From the

Angela Brakey

WHEN White Hawk resumed racing this season his trainer Angela Brakey had high hopes of winning the Hobart or Launceston Cup. Half-way through his first preparation, she even dared to think of capturing both.

The gelding showed his first glimpse of form when he won the Golden Mile over 1650m at Devonport to gain ballot-free entry into the Devonport Cup at odds of \$61.

A lacklustre run at his subsequent outing in the Sheffield Cup had much to do about how he was ridden that day, and with instructions to keep him wide and out of trouble and allow him to unwind interference-free from the 800m mark led to his brilliant Devonport Cup win with Mehmet Ulucinar aboard.

With Ulucinar sidelined with a wrist injury, Brakey called on talented apprentice Erica Byrne Burke to partner her stable star in the weight-for-age Summer Cup at Elwick and with the same riding instructions carried out to the tee, White Hawk emerged an impressive winner.

“It took me a long while to work this horse out, but one thing for sure is, he has to be allowed to wind up from a long way out in staying races because he is way more comfortable and gets frustrated if he is held up and can't get his own way,” Brakey said.

“He is a very quirky horse and I've had my share of grief from him over the years, but I think I know all of his weird ways and habits and riders have to realise he has to be ridden a certain way to get the best out of him.”

Ulucinar regained the ride in the Hobart Cup and Brakey was confident the eight-year-old was in peak condition for the 2400-metre Group 3 event.

The race was run at a muddling tempo and when White Hawk was buried back in the field and Ulucinar unable to extract him from a pocket formed 1000m from home by one of the interstate runners Lord Belvedere, his chances of allowing Brakey to live out her dream came crashing down.

White Hawk was 20 lengths off the leader when they hit the home straight, but he ran on resolutely over the final 300m to run third and finish 5-1/2 lengths from the winner.

Ulucinar had to watch the Launceston Cup in the jockeys' room after Brakey called on Byrne Burke to take the reins to try and replicate her Summer Cup ride.

But like the Hobart Cup, plans went awry and she found herself with too much ground to make up.

Again, White Hawk flashed home from well back to finish fourth and he was finishing better than any other runner, including the winner Aurora's Symphony.

While White Hawk might not have given Brakey a dream ending to the carnival, he escaped unscathed, and she believes the horse can return next year for another crack at the major cups.

"The horse is perfectly sound, and he is a down and out stayer with an incredible set of lungs and will to run, so if he is in this sort of shape next season, we'll push on to try and get the result in 2023."

White Hawk is the first horse raced in partnership by Brakey and her sister Mandy Gunn who owns and operates Motree Thoroughbreds, one of the top three thoroughbred breeding enterprises in the state.

Brakey has been working with horses from an early age, but Gunn only started to take racehorse breeding seriously after she ventured to the 2008 Tasmanian Yearling Sale and purchased a gelding for \$2,000 that became Banca Mo.

Under the guidance of premier trainers David and Scott Brunton, Banca Mo was a star, especially interstate, winning on all city tracks including the Pakenham and Warrnambool Cups in 2013 then two years later he won the \$350,000 Mornington Cup.

Banca Mo won 12 and notched as many minor placings for over \$800,000 in prizemoney.

The prizemoney was nice, but for Mandy it has always been about the horse and that led to her developing and expanding her thoroughbred breeding enterprise. This coming spring 41 of her broodmares will foal down at her property at Waterhouse on Tasmania's North-East Coast.

The sisters have become closer since Mandy became involved in thoroughbred breeding and racing.

Mandy is four years older than Angela, so as adolescents they travelled on quite different plains, but the love of thoroughbreds has helped them develop an unbreakable sibling bond, not that it was ever broken.

They bred White Hawk from the mare White Yard who they also raced together and sharing the White Hawk journey has been special.

"To have had him from a foal and going through what we've achieved with him is an amazing experience for both of us," Brakey said.

"When he won the Devonport Cup, Mandy wasn't there because on her way to the track she got a call from her daughter who told her she had tested positive to Covid, so she didn't think it would be safe for her to attend the meeting and that was disappointing."

If White Hawk can go on and win a major cup next year Brakey might consider giving up riding trackwork, something she already has suggested to her family.

She made the pledge after she was dumped by White Hawk about 18 months ago that resulted in her tearing away all the ligaments around her C4-5 vertebrae and shaved off one of her discs which had her sidelined for a few months.

"I did tell the family that I would hang up the riding boots when I'm 60, but you say some silly things when you're injured and unsure of what the future might hold."

ANOTHER RECORD BREAKING TASMANIAN MAGIC MILLIONS SALE

The 2022 Tasmanian Magic Millions Yearling Sale grossed a record \$4.3 million to outshine last year's record by almost \$900,000.

The sale attracted buyers from around Australia, New Zealand, Singapore and Hong Kong which assisted the sale to achieve a record gross of \$4.3m - well above the 2021 record of \$3.3m and a record average, with a clearance rate of more than 80 per cent.

Magic Millions and Tasbreeders are to be congratulated for the work they did with Tasracing on the sale. This year's sale success demonstrates what we can achieve if we work collectively.

It is also a clear statement that the Tasmanian racing industry is alive and well and our local breeding is on the rise.

Consigned by Armidale Stud, the Toronado filly topped the record breaking Tasmanian Yearling Sale selling for \$150,000.

A filly by Toronado led the way as records tumbled across the board at the 2022 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale at Quercus Park.

New records for average and sale gross were achieved at the auction with a strong local, interstate and international buying bench competing for the cream of the Tasmanian yearling crop.

A List Stud rounded out the day as leading buyer, securing six lots including the sale topper (Lot 106) at \$150,000.

Consigned by Armidale Stud, the Toronado filly is from the good producing Elvstroem mare Il Sogno, a daughter of the triple group winner Tickle My.

“She was the pick of the sale for my team across the inspections and we are delighted to be able to buy her,” A List’s Chris Lee said.

“Her sire Toronado is going really well with his progeny in Australia and overseas. She’s a great mover – got a lovely walk and I look forward to her joining the A List stable.”

Lee said the filly would head to the Gold Coast stables of Allan Chau and enter the A List system and a decision will be made whether or not she is offered as a two-year-old or she is retained to race.

“She has got a nice pedigree and I might choose to keep and race her and eventually join the A List broodmare band,” Lee added.

A List Stud went to \$115,000 to secure Armidale Stud’s Epaulette colt from Myhro late in the day – achieving the third highest price.

Leading bloodstock agent John Foote snapped up five lots on the day. His purchases were headlined by the day’s fourth six figure seller – the Shamus Award-Ecosse colt from Alva Stud at \$110,000.

Denise Martin’s Star Thoroughbreds again invested heavily, buying three for a total of \$192,500 of which a colt by Needs Further from Arenzano went for \$97,500 in what developed into a keen tussle with two other bidders.

Martin also acquired the only All Too Hard at the sale for which she paid \$65,000 and a filly by Stratosphere from Airlie Magic for \$30,000 presented by Brooklyn Park Stud.

Victorian trainer Mitch Freedman invested some of the money he won from his former Hong Kong stayer Ho Ho Khan’s Hobart Cup win last week by purchasing an Ambidexter colt from Brooklyn Park Stud for \$80,000.

The leading buyer for individual lots was leading local trainer John Blacker – his nine lots cost a total of \$190,000, the highest priced being \$32,000 for an Alpine Eagle-Elusive Affair filly from Armidale.

Progeny by Grenville Stud’s freshman sire Stratosphere (Snitzel) proved popular and his colt from In Harmony (Lot 107) was the star when selling to Bevan Smith Bloodstock for \$125,000.

The colt, from an Exceed and Excel mare, is a half brother to two stakes performers including the Singapore star Celavi and the colt is set to join that star at Kranji.

2022 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale *continued*

Armidale Stud finished the sale as leading vendors by gross (\$1,709,500) and average (\$53,422) for 32 lots sold. Grenville Stud (\$638,000 for 17 sold) and Motree Thoroughbreds (\$609,000 for 17 sold) also enjoyed positive results.

"I am thrilled with today's results. It's continued on with the trend of the yearling sale series this year," Magic Millions Managing Director Barry Bowditch said.

"There's been a good, strong, healthy market and I am delighted for the vendors of Tasmania. They really work hard to achieve these results and, on a whole, to get their horses sold with a record average, record median and a record gross, it's a great result for Tasmania."

"Nearly all states of Australia bought a horse which was great. Victoria was fantastic, there was a bit of international participation, so Tasmania's getting great coverage, and rightly so."

"Having those buyers willing to come down here and be willing to support this sale and expose the breed of horse to the mainland, it's great to see and it's important for the future."

SECTION 11 | BALLOTING CONDITIONS

11.1 (d)

(d) (i) In TWO-YEAR-OLD OPEN CLASS SET WEIGHT RACES, prior to 1 February, horses will be eliminated as per LR11.1(e) Ratings Based Handicapping Balloting with the following horses treated as rating 59 and eligible in order of: **(Amended Rule effective 01/09/21)**

1. Unraced horses which have won a trial.
2. Unraced horses which have placed 2nd in a trial.
3. Unraced horses which have placed 3rd in a trial.
4. Unraced horses which have not finished 1st to 3rd in a trial.
5. Horses scratched by stewards due to no rider availability at previous meeting.
6. Horses subject to Balloted Out List conditions and rankings (refer LR 11.1(a)(ii) below).
7. Horses will then be eliminated as per 11.1(e) Ratings Based Handicapping Balloting.

(ii) In TWO-YEAR-OLD RACES (UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED) horses will be eliminated as per LR11.1(e) Ratings Based Handicapping Balloting.

- (e) Ratings Based Handicapping Balloting-Method of elimination of surplus horses: Elimination MUST be effected in order from the horse or horses with the lowest Ballot Ratings upwards as follows:
- (i) Horses with the lowest Ballot Rating will be eliminated first
 - (ii) When two or more horses are of the same Ballot Rating oldest will be eliminated first
 - (iii) When two or more horses are of the same Ballot Rating and age elimination, ballot shall be by lowest prize money. (Amended Rule effective 01/10/16)
 - (iv) Unraced horses shall be treated as rating 59 ~~and eliminated according to early season two-year-old races:~~

DON'T FORGET to lodge your notification form!

Notification Forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.

Notification forms for retirement of horses should be completed

Named horse within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse from racing or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Unnamed horse within 1 month of the decision to not commence racing the horse, or within 24 hours of the horse's death.
