Spreyton Raceday Amenities Building Construction Works Sewer Line Alignment Works

Tasracing has taken an unexpected opportunity to commence works on the new sewer line alignment starting this Thursday, 04 May 23 at 0900. Tasracing appreciate that this is short notice and may be of some inconvenience.

For horse and rider safety and to maximise permitted working hours the track will also close at 0900, Monday to Friday until further notice.

The works on the new sewer line alignment will commence near the horse shoe that is adjacent to the mounting yard. The alignment will then proceed in stages rising from the start point toward the day stalls then across between the day stalls and existing raceday amenities building to the grassed area opposite the tavern as shown on the attached drawing. This work is expected to take a number of weeks to complete.

The new sewer line alignment works will not interfere with race day this Sunday, 07 May 23, nor the trials on Tuesday, 09 May 23. Work will commence on Tuesday after the trials have been completed.

Access for horses to the track on raceday and trial day will be from the day stall location down to mounting yard as per normal procedure and as shown on the attached drawing.

Please be aware of moving vehicles and machinery, loud continuous construction noise, open trenches and excavations. Temporary fencing will be erected as the works progress and may be in place for an extended period of time. Please do not breach any temporary fencing.
