

AUSTRALIAN HARNESS RACING RULES Rules Amendments HRA approved 13 May 2020

Adopted by Tasracing 17th June 2020, Effective 13th May 2020

DICTIONARY

Amend definition – Racing Year

"**Racing year**" means the period commencing 1st January in a calendar year and concluding on 31st December in the same year.

3. MEETINGS & RACES

Conditions and Restrictions

• Repeal Rules 35A(1), (2)

(1) A horse shall not compete in a race before 1st October in the racing year in which it attains the age of 2 years. (REPEALED)

(2) A horse shall not before 1st May in the racing year in which it attains the age of 2 years compete in a race in excess of 2200 metres. (REPEALED)

5. HORSES

Age

• Amend Rule 92(1), (2)

92. (1) Save and except for sub-rule (2), provided that the service date of the foal is on or after 1st September the age of a horse shall be reckoned as beginning on 1st January in the next but one racing year.

(2) If a horse is foaled in New Zealand between 1st August and 31st August inclusive its age shall be reckoned as beginning on 1st January in the next but one racing year.
