





Can Newhart make it back to back wins in the 2021 Ladbrokes Devonport Cup?

Last season's Devonport Cup winner Newhart has spent autumn and winter preparing for what could prove to be the defining carnival of the gelding's career.

Newhart could not have been more impressive in winning the Devonport club's showcase event over 1880 metres last season. And according to trainer Leanne Gaffney, this season could be even better.

The plan is for Newhart to kick off in the Newmarket Handicap, the state's premier sprint race, and then progress to another Devonport Cup via the Golden Mile and the Sheffield Cup.

If everything goes to plan the gelded son of Fighting Sun will progress to the Group 3 Hobart and Launceston cups.

"I couldn't be happier with how Newhart has progressed given he's been unable to race since January because of the COVID pandemic restrictions," Gaffney said.

"We had him back in work and almost ready to trial when the pandemic struck, and we were shut down for almost three months. "But the horse couldn't be in better order as he heads towards one or two trials leading up to the Newmarket, which is his first-up assignment.

"The plan is then to tackle the Golden Mile and the Sheffield Cup as his main lead-ups to the Devonport Cup.

"Plans to run him in the Hobart and or Launceston cups won't be locked in until after the Devonport Cup."

Newhart is only lightly raced, having had nine starts for four wins and three seconds for \$109,500 in stakes.

Gaffney is also looking forward to her star three-year-old filly from last season, Deroche, resuming racing in November.

"Deroche will most likely have her first start this season in the Goodwood Handicap in Hobart before she goes to the Newmarket.

"No doubt we will again look at setting her for the Group 3 fillies and mares' races (Bow Mistress and Vamos) in February."

Deroche was a luckless second in last season's Bow Mistress before she went on to win the Vamos Stakes.



BETTY **BOUNCES BACK!**

When a horse is labelled a superstar, and that certainly applies to the Tasmanian mare Mystic Journey given her impeccable record, winning is expected not anticipated.

WHEN star Tasmanian mare Mystic Journey powered her way to victory in the Group 2 Stocks Stakes over 1600m at Moonee Valley in September to end a lengthy losing streak, her owner and trainer heaved a sigh of relief.

It was the first time Mystic Journey had crossed the line first in over a year, but to put that in perspective there were only seven starts between wins.

When a horse is labelled a superstar, and that certainly applies to the Tasmanian mare given her impeccable record, winning is expected not anticipated.

Before the most recent win, Betty contested many of the best races on the Victorian calendar last season without finding the winner's circle.

She placed second in the Group 1 Makybe Diva and a luckless fifth in the Group 1 Turnbull Stakes. The now five-year-old daughter of Needs Further finished a gallant fifth in the W. S. Cox Plate behind champion Japanese mare Lys Gracieux.

BETTY BOUNCES BACK Continued

The mare's journey back to winning form led to missed placings in some of the best races on the calendar, which proved to be fodder for keyboard warrior criticism of the mare and her trainer on social media platforms.

While Trinder and Roser were hurt by some of the comments, they retained the professionalism which has become the hallmark of the Trinder/Roser partnership.

Adam and I agreed to ignore the comments and just get on with the job at hand and that was to get Mystic back to winning form," Roser said.

"I must admit I was on tenterhooks before the Stocks Stakes but when she delivered the way she had done in some of her previous wins, I was just full of admiration for the mare.

"She was out there three-wide with no cover and that's the way she likes it and her sectionals on the night told us she was back."

COVID-19 caused Trinder to change a routine that had proven effective in previous campaigns and that affected her performances this time in.

to travelling her a few days before she races and she's back home a couple of days after her race."

When Mystic Journey failed to flatter in the Memsie Stakes. Trinder opted to change tack and head towards the Group 1 Empire Rose, a weight-for-age race for fillies and mares over 1600 metres at Flemington on VRC Derby Day (October 31).

There was plenty of speculation about whether Trinder would rethink a Cox Plate start after she won the Stocks Stakes but he was adamant that was never in their thought processes.

Mystic Journey has started only 21 times for 12 wins and a solitary minor placing for almost \$3.9 million in stakes.

Roser has enjoyed the financial rewards of Mystic Journey's feats but he has continued to invest in more horses and one that could measure up this season in feature three-year-old events is Warrior Prince.

The gelded son of Artie Schiller had only two starts last season for a debut second in the 2YO Tasmanian Magic Millions Classic and a maiden win a month later, after which he was dispatched to the spelling paddock.

Warrior Prince resumed with a win in a class one handicap against older and more experienced horses in Devonport and he has been freshened up for a tilt at the \$100,000 3YO Cup on November

Roser knew it was only a matter of time before Mystic Journey would regain the form that took her to great heights as a three-year-old that included victory in a Group 1 Australian Guineas and the inaugural \$5 million All Star Mile.

Betty hadn't won for 18 months, so Roser was anxious when his life-changing mare lined up in the Stocks Stakes after two previous outings in August that produced an eight of 11 in the P. B. Lawrence Stakes, won by Savatiano, and a 10th of 13 to Behemoth in the Group 1 Memsie Stakes.

The pandemic travel restrictions meant sending his stable star interstate without him by her side. While the mare was cared for brilliantly, she was out of kilter and basically missed her trainer and those who tend to her regularly at Trinder's Spreyton stables when she is in racing mode.

"We had a winning formula and COVID took that away from us.

"We tried having her reside in stables in Victoria, but it didn't work so we are back

"Once we missed in the Memsie there was a firm plan of tackling the Stocks Stakes and then onto the Empire Rose and that race would most likely end her spring campaign," Trinder said.









STARS SHARE TOP AWARD

TASMANIA'S star performers of last season, Mystic Journey and The Inevitable, created history when they were announced as joint winners of the 2019-20 Horse of the Year award at the annual awards dinner at Elwick in September.

Judges could not split the pair and other contenders Mandela Effect and Hobart Cup winner Toorak Affair also polled well.

It was the first time since the Horse of the Year Award was introduced in 1980 that judges could not produce an individual winner.

The connections of both horses were humbled by the outcome but given their feats during the season it is understandable that they could not be separated.

The Inevitable, prepared by Scott Brunton, won a race at Flemington over 1000m on a heavy track before taking out the Listed Bendigo Bank Stakes (1200m) at Moonee Valley and then went on to make it three wins in succession in the inaugural \$500,000 Silver Eagle at Randwick over 1300 metres.

The Silver Eagle was a lead-up to the \$7.5 million Golden Eagle in which he had no luck finishing 12th of 16.

Mystic Journey won the Group 2 P.B. Lawrence Stakes (1400m) at her first start for the season and went on to finish second in the Group 1 Makybe Diva Stakes (1600m).

She followed up with a luckless fifth in the Group 1 Turnbull Stakes (2000m) that led to her fifth in the W. S. Cox Plate after which she was spelled.

The Adam Trinder-trained mare returned to racing in March with a fifth to Loving Gaby in the Group 1 William Reid Stakes which ended her 2019-20 season.

Mandela Effect, also from the Brunton stable, was a worthy contender as he won half of his eight starts that comprised a benchmark win at Flemington before returning to Tasmania to finish second to Blaze Forth in the weight-forage Conquering Stakes.

But he saved his best for last by taking out the weight-for-age Triple Crown in the Tasmanian Stakes (1600m), Thomas Lyons (1400m) and Mowbray Stakes, all of which are \$100,000 Listed races.

Toorak Affair, from the Michael Trinder stable, was the star stayer of the season winning six of her nine starts for the season that included the Sheffield Cup, Brighton Cup, weight-for-age Summer Cup, and the Group 3 Hobart Cup.



OFF THE TRACK HORSE SPOTLIGHT:

Super Leane raced in Tasmania from 2014 through to 2019, competing on all three of the State's Thoroughbred race tracks.

The chestnut gelding retired from racing in March last year, and shortly after found his forever home with Harriett Faulds and her family. He has since swapped his racing name for a more extravagant showing name; The Count of Faulbrook. However, to his new family he is affectionately known as "Squishy".

Described by Harriett as having "the most beautiful nature", Squishy is thriving in his new career as a show horse.

Squishy's first outing was the Hamilton Show, where he took home the Champion Hack title. In September 2020, Squishy competed in his second show at the Southern Tasmania Show Horse Championship in Hobart, where he was awarded Champion Large Hack and Champion Preliminary Hack. Harriett also rode the elegant gelding in the 10 to 12 years class in which they took out another first place.


When asked about Squishy's future, Harriett confessed her mum had originally intended him for dressage, however it now appears he may be destined for a successful show career!

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.


Notification forms for retirement of horses should be completed

Named horse within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse from racing or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Unnamed horse within 1 month of the decision to not commence racing the horse, or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

The Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival represents the pinnacle of racing in the state and will once again provide excellent opportunities for participants throughout the feature summer racing period.

The 2020/2021 summer racing carnival feature race dates have altered significantly this year with the redevelopment of Hobart complete and many feature races returning to the South of the state.

Base stakes levels, which increased on October 4th from \$17k to \$18.5k, provide an additional \$200k to participants over the Ladbrokes Tasmanian Summer Carnival which begins on January 6th at Devonport with the running of the \$100k Devonport Cup.

Throughout the grid in 2019/2020, lead up events and feature race progression were shortened due to the Hobart track redevelopment and the demand on the

Launceston Track. In 2020/2021 these extended periods between feature races will be reintroduced with additional time between runs giving horses better progression.

With the increase to base stakes, the divided race pool will be limited coming into the Tasmanian Summer Racing Carnival, but additional options may be available for two and three year olds if the population shows a need to program extra races.

Tasbred will provide multiple options again throughout December to March, with 5-7 Races on average programmed a month over the feature calendar.

Magic Millions race day remains on Sunday 21st February this year but the 2021 Tasmanian Magic Millions sale will have a new venue, with the sales to be conducted at Quercus Park in Carrick on Monday 22nd February 2021.

Approved whips

For the purposes of AR 132(1), the following padded whips have been approved by Racing Australia for use in races, official trials, jumpouts and trackwork:

- 1. Pro Cush
- International Lite-Touch
- McKey Slick Stick
- Persuader
- Enforcer
- Protekta
- Celtic Equine
- Goostick

Padded whip specifications

- Maximum length of whip not exceeding 70cm.
- No binding within 18cm of end of whip.
- Minimum width of pad 2.5cm.
- 4. Minimum length of pad not less than 18cm for whips 60cm in length; for longer whips the flap length must not be less than 30% of the whip length.
- 5. The overall weight of the whip must not exceed 160gm.
- 6. The contact area of the shaft (including pad) must be smooth with no protrusion or raised surface.
- 7. The padded segment of the whip shall consist of a material approved by Stewards, that does not harden over time. Padded materials must not absorb water.
- Leather pads are not permitted.
- 9. The inner padded section shall consist only of closed cell foam of not less than 7mm (one side) in thickness.
- 10. The thickness of the outer pad can be no greater than 1mm.
- 11. All whips must be dark in colour.

MYHORSERACING.HORSE **AUSTRALIA'S ONLINE PORTAL EXPANDS FOR TRAINERS**

Nichols, Racing Australia's Chairman, has announced an expansion of the myhorseracing.horse online portal first launched in 2019 for racehorse owners to incorporate online tools for trainers to replace the current Stable Assist online service.

"Stable Assist was first launched 15 years ago and is used by over 75% of trainers nationally to lodge racing related transactions online. This is a significant advancement for trainers with Stable Assist now integrated into the new myhorseracing.horse online portal", Mr Nichols said.

Later this week selected trainers nationally will be invited to participate in a live pilot to provide Racing Australia feedback on the new Stable Assist within myhorseracing. horse.

Following an assessment of the feedback in August, trainers nationally will be contacted inviting them to validate their myhorseracing.horse accounts. For trainers who are also owners and have already validated a myhorseracing.horse account and have been issued with an RA ID the one RA ID will enable access to all owner and trainer related functions.

"The addition of trainers to the myhorseracing.horse portal forms part of Racing Australia's ongoing investment and strategy begun when myhorseracing.

horse was first launched last year for owners. The addition of trainers is the next step with breeders to also shortly benefit from enhanced integrated services on the one national myhorseracing.horse portal", said Myles Foreman Operations CEO (Acting CEO) Racing Australia.

During the period of transition, the existing Stable Assist will continue to operate while trainers move across to the new Stable Assist in myhorseracing.horse. The Racing Australia Service Centre will provide transitional support to trainers. The phone service, still used by 25% of trainers, will continue to operate but with myhorseracing.horse it is now even easier and more convenient to transact online.

Trainers will be contacted directly by Racing Australia and provided with further information on this exciting advancement.

STEWARDS' NOTICES

Participants are reminded of their obligation under the following rules.

Division 5 – Traceability of horses AR 50 Manager to disclose the location of an unnamed horse

The manager of an unnamed horse or his or her authorised agent, or any other person with the relevant knowledge, must disclose:

- (a) the location of the unnamed horse upon request by Racing Australia and/or the relevant PRA, including as required by any registration, ownership transfer, or other form; and
- (b) any change in the previously notified location of the unnamed horse, to the satisfaction of the relevant PRA, within 7 days of that change occurring.

AR 51 Manager to notify Racing Australia of the retirement of a horse

- (1) Within 1 month of a decision to retire a named horse, or not commence racing an eligible horse, the manager of the horse or his or her authorised agent must notify Racing Australia of that, by lodging the relevant form (including a Stable Return or relevant retirement form) prescribed by Racing Australia.
- (2) Once a form has been lodged in accordance with subrule (1), the horse will be ineligible to race or be trained unless it is reinstated to race or be trained.
- (3) If a horse ceases to be eligible to race or be trained under this rule, a person must not reinstate the horse to race or be trained without the express permission of a PRA or the Stewards.

Local Rule 7 - Stable Returns

- 7.1 The completion by the Trainer of a Stable Return and any required amendment thereto duly lodged to RISA Trainers Service Centre shall be deemed to be part of an entry for a race at a race meeting in Tasmania.
- 7.2 A Trainer is required to lodge a Stable Return completed in its entirety within seven (7) days of every registered horse entering his stable. However, if any horse is entered for any race or official trial, a Stable Return completed in its entirety must be lodged no later than two (2) clear working days prior to closing time of entries for such race or trial.
- 7.3. When any particulars on the original Stable Return change, a Trainer must notify the Stewards immediately, and notify such change to RISA Trainers Service Centre.
- 7.4 Any Trainer not in Tasracing's area may fulfil the requirements of this Rule by lodging such return with RISA (Trainers Service Centre).
- 7.5 Should any Trainer fail to fulfill the requirements of this Rule, he may be punished, and/or the horse concerned may be withdrawn from its engagement.
- 7.6 Further to the provisions of AR.206 a horse may run in any race provided that:
 - (a) An official Stable Return indicating the gear to be used on the horse is lodged prior to the declaration of acceptances.
 - (b) Stewards may, in their sole discretion, in exceptional circumstances permit a change of gear in respect of any horse after the time for the closing of declaration of acceptances.

(c) Any gear approved and used on any horse in a race shall be used in subsequent races without variation unless otherwise permitted or directed by the Stewards. Notwithstanding the provisions of this rule, excluding a direction by Stewards, any change of gear shall be effected by the lodgement of an official Stable Return as provided for in LR 7.1.

AR 52 Deaths of named and unnamed horses to be reported

- (1) Upon the death of a named horse which has not been retired from racing under AR 51:
 - (a) the manager or his or her authorised agent must, within 24 hours of the horse being deceased, notify Racing Australia of that by lodging the relevant death notification form prescribed by Racing Australia; and
 - (b) the manager must not dispose of the horse without the written approval of the relevant PRA unless a veterinary certificate as to cause of death is provided to the relevant PRA.
- (2) Upon the death of an unnamed horse, the manager or his or her authorised agent must, within 48 hours of the horse being deceased, notify Racing Australia of that fact by lodging the relevant death notification form prescribed by Racing Australia.
- (3) Any person who fails to comply with subrules (1) or (2) is not guilty of a breach of the relevant subrule if he or she proves to the satisfaction of the Stewards that he or she was not aware, and could not reasonably have been aware, of the death of the horse

Division 3 – Conduct detrimental to the interests of racing

AR 228 Conduct detrimental to the interests of racing

A person must not engage in:


- (a) conduct prejudicial to the image, interests, integrity, or welfare of racing, whether or not that conduct takes place within a racecourse or elsewhere;
- (b) misconduct, improper conduct or unseemly behaviour;
- (c) improper or insulting behaviour at any time towards a PRA, the Stewards, a Club, or any official, employee, contractor or agent of any of them in relation to the relevant person's functions, powers or duties;
- (d) publishing or posting on any social media platform or channel any material, content or comment that is obscene, offensive, defamatory, racist, threatening, harassing, discriminatory or abusive to or about any other person involved in the racing industry;
- (e) conduct which threatens, disparages, vilifies or insults another person ("other person") on any basis, including but not limited to, a person's race, religion, colour, descent, national or ethnic origin, special ability/disability, or sexual orientation, preference or identity, while the other person is acting in the course of his or her duties in the racing industry.


