Brighton Training Centre Construction Works

Hours of Work & Workplace Health and Safety

Construction works will recommence at Brighton Training Centre on Monday, 03 July 23 and the following hours will apply until further notice.

- 0400 to 1000hrs – Trackwork.
- 0940hrs – Last horse on track.
- 0945hrs – Crossroads Civil commence moving temporary fencing to open up their work area in preparation for 1000hrs construction start.
- 1000hrs – All horses back in respective stables or day stalls area – this is not the time to exit the track as machinery will be starting at the same time.
- 1000hrs – All vehicles in the vicinity of the stables, located along the stable road are to be relocated to the top car park.
- 1000hrs – Crossroads Civil start machines and commence construction work.
- 1730 to 1800hrs – Crossroads Civil close of work, reinstatement of temporary fencing with machinery permitted to remain behind temporary fencing each day.
- Bullring and Pool remain open during the works with due care and consideration on behalf of the trainer/participant in moving the horse past active machinery.
- Vet access to stables is unrestricted.
- Construction work will allow for loading and unloading of horses for weekday trials and race days.

Tasracing has engaged security personnel for the duration of the construction works to ensure adequate separation of trainers/participants and Crossroads Civil during the construction works.

Workplace Health and Safety is everyone's responsibility. The minimum legislated requirement of all people on a Tasracing site is that you do not put yourself nor other people in any form of risk or danger. Tasracing security will report any incidents or near misses which will be investigated fully.

All persons on site at Brighton Training Centre are to be aware that there will be loud trucks, excavators, rock breaking, vibrations and use of loud power tools during the construction works. All persons in control of horses are to take adequate preparation for their horses during the construction period in full knowledge of the construction environment noises.

Please report any concerns to the Tasracing security representative or the BTC track manager in the first instance.
