



From the CEO's DESK



As we head into the new racing season, it's extremely pleasing to see the thoroughbred code in good shape.

We're still seeing strong wagering performance for the code, outstanding horses being bred and raced in our state, and some outstanding training and jockey performances across the board.

It was pleasing to see our industry represented so positively at this year's AGFEST. Despite lower overall attendance due to COVID restrictions, it filled me with great optimism to see so many children and young adults try out their race riding technique on the mechanical horse! We were lucky enough to have Codi Jordan and Raquel Clark volunteer their time to impart their passion and expertise to our AGFEST visitors. It was obvious that many young people left with the thought of a racing career planted in their minds.

We're committed to promoting the code to the next generation. The entire industry depends on the sustainable supply of new participants. With that in mind, Tasracing is currently sponsoring a scholarship to be awarded to one lucky young Tasmanian with a passion for a career in thoroughbred racing. We have partnered with Thoroughbred Industry Careers (TIC) to offer a funded place in their 12 month Explorer Cadetship Program, conducted in New South Wales. Interested parties should review the information on our 'It's Why We Race' website. Applications close on 1 October this year, so please help spread the word to any young person you think has what it takes.

The other area of focus for us is of course promoting the love, care and commitment

we all have as a code towards the health and welfare of our racing and retired thoroughbreds. Tasracing is currently working on a draft of Equine Welfare Guidelines that will be released to Industry for comment in the near future.

Tasracing has recently launched a new partnership with Hygain Feeds to provide discounted feed and tailored nutritional advice to new owners of OTT horses. We are also continuing to promote our subsidised OTT lessons. Again, further information on these programs can be found on itswhywerace.com.au.

Of course, we remain highly focused on the task of growing revenue in order to underpin sustainable investment in infrastructure, stakes and participant attraction for the code. Tasracing has recently enhanced our digital product offering. Formplus Pro was released in June with the aim of giving wagering customers and fans of Tasmanian racing the widest possible range of content and information. An example of the new content is a number of new camera angles for all thoroughbred tracks, and live streaming of all thoroughbred trials.

In closing, I'd like to express my ongoing gratitude and admiration for each and every one of you engaged in Tasmania's thoroughbred code. The entire team at Tasracing are more committed than ever to working alongside you to achieve our shared vision of a vibrant, sustainable industry valued by the entire community for our contribution to Tasmania.



TURK WARRIOR

When trainer Glenn Stevenson first laid eyes on Turk Warrior he was underwhelmed by the gelding's presentation but the moment he saw him gallop his heart skipped a beat. five months later Turk Warrior made his way to the spelling paddock undefeated from six starts with the surety of being named Tasmanian 2YO of the Year.







"Turk Warrior has only ever done what he had to do to win and has never been fully tested, so it will be interesting to see how he comes up next season.

"We made sure he wasn't over raced because sometimes they can be burnt out when they do too much at two, but this horse could probably have taken on much more than we asked of him because of the way he is made." Glenn Stevenson

Turk Warrior, owned by Devonport businessman Seyit Basol, is by Outreach from the former star race mare Ehor that excelled as a two-year-old, winning an Elwick Stakes and Gold Sovereign Stakes.

Nicknamed Donkey, being out of Ehor, Stevenson's rising superstar will be given the chance to dance on the big stage next season.

"I have no doubt this horse will be at his best over 1600m and that's why we have decided to target the Group 1 Caulfield Guineas.

"He is such a good doer, that I can't afford to give him too long a break, so we will have to give him a run somewhere during the winter and that is likely to be in Melbourne. "That will serve two purposes. He will learn to travel, and we could get a bit of an idea of where he fits into the big picture."

After Turk Warrior won the Elwick Stakes there were verbal offers from Hong Kong interests to buy the gelding, with as much as \$750,000 bandied about.

"There were offers for the horse, but talk is cheap, so in the end we told those who had been making the offers to either put the money in the owner's bank account or stop calling!."

Stevenson has had some very good horses pass through his stables and none better than I'm Wesley, the winner of three consecutive Newmarket Handicaps. But when drawn into making a comparison, Stevenson said it was too early to compare the two.


Turk Warrior has shone brighter than I'm Wesley as a juvenile, but Stevenson says Wes showed his greatness as an older horse.

"I'm not big on comparing horses' abilities and in this case Turk and Wes are worlds apart in terms of personality and physique, but if the young horse keeps doing great things as a three-year-old, then we might have a different opinion, but we'll wait and see.

PETER LUTTRELL

Peter was born into racing and it has remained an integral part of his life for over four decades.

He has looked adversity in the face and won the battle but a day won't pass without him thinking about the most important person in his life who was taken from him by cancer over two years ago. Luttrell is a great horseman who now lives for the early morning starts and the challenge to extract the best from each of his trusty steeds.

Horses put spring in his step

Story and photography by Peter Staples PETER LUTTRELL was destined to find his way into racing having been born into a family that had strong ties to the thoroughbred code.

Three of his brothers - Craig, Mick, and John, all carved careers out of the sport and along the way they have all had their fair share of success.

Craig has retired as a jockey and Mick no longer has an interest, but Peter and younger brother John remain committed to training horses for a living.

When Peter first started out training just over 40 years ago it was only part time but that was enough to keep the flame from petering out.

"I worked at the abattoirs down south for 10 years and I had a 10-year stint with Woolworths and during those times I always had at least one horse in work," Luttrell said.

"My first winner was All Over Dover, a Court Clown mare that I leased from Walter McShane, but as for how many winners I've trained, I couldn't tell you."



"I had really good two years-olds in Fearless Admiral and Shining Storm and they both won Listed two-year-old races and Shining Storm almost gave me my first winner in Melbourne."

In 2005 Luttrell relocated to Longford and he says it is the best move he ever made.

"When they moved training from Elwick to Brighton, I just didn't like the environment at Brighton, so I looked at all of my options and we settled on Longford."

Life was flowing smoothly for Peter and wife Debbie, with plenty of horses in the stable and winners popping up regularly.

But in August 2019, Debbie lost a battle with cancer and it understandably knocked the stuffing out of the man who, until then, had been able to deal with any setback life had thrown at him.

"When Deb died, I honestly felt as if my own life was over."

"Everything I did with horses I did with her by my side. She loved the horses even more than I did and for her to be taken away at such a young age was tragic."

He was on the verge of closing the stables and, in his words, "finding a place to curl up and die."

But through strong support from family and close friends he found a way out of the dark place he lived in while grieving for his childhood sweetheart.

"I have no doubt it has been the horses that have kept me going.

"I know Deb would have wanted me to stay involved with training horses because she knew how passionate I am about them and the industry, and I would only have been letting her and myself down if I threw in the towel."


Luttrell has bounced back this season and as this edition of the publication heads to the printers, he has prepared 15 winners to be in the top 10 on the trainer's premiership table with a winning strike rate of almost 14 per cent.

Luttrell doesn't know for sure whether he has another Fearless Admiral or Shining Storm coming through the ranks, but he has some young ones that show potential.

"There are a couple of two-year-olds by Alpine Eagle that have shown me enough to suggest they might be good three-year-olds and one is a filly out of the good race mare Aprilia.

He also has taken a shine to an interstate reject named Military Law that has lobbed in his care.

"I can't put my finger on what it is about Military Law, but whatever it is, he puts a spring in my step whenever he's about."

... Strutts her Stuff

STAR three-year-old filly Hela delivered some of the most impressive wins of the season in her home state with none better than the effortless victory in the \$100,000 Listed Strutt Stakes at Elwick on Hobart Cup day.

The Scott Brunton-trained filly also captured the Thousand Guineas that formed part of a winning streak that had her unbeaten from seven starts on home soil this season.

It wasn't until she stepped out in the Group 1 Australasian Oaks that her record became blemished, finishing last of 16 but was later found to have been hindered by an elevated heart rate caused by a low-grade virus.

But the South Australian experience aside, Hela was one of the genuine stars of Tasmania's racing season and clearly the state's best three-year-old filly.

"Hela's record speaks for itself and had things not gone wrong in Adelaide we would probably be talking about her as a potential horse of the year," Brunton said.

Hela (Night of Thunder-Smooth Return) was well placed this season winning graded events leading up to her two feature race triumphs.

If there were any doubts about her credentials as a potential Group 1 performer, they were dispelled when she broke the track record in winning the Strutt Stakes over 2100m, carving over two seconds off the previous best.

After blitzing her rivals in the Strutt Stakes, the Tasmanian Oaks looked hers for the taking, but Brunton always had his eyes on a bigger prize.

Hela was ridden by multiple premiershipwinning jockey David Pires throughout her two campaigns.

"This filly went from strength to strength as the season progressed and after she won the Strutt Stakes I was convinced she was capable of winning at the absolute top level," Pires said. "When she won the Strutt Stakes it was like riding in slow motion, so smooth was her action and in the straight it was like she was floating. She did it so easily".

Pires was aboard in the Australasian Oaks and he thought at the half-way mark that she was on her way to winning a Group 1.

"The filly felt great and 600m from home I thought they would struggle to catch us when I asked her to go, but she found nothing and that was so out of character for her.

"I knew there had to be something amiss and while it was disappointing for all of her owners, given all the hype going into the race, the filly has come through the experience alright and I'm sure she will go on and win more races."

Hela ended her season with seven wins from eight starts for \$172,000 in stakes.



Moe is a great example of just how trainable, versatile and successful an Off the Track horse can be in their new career.

Following retirement from a successful racing career, Moe went to live with his new owner, Pyper Page in northern Tasmania.

Piper retrained Moe in show jumping and dressage, and the pair entered their first Pony Club competition in November 2020. While Moe was less experienced than many of the other competitors, Pyper had confidence that he would do her proud. "He was new to this career, but he had done everything right in our training and this was intended to be a fun day out where we were not focused on the competition." Moe placed second

overall in dressage and fourth overall in the 80cm show jumping.

Later in the season, Moe and Piper entered the Pony Club State Eventing Trials where the pair qualified for Nationals after placing in the top ten. Moe also impressed in the Pony Club State Dressage and Show Jumping Championships, winning and placing in several classes.

Moe went to Agfest 2021, where he was a demonstration horse in dressage and pole work.

When not training or competing, Moe and Piper enjoy trail riding and spending time at the beach with friends.

Pyper proudly notes "I am forever grateful that I was entrusted to take on Geegees Baritone after his racing career, and I am hopeful we can continue to grow as a partnership and keep achieving our goals."

BETTING

Summarv:

Prior to the rewrite of the Rules of Racing in March 2019, AR 115 was covered by AR 83. An inadvertent result of the new drafting is

- the prohibition on jockeys betting on races does not expressly refer to thoroughbred races (although Stewards interpret the rule as only applying to thoroughbred races);
- · the prohibition on betting on contingencies related to races does not necessarily include races in which the jockey is not riding.

Racing Australia has approved amendments to AR 115(1) to address this and ensure the rule is better aligned with the terms of the previous AR 83.

It is considered that these amendments are necessary as Australian jockeys ought not be able to bet on any thoroughbred race regardless of its location. A jockey's ability to bet on international races poses a potential integrity issue in Australia and is also prejudicial to the image and interests of racing. To improve integrity, Racing Australia has also approved that the betting prohibitions which apply in respect of races in which jockeys are riding (and attract a mandatory minimum 2-year disqualification) include facilitating a bet.

Amend AR 115 as follows:

AR 115 Jockey and apprentice jockey misconduct

- (1) A jockey or apprentice jockey must not:
 - (a) engage in misconduct;
 - (b) other than from his or her nominator, accept or agree to accept any money, gift, or other consideration

- without the consent of the Stewards and his or her nominator:
- (c) bet, or have any interest in a bet, or facilitate a bet, on any thoroughbred race or contingency relating to thoroughbred racing in any jurisdiction anywhere in the world;
- (d) be present in the betting ring during a race meeting:
- (e) bet, or have any interest in a bet, or facilitate a bet, on any thoroughbred race or contingency relating to thoroughbred racing involving a race in which he or she is riding in any jurisdiction anywhere in the world.
- (2) For the purposes of this rule, "bet" includes a lay bet.
- (3) If a jockey or apprentice jockey breaches subrule (1)(e), a disqualification of not less than 2 years must be imposed unless there is a finding that a special circumstance exists or the relevant race occurred outside Australia, in which case that penalty may be reduced.

Date of effect: 1 May 2021

AR 120A RIDING INSTRUCTIONS

Summary:

Racing Australia is aware of the increasing prevalence of persons other than trainers and connections - such as riders' agents and form analysts - providing tactical riding instructions to iockevs.

Racing Australia is of the view this is inappropriate and may create integrity (and perception) issues, as well as potentially confusing jockeys who receive conflicting riding instructions.

Accordingly, Racing Australia has approved the introduction of a new rule to deal with the

Introduce AR 120A as follows: **AR 120A Riding instructions**

(1) A rider must not receive, directly or indirectly, instructions concerning the running or riding of a horse in a race in which the rider is declared to ride from anyone other than the trainer (or authorised

agent) or an owner of the horse.

- (2) A person must not provide, or offer to provide, to a rider, directly or indirectly, instructions concerning the running or riding of a horse in a race in which the rider is declared to ride, unless that person is the trainer (or authorised agent) or an owner of the horse.
- (3) For the purposes of this rule:
 - (a) "instructions" includes, but is not limited to, riding and/or tactical race instructions or directions, regardless of whether such instructions and/or directions are:
 - (i) provided verbally, in writing, or otherwise:
 - (ii) contained on a speed map; and
 - (b) "instructions" does not include a speed map in respect of a race indicating only the likely pace in the race and/or the likely settling positions of runners in the race.

Date of effect: 1 May 2021

AR 252A & AR 254A PROHIBITION ON **INJECTABLE COBALT SALTS**

Summary:

Racing Australia is of the view that:

 a typical daily diet of a racehorse meets their daily dietary cobalt requirement;

- · there have been no reported cases of cobalt deficiency in horses: and
- there is no nutritional, medical or welfare iustification for the administration of cobalt by injection to a horse at any time.

Despite there being no therapeutic rationale for the use of injectable cobalt containing products in horses, registered supplements containing cobalt (amongst other substances) are widely used in racehorses.

In circumstances where Racing Australia is of the view that there is no place in racing for injectable products containing cobalt salts, it has approved the introduction of new rules which prohibit:

- the possession of injectable products containing cobalt salts; and
- the administration of cobalt salts by injection.

There are four injectable veterinary products that have been either previously or currently registered and/or available for use in horses that contain cobalt salts: NV V.A.M. Injection, Troy Hemoplex Injection, Hemo-15 Vitamin-Amino Acid Injection and NV Haemo Injection.

Possession and/or administration of these products, or any other injectable product containing cobalt salts, is prohibited under the new rules.


Introduce AR 252A as follows:

AR 252A Possession of injectable products containing cobalt salts

- (1) A person must not have in his or her possession, or on his or her premises, any injectable product which contains cobalt salts.
- (2) The Stewards may confiscate any product referred to in subrule (1) and use it as evidence in any inquiry, hearing or other proceeding under the Rules.



AMENDMENTS



- (1) A person must not:
 - (a) administer:
 - (b) cause to be administered;
 - (c) attempt to administer; or
 - (d) be a party to the administration or attempted administration of, a product containing cobalt salts to a horse by injection.
- (2) If the Stewards are satisfied that a horse has been, or is likely to have been, administered a product containing cobalt salts by injection, the Stewards may prevent the horse from starting in any race, official trial or jump-out.
- If a horse has been administered a product containing cobalt salts by injection, but the horse competes in a race, official trial or jump-out, the horse may be disqualified from that race, official trial or jump-out.
- (4) For the purposes of this rule, an "injection" includes, but is not limited to, the insertion of a hypodermic needle into a horse.

Date of effect: 1 May 2021

TOR RULE 6 OWNERSHIP RESTRICTIONS ON PERSONS THE SUBJECT OF AN ENFORCEMENT **ACTION APPLICATION**

Summary:

Under the Trainer and Owner Reforms (TOR) Rules in Schedule 2 to the Australian Rules of Racing, where an owner has failed to pay their training fees as required (and has not lodged a Dispute Notice in respect of them) a trainer may lodge an Enforcement Action Application (EAA) against the owner. Upon lodging an EAA, the trainer may seek the

following consequences be applied against the owner until the outstanding fees have been paid:

- owner not permitted to transfer the horse to another trainer (if the owner owns at least 50% of the horse):
- · owner not permitted to transfer their share in the horse to another person; and
- · owner's prizemoney is frozen and redirected to the trainer.

However, an EAA issued against a defaulting owner does not restrict that owner from

entering the ownership of other horses, even while the debts remain unpaid. This can affect future training and joint ownership relationships, as participants may unwittingly enter into arrangements with persons who have a history of not paying their training fees and who can continue to accumulate training debts throughout the industry. This has the potential to create negative experiences for participants and can threaten (particularly for owners) their ongoing involvement in the industry.

To address this situation, Racing Australia has approved amendments to TOR Rule 6, such that where a defaulting owner is the subject of a current EAA he or she will be prohibited from entering the ownership of any other horse. Only once the EAA is lifted (i.e. by payment of the training debt or through agreement with the trainer) will such an owner be permitted to acquire and register ownership interests in other horses. The rule change includes a discretionary element that allows Racing Australia/Principal Racing Authorities to waive any relevant ownership restriction where they believe it will assist in reducing the training debt owed by a defaulting owner.

These changes will not affect a defaulting owner's existing ownership in other horses (if any) given the potential for that to affect other innocent owners.

The rule change will take effect with the start of the new racing season on 1 August 2021, which will provide sufficient time for defaulting owners to clear their training debts.

Amend TOR Rule 6 as follows:

TOR Rule 6 - Consequences if the presumption of a training debt arises

- Subject to subrule (7), if an EAA has been applied by Racing Australia and/ or a PRA against an owner under this rule, while that EAA remains in place:
 - (a) that owner must not, either directly or indirectly, acquire an interest in another horse and/or lodge with Racing Australia or a PRA in respect of another horse:
 - (i) a Foal Ownership Declaration;
 - a registration application;
 - (iii) a transfer of ownership application, except for the purpose of that owner selling his or her interest in another horse; or
 - (iv) a lease application; and
 - (b) Racing Australia and/or a PRA must not process any such application or lodgment.
- (7) Racing Australia and/or a PRA (as applicable) may waive any prohibitions in subrule (6) if they are of the opinion that such waiver will assist in reducing the relevant owner's training fees and/or training disbursements debt.

Date of effect: 1 August 2021

AR 2 SOUTH AUSTRALIA PRA NAME CHANGE

Summary:

The Principal Racing Authority in South Australia has changed its name from Thoroughbred Racing S.A. Limited to Racing SA Ltd.

Racing Australia has approved an amendment to the definition of "Principal Racing Authority" in AR 2 to reflect the name change.

Amend AR 2 as follows:

AR 2 Dictionary

In the interpretation of these Australian Rules (and any race meeting held under them). unless the context requires otherwise, the words and phrases below have the meanings set out in this rule.

Principal Racing Authority (PRA) means a body (statutory or otherwise) recognised as a principal racing authority under Racing Australia's Constitution, that has the control and general supervision of racing within a State or Territory, and comprises:

- (a) Racing New South Wales in New South Wales:
- (b) Racing Victoria Limited in Victoria;
- (c) Racing Queensland Board in Queensland:
- Racing SA Ltd in South Australia;
- (e) Racing and Wagering Western Australia in Western Australia;
- Tasracing Pty Ltd in Tasmania;
- Thoroughbred Racing NT in the Northern Territory: and
- (h) Canberra Racing Club Incorporated in the Australian Capital Territory.

Date of effect: 1 May 2021



AMENDMENTS

Part 14 – Traceability Rules (and consequential amendments to AR 2, AR 30, AR 34, AR 37, AR 38, AR 45, AR 46, AR 48, AR 50, AR 51, AR 52, AR 103, AR 116, AR 253)

Summary:

Racing Australia has approved the introduction of new rules to improve the horse traceability requirements in the Australian Rules of Racing.

The purpose of the new traceability rules is to enhance and broaden the traceability of horses throughout the period of their life during which the racing industry has jurisdiction over them and relevant industry participants. It is envisaged that greater transparency with respect to the status and movement of horses will enable racing authorities to better track horses and, consequently, help ensure more positive equine welfare outcomes.

The new traceability rules are separated into 5 divisions for ease of reference:

- Unnamed horses
- Named horses
- Breeding horses
- Access to property
- Breach of traceability rules

These rules have also resulted in various consequential amendments to the Australian Rules of Racing, which are summarised as follows:

- AR 2 new, amended and deleted definitions
- AR 30 deleted replaced and amended by AR 294
- AR 34 deleted replaced and amended by AR 285, AR 286, AR 287 and AR 288
- AR 37 and AR 38 deleted replaced and amended by AR 295
- AR 50 deleted replaced and amended by AR 289
- AR 51 deleted replaced and amended by AR 290 and AR 297
- AR 52 deleted replaced and amended by AR 292 and AR 299
- AR 45, AR 46 and AR 48 amended to include breeding horses
- AR 103(4)-(8) deleted replaced and amended by AR 296
- AR 116 and AR 253 amended to refer to unnamed horses

AMENDMENTS TO RULES & POLICIES

TPOL0028 | ADDITIONAL RIDING FEES

1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this policy is to clearly define the eligibility requirements for an additional riding fee.

2. POLICY

Eligibility

A rider maybe eligible for an additional riding fee of \$100:

- 2.1 If the riders originally declared ride is scratched and the rider accepts an additional ride on any horse that is starting in the race inside 24 hours prior to Race 1 of that meeting.
- 2.2 Interstate riders will only become eligible for an additional riding fee if there are no local riders available.

2.3 Riders will not be eligible if the accepted additional ride is on a horse from the same stable as the horse they were originally scratched on.

3. PROCESS

- 3.1 Riders eligible for an additional riding fee must submit their request to Tasracing (racing@tasracing. com.au) within 48 hours after the official race meeting scratching time.
- 3.2 The additional riding fee must be approved by Tasracing.
- 3.3 The amount will be paid directly into the jockey's prescribed bank account within ten working days of the race meeting.

STEWARDS' NOTICES



The replacement of riders is undertaken on a Jockey for Jockey and Apprentice for Apprentice basis. Non-claiming and 1.5kg claiming Apprentices are determined as being interchangeable.

In the event of an alternative senior rider or apprentice not being available, Stewards may apply their discretion and permit an apprentice to replace a senior rider or vice versa, however each case is to be treated on its merits with consideration being given to the impact that any substitution may have on betting.

Although the policy mentioned is the quideline for changes of declared riders, in the case of non-claiming races, the Stewards may allow for any to be substituted at their discretion-Jockey or Apprentice, with each case being treated on its merits.

In the event of an alternative senior rider or apprentice not being available, Stewards may apply their discretion and permit an apprentice to replace a senior rider or vice versa. However, each case is to be treated on its merits with consideration being given to the impact that any substitution may have on betting. This is particularly evident in the event of a late change having to be made on an event where totalisator betting has already commenced and significant novelty type betting has previously opened such as quadrella and quartet betting. In such circumstances, difficulties can arise if a senior rider is replaced by an inexperienced apprentice or vice versa as investors may be disadvantaged after having already placed an investment on the particular race.

RIDER DECLARATION

Riders must be declared by the time listed in the calendar. This is usually 12.00 pm on acceptance day, however this may be extended at the Stewards' discretion if there has been a delay in releasing the fields.

Trainers are liable to be fined if they do not declare a rider by the prescribed time. If a trainer advises the Stewards prior to 12.00 pm that they are having trouble finding a rider and the stewards deem that the reasons are genuine, late declaration will be permitted.

OVERWEIGHTS

Jockeys are permitted to ride 1kg overweight only on the minimum weight of 54kg with the permission of the Stewards. Permission will only be granted with the approval of the connections of the horse which the rider must first obtain prior to seeking approval from the Stewards.

Jockeys are permitted to ride 0.5kg overweight at the allotted weight to a ceiling of 57kg with the permission of the Stewards. Permission will only be granted with the approval of the connections of the horse which the rider must first obtain prior to seeking approval from the Stewards.

In races where the allotted weight of the horse is lower than the standard minimum weight, the Stewards may, at their discretion and on the request from the Owner(s) and/ or Trainer permit Jockeys to ride up to 1kg overweight. Such application must be made at the time of final rider declarations to allow sufficient time for the riding weight of the Jockey to be printed in the racebook and relayed to media publications.

UPDATE REGARDING PRODUCTS CONTAINING ALTRENOGEST

Date of issue 24th May 2021

In June 2018, The Office of Racing Integrity, Tasmania, issued a media release warning trainers regarding the use of products containing Altrenogest.

This advice was to cease the use of such products and remains unchanged. Prescription animal remedy products containing Altrenogest, for example regumate, which are used to control the cyclic activity of fillies and mares, have been analysed and found to contain varying amounts of by-products trenbolone and/or trendione. These are androgenic anabolic steroids which are permanently banned and may have extended detection times.

Oral forms of products containing Altrenogest have been analysed to contain less of the above substances than injectable products. Racing authorities have been working to develop a national approach to this issue in addition to consultation with the manufacturers to reduce or eliminate the by-products. These attempts have been unrewarding at this stage.

Alternatives for controlling the seasonal activity of fillies and mares are available, the Office of Racing Integrity suggest trainers should consult their Veterinarians regarding the use of these products and administer in accordance with the manufacturers guidelines, maintain treatment records and ensure strict compliance with the relevant "one clear day" treatment rules.

Trainers using products containing Altrenogest do so at their own risk. Androgenic anabolic steroid detection carries significant penalties for the horse and trainer.

NOTICE TO TRAINERS BAN ON INJECTABLE PRODUCTS CONTAINING COBALT SALTS

From 1 May 2021, the Australian Rules of Racing will prohibit:

- the possession of injectable products containing cobalt salts; and
- · the administration of cobalt salts by injection.

These bans are set out in new rules AR 252A (possession) and AR 254A (administration). Penalties apply for failure to comply with these rules.

Racing Australia reiterates its view that there is no place for injectable supplements containing cobalt salts in racing when there is no therapeutic rationale for their use. This is because (among other things):

- · a typical daily diet of a racehorse meets their daily dietary cobalt requirement;
- · there have been no reported cases of cobalt deficiency in horses; and
- · there is no nutritional, medical or welfare justification for the administration of cobalt by injection to a horse at any time.

There are four injectable veterinary products that have been either previously or currently registered and/or available for use in horses that contain cobalt salts.

- NV V.A.M Injection;
- Troy Hemoplex Injection;
- · Hemo-15 Vitamin-Amino Acid Injection;
- · NV Haemo Injection.





Possession and/or administration of these products (and any other registered or unregistered injectable products that contain cobalt salts) are prohibited under the new rules from 1 May 2021.

Trainers are advised to check the active constituents of all injectable veterinary supplements they currently hold. Further, it is advised that trainers carefully check the active constituents of any injectable veterinary supplements at the time of purchase to ensure that no injectable products are purchased or held that would be an offence under the new rules.

Notification Forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.

Notification forms for retirement of horses should be completed

Named horse within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse from racing or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Unnamed horse within 1 month of the decision to not commence racing the horse, or within 24 hours of the horse's death.


