





# THE GREAT DEBATE!

Judges face quandary over top 3YO crown.

Deciding which of these two amazing equine athletes will be crowned Tasmania's best in their age group is a task set for the small group of industry experts who will no doubt spend more time on this award than any other.

#### THE GREAT DEBATE by Peter Staples

THE 2019-20 season is coming to a close and what a tumultuous season it has been.

There is no doubt that the COVID-19 shutdown for almost three months in April-June wreaked havoc on racing life in Tasmania. But as the industry has always done, it will emerge from the setback and move forward.

While the suspension of racing was a hard pill to swallow, we can still rejoice in the fact that Tasmania produced some star performers this season and two of those are the subject of a pending decision that will no doubt be debated for years to come.

Fillies have dominated the annual awards in recent seasons with Mystic Journey the clear standout in her two and three-year-old seasons and her younger three-quarter sister Mystical Pursuit owned last season's Two-year-old of the Year title.

But the season that is about to end produced some amazing feats from two stand-out three-year-old fillies in Deroche and Still a Star.

Which of these two amazing equine athletes will be crowned Tasmania's best in their age group is a task set for the small group of industry experts who will no doubt spend more time on this award than any other.

In the red corner we have the Bill Ryantrained Still a Star (Toronado-Lita) that delivered incredible performances over distances ranging from 1100m to 2100m and included in her six wins were four Listed events carrying prizemoney ranging from \$100,000 (x3) to \$150,000 (Oaks).

And in the blue corner we have exciting sprinter Deroche (Needs Further-Buzzing Along) from the Leanne Gaffney stable.

Deroche won five of her seven starts

(1150m-1400m) that included the \$65,000 Magic Millions 3YO & 4YO Classic and she ended her preparation with a brilliant win in the \$150,000 Group 3 Vamos Stakes for fillies and mares at Mowbray.

Analysing the performances also becomes complicated when Deroche raced only in sprint races while Still a Star tackled both sprint and staying events.

As two-year-olds the pair met twice and each time Deroche emerged triumphant over sprint distances.

But this season they clashed only once and Still A Star was the victor in the \$75,000 3YO Cup over 1200m in which Deroche started the odds-on favourite but finished fifth.

In Deroche's defence she was first-up and had come off a hard hit-out in a trial at Devonport that she won by 15 lengths only eight days before her first-up assignment in the 3YO Cup.

There is no doubt that trial most likely took the edge off the filly while Still a Star was second-up in the 3YO Cup, showing the benefit of winning an 1100-metre event three weeks beforehand.

But nevertheless the record books will only show Still a Star had the better of the Leanne Gaffney-trained filly the only time they met.

Still a Star went on to the \$50,000 3YO Trophy over 1400m at Mowbray and as the odds-on favourite she had her colours lowered for the only time during her lengthy campaign when Mystical Pursuit ran home powerfully to score by a half-length.

Deroche bounced back with a win in a benchmark 74 on the synthetic at Spreyton and that paved the way for an effortless win in the \$30,000 3YO Vase over 1120 metres at Mowbray.

The flashy chestnut filly progressed to the \$150,000 Group 3 Bow Mistress over 1200m at Elwick but tragically she finished a luckless second to Victorian mare Zargos, who beat her by half a length.

There will be very few who wouldn't agree she should have won the race but once again the record books will tell us she finished second.

Connections were then faced with the tough decision of whether to aim her at the remaining Group 3 event for fillies and mares, the Vamos Stakes (1400m), or head to the 3YO & 4YO Tasmanian Magic Millions Classic with the races only three days apart.

Deroche came out and won the Magic Millions Classic and when she backed up in the Group 3 Vamos on Launceston Cup Day three days later and won impressively with her regular rider Craig Newitt aboard, the filly clearly staked her claim as arguably the best Tasmanian sprinting filly since the great Cafeteria.

Deroche ended her season with five wins from seven starts for \$204,938 in stakes.

Still a Star went on from her 3YO Trophy win to take out the Listed \$100,000 3YO Tasmanian Guineas (1600m) that comprised both sexes in her age group.

Ryan then needed to test his filly over more ground to ascertain whether she was a genuine Oaks prospect and what she did at her first attempt over 2100m in the Listed Launceston Guineas over 2100m erased any doubts.

The daughter of Toronado cruised to the leaders at the top of the home straight and powered her way to an emphatic five-length win.

Ryan was confident he could aim her at both the Tasmanian Derby and Strutt Stakes on the way to the Oaks but on the eve of the Derby the filly was scratched owing to a blood disorder that also forced her to miss a few days work. The filly progressed to the Strutt Stakes, the traditional lead-up race to the Oaks, and again showed her courage and grit to stave off a gallant Mystical Pursuit that ran her to a short half-head.

Punters sent Still a Star around the \$1.50 favourite in the \$150,000 Tasmanian Oaks that comprised a field of only seven but the other six runners were from interstate.

Still a Star jumped well but was caught four-wide to the first turn so jockey Brendon McCoull eased his filly out of the battle for the lead.

In a muddling run race Still a Star forged to the lead at the top of the straight and had enough in reserve to stave off all challenges.

Still a Star ended her three-year-old campaign with six wins and a second from seven starts for \$336,500.

Based on prizemoney alone, Still a Star would emerge with the crown, but what judges will need to weigh up is whether or not Deroche's one Group win can overshadow Still a Star's four Listed victories.

Both fillies also have a claim on the Tasmanian Horse of the Year title but they might be hard-pressed to topple the Michael Trinder-trained Toorak Affair.

The mare won six of her nine starts including the Brighton Cup and weight-forage Summer Cup on the way to winning the \$250,000 Group 3 Ladbrokes Hobart Cup.

#### 1. PURPOSE

The Tasmanian government has a plan to 'Rebuild a Stronger Tasmania'. As part of this plan, all workplaces are required to have a COVID-19 safety plan that complies with the minimum COVID-19 safety standards. The purpose of this Procedure is to outline the protocols that demonstrate our compliance with the *Minimum Standards* (Work Health and Safety Amendment Regulations 2020).

The Procedure demonstrates our ability to protect Tasracing's workers and racing industry participants as we operate with new hygiene and safety protocols during the COVID-19 pandemic for the purpose of thoroughbred racing operations at the venue.

Tasracing is committed to providing a healthy and safe working environment and has identified alternative ways to deliver its racing operational practices to limit the spread of COVID-19. It is imperative that we comply with the safety standards outlined in this Procedure to safeguard racing in Tasmania.

#### For the purpose of this Procedure:

#### "we / our"

means Tasracing Workers, the racing industry participants, the Stewards and Racing Officials.

#### "workplace"

means a place of work for Tasracing Workers and the racing venues, Launceston Ladbrokes Racing Centre (Mowbray), Hobart Ladbrokes Park (Elwick) and Ladbrokes All Weather Spreyton (Spreyton), where the race meetings are held for the racing industry participants.

#### "venue"

means Launceston Ladbrokes Racing Centre (Mowbray), Hobart Ladbrokes Park (Elwick) or Ladbrokes All Weather Spreyton (Spreyton) as applicable to the location of the race meetings.

The Australian Federal, State and Territory Governments have put restrictions in place to slow the spread of COVID-19. The National Cabinet have a 3-step plan to create a COVIDsafe society with new ways of living and working. This Procedure will be regularly reviewed and updated as these restrictions are varied and to reflect the recommendations by the Governments and Worksafe Tasmania.

#### 2. SCOPE

This Procedure applies to:

#### Tasracing:

Tasracing employees (including full-time, part-time, casual and fixed term employees), volunteers, contractors (security, Track Marshalls and suppliers to Tasracing) (collectively referred to as Tasracing Workers)

#### **Racing Industry Participants**

All industry participants and other persons that attend thoroughbred race meetings at the venue.

#### Stewards

Stewards of the Office of Racing Integrity (ORI)

## **Racing Officials**

Includes judges, vets, track workers, attendants, Club Committee members, club employees and volunteers and any other position deemed to be a Race Official by Tasracing or ORI.

#### 3. CORONAVIRUS

#### 3.1 COVID-19

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses that cause respiratory infections. These can range from the common cold to more serious diseases. Coronavirus is a disease caused by a new form of coronavirus. It was first reported in December 2019 in Wuhan City in China and the disease outbreak is named COVID-19.

#### 3.2 Symptoms

Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, coughing, sore throat and shortness of breath. If you have any of these symptoms **do not attend** your workplace or a race meeting.

#### 3.3 Protect others and stop the spread

It is a requirement that all Tasracing Workers, Racing Industry Participants, Stewards and Racing Officials practice good hygiene, social distancing and understand when to self-isolate if you need to. These practices will slow down the spread of the virus.

#### Good hygiene means:

- wash your hands often with soap and water. This includes before and after eating and after going to the toilet;
- use alcohol-based hand sanitisers when you can't use soap and water;
- avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth at all times:
- maintain good hand, sneeze and cough hygiene;
- clean and disinfect surfaces you use often such as benchtops, barriers and doorknobs;

- clean and disinfect objects you use often such as mobile phones, keys, wallets and work passes: and
- increase the amount of fresh air by opening windows or utilising air conditioning.

#### Social distancing

The more space between you and others, the harder it is for the virus to spread. Social distancing in public means you keep 1.5 metres away from others wherever possible and avoid physical greetings such as handshakes.

#### Self-isolate

A person with COVID-19 or suspected to have the virus must enter mandatory isolation. You will need to isolate to prevent the spread of the virus to others at your home if it is suitable, hospital if you need hospital care or another location if needed as decided by the public health authority.

	seeking continuous Procedure improvement for enhanced compliance.
Security	Security is responsible to sight and confirm that all persons entering venues provide the necessary documents, and meet any other requirements before entry.
Tasracing Workers	Tasracing Workers must comply with this Procedure and assist the Track Marshalls and Officials in ensuring that all attendees at a race meeting comply with this Procedure.
	Tasracing Workers are responsible for identifying improvements to compliance controls and reporting them to the CEO.
Racing Officials	Racing Officials must comply with this Procedure and provide written recommendations for improvements for enhanced compliance controls to the CEO.
Racing Industry Participants	Racing Industry Participants have a responsibility to understand, observe and comply with this Procedure and related procedures, and to identify and report improvements to enhance compliance controls to the CEO.
General Public	Member of the General Public have a responsibility to understand, observe and comply with this Procedure and related procedures.

# 5. THOROUGHBRED RACE MEETING REQUIREMENT

#### 5.1 Executive Summary

Thoroughbred race meetings after the 26th June are to be conducted at the venue with no more than:

- Inside area 1 person per 2 sqm up to a maximum 250 persons
- Outdoor area 1 person per 2 sqm up to a maximum 500 persons

Tasracing's Thoroughbred race meetings will be managed strictly in-line with this Procedure and WorkSafe Tasmanian's Guidelines for COVID Safe Workplace operations.

#### 6. THOROUGHBRED RACE DAY PROTOCOLS

#### 6.1 Before Leaving Home

Do not attend a race meeting if you feel ill or have any of the symptoms outlined in section 3.2.

If you identify with any of the below conditions, you **MUST** stay home and not attend any race meeting:

- you are suffering COVID-19 symptoms or are otherwise unwell:
- you are subject to self-isolation requirements imposed by the Government / Public health authority; or
- you have been in close contact with a person suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19.

#### 6.2 People most at risk of COVID-19

People aged 70 years and over, people aged 65 years and over with chronic medical conditions, people with compromised immune systems, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people over the age of 50, are at greater risk of more serious illness if they are infected with COVID-19. Chronic medical conditions include but are not

limited to diabetes, lung disease, heart disease, cancer and kidney failure. There is currently no cure or vaccine for COVID-19, or immunity in the community, so you must exercise a high degree of caution when deciding to attend a race meeting.

Tasracing strongly recommends that people most at risk continue to stay at home, avoid contact with others and carefully consider whether attending a race meeting will compromise your health. Should you attend a race meeting, Tasracing reminds you to practice good hygiene and social distancing measures to best support your health and wellbeing.

#### 6.3 Venue Restrictions and Hygiene

In addition to the good hygiene requirements outlined in section 3.3, the following procedures will take place at venues for all thoroughbred race meetings:

- no food or drink will be available to participants or staff at the venues unless it is provided in line with the hospitality industry guidelines for the provision of food and drink;
- doors will be left permanently open where possible to allow throughway access without touching surfaces;
- disposable gloves will be provided by Tasracing to all persons attending the race meeting to wear if they wish;
- hand sanitiser will be supplied at the entry to the venue, toilets, and as marked on the corresponding site map.
- all attendees will be required to wash/ sanitise their hands thoroughly throughout the race meeting;
- all workstations will be wiped clean before use and after a race meeting in accordance with the cleaning procedure.

Please note changes may be implemented at any time. Please refer to tasracingcorporate.com.au





# 6.4 COVIDSafe App

Tasracing encourages all persons to play an important role in helping stop the spread of COVID-19 by downloading the COVIDSafe app. The app can be downloaded at the following link: https://www.health.gov.au/resources/apps-and-tools/covidsafe-app

Downloading the app is something you can do to protect yourself, your family and the racing industry. The app helps expedite contact tracing and serves to benefit the racing industry in the event the app user tests positive for COVID-19.

If you do not wish to download the app or do not have a smartphone to download the app, Tasracing recommends that you maintain a travel log to perform a similar function.

#### 6.5 Travel Log Requirements

The recommended minimum amount of travel details to be kept by anyone attending a race meeting (who do not have the COVIDSafe app) is as follows:

- · date:
- name of person(s) making the journey;
- · departure address; and
- location of all stops during the journey to the race meeting; including the name and address of any business visited (service station or takeaway food outlet etc).

#### 6.6 Social Distancing

In accordance with section 3.3, you are required to comply with the strict social distancing requirements while attending a race meeting. A minimum distance of 1.5 m between any two personnel is required. If any person fails to adhere to this social distancing requirement, Security and Track Marshalls will have authority to direct a person to leave the venue.

#### 6.7 Duties of Track Marshalls

Track Marshalls shall be present at every race meeting and will monitor all areas of the venue as required.

Track Marshalls will be responsible for ensuring all documented protocols in the Procedure are adhered to by all persons attending the race meeting.

Track Marshalls may demand identification information and will be authorised to report breaches to the Stewards. They will be observing all persons attending the race meeting to ensure compliance with this Procedure.

Track Marshalls will pay particular attention to social distancing and all personnel must follow the direction of Track Marshalls in relation to social distancing.

#### 6.8 Non-compliance

Any racing industry participant found to have breached a COVID-19 principle and/or protocol as contained within this Procedure will be reported to the Stewards for inquiry and will be subject to any penalty the Stewards deem appropriate. They will be escorted off the venue immediately.

Non-compliance of this Procedure shall be considered an offence under—AR 232(b) - "A person must not fail or refuse to comply with an order, direction or requirement if the Stewards or an official".

For Tasracing Workers, incidents of non-compliance with this Procedure are considered to be serious and may result in disciplinary outcomes or termination of the contract (for contractors engagements).

# 6.9 Venue Signage and Social Distance Markings

Tasracing will display clear instructions and reminders of these protocols at the venue. Floor and ground markings will be installed (where possible) to assist all personnel to adhere to social distancing protocols.

Track Marshalls will monitor adherence to floor or ground markings.

#### 6.10 Thoroughbred Nominations

Trainers are required to nominate horses via Racing Australia by times stipulated on programs advertised on tasracingcorporate. com.au and Racing Australia.

# 6.11 Arrival / Departure Time at Race Venue

The Equine carpark area is only to be used by those vehicles used to transport horses to and from the venue. All vehicles not transporting horses to the race meeting are required to park in the participants car park as per the specific Location Maps listed at the end of this document.

## 6.12 Ready to Race

One stall may be allocated between each stable group when possible to safeguard social distancing.

Trainers are to present their horses to the mounting yard as directed by Stewards. Each horse is to be led by only one person unless otherwise approved via Stewards.

All persons who assisted the rider in mounting the horse must sanitise their hands immediately after the horse has safely entered the track.

#### 6.13 After Racing


Trainers and stablehands must return the used saddlecloth to the raceday office. Saddlecloths will be sanitised after each use by Racing Officials.

#### **REVISED TONGUE TIE POLICY**

Please be advised that following a recommendation from the Veterinary and Analytical Committee (VAC) and endorsement by the Chairmen of Stewards Committee (COSC), Racing Australia has amended the Tongue Ties Policy. The new policy can be found in the National Equipment Register.

The policy has been in effect since 1 April 2020.

#### **Tongue Ties & Tongue Clips**

**Approval for use:** Tongue Ties and Tongue Clips are approved for use for the purposes of AR 206(1), subject to the conditions set out below.

**Specifications:** Tongue Ties must be either: (a) leather strap or rubber band (at least 15mm wide); or (b) lycra or neoprene (at least 50mm wide).

**Application:** Tongue Ties and Tongue Clips must not be applied more than 30 minutes prior to race time.

**Proper application:** All Tongue Ties are to be looped around the tongue and secured around the lower jaw. Tongue Ties must be clearly visible at all times. Tongue Ties must never be attached to the bit or bridle.


**Tongue position:** Tongues which are tied must remain inside the horse's mouth in its usual position.

**Tongue Clips:** Tongue Clips must be rubber and attached to the bit. Tongue Clips with strap are also permitted.

**Removal:** Tongue Ties and Tongue Clips must be removed as soon as practicable.
