TAYLOR MADE FOR COMEBACK

THERE'S A SAYING THAT TO BECOME A CHAMPION, YOU FIRST NEED TO OVERCOME ADVERSITY.

For apprentice Taylor Johnstone, a trackwork injury in January this year created her first major absence from the saddle since she debuted in 2021.

"I snapped my collarbone clean in half and it's the first broken bone I've ever had," Johnstone said.

The injury came at an inopportune time for Johnstone who has established herself as one of Tasmania's leading apprentices and had her sights firmly on the apprentice title for the 2022/23 season.

Despite the layoff, Johnstone hasn't given up hope of a maiden premiership, hoping to chase down the leader Chelsea Baker in the latter part of the season.

"Chelsea's leading the premiership at the moment but she's not too far in front, so it is possible to get back and see if I have a chance of winning it."

True to her word, Johnstone returned to race riding at the 28 May meeting in Hobart and landed a winner with promising mare Ole Ola for trainer Scott Brunton.



With seven meetings remaining in the season, Baker has a six-win lead over Johnstone for the apprentice' title, and both jockeys' comfortably sit inside the top 10 for the overall premiership.

Johnstone says the break from riding only made her appreciate how much she enjoys being a jockey.

"I just tried to get back into it as quick as I can, and the time off has made me realise just how much I love my job."

Taylor's hard work was rewarded with the opportunity to partner the Scott Brunton-trained First Accused in a Saturday race at Sandown on 10 June. While the horse finished unplaced, it was fitting that Johnstone had the experience as her collarbone injury forced her to miss representing Tasmania in the 2023 National Apprentice Race Series (NARS), where ironically, she was set to ride for the state at a Sandown meeting back in April.

"It was my first time riding out of Tasmania and it was a great experience.

"Everyone was just so helpful."

Armidale Stud is a picturesque property which consists of 1000 acres of prime country in central North Tasmania nestled between the junction of the Liffey and Meander Rivers near Launceston.

Armidale Stud has been part of the Wishaw family since 1919. It is now under the guidance of Managing Director David Wishaw and his wife Rhiannon Wishaw, who serves as the racing and bloodstock manager.

Armidale Stud is where yearling manager James Green, for just over eighteen months, has left a profession in podiatry to follow his passion for thoroughbreds.

It has been a whirlwind week for Green, and he admits that he's feeling a 'little rusty' on Friday when travelling home to Tasmania.

With most of the bloodstock world clustered on the Gold Coast for the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, others travelled to the Gold Coast to celebrate the finalists of the 2023 Stable and Stud

Awards on Wednesday night hosted by the Gold Coast Turf Club.

Among the seven categories awarded is the Newcomer, sponsored by Lindy Maurice's Thoroughbred Industry Careers (TIC) and Marcus Oldham, whose recipient has worked in the industry for less than three years; the winner was Green.

Honoured to receive such a prestigious award so early in his career, with a chuckle, Green added, "Obviously, I am thrilled to have won and been recognised, but I didn't even know the Godolphin Stud and Staff Awards existed until I was nominated.

"Eighteen months into my career, the furthest thing from my mind was an award, and I never thought I'd even be nominated for something, let alone win it."

CAREER CHANGE

As Green described, the furthest thing a 'naive 18-year-old' would have been a profound career change from podiatry to thoroughbreds.

"Working with thoroughbreds was never on the radar as a young person. My parents pushed me to have a nice solid career and a stable income. As a naive 18-year-old, I thought podiatry could be an interesting career, so I did my four years at university and went straight into the profession."

Although, it turned out podiatry was not Green's true calling in life and deciding to take a seachange.

"I entered the thoroughbred workforce because I had a passion for racing and wanted to learn more. My parents bred a few cows when I was younger, and that process interested me.

"But I thought I had to raise all the money from sitting in my podiatry office, but I took a chance to gain hands-on knowledge, and the Wishaw family gave me the opportunity."

Green admits he is much happier now working with the horses daily but that the industry ran much differently than expected.

"I think I had this naive idea that I could get into the horses, learn how the breeding side works, invest a bit of money, and try to make some money, and it would all just work.

"MY GOAL IN THE FUTURE IS TO INVEST IN BLOODSTOCK, I WOULD LOVE MY OWN BROODMARES, BUT I REALISE SOME OF THE DIFFICULTIES NOW, BUT I'M SLOWLY CHIPPING AWAY AT IT."

Despite the pitfalls and tragedies in among the triumphs of breeding thoroughbreds, Green wouldn't have it any other way.

"Once I got involved here at Armidale, I enjoyed it so much that I'm working on the farm full time."

GREEN STICKING WITH BREEDING

Green has been entrusted as the yearling manager at the Wishaws' farm, with paddocks that have raised the likes of the champion, Mystic Journey, a daughter of the Armidale Stud's very own Needs Further, and the multiple Group 1-placed Soul Patch are just some of the names produced under the Armidale Stud banner.

It is no small feat for Green but one he takes all in his stride.

It's a small team at Armidale Stud; we all pitch in where we can. Currently, as it's wintertime, things are a bit quieter at the moment. I'm just working with the team day-to-day.

"We have just finished the weaning process with our weanling crop, so now we are preparing to start educating our weanlings, which, of course, will become our next crop of yearlings. My role will be overseeing that process and ensuring our stock is heading in the right direction.

"I JUST LOVE WATCHING THE STOCK DEVELOP AND THEN AS A TEAM TRYING TO PLACE THEM WHERE THEY WILL FIT BEST AT THE SALES. WE ARE A SMALL FAMILY-RUN BUSINESS, SO DAVID AND RHIANNON (WHISHAW) MAKE THE FINAL CALL AT THE TOP, BUT I'M GETTING INCREASINGLY INVOLVED IN THAT SIDE OF THE BUSINESS, WHICH I REALLY APPRECIATE."

Green, extremely humble, laughed and said, "When I first started, I was petrified of the horses. At the time, I didn't know how to respond to the horses' behaviour.

"My first yearling preparation, I reckon I barely kept my head above water the first couple of days. I would have loved and wished there was footage of my first yearling preparation compared to

my development now, and I think the difference would be great to look at."

Quickly getting over the fear of horses and proving to be quite the natural, Green has even handled the resident stallions at Armidale Stud, Needs Further and Alpine Eagle.

"I have handled the stallions Needs Further and Alpine Eagle. Jayden Schueddekopf is our stallion manager, so he handles most things in that department. However, I have done my fair share of work with the boys."

Green is always eager to thank and share his appreciation to David and Rhiannon Wishaw for a life-changing opportunity.

"David and Rhiannon are incredibly passionate about their farm, team and business. They have helped and taught me so many things and continue to do so, and they keep me motivated and focused.

"I'm very thankful for the opportunities they have given me."

Green inspires those feeling unfulfilled in their current occupations and reminds

them that a career change, albeit scary at times, is always possible and with passion, dedication and open mind, you can thrive and succeed.

The thoroughbred industry has gained a name it will likely see around for a long time.

I am so excited for our future together as Crystal is only four years old. I am so excited to share our lives together for many years into the future.

I rode OTTs in my teenage years at pony club and now I'm in my 40's and back enjoying this wonderful, versatile breed. I feel so lucky to be chosen to have my gem Crystal and provide her with a life after racing.

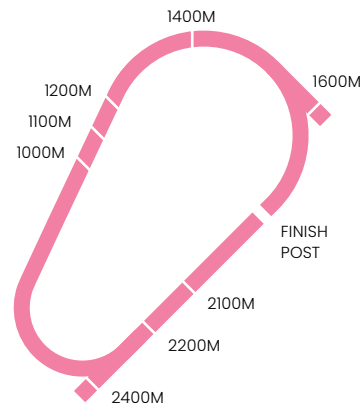

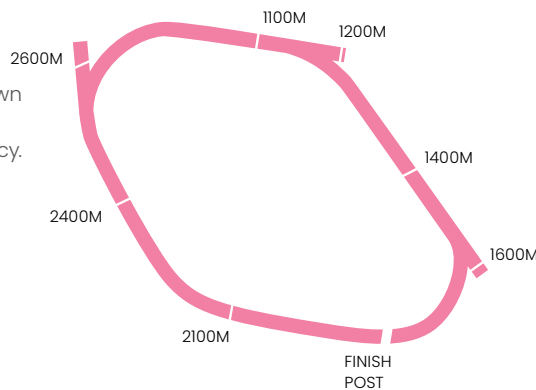

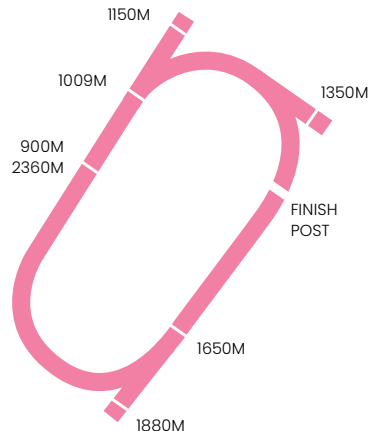

Instructions Follow the line across from the rating to find the weight a horse would carry in the various race-type columns.

Fillies/Mares When fillies and mares race against male horses they shall receive a 2.0kg weight allowance.

3yo's When 3YO horses race against older horses they shall receive a weight allowance which is a sliding scale that varies from 2.5kg in August to nil by the end of the season. In open races they shall receive a weight allowance at the handicapper's discretion. Some Victorian race columns have been included to provide a guide to the weights a horse might expect to receive in these events.

Unraced horses rated 59 are eligible to compete in Benchmark 62.

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

EFFECTIVE 1 JUNE 2023

CODES OF PRACTICE

HORSES RETURNING FROM EXTENDED LAYOFFS/INJURIES, 12 YEAR OLD HORSES & REINSTATEMENT OF RETIRED HORSES

Summary:

Racing Australia has introduced nationally consistent policies to address the following issues:

1. Horses that have not started in a race for 12 months or longer – returning to training and racing;
2. Horses that have experienced a cardiac arrhythmia after a race – returning to training and racing;
3. Horses that have suffered a major fracture and/or undergone major orthopaedic surgery – mandatory reporting and returning to training and racing;
4. Horses aged 12 years – pre- and post-race veterinary inspections; and
5. Horses that have been retired from racing – reinstatement for training and racing.

Each of these policies seek to improve horse welfare outcomes by clearly defining the protocols that must be adhered to when a horse is returning to training/racing after an extended period or serious injury.

These policies are given force under the Rules of Racing as Racing Australia Codes of Practice. While participants

have general obligations to comply with such Codes and may be penalised for non-compliance (see AR 16 and AR 233), new rules have been introduced to impose specific obligations regarding participants' compliance with these new Codes, as follows:

- New AR 88B in Part 5 – Eligibility of horses to race, Division 2 – Restrictions/exclusions in relation to participation of horses in races etc for 1-3 above;
- Amendments to AR 78 for 4 above; and
- Amendments to AR 297 for 5 above.

1. ADD NEW RULE 88B AS FOLLOWS UNDER PART 5 – ELIGIBILITY OF HORSES TO RACE DIVISION 2 – RESTRICTIONS/EXCLUSIONS IN RELATION TO PARTICIPATION OF HORSES IN RACES ETC:

AR 88B Horses returning from extended layoffs, injuries etc.

- (1) Where a horse has not participated in a race for 12 months or more, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Horses that have not started for 12+ months (as amended from time to time) in respect of any future running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out.
- (2) Where a horse is detected with a cardiac arrhythmia, or where a cardiac arrhythmia has been identified, following a race, official trial, jump-out,

or at any other time, including, but not limited to, following track work, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must;

- (a) report the detection or identification of a cardiac arrhythmia to the Stewards without delay, and
- (b) comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Cardiac arrhythmias detected during post-race inspections (as amended from time to time) in respect of any future training of the horse and/or running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out.
- (3) Where a horse has sustained a major fracture and/or undergone major orthopaedic surgery, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Compulsory reporting of major fractures, orthopaedic surgery and approval of affected horses to return to racing (as amended from time to time) in respect of reporting such events and any future training of the horse and/or running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out. For the purposes of this subrule, "major fracture" and "major orthopaedic surgery" have the meanings given to them in the Code of Practice.

Date of Effect: 1 June 2023

2. AMEND AR 78 AS FOLLOWS:

AR 78 12+ year old horses.

- (2) The Stewards may give their express permission for a horse aged 12 years to start in a race/s during its 12 year old racing season, if:
 - (a) the trainer provides to the Stewards a veterinary report in respect of the horse's condition and suitability to race, and any other information, examination or report as required by the Stewards;
 - (b) the trainer complies with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Veterinary Inspections for 12 year old horses (as amended from time to time); and
 - (c) the Stewards are satisfied that the horse is suitable to race.

Date of Effect: 1 June 2023

3. AMEND AR 297 AS FOLLOWS:

AR 297 Decision to retire named horse

- (3) If a horse ceases to be eligible to race or be trained under this rule, a person must not reinstate the horse to race or be trained without unless he or she complies with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Reinstatement of a retired racehorse (as amended from time to time) and obtains the express permission of a PRA or the Stewards.

Date of Effect: 1 June 2023

STEWARDS SEGMENT

RETURNING TO THE MOUNTING YARD

Riders are reminded that when returning to the mounting yard that the first five placegetters are to return to the gate allocated at each track. This assists in managing the number of horses in the yard at any one time, not only for the welfare of the animals but the safety of all participants.

BARRIER MANNERS

Over recent months the number of horses requiring to trial because of poor barrier behaviour has increased. The consequence of such bad behaviour is a risk to not only their riders but also to other horses. Additionally, this conduct reflects poorly on the Tasmanian industry. Moving forward the Stewards will be taking a stricter approach with respect to barrier conduct with the aim being to better protect not only rider and horse, but also provide for a greater overall safety for all participants.

LATE RIDER NOTIFICATIONS

Trainers are advised that if you are finding it difficult to obtain the services of a rider, and the declaration deadline has past, then the Stewards must be advised. In such instances the Stewards may be able to assist by advising of those riders that may not have engagements in the race causing difficulty.

RIDER DECLARATION

Riders must be declared by the time listed in the calendar. This is usually 12.00pm on acceptance day, however this may be extended at the Stewards' discretion if there has been a delay in releasing the fields. Trainers are liable to be fined if they do not declare a rider by the prescribed time. If a trainer advises the Stewards

prior to 12.00pm that they are having trouble finding a rider and the stewards deem that the reasons are genuine, late declaration will be permitted.

PLATES AND TIPS – TRIALS & RACEDAYS

Trainers are responsible at all times for ensuring horses with racing engagements including trials comply with the following requirements. A horse cannot start in a race or trial unless it is fully shod with plates or tips. Any breach of this rule stewards will immediately scratch the horse from the trial or race and penalties will be imposed. This falls under Australian Rule of Racing ARI07 Plates and Tips, and is also covered under Local Rule 25.15(b).

OVERWEIGHTS

Jockeys are permitted to ride 1kg overweight only at the minimum weight of 54kg with the permission of the Stewards. Jockeys are permitted to ride 0.5kg overweight at the allotted weight to a ceiling of 57kg with the permission of the Stewards. In both instances, permission will only be granted following the approval from connections of the horse which the rider must first obtain prior to seeking approval from the Stewards.

MATTERS EFFECTING PERFORMANCE

From time-to-time reasons/explanations for a horses disappointing performance may not become evident until after the race meeting has concluded. When such reasons/explanations are found then these should be conveyed to the Stewards. At the same time, it is a reminder to riders to ensure they report anything to the stewards that may affect the performance of their horse in a race or trial.

RETIRING YOUR THOROUGHBRED

Notification forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.
