

### Brighton reinswoman Taylor Ford secures the 2020 BOTRA Claiming Novice Drivers Series.

The series was first held in 2012, with BOTRA sponsoring the series every year since its inception, and is restricted to Tasmanian licensed Claiming Novice Drivers.

Ford drove two of the four winners in the series and had an unbeatable lead going into the final heat.

Taylor secured maximum points in the Tourello Standardbreds BOTRA Series Heat One on the Micheal Laugher-trained Christian Jaz, who raced up to his excellent recent form which included a win on the Launceston track two starts before Friday's victory.

"On paper it looked like he was going to be hard to beat as he had been racing well, but those runs were from the second-row, so I was a little concerned drawing well," said driver Taylor Ford after the race.

"We ended up in a good spot without doing any work and got out at the right time," added the winning driver.

Ford then partnered up with the John Castles-trained Estelle who was another


in-form pacer who recorded her third win at her sixth race track appearance.

"She is a nice little filly, she wanted to switch off a bit when we started to race away from them, but to her credit, she dug deep late," explained Ford.

"It's always good to be in these series, and it is even better to win them, but if it weren't for the support of the trainer and owners putting the horses in these races then there wouldn't be a series," added the winning driver.

The remaining two heats were won by the race favourites, with Lachlan Dakin driving Lip Reader to victory in heat three, while Feel the Burn for driver Samantha Gangell won the fourth and final heat.

### TASSIE GOLDEN APPLE HEATS - RACE CONDITIONS

A standing start event to be conducted in two heats and a final at Launceston over 2200 metres.

The series will be a conditioned handicap with a Random Barrier Draw as follows:

NR 80-86 - Front

NR 87-93 - 10 metres

NR 94-104 - 20 Metres

NR 105 or more – 30 metres

No mare or driver concessions apply to this series.

A field limit of 12 horses applies to both the heats and the final.

In the event of more than 24 nominations for the heats, the selection of the fields will be done on the highest national Rating to the lowest National Rating. In the case of horses with equal National Ratings the horses will be selected on Field Selection Points from highest to lowest and if still equal a random ballot between those horses shall then be conducted.

The allocation of horses to each heat shall be manual allocation based on the National Rating of each horse selected to participate as follows:

The horse with the highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 1, the horse with the second highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 2, the horse with the third highest National Rating will be allocated to heat 1, the horse with the fourth highest National Rating shall be allocated to heat 2 etc.

In the case of horses with equal National Ratings the horses will be allocated on Field Selection Points from highest to lowest and if still equal a random ballot between those horses shall then be conducted.

The first six horses finishing in each heat shall be deemed qualified for the Final with the seventh placed horse in the fastest heat being named as the emergency. Horses qualifying for the Final shall start from the same handicap as the heat.

### **FEATURE RACE CONDITIONS**

### **CONDITIONS - BLOCK NOMINATIONS - 11TH OCTOBER**

The 50 to 79 national ratings nominations will be divided into between 3 - 5 races (dependent on the Sires Stakes Heats). All races will be PBD/LT\$.

The races will be formed as follows:

- · The number of heats will be determined
- All horses that do not have an unfulfilled engagement will be selected first
- · Horses with unfulfilled engagements will then be included to the maximum number required for the
- Horses will then be selected in rating order to determine each field (12+1)
- The emergency in each heat will be determined by the following:
  - · Heats with horses that have unfulfilled engagements, horse that has an unfulfilled engagement with the lowest FSP will be the emergency
  - · Heats with horses that have no unfulfilled engagements, emergency will be horse with lowest FSP

NB: Emergencies will not be included as a starter in any race.

To determine fields when a horse is on the same National Rating

For selection in the field – the horse/s with the highest field selection points will be first selected and if still equal, then the horse with the Highest Lifetime Wins and then by a random draw.

To determine the Emergency when multiple horses are on the same FSP

For selection as the emergency, if horses are on the same FSP the horse with the lowest Lifetime Wins and if still equal then by random draw.

If there are less than the required number of nominations received (including emergencies) to field the number of specified races then those horses shall be starters and nominations will be extended with the remaining starters being selected from the extended nominations received from the highest rating down. The horses selected as starters will then be divided into the specified number of races from the highest rating down. The emergency named for each race will be a horse from the extended nominations with the highest rating (as defined above for selection as a starter) within the ratings of the race formed. If there is not a horse with a rating within the ratings of the race then the horse with the next highest rating below the front of the race will be named the emergency and the front of the race will be amended, but the field already formed will not be changed (apart from the inclusion of the emergency).

### **CARRICK TRAINERS ENCOURAGEMENT SERIES**

A series to be conducted in two heats and a Final at the Carrick Park Pacing Club.

The series is restricted to horses which have been in the stable prior to 1 September 2020 of a trainer who trained ten or less winners in the 2019/20 season and which has lifetime earnings of \$25,000 or less.

The series shall be a mobile barrier start over 2150 metres with a Preferential Draw for both the heats and the final on National Ratings at the time the fields for the heats are determined.

The selection of the fields shall be done in accordance with the Race Field Selection of the Harness Handicapping Policy.

Mare or Driver concessions may be claimed in the heats and if claimed must be used in the Final. A concession cannot be claimed in the final unless it was claimed in the heats.

Two heats will be conducted with the first five horses finishing in each heat qualifying for the final with the sixth placed horse in the fastest heat being named as emergency.

### Claimers in Open Class Races

In order to provide claimers with a continuity of opportunities to race, they will be permitted to race where "Also Eligible" conditions stipulate.

Claimer eligibility will be determined by aligning the claiming price with the following ratings points:

Concessions will operate as per the Mares Concession and Novice Driver Concessions as approved from time to time.

Claimers nominating for races under the "Also Eligible" clause shall be deemed eligible for the race if they meet the also eliqible criteria and shall not be deemed to be nominating in advance of their rating. Claimers with a transition rating less than the front of the race shall be deemed to be a rating of the front of the race.

If ballots are necessary, those horses eligible for the race by way of their claiming price shall be first eliminated.

In races where the draw is (or is in part) a PBD/NR, horses eligible by way of their claiming price shall be drawn at the end of each rating. For example, horses with a claiming price up to \$5000 will be eligible for a 65 to 70 rating race if the conditions permit and horses with a claiming price up to \$4000 will be drawn after the 65 rating horses, but before the 66 rating horses and the horses with a claiming price of \$5000 will be drawn after the 70 rating horses.

### Waiver

Race meeting details in this publication are published on behalf of Tasracing and the Office of Racing Integrity and reserve the right from time to time to alter the date of running, to make any alteration or modification to these races, to alter the sequence of races, to cancel the meeting or any portion thereof, and to alter the time for taking entries, declaration of handicaps or acceptances, and also the right to reject, at any time, any entry submitted to or for them.

All races programmed will be run according to the Tasmanian Rules of Racing and under the Australian Handicapping Rules and the Handicapping Policies adopted by the Office of Racing Integrity unless specified in the conditions of the race.

### **AUSTRALIAN HANDICAPPING RULES 5.3**

A 3YO with a Rating greater than 50 that is nominated for an Open Age Race may at the discretion of the State Controlling Body claim a concession of up to 5 Ratings Points excepting that:

(a) the mininum Rating of the subject 3YO cannot be less than NR50. Example: A 3YO with a Rating of 53 would thus have a Rating of 50 for an Open Age Race.

3YO concession can be used in conjunction with a driver or mares concession.



### **HOW TO NOMINATE FOR TRIALS**

- Telephone nominations will only be accepted if the horse is stood down from the weekends meeting immediately prior to the trial date.
- · It is preferable a driver be named on the nomination but it is not essential.
- A horses's Assessment Certificate (not a copy) must be presented to stewards to qualify or undergo any required inspection.

### **RACE DAY TRIAL CONDITIONS**

Harness Race Day trials will be held under the following conditions:

- · A maximum of 3 Qualifying Trials
- First trial to commence 1 hour prior to Race 1
- · Nominations will close Thursdays, 12 noon. No extensions will be applicable.
- A maximum of 6 starters per trial.
- Trials will be scheduled 15 minutes apart
- · Any horse may nominate for these trials however the following order of choice will be applied:
  - Qualifying horses
  - Ohorses ODM, ODS or horses that are required to trial to get back in the draw
  - ♦ Horses that have not competed in a race for the longest period of time
  - ♦ Horses that have recently raced
- Number of trials and runners will be dependent on number of races / starters at the meeting.
- · Notification of any changes to the above will be sent via text prior to trial nominations closing.
- · A minimum of 3 acceptors are required for a trial to proceed.
- One Education trial will be programmed to commence 20 minutes prior to the 1st trial.
- The Education trial is only available for unqualified horses requiring barrier education.
- The trial fee will be \$15. Tasracing will invoice trainers directly.
- Scratching's received on trial / race day will be charged the full trial fee.

### NON RACE DAY TRIAL CONDITIONS

**Harness Qualifying trials** will continue under the current format, to be reviewed on an ongoing basis:

- · Nominations will close 12 noon Friday for Saturday / Monday trials. No extensions applicable
- Trials will be scheduled 15 minutes apart
- Any horse may nominate for these trials.
- · Notification of any changes to trials will be sent via text.
- A minimum of 6 acceptors are required for a trial to proceed.
- Qualifying trials will only be held over the following distances:
  - ♦ Hobart 1609m
  - ♦ Carrick 1609m
  - ♦ Launceston 1680m
  - ♦ Devonport 1930m
- The trial fee will be \$20. Tasracing will invoice trainers directly.
- Scratching's received on trial day will be charged the full trial fee.
- Education trials will be held at the discretion of the club. Please contact the club directly to confirm. Education trials will incur a fee of \$10 per horse.

### **\$5K HARNESS YEARLING SALE BONUS - CONDITIONS**

Horses sold at the 2019 Harness Yearling Sale will be eligible to compete for a \$5k bonus on advertised 2YO races.

Any yearling passed in at the 2019 Harness Yearling Sale will be eligible for the bonus if a nomination fee of 10% of the reserve has been paid to Tasracing by COB on Friday 10th January 2020.

The \$5k bonus on the specified races will be paid to the winner if it was sold at the 2019 Harness Yearling Sale.

The bonus is payable to the winner only and a horse is only eligible to win one bonus.

If no horse eligible for the bonus competes in a specified race Tasracing may transfer that bonus to another advertised 2YO race.

### HARNESS INSURANCE PROGRAM - TASMANIA [NEW]

Tasracing works with Harness Racing Australia (HRA) and other State Controlling Bodies to put in place an annual insurance program that covers all affiliated clubs and licenced persons. The insurance cover applies when licence holders and other insured persons/ entities are involved in activities that are sanctioned by HRA and Tasracing. These activities include official events, training, competition, committee meetings, fundraising activities, plus travel to and from these activities.

There are two overarching policies which cover Personal Accident Insurance and Public & Products Liability Insurance. Full details are available on the tasracingcorporate.com.au website.

The original draft of the Harness Race Programming Guidelines was put out for industry feedback in July 2020. Submissions were received, considered and amendments made. Changes to the Harness Racing Season were also taken into account when redrafted.

These were tabled at the Industry meeting held 17th September and approved.

These guidelines will be effective from 1st January 2021.

### **METHOD**

The method for achieving the revenue aim is:

- a. At least eight races will be programmed for the major meeting and seven races for the minor meeting when two race meetings are scheduled during a week.
- b. At least nine races will be programmed at a major race meeting featuring an open age feature race worth \$25,000 or more.
- c. At least nine races will be programmed when only one race meeting is scheduled for a week.
- Based on historic data on wagering and field sizes for two year olds (2YO's) and trotters, major race meetings will not feature both a 2YO race and a trot race. Furthermore, an additional race (refer above to a), b) and c)) may be programmed when a 2YO race or a trot race are scheduled at a major meeting.

The method for achieving attractive racing options for all classes and abilities of horses is:

### 2YO's.

No 2YO races will be programmed in January and February.

At least three races each month will be programmed from March to June.

At least four races each month will be programmed from July to December.

A minimum of one maiden race each month will be programmed from April to December.

No SS races will be programmed.

### 3YO's.

At least two maiden races will be programmed each month. These races may include 4YO and older maidens.

At least two 3YO age restricted races will be programmed every month.

No SS races will be programmed at Hobart, Launceston, Devonport and Carrick.

SS races may be programmed at St Marys, Scottsdale and Burnie.

### Maiden Races

A maiden race is a race for horses that have not previously won a race.

Details of 2YO and 3YO maiden races are listed above.

4YO and older maidens are likely to be programmed to race with 3YO maidens (minimum of two races programmed each month).

No SS races will be programmed at Hobart, Launceston. Devonport and Carrick.

SS races may be programmed at St Marys, Scottsdale and Burnie.

### 4YO and Older Restricted Wins

A minimum of two races will be programmed each month for 4YO and older horses with no more than two lifetime wins.

A minimum of one race will be programmed each month for 4YO and older horses with no more than four lifetime wins.

### Fillies and Mares

A minimum of three races will be programmed each month for fillies and mares.

One of the three races will be for 3YO and older fillies and mares. Preference in field selection will be given to horses with the least number of LTW's and the barrier draw will be based on LTW's with 3YO's drawing first in each win category. These races will have LTW restrictions. An example is 3YO and older fillies and mares with NMT2LTW's.

### Claimers

A minimum of two races per month will be programmed for Claimers with a mix of SS and MS start types.

The front for SS Claimers will be \$5,000.

The range for MS Claimers will be \$1,000 to \$12,000.

### Open Class Races

Open class races will be scheduled around open class feature races.

Every major race meeting each week will include a minimum of one open class race.

A minimum of one SS and one MS open class race (includes feature races) will be programmed each month. At least one SS each month will be programmed as a discretionary handicap.

Excluding feature races, the barrier draw for MS races will be on NR or LTW's.

### Trainers Encouragement Races

A minimum of two races per month will be scheduled.

### Standing Starts

A minimum of two standing start races (includes feature races) will be programmed each month. The front for these races will be in the NR range of 50 - 65 (excludes feature races).

### Mobile Start Racing Options at Major Meetings

At all major meetings, every endeavour will be made to achieve MS racing opportunities for all horses in the NR range of 50 - 79.

A maximum of 15 NR points will apply when framing races for horses in the NR range of 60 - 80. For example, a range could be 60 - 74 or 65 - 79

A maximum of 10 NR points will apply framing races for horses in the NR range of 50 - 59.

### Trotting Races

Two trotting races will be programmed each month.

At least 25% will be MS races.

SS races will be programmed as discretionary handicaps or conditioned handicaps.

### Mare and Novice Driver Concessions

Mare and Novice Driver Concessions will not apply to any race with a front of NR54 or lower.

### Claiming Novice Driver Races

A minimum of one race each month will be programmed for Claiming Novice Drivers.

### · Tasbreds Selected First

One race meeting each month will include some races where Tasbreds are selected first. Usual

barrier draw types will apply such as PBD/NR, RBD. PBD/LTW etc.

Tasracing assigns the highest priority to its responsibilities in relation to the safety of all racing participants.

Tasracing is committed to maintaining the highest possible standards in relation to the safety of the racing venues and equipment provided to racing participants.

All racing participants are kindly asked to always remember their personal responsibilities in relation to their own safety, those in their care, and to the general public who attend racing events. Racing participants must take reasonable care for their own health and safety, take reasonable care that their acts or omissions do not adversely affect the health and safety of other persons, and comply with any reasonable instruction of Tasracing as the Person Conducting the Business or Undertaking (PCBU).

### Safety notice to racing participants and the public

All persons should be aware that entry to Tasracing venues is at the individual's own risk and is governed by Tasracing's Conditions of Entry, as well as the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Track Rules (at applicable venues). Tasracing accepts no responsibility for injury or loss to any person entering Tasracing venues. Any unlicensed person entering a Restricted Area such as the Day Stalls or Barriers, do so at their own risk. There are signs at all Tasmanian racing venues clearly identifying these Restricted Areas.

### Strictly no access for children within restricted areas

Tasracing advises all racing participants and members of the public that under no circumstances are children allowed access to Restricted Areas at Tasracing venues. Clear signage at all racing venues identifies the location of Restricted Areas, and states that no children are permitted access. Under the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (Tas), Tasracing as the PCBU has a duty to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that the health and safety of persons is not put at risk from work carried out as part of the conduct of the business or undertaking at its venues. Restricting access for children within Restricted Areas assists with protecting their safety, and the safety of those using these areas. Clause 14 of Tasracing's Conditions of Entry also clearly states that no children are allowed in the mounting yards, horse stalls, stables and kennels at Tasracing venues under any circumstances.

## RACING YEAR PERMANENTLY CHANGED TO 1 JANUARY

Ironically, on the day Australian Standardbreds would ordinarily be turning a year older, Harness Racing Australia (HRA) today advise that the Racing Year (season), will be permanently changed to a calendar year from 1 January 2021.

Following consultation subsequent to HRA's decision to extend the current season to 31 December 2020 due to COVID-19, today's announcement was a recommendation emanating from the HRA Executive meeting of 28 August 2020 and subsequently approved by a two-thirds majority of HRA Members.

Changing the season permanently to a calendar year is intended to bring about a number of important commercial, marketing and welfare benefits across the industry.

Most noticeably from the outset will be some major changes to the Feature Race Calendar, with the traditionally condensed season-end juvenile features able to be staggered throughout the year, with the space for States and Clubs to build momentum for promotion, wagering, visiting horses and interest in the sport.

As all horses will now turn a year older on 1 January each year, the additional 4-months provided for due to the racing year change can also benefit the education, training and confidence of young horses preparing for their racing careers.

With the current two-year old January to August racing season being extended under the changes, pressure on young horses to maintain performance for end of season features can be alleviated. Programs can

now provide feature races throughout the year and more developed two-year old's in feature racing.

While this provides more opportunities for more horses to compete in feature juvenile races, this can also establish an important foundation for a stronger racing base to sustain a program of racing more often and for longer for the future.

From a commercial perspective, moving the traditional end of season juvenile features to spring and summer provides harness racing a great opportunity to showcase itself in the warmer weather, where it is expected that an increase in promotion and marketability will result in larger crowds and ultimately larger turnover nationally on harness racing.

HRA, along with the State Controlling Bodies will continue to collaborate on the calendar and feature races, updating the Feature Race Calendar on the harness.org. au website regularly.

Importantly, this change only affects the racing year – as the breeding season will remain as it is, starting on 1 September each year. As that is today, all at HRA extend their best wishes to all breeders, studs, veterinarians and AI technicians for a successful breeding season ahead.

**"Breeding Season"** means the period commencing 1 September in a calendar year and ending 31 August in the following calendar year.

### 18. STUDS, SIRES and STUD BOOK

Sire summary sheet and related matters

- Amend Rule 275(6), (7)
- Renumber existing Rule 275(6), (7) to 275(8), (9)
- 275.(6)(a) Subject to paragraph (b), in a breeding season the total number of mares bred in accordance with Parts 18 and 19 of these Rules to a sire registered in Australia including free returns from a previous breeding season shall not exceed 150.
  - (b) In the breeding season commencing 1 September 2020 and ending 31 August 2021 the total number of mares bred to a stallion registered in Australia may exceed 150 to a maximum of 170 provided that:
  - (i) each additional foal is the progeny of a free return to that sire; and,
  - (ii) the free return must be to the same mare and that sire; and,
  - (iii) the studmaster has made written application to HRA to use the free return and the application has been approved.
  - (7) A horse that is foaled in contravention of sub-rule (6) shall not be eligible for registration.
  - (8) The Controlling Body may from time to time change the information required to be recorded under this rule, the way in which it is recorded and the manner, form and time in which information is to be supplied, materials or documents lodged or issued, or application made to the Controlling Body or other person.
  - (9) A person who fails to comply with any provision of this rule is guilty of an offence.

### 19. ARTIFICIAL BREEDING

### **Transported Semen**

- Add new Rule 285A(1)(a), (b)
- Add new Rule 285A(2)
- 285A.(1)(a) Semen from an Australian registered sire which has died or disappeared or been gelded shall, subject to sub-paragraph (b) only be used in the breeding season in which the sire has died or disappeared or been gelded or the next breeding season.
  - (b) If a broodmare has been inseminated by the sire which has died or disappeared or been gelded and that insemination did not produce a live foal then the progeny of a subsequent insemination of the same broodmare by the same sire shall be eligible for registration in the second breeding season following the death or disappearance or gelding of the sire.
- (2) The provisions of sub-rule (1) do not apply to a registered standardbred which has prior to 1 September, 2020 died, disappeared or been gelded.

### WHIP RULE UPDATE - AHRR 156A

HRA previously issued a notice on 19 June 2020 regarding Australian Harness Racing Rules (AHRR) 156A, which deals with the type of whip that could be used from 1 September 2020.

Following a meeting of the HRA Executive earlier today, an updated notice is now given that the proposed amendments of AHRR 156A will be parked until such time as HRA has had an opportunity to complete a study which is testing whips in order to set an industry Standard for approval, which will include length, width, materials, colours and the use of poppers or keepers on whip tips, and therefore providing the best welfare outcomes for Standardbreds.

Until such work is completed, the existing AHRR 156A will remain in place:

The approved whip is a flexible whip of black or dark tan colour with a core of fibreglass with a handle base and shaft and either a leather keeper to a maximum of 60 millimetres in length and 20 millimetres in width or a non rigid tip amounting to a maximum overall length of 1600 millimetres.

The review period regarding effectiveness and compliance of AHRR 156 following introduction on 1 September 2020 remains unchanged.

### 9. DRIVERS

Whips

### • Amend Rule 156(2)(a),(b)

- (2) (a) A driver shall only apply the whip in a wrist only flicking motion whilst holding a rein in each hand with the tip of the whip pointed forward in an action which does not engage the shoulder.
  - (b) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (a), "wrist only flicking motion" means:-
    - (i) Ensuring no force is generated by the use of the elbow or shoulder when applying the whip.(ii) The forearm is not raised beyond forty-five degrees relative to the racing surface.
    - (iii) Not applying the whip with overt force.

### • Add new Rule 156(4)(d)

- (4) For the purposes of sub-rule (3) a driver shall be deemed to have used the whip in an unapproved manner in the following circumstances which are not exclusive:-
- (d) If the whip is used in a prodding or jabbing fashion.

### Amend Rule 156A

156A. The approved whip is a flexible whip of black or dark tan colour with a core of fibreglass with a handle base and shaft and a leather keeper to a maximum of 60 millimetres in length and 20 millimetres in width amounting to a maximum overall length of 1600 millimetres.
