



CAPITALIST FILLY TOPS SUCCESSFUL TASMANIAN YEARLING SALE

A filly by Capitalist was the star of the show as Grenville Stud graduates led the way at a successful 2023 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale at Quercus Park.

Peter Morgan went to \$115,000 to secure the filly, catalogued as Lot 131, the third foal of the Fastnet Rock mare Sunrise Yellow.

She was one of three yearlings to sell for \$100,000 or more, helping the sale return the second highest figures in history.

All three yearlings were sold through the draft of Grenville Stud.

IT WAS REALLY POSITIVE FOR TASMANIA. THERE WAS A GOOD SPREAD OF BUYERS - NO ONE REALLY GOT IN AND DOMINATED THE MARKET - AND THERE WAS GREAT EQUILIBRIUM WITH THE INTERSTATE PARTICIPANTS AND THE LOCAL BUYERS.

"I have waited all day for her," Morgan said moments after the hammer fell. "I'll probably miss my plane, but they said they'd give me a bed."

"She was all I was coming for as I wasn't coming to the sale, but Graeme McCulloch rang me three times and said, 'you've got to come for this filly', so I thought I'd come down and have a look," Morgan said.

"I jumped on the plane, had a look and we've ended up with her. This is my first time in about five years that I've come down for the sale."

Across the day almost \$4 million was traded on 109 lots sold at an average price of \$36,124 and a clearance rate of 85%.

Tasracing CEO Andrew Jenkins said the 2023 sale was an extremely positive day for the Tasmanian thoroughbred racing and breeding industry.

"It's been a successful day," Jenkins noted.
"To see the locals so active was great and
it bodes well for the future of the industry
in Tasmania."



"The results show the importance of the five-year contract extension that was recently announced between Magic Millions, Tasbreeders and Tasracing."

The gross and average price figures of the 2023 sale are the second best in the history of the sale, while the clearance was the highest of all time.

"It was really positive for Tasmania," Magic Millions Managing Director Barry Bowditch said. "There was a good spread of buyers – no one really got in and dominated the market – and there was great equilibrium with the interstate participants and the local buyers. It felt fairly good throughout the day."

"At the end of the day, Tasmanians bought 50 horses, which is great. They bought half the catalogue and the leading two buyers are local. It is great they have been able to participate (strongly)."

"We will work closely with TasBreeders and Tasracing to continue to strengthen the industry down here." AT A GLANCE:

STARTERS JOB – A FAMILY AFFAIR

When the gates crashed back to release the field for the 2023 Group 3 Ladbrokes Hobart Cup, it was a special moment for David and Justin Evans.

The father and son combination released the Hobart Cup field for the first time in the 2022 edition of the race won by Ho Ho Khan, but David has been on the starter's ladder going back into the 1980's.

"That was around my 32nd Hobart Cup and altogether I've been working on them for nearly 40 years," said David Evans who also works as relief in both Devonport and Launceston.

On a Cup Day with full fields, big crowds and often fizzed up horses, the job of making sure the field is released on time often isn't an easy one.

"The starter is in charge of everyone at the start including jockeys, horses, barrier attendants, the vet and even ambulance crew if they're needed," explained David adding the difficulties that come with managing inexperienced horses, particularly first starters.

Diving into the memory bank, David recalls the 1992 Hobart Cup win of Russian Rogue as one that was particularly troublesome for the starter.

"Russian Rogue had a bad gate that he was standing in, there was a horse a few stalls down from him that kept kicking the back of the gates and Russian Rogue's

gate kept coming open and he would pop through.

"I think he got through three times, and he ended up winning the Cup," David laughed.

More than 30 years on from the Cup win of Russian Rogue, David remains in the starter's position and having his son Justin involved is something he says was a long time in the making.

"I used to work with the TRC (Tasmanian Racing Club) and the boys would come down and play with the barriers that were on the infield for trainers to practice.

I REALLY ENJOY STARTING RACES, YOU GET AN ADRENALINE RUSH AND THERE'S LOT MORE THAT GOES ON BEHIND THE SCENES THAN PEOPLE SEE.

"Nine times out of 10 they'd be in there pretending they were horses and leading each other in, but they couldn't shut the gates they weren't strong enough back then," David laughed referring to Justin and his brother Josh who is also involved in the racing industry in a variety of race day roles.

Justin Evans, who on top of his Assistant Starter position is also Track Steward in Devonport, backs up his father's assessment of his introduction into racing.



"Both sides of the family are involved in racing. Mum is Gary White's (Hall of Fame trainer) sister, so I worked for Uncle Gary for a lot of years before I left school.

"I've been going to the races since before I could walk," said Justin.

David says that having his son as the Assistant Starter has generated a new fulfilment in the starter role which will likely see him release plenty more Cup fields into the future.

"I'm not sure how many more years I'll be doing it for, but I still really enjoy it, particularly now Justin's involved.

"I think Justin will keep doing it while I keep doing it and it's great to have your son follow in your footsteps."


When David does call time on his career, it doesn't sound like the search for a

replacement will need to go very far.

"I really enjoy starting races, you get an adrenaline rush and there's lot more that goes on behind the scenes than people see.

"I'd love to keep on going with it when dad finishes up, whenever that may be," said Justin.







DR MARTIN LENZ CHIEF VETERINARY AND ANIMAL WELFARE OFFICER

Tasracing has appointed Dr Martin Lenz to the newly created position of Chief Veterinary and Animal Welfare Officer.

Dr Lenz will lead Tasracing's work to ensure the organisation meets its animal welfare objectives. One of his principal roles will be to provide advice and services to Tasracing and the Tasmanian racing industry regarding the delivery of animal welfare and veterinary services.

Dr Lenz is highly experienced and well credentialled regulatory veterinarian, having worked in equine veterinary practice in Australia and the United Kingdom, and as a racing vet at the Singapore Turf Club.

In 2007 Dr Lenz started working as the inaugural Veterinary Officer for Racing Queensland, the same year that Equine Influenza broke out (Queensland was one of the two Australian states seriously impacted by the outbreak).

He joins Tasracing after six years as the Director of Veterinary Services and Animal Welfare at the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission and prior to that had worked for Racing Queensland from 2007.

Dr Lenz is passionate about the racing industry and believes that racing's future prosperity is intimately linked to how well the horses and greyhounds at the centre of the industry are looked after.

"I see great potential in our ability to optimise racing animal welfare through life-time traceability, injury monitoring and minimisation and rehoming programs for all racing animals, all of which are strategies designed to maintain and build public trust in this great industry," he said.

"And I am very much looking forward to working with all stakeholders to achieve these outcomes."

Tasracing CEO Andrew Jenkins said animal welfare was a key component of responsible racing.

"Tasracing places the welfare of racing animals across all three codes front and centre of our operational decisions," he said.

"Dr Lenz's appointment to this newly created position will assist us to continue to meet this important obligation and drive further improvement in line with community expectations."

Fillies/Mares When fillies and mares race against male horses they shall receive a 2.0kg weight allowance.

3yo's When 3YO horses race against older horses they shall receive a weight allowance which is a sliding scale that varies from 2.5kg in August to nil by the end of the season. In open races they shall receive a weight allowance at the handicapper's discretion. Some Victorian race columns have been included to provide a guide to the weights a horse might expect to receive in these events.

Unraced horses rated 59 are eligible to compete in Benchmark 62.

NOTICE REGARDING THE DETECTION OF THE BRONCHODILATOR DRUG CLENBUTEROL

The International Screening Limit (ISL) for clenbuterol of 0.1ng/ml in urine has been adopted by Racing Australia and will be implemented by Australian racing laboratories with effect from 1 April 2023.

This will have important implications for the detection of clenbuterol following its administration to racehorses, and will lead to a **prolongation of detection times** for this substance.

The European Horserace Scientific Liaison Committee (EHSLC) has published detection time information for clenbuterol following both oral and nebulised administration. The published detection times of 13 days (oral) and 6 days (nebulised), for the stated dosage regimen and pharmaceutical preparations, are valid for the new ISL to be applied by Australian racing laboratories.

The EHSLC detection time document can be found here; www.ehslc.com/images/uploads/documents/EHSLC_DETECTION_TIMES_(updated_1_February_2021).pdf

It should be noted that the revised detection times for clenbuterol are longer than the 3 - 4 days (oral) and 2 days (nebulised) previously reported, using the analytical methodology at that time, in the Australian Equine Veterinary Association (now Equine Veterinarians Australia - EVA) publication 'Detection of Therapeutic Substances in Racing Horses' ('The White Book').

Veterinarians are therefore advised that recommended withdrawal periods for treatment with clenbuterol (for example, in products including, but not limited to, Airway Gel, Claire Gel, Broncopulmin Powder, Ventipulmin Granules, Ventipulmin Injection and products in combination with trimethoprim and sulfadiazine) must be based on the published EHSLC detection times and not on the previous advice provided in the 'The White Book', and that trainers are warned accordingly.

The EHSLC detection times appear, alongside those previously published in 'The White Book', in the current Equine Veterinarians Australia (EVA) publication 'Equine Medication Detection and Withdrawal Times: A Survey of Veterinarians in Australia'.

It is important to note that a withdrawal (or withholding) period is not the same as a detection period. Any withdrawal period should be calculated based on the published detection time, with the addition of a suitable safety margin based on the circumstances of the administration, including dose, route of administration and preparation administered.

It should also be noted that none of the veterinary preparations containing clenbuterol registered for use in Australia are registered for administration by nebulisation. Such administration therefore represents off-label use of these products.

The screening limit of 0.1ng/mL in urine for clenbuterol will come into effect on 1 April, 2023.

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

Bisphosphonates are drugs that inhibit the normal biological mechanism for bone maintenance/repair, which can lead to an accumulation of micro-damage and bone fragility.

Bisphosphonates can also cause retention of calcified growth cartilage in skeletally immature animals, leading to developmental orthopaedic disease.

To compound these issues, bisphosphonates are potent analgesics and may disguise the signs of underlying serious orthopaedic injuries such as stress fractures in young animals.

Racing Australia advises that, for these reasons, bisphosphonates should never be used in young, skeletally immature, athletic horses.

Racing Australia also notes the ratification of the IFHA position (under Articles 6D and 6E of the International Agreement on Breeding Racing and Wagering), which is to:

- ban the administration of bisphosphonates to horses under the age of 3 years and 6 months; and
- prohibit administration of bisphosphonates to a horse on the day of a race or on any of the 30 days before the day of the race in which the horse is declared to run

Racing Australia believes it is prudent for the Australian rules to adopt an age of 4 years (by calendar year/season of birth) as a more rational way of clearly demarcating to which horses this rule

Accordingly, two new rules restricting the use of bisphosphonates in the racing industry have been introduced in respect of horses aged less than 4 years and 4 vears or older.

1. ADD NEW RULE 88A AS FOLLOWS:

"AR 88A Horses (less than 4 years) treated with bisphosphonates:

- (1) This rule only applies to horses that are aged less than 4 years at the time of the relevant administration or attempted administration.
- (2) A person must not:
- (a) administer:
- (b) cause to be administered:
- (c) attempt to administer; or
- (d) be a party to an administration or attempted administration of, any bisphosphonate to a horse gaed less than 4 years.

- (3) A horse that has been subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate
 - (a) ineligible to participate in any race, official trial, jump-out or trackwork for a minimum of 12 months from the date of administration; and
 - (b) not permitted to race until 1 August of the year the horse turns 4.
- (4) If a horse is subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate:
- (a) the trainer or owner of the horse (or his or her authorised agent) must, as soon as practicable after such administration, notify the Stewards;
- (b) the Stewards shall then ensure that details of such administration and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racina Australia's national online database
- (5) A person must not:
 - (a) enter or run a horse in a race, official trial, jump-out or trackwork in contravention of subrule (3); or
 - (b) fail to notify the Stewards as required by subrule (4)(a).
- (6) It is a defence to a charge laid under subrule (5) that the person was not aware, and should not reasonably have been aware, that the horse had

- been subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate.
- (7) For the purposes of this rule, a bisphosphonate includes but is not limited to tiludronic acid (disodium tiludronate) or clodronic acid (clodronate disodium tetrahydrate).
- (8) Nothing in this rule affects Prohibited List A, which includes zoledronic acid and any other bisphosphonates not reaistered for veterinary use in Australia."

Date of effect: 1 February 2023

2. ADD NEW RULE 88AA AS FOLLOWS:

"AR 88AA Horses (4 years or older) treated with bisphosphonates:

- (1) This rule only applies to horses that are aged 4 years or older at the time of the relevant administration or attempted administration.
- (2) A horse that has been subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate is ineliaible to participate in any race, official trial or jump-out at any time during the 30 clear days following midnight on the day of the administration.


AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING (CONTINUED)

AR 88A & AR 88AA BISPHOSPHONATES

- (3) Where a horse has been nominated and/or entered for a race, official trial or jump-out, a person must not:
- (a) administer;
- (b) cause to be administered;
- (c) attempt to administer; or
- (d) be a party to an administration or attempted administration of, any bisphosphonate to the horse at any time within 30 clear days of the race, official trial or jump-out.
- (4) A trainer must not enter or run a horse in any race, official trial or jump-out where the horse has been subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate during the 30 clear days prior to the day of the race, official trial or jump-out.
- (5) Where:
- (a) a horse has been subjected to an administration of any bisphosphonate at any time during the 30 clear days prior to the day of a race, official trial or jump-out; or
- (b) the Stewards reasonably suspect that there has been such an administration (as referred to in subrule (5)(a)), the Stewards may order the scratching of the horse from the relevant race, official trial or jump-out.

- (6) For the purposes of this rule, a bisphosphonate includes but is not limited to tiludronic acid (disodium tiludronate) or clodronic acid (clodronate disodium tetrahydrate).
- (7) Nothing in this rule affects Prohibited List A, which includes zoledronic acid and any other bisphosphonates not registered for veterinary use in Australia.

STEWARDS SEGMENT

TREATMENT BOOKS

Trainers are reminded of their obligation to record all treatments in a property formatted and maintained treatment record books. Recent inspections have identified deficiencies in this area, and we ask that you comply with this important aspect or our operations.

MATTERS EFFECTING PERFORMANCE

From time-to-time reasons/explanations for a horses disappointing performance may not become evident until after the race meeting has concluded. When such reasons/explanations are found then these should be conveyed to the Stewards. At the same time, it is a reminder to riders to ensure they report anything that may affect the performance of their horse in a trial or race.

TIMELINESS

As racing has become more and more a television spectacle there is a demand on administrators to ensure that we present a product that meets both industry best practice and expectations. From the Stewards end this means ensuring our races start on time and are not delayed by matters that can be avoided. While acknowledging that sometimes we will encounter issues (horses can be unpredictable) with respect to presenting horses in the parade area on time, we nonetheless ask that all trainers place emphasis on ensuring that they are in the parade area by the prescribed time.

BARRIER MANNERS

Over recent months the number of horses requiring to trial because of poor barrier behaviour has increased. The consequence of such bad behaviour is a risk to not only their riders but also to other horses. Additionally, this conduct reflects poorly on the Tasmanian industry Moving forward the Stewards will be taking a stricter approach with respect to barrier conduct the aim being to better protect not only rider and horse, but also provide for a greater overall safety for all participants.

LATE RIDER NOTIFICATIONS

Trainers are advised that if you are finding it difficult to obtain the services of rider, and the declaration deadline has past, then the Stewards must be advised In such instances the Stewards may be able to assist by advising of those riders that may not hare engagements in the race causing difficulty.

TRIALS AND JUMP OUTS

Stewards now manage and monitor the running of jump out alias Ag changes to the jump outs must be approved by Stewards prior to the jump outs being conducted, Stewards, in consultation with Tasracing may make changes to the composition of the jump out fields.

RETIRING YOUR THOROUGHBRED

Notification forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.

THOROUGHBRED BREEDING **INCENTIVE SCHEME**

The TasBred Incentive Scheme commenced in the 2018/19 Racing Season and replaces the tasBonus Incentive Scheme. \$1.54M in bonuses will be on offer to eligible 2, 3 & 4YO horses, distributed across 72* races.

FLIGIBILITY

Yearlings that qualify for the scheme are:

- **TASMANIAN SIRED**
- INTERSTATE SIRED (BREEDBACK) (mare must be Tasmanian owned and was served by a stallion which stood in Tasmania during the following year's breeding season. – based on Australia Stud Book)
- TASMANIAN REARED* (the foal and dam must have resided in Tasmania for at least 6 continuous months between when the foal was born and the foals first birthday as listed by the Australian Stud Book).
 - * Supporting documentation Required.

BONUSES

Offered on 72* Selected Races:

- All 2YO Maiden races
- Selected 2YO Handicaps up to 1400m, under \$30k prizemoney
- All 3YO Maiden races
- Selected 3YO Handicaps up to 1400m, under \$30k prize money
- Selected 2YO/3YO & Up Maidens 1200m, 1400m & 1600m races
- Selected Maiden / Class 1 1600m & 2100m races
- 2 x TASBRED ONLY races with prize money of \$50,000
- Owner and Breeder SuperVOBIS bonus matched for Tasmanian **sired** horses who win in Victorian SuperVOBIS races.

COSTS

TASMANIAN SIRED \$550 (GST INC)

INTERSTATE BRED \$1,100 (GST INC)

TASMANIAN REARED \$1,650 (GST INC)

A one off nomination fee is paid to Tasracing when the horse is a yearling. The horse then becomes eligible for a bonus whilst it is a 2, 3 or 4 year old, for a win in any specified TASBRED nominated race
