RACE INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Information on the race and how to enter form part of these terms and conditions. By nominating a horse in the Beautide, the trainer/s and owner/s of the horse agree to be bound by these conditions.

| Race Details | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name: The Beautide • Date: Saturday, 5 August 2023 • Location: Elwick Racecourse • Field size: 10 runners plus 2 emergencies • The Tasracing Eureka Selection Panel (TESP), comprising of the Director of Racing, Chairman of Stewards and Office of Racing Integrity staff, Tasracing CEO and Tasracing staff, will be responsible for the selection of the field of the Beautide. The Director of Racing will have ultimate responsibility for controlling the final field. • Winner of the Beautide will fill Tasracing’s slot in the TAB Eureka – The World’s Richest Harness Race on 2 September 2023 at Menangle Park in NSW. |
| Core Eligibility Criteria | <p>Eligibility to nominate a horse in the Beautide is based on meeting Horse Criteria 1; and <u>EITHER</u> Horse Criteria 2 <u>OR</u> the Owner/Trainer Criteria.</p> <p>Details are below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HORSE CRITERIA 1 - Horses must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Three or Four Year Old Australian Bred Standardbred Pacers who are authorised to race in Australia</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ‘Australian Bred’ means the progeny of a Mare registered in the Australian Trotting Stud Book and domiciled in Australia when served by a Stallion who is also registered in the Australian Trotting Stud Book at the time of that service. • HORSE CRITERIA 2 - Horses must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>TASBRED foals in accordance with the definition in Tasracing’s Harness Breeders Support Policy in section 2.5.</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A copy of the Policy is located in Schedule 1 of these terms and conditions. • OWNER/TRAINER CRITERIA: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>All owners of the horse must be Tasmanian residents and have owned the horse for at least 12 months prior to the Eureka Race (2 September 2023); AND</u> ○ <u>The horse must be trained by a licensed Tasmanian trainer for no less than six (6) months prior to the Eureka Race (2 September 2023).</u> |
| Discretionary Eligibility Criteria | <p>All nominations in the Beautide meeting the Core Eligibility Criteria will also be subject to discretionary criteria to be applied by the TESP.</p> |

| | <p>The TESP will make a decision in its sole discretion on which horses are selected to participate in the Beautide, and will consider, but is not limited to, the following criteria in addition to the Core Eligibility Criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prizemoney earned in the twelve (12) months precedent the closing of nominations. • Horses demonstrating progressive form in the current season. • Horses that have performed strongly in a group race in the prior or current season. • Winner or placed performance in a feature race(s) in the current season. |
| Nomination Details | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominations will open at 9.30am on Monday, 17 July 2023. • Nominations will close at 9.30am on Monday, 31 July 2023. |
| Runners | The horses that are selected to participate in the Beautide will be announced by media release on Monday, 31 July 2023. |
| Prize Details | <p>\$80,000.00 prizemoney in total</p> <p>1st - \$40,000.00 + Tasracing TAB Eureka slot and \$5,000 towards transportation 2nd - \$17,000.00 + \$5,000 towards transportation if participating in 'The Singo' 3rd - \$10,000.00 4th - \$5,000.00 5th - \$3,000.00 6th - 10th - \$1,000</p> <p>Prizemoney is paid to the trainer/s and owner/s of horses that obtain the above placings in accordance with trainer and owner registration details recorded in the national Racing Information Services Enterprise (RISE) system.</p> |
| If First Place cannot participate in TAB Eureka | <p>In the event that the horse of the trainer/s and owner/s that wins first place in the Beautide cannot participate in the TAB Eureka on 2 September 2023 for any reason, the second placed horse in the Beautide will fill Tasracing's slot at the TAB Eureka (if this can be achieved before nominations for the TAB Eureka close – Friday, 25 August 2023, and as otherwise in accordance with the TAB Eureka race conditions). The same procedure will follow if the second placed horse in the Beautide cannot participate in the TAB Eureka in lieu of the first placed horse (i.e. the third placed horse in the Beautide will fill Tasracing's slot at the TAB Eureka) and so on and so forth.</p> <p>Note, there will be no changes in prize money if the horse that wins first place in the Beautide does not participate in the TAB Eureka. However, the additional \$5,000 towards transportation will need to be repaid by the trainer of the first placed horse at Tasracing's request.</p> |
| Second Place | <p>If the horse that finishes in second place in the Beautide is nominated and accepted to participate in the new 2400m race called "The Singo" at Club Menangle in NSW on 19 August 2023, Tasracing will pay \$5,000 to the trainer of the horse on presentation of evidence of registration in 'The Singo'.</p> <p>However, the additional \$5,000 towards transportation will need to be repaid by the trainer of the second placed horse at Tasracing's request if the horse does not subsequently participate in "The Singo".</p> |
| Scratchings | Emergencies selected by the TESP will replace any selected runners that are scratched from the Beautide. |

| | <p>In the event that there are more scratchings than emergency runners, the TESP will select which horses replace those runners using the eligibility criteria.</p> <p>The Director of Racing will ultimately control decisions regarding scratchings.</p> |
| Dead Heat | <p>In the event of a Dead Heat, where two runners cross the finish line at the same time and no one winner or placeholder can be determined between the horses, the prizemoney for that placing will be split evenly between the connections of the horses in question.</p> <p>If there is a Dead Heat for first place, The TESP, with ultimate decision-making coming from the Director of Racing, will decide which horse will fill Tasracing's slot at the TAB Eureka with the trainer/s receiving \$5,000 towards transportation costs, in its sole discretion.</p> <p>If there is a Dead Heat for second place, The TESP, with ultimate decision-making coming from the Director of Racing, will decide which trainer will receive \$5,000 towards transportation costs if their horse is nominated and is accepted into 'The Singo', in its sole discretion.</p> |
| Funding | <p>The trainer of the horse that wins the Beautide will receive \$5,000.00 from Tasracing towards transportation costs in relation to the TAB Eureka.</p> |

FURTHER DETAILS

1. **Nominations:** Tasracing Pty Ltd (**Tasracing**) accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected nomination entries or other communications. Tasracing assumes no responsibility for any failure to receive a nomination, inaccurate information or any loss, damage or injury as a result of technical or telecommunications problems (including security breaches, theft or destruction), any cause beyond Tasracing's control, or unauthorised access to or alteration to nominations. If any of these events occur, Tasracing may (subject to any directions from relevant authorities) modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Beautide. Further, Tasracing at its sole discretion may recommence the Beautide under the same conditions.
2. **Unavailability of Prizes:** If any prize (or portion of a prize) becomes unavailable for any reasons beyond Tasracing's control, including but not limited to, technical difficulties, or unauthorised intervention, Tasracing may substitute a prize (or portion of a prize) of equal or greater value (subject to any directions from relevant authorities). No compensation will be offered if such event occurs.
3. **Suspension/modification:** In the event of war, terrorism, pandemic, state of emergency, or disaster, Tasracing reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Beautide, or suspend or modify a prize.
4. **Owner/trainer details:** It is the obligation of the trainer/s and owner/s of horses participating in the Beautide to ensure that their details are up-to-date in the RISE system.
5. **Identity:** If there is a dispute as to the identity of a trainer or owner of horse nominated for the Beautide, Tasracing reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the trainer or owner.
6. **No liability:** Tasracing shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered or sustained (even if caused by negligence) as a result of using a prize or in relation to participation in the Beautide, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. Tasracing and its associated

agencies and companies will not be liable for any damage, loss or delay in transit regarding the prize.

7. **TAB Eureka:** One of the prizes for first place in the Beautide is Tasracing's slot in the TAB Eureka. That slot is subject to the race conditions for the TAB Eureka as set by HRA Events Pty Ltd, Harness Racing NSW and New South Wales Harness Racing Club. Tasracing is not responsible or liable for any loss, damage or injury suffered as a result of the conduct of any third-party in the TAB Eureka.
8. **Image/video consent:** Trainer/s and owner/s of horses participating in the Beautide consent to Tasracing using their image and/or voice in any media for an unlimited period of time without remuneration for the purpose of promoting the Beautide or the TAB Eureka (including any outcome) and/or promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by Tasracing, and/or any future events promoted by Tasracing.
9. **Personal information:** The personal information of the trainer/s and/or owner/s of horses nominated for the Beautide will be collected and used for the purposes of conducting the race (which may include disclosure to third parties, the Tasracing's related bodies corporate, agencies and contractors for the purpose of processing and conducting the Beautide) and for promotional purposes, public statements and advertisements surrounding this race. By entering the Beautide, the owner/s and trainer/s consent to the use of their information as described and agree that Tasracing may use this information, or disclose it to other organisations that may use it, in any media for future promotional purposes without any further reference or payment to the person. Tasracing is bound by the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth). A copy of Tasracing's privacy policy can be viewed on tasracingcorporate.com.au. 10. **General:** Nothing in these terms and conditions affects the jurisdiction of the Office of Racing Integrity in harness racing or the Australian Harness Racing Rules and Regulations. Where there is an inconsistency between these conditions and the jurisdiction of the Office of Racing Integrity/HRA Rules, the latter will prevail. These conditions only relate to selection of the horses to participate in the Beautide in 2023 and not for future eligibility races to determine which horse fills the Tasmanian TAB Eureka slot in future years. Tasracing reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions in its sole discretion. In this event, an updated copy of the terms and conditions will be displayed on Tasracing's website.
