

HARNES QUALIFYING TRIALS

Effective 1 Jan 2022

Harness Qualifying trials will continue under the current format, to be reviewed on an ongoing basis:

- Nominations will close 12 noon Friday for Saturday / Monday trials. No extensions applicable
- Trials will be scheduled 15 minutes apart
- Any horse may nominate for these trials.
- Notification of any changes to trials will be sent via text.
- A minimum of 6 acceptors are required for a trial to proceed.
- Qualifying trials will be held over the following distances:
 - Hobart – 1609m 2YO only / 2090m (MS & SS)
 - Carrick – 1609m 2YO only / 2150m (MS) (SS only 2150m)
 - Devonport – 1930m 2YO only / 2297m (MS) / 2286m (SS)
 - Launceston – 1680m (MS only) **pre-race only**
- Trainers must place a comment against their nomination if that horse has been stood down or trialling to get back in the draw.
- The trial fee will be \$20. Tasracing will invoice trainers directly.
- Scratching's received on trial day will be charged the full trial fee.
- No fee will be charged for Trainers utilising Junior Drivers advancing towards their Race licence.
- Education trials will be held at the discretion of the club.
