Spreyton Raceday Amenities Building Construction Works Participant Accommodation from Wednesday, 19 July 23 onwards

The trials at Spreyton on Tuesday, 18 July 23 will be the final use of the existing raceday amenities building at Spreyton. Please ensure that all personal possessions have been removed from the existing building at the completion of the day's events.

From Wednesday, 19 July 23 onwards the temporary accommodation, located in the large car park as per the attached drawing, will be in use for the following groups:

- Office of Racing Integrity (ORI),
- Female Jockeys,
- Male Jockeys, and
- Stride Master attendant

All buildings will be signposted.

There is no unauthorised entry to the temporary accommodation compound. Access to the temporary accommodation compound is restricted to those people who would normally access the existing raceday amenities building.

The weigh in scales will be located with ORI in the temporary accommodation compound or other location as directed by ORI.

The StrideMaster saddle cloths will be located with the StrideMaster attendant in the temporary accommodation compound or other location as directed by ORI or StrideMaster.

Please be aware the ORI have complete authority and control over the temporary compound during race day and other events and all personnel are to comply with ORI directions during these times.
