Brighton Training Centre Construction Works

Tasracing remind all Brighton participants that Crossroads Civil commence work at 10am sharp to gain maximum use of permitted work hours.

All participants and horses are to be clear of the Crossroads Civil work area by 10am without exception; after 10am Crossroads Civil have right of way and site possession.

If participants make an active choice to disregard Workplace Health and Safety by moving horses past actively working machinery you may become subject to a WHS investigation

All participant vehicles are to be clear of the Crossroads Civil work area and are not to interfere with works being carried out by Crossroads Civil.

Tasracing has received multiple complaints from Crossroads Civil of verbal abuse from participants towards them in the conduct of Tasracing business. This is in addition to the horse manure being moved into the Crossroads Civil work area. This behaviour is not acceptable.

All participants are notified that if the behaviour of abuse or interference with Crossroads continues there is a risk the Brighton Training Centre operation will be impacted while an investigation is conducted.

Tasracing appreciates the impact to training activities of the drainage and road works and ask that we work together to complete the works asap to solve the flooding ahead of winter.
