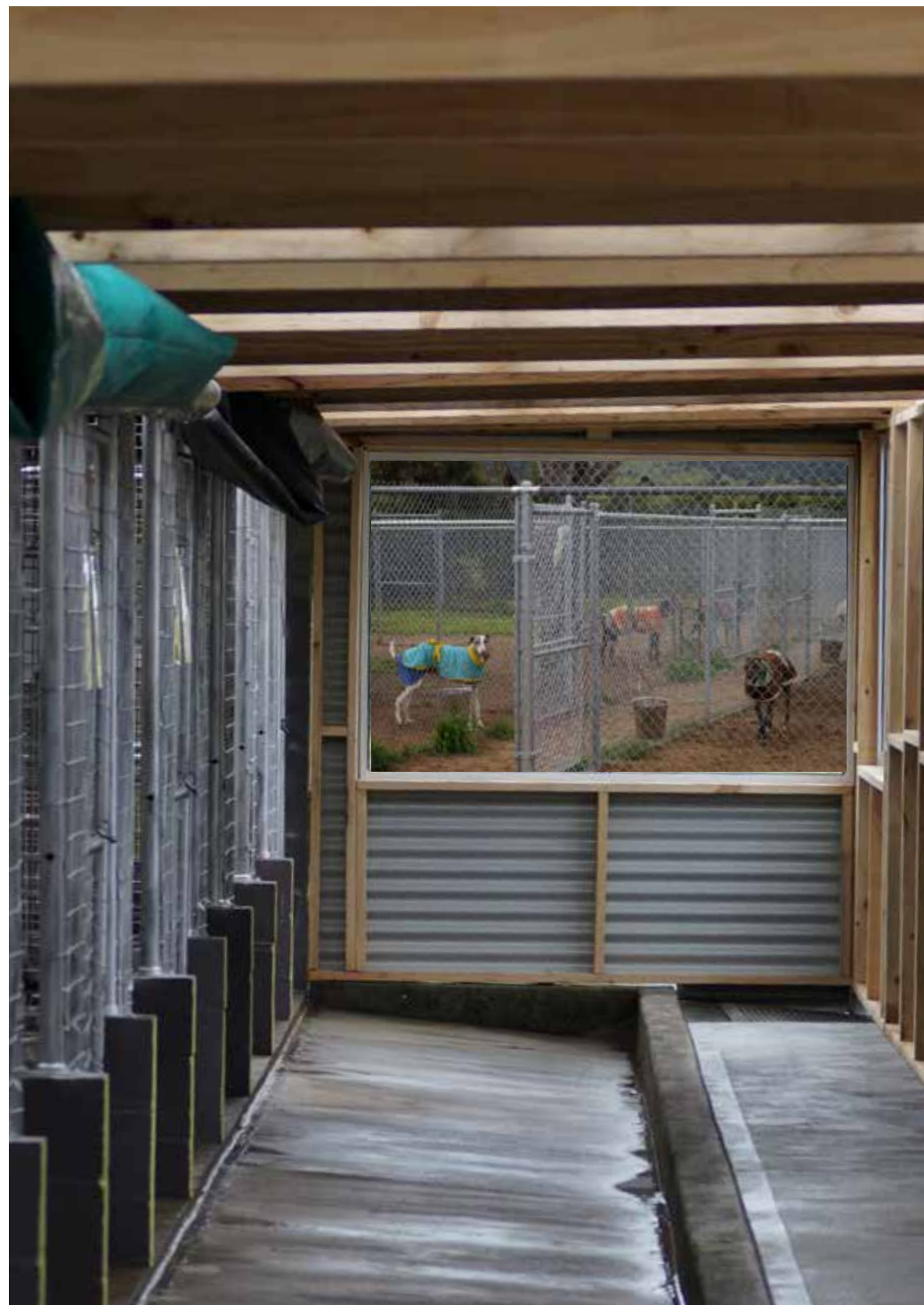




In January 2020, Tasracing purchased the State's first dedicated greyhound rehoming facility at Mangalore. Following minor renovations, GAP Tasmania commenced operating from the new property in March 2020, and the facility was officially opened by the Minister for Racing in May 2020. The COVID-19 pandemic has delayed an official opening to the public, however the commitment and dedication of the GAP team has enabled the Program to continue operating during the pandemic, through the implementation of strict hygiene protocols and social distancing measures.

In 2019/20, GAP rehomed 137 greyhounds (that figure was 89 in 2018/19) and aims to rehome 150 greyhounds a year.
