NOTHING WACKO ABOUT JACKO'S DEBUT

FIRST RIDE. FIRST WINNER.
THE RACING CAPER IS EASY, ISN'T IT?

The John Blacker-trained Rigoletto delivered a dream debut for 17-year-old apprentice jockey Jackson Radley when he won a maiden/class 1 over 1600m in Hobart on 13 August.

Indentured to the Longford-based Blacker, Radley began his career with the same restrictions imposed on most new apprentice riders, limiting them to two rides per meeting.

Entering the race in solid form, Blacker thought he'd found the right horse to give Jackson the perfect start to his riding career.

"I thought this was the best horse (Rigoletto) for him to start off on, and luckily it was his first ride.

"For a kid having his first ride, I thought he rode him nine out of 10," said Blacker after the race.

Radley had been riding since an extremely young age and has achieved a lot in the equestrian field, including a second placing in the under-15 rider class at the national championships in 2019, before turning his attention to the racetrack.

"There wasn't really a decision to become a jockey.

"I just started riding track work, and it went from there," said Radley.

Also debuting on the same Hobart program was mature-age apprentice

Ryota (Rocky) Morimoto, who was able to land a third placing aboard \$14 chance I'm Back in a BM60.

Approaching two months of race riding, Morimoto is still chasing his first winner, unfortunately being on the wrong side of some close finishes aboard the Leanne Gaffney-trained Cornelian Bay.

In the final race on the 24 September program in Devonport, Radley and Morimoto delivered the quinella as Jackson was able to partner Rodrick's Secret home for his master, while Rocky had to settle for a fast-finishing second on Cornelian Bay.

Tasmanian Apprentice Jockey Coach Stephen Maskiell is happy with the progress of both apprentices as they begin to forge their careers.

"Rocky hasn't ridden a winner, but if you closely study his most recent rides, he hasn't done much wrong," said Maskiell.

"He's desperate for a win, but you just keep reinforcing that he's going well, and the results will come.

STRIDES BEING MADE IN ANIMAL WELFARE

Stridemaster has been a staple of Tasmanian thoroughbred racing for the best part of a decade, providing valuable sectional times and horse stride efficiency data.

Most people wouldn't know that Stridemaster also provides a product called StrideSAFE which is in the evaluation phase with Tasracing's Chief Veterinary & Animal Welfare Officer, Martin Lenz.

Injury prevention is the platform's primary objective, using data to identify changes in a horse's action that may indicate an existing or impending injury.

"StrideSAFE provides a traffic light system which flags potential at risk horses," said Martin Lenz.

"STRIDESAFE PROVIDES A TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM WHICH FLAGS POTENTIAL AT RISK HORSES."

"We then review the horse's performance in conjunction with stewards reports and race-day vets to validate the accuracy of the StrideSAFE report," Lenz added.

While the system is currently in the review phase, it is the intent that StrideSAFE will become a key component in preventing horse injury before it occurs.

Tasracing continues to work hard to expand and develop the Off the Track (OTT) program for those horses at the end of their racing careers.

Demand for retired racehorses is being stimulated within the equestrian community through Tasracing's sponsorship of OTT classes at a variety of equestrian events and competitions throughout the competition season.

The OTT team will also be a prominent feature in the Tasracing marquis at this year's Hobart Show.

To help aid a newly-retired racehorse's transition to a new discipline and assist in building a strong bond between horse and rider, 10 free lessons with a Tasracing-sponsored OTT coach are being provided for every retired Tasmanian racehorse. Last financial year, 84 applicants were approved for the OTT free lessons program.

To aid the growth of the program, Tasracing has begun a process to recruit new OTT coaches, expanding from the existing 3 coaches.

The successful new candidates will cover a wider range of equestrian disciplines and greater spread of geographical areas, which will enhance the program



and facilitate the transition of more retired OTT horses and riders into their new disciplines.

In addition to those initiatives, a Code of Practice for Equine Welfare is in the latter stages of stakeholder consultation. This Code will cover all aspects of racehorse care including feed, water, accommodation, health, transport and retirement, and will set enforceable minimum standards of welfare for all Tasmanian Thoroughbred and Standardbred racehorses

Recommendations from the recently released Interim Murrihy Report are being incorporated into the latest draft with an

expectation that the final Code will be released early in 2024.

LADBROKES HORSE OF THE YEAR? IT'S INEVITABLE.

To the surprise of absolutely no one, The Inevitable was crowned the 2022/23 Ladbrokes Tasmanian Horse of the Year at the annual Thoroughbred Awards in Launceston on 13 October.

In a career full of highlights, the 2022/23 season was arguably The Inevitable's best yet, winning all six of his Tasmanian starts, with five of them coming at Listed level.

The national audience then recognised his performances at home when he secured enough fan votes to take his place in the \$5 million All-Star Mile at Moonee Valley in March. The Inevitable did all his connections proud that day, finishing third and less than a length behind Mr Brightside, who has since established himself as arguably the best horse in the country.

The story of The Inevitable is an inspirational one. The eight-year-old gelded son of Dundeel and Gift Bouquet was almost considered too small to be a racehorse. Still, early on in his career, it quickly became apparent his racing ability far outweighed his small stature and that the \$90,000 2017 Adelaide Magic Millions purchase may eventually end up a shrewd buy.

Entering the 2022/23 season, there was little indication of what was to

come. Despite winning the 2021 Listed Conquering Stakes, either side of that performance were narrow defeats in the Newmarket and Tasmanian Stakes, races that The Inevitable would win with ease 12 months later.

In the care of Scott Brunton and Tegan Keys at Seven Mile Beach, a few changes to The Inevitable's training routine were part of his regaining peak form.

"We thought we would give him a go over the jumps, and we just made some out in the forest, and now he actually loves jumping," said Tegan Keys.

"WE THOUGHT WE WOULD GIVE HIM A GO OVER THE JUMPS, AND WE JUST MADE SOME OUT IN THE FOREST, AND NOW HE ACTUALLY LOVES JUMPING."

With wins in the Goodwood, Newmarket, Conquering, Tasmanian Stakes, Thomas Lyons and Hellova Street, The Inevitable produced a season without peer, which may take a long time, if ever, to be replicated.

"There's a big crew of owners, and we didn't think we'd be going to the places that the little fella has taken us to," said managing owner Richard Robinson.

"He's taken us on a wonderful journey."

The Ladbrokes Horse of the Year title is the second for The Inevitable, who shared the owners with Mystic Journey for the 2019/20 season.

The other Horse of the Year winners for 2022/23 were Bello Beau, who added the

three-year-old crown to the title he won last year, and Needs Sugar won a tight contest for the top two-year-old.

Feature Race Conditions of Entry

Horses declared to be emergencies and which fail to gain a start, or horses which are eliminated under the balloting conditions are still liable for the nomination fees and only the declaration of acceptance fee will be refunded.

Acceptance fees must be paid prior to the horse starting. However, Tasracing may in its absolute discretion eliminate any horse or horses from this race and/or exclude any horse or horses from the operation of the preceding elimination conditions.

Tasracing reserves the right from time to time to alter the date of running, to make any alteration or modification to this race, to cancel the meeting or any portion thereof, to alter time for taking entries or acceptances, also the right to reject at any time any entry submitted to and for them.

Penalties

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING EFFECTIVE 1 JUNE 2023

CODES OF PRACTICE

HORSES RETURNING FROM EXTENDED LAYOFFS/INJURIES, 12 YEAR OLD HORSES & REINSTATEMENT OF RETIRED HORSES

Summary:

Racing Australia has introduced nationally consistent policies to address the following issues:

- Horses that have not started in a race for 12 months or longer – returning to training and racing;
- Horses that have experienced a cardiac arrhythmia after a race – returning to training and racing;
- Horses that have suffered a major fracture and/or undergone major orthopaedic surgery – mandatory reporting and returning to training and racing;
- 4. Horses aged 12 years pre- and postrace veterinary inspections; and
- Horses that have been retired from racing – reinstatement for training and racing.

Each of these policies seek to improve horse welfare outcomes by clearly defining the protocols that must be adhered to when a horse is returning to training/racing after an extended period or serious injury.

These policies are given force under the Rules of Racing as Racing Australia Codes of Practice. While participants have general obligations to comply with such Codes and may be penalised for non-compliance (see AR 16 and AR 233), new rules have been introduced to impose specific obligations regarding participants' compliance with these new Codes, as follows:

- New AR 88B in Part 5 Eligibility of horses to race, Division 2 – Restrictions/ exclusions in relation to participation of horses in races etc for 1-3 above;
- Amendments to AR 78 for 4 above; and
- Amendments to AR 297 for 5 above.

1. ADD NEW RULE 88B AS FOLLOWS UNDER PART 5 – ELIGIBILITY OF HORSES TO RACE DIVISION 2 – RESTRICTIONS/EXCLUSIONS IN RELATION TO PARTICIPATION OF HORSES IN RACES ETC:

AR 88B Horses returning from extended layoffs, injuries etc.

- (1) Where a horse has not participated in a race for 12 months or more, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Horses that have not started for 12+ months (as amended from time to time) in respect of any future running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out.
- (2) Where a horse is detected with a cardiac arrhythmia, or where a cardiac arrhythmia has been identified, following a race, official trial, jump-out,

or at any other time, including, but not limited to, following track work, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must;

- (a) report the detection or identification of a cardiac arrhythmia to the Stewards without delay, and
- (b) comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Cardiac arrhythmias detected during postrace inspections (as amended from time to time) in respect of any future training of the horse and/or running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out.
- (3) Where a horse has sustained a major fracture and/or undergone major orthopaedic surgery, the trainer and any other person in charge of the horse must comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Compulsory reporting of major fractures, orthopaedic surgery and approval of affected horses to return to racing (as amended from time to time) in respect of reporting such events and any future training of the horse and/or running of the horse in a race, official trial or jump-out. For the purposes of this subrule, "major fracture" and "major orthopaedic surgery" have the meanings given to them in the Code of Practice.

Date of Effect: 1 June 2023

2. AMEND AR 78 AS FOLLOWS:

AR 78 12+ year old horses.

- (2) The Stewards may give their express permission for a horse aged 12 years to start in a race/s during its 12 year old racing season, if:
- (a) the trainer provides to the Stewards a veterinary report in respect of the horse's condition and suitability to race, and any other information, examination or report as required by the Stewards;
- (b) the trainer complies with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Veterinary Inspections for 12 year old horses (as amended from time to time); and
- (c) the Stewards are satisfied that the horse is suitable to race.



3. AMEND AR 297 AS FOLLOWS:

AR 297 Decision to retire named horse

(3) If a horse ceases to be eligible to race or be trained under this rule, a person must not reinstate the horse to race or be trained without unless he or she complies with the Racing Australia Code of Practice: Reinstatement of a retired racehorse (as amended from time to time) and obtains the express permission of a PRA or the Stewards.

Date of Effect: 1 June 2023



AMENDMENTS TO RULES & POLICIES

LOCAL RULE 15.21. TRAINER & JOCKEY – DUAL LICENCES

- (a) No person shall apply for dual licences unless he/she is:
 - (i) a licensed jockey or eligible to be licensed as a jockey, pursuant to LR 16 and;
 - (ii) a licensed trainer or is eligible to be licensed as a trainer and satisfied all the requirements of LR 15.
- (b) Further to the provisions of LR 15 & LR 16, the following provisions shall apply to dual licenses, namely:
 - (i) a dual license holder shall not be eligible to be granted an Owner Trainer permit or train in partnership and no person who has been granted an Owner Trainer Permit or train in partnership, shall be eligible for consideration as a dual licence holder.
 - (ii) a dual license holder may be granted permission to have an Apprentice Jockey indentured to him/her, provided that in the event permission is granted, then notwithstanding the provisions of LR 15.21 (c) and in addition to those provisions; a dual license holder, and his/her Apprentice Jockey may not ride in the same race, regardless of whether the dual license holder is the trainer of a horse in that race.

- (iii) a dual licence holder shall not have any ownership interest in any horse.
- (iv) the continued entitlement to hold dual Licences shall be contingent on the dual licence holder being eligible to have both a Jockey's licence and a trainer's licence under the Rules and or licence requirements.
- (c) Where a dual License holder is the trainer of a horse entered in a race, the dual licence holder may ride that horse but shall not be declared for, or ride, any other horse in that race.
- (d) Where a dual license holder has horses entered for a race meeting the dual licence holder may elect to ride at the meeting, as such the dual license holder must adhere to the regulations and areas designated for Jockeys until such time as they have completed riding duties and been released by Stewards on the day have appointed a licensed trainer or stable employee to perform race day duties, in accordance with LR 15.16.
- (e) In the event that a dual licence holder is the trainer of more than one horse entered in the same race, then that dual License Holder may not be declared for, or ride any horse in that race, without express permission of the Chairman of Stewards.

- (f) If a horse which is trained by a dual licence holder changes stables and is thereafter trained by another trainer, that dual licence holder may not ride that horse, or any other horse entered to race in the same race for a period of 28 days following that change of stables without express permission of the Chairman of Stewards.
- (g) Where the holder of a licence to ride and a licence to train is suspended for actions, matters or things pertaining to his or her Jockey licence may, at the discretion of the Stewards or PRA, and in addition to any other penalty authorised by the Rules or the relevant policies, be suspended as a Trainer for the same or such other period as the Stewards or Principal Racing Authority (PRA) determine.
- (h) Where the holder of a licence to ride and a licence to train is suspended for actions, matters or things pertaining to his or her Trainer licence may, at the discretion of the Stewards or PRA, and in addition to any other penalty authorised by the Rules or the relevant policies, be suspended as a Jockey for the same or such other period as the Stewards or the PRA determine.

STEWARDS SEGMENT

HORSES ARRIVING AND LEAVING THE COURSE

Trainers with horses competing in Race 1 are to arrive on course no later than 1 hour prior to the scheduled start time. Trainers with horses competing in Races 2 onwards are to arrive on course no later than 1.5 hours prior to the scheduled start time of the race they are competing in. Horses must remain on course for a minimum of 30 minutes prior to leaving following competing in a race.

BARRIER CERTIFICATE AUTHORISATION

In accordance with Local Rule 8.3, an unraced horse must not be permitted to start until it has been issued with a barrier certificate after performing satisfactorily in a trial, over at least 600 metres, with at least two other horses.

LR 8.3 Unraced horses must have a barrier certificate obtained in an official trial prior to the closing of acceptances.

- A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if it is seen to be tractable when entering, standing in and jumping away from the barriers.
- 3. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if:
- It is ridden into the barriers with minimal assistance (one attendant with a lead on the bridle and a gentle guide behind)
- It stands without assistance with all four feet on the ground
- It jumps out in a satisfactory manner
- 4. A horse will not be issued with a barrier certificate if:
- It has to be 'lifted' into the barriers
- It is fractious or laying to excess on the side of the stall

- It rears or attempts to burrow under the front gates
- It stands flat footed and fails to jump away (2 lengths)
- It jumps out and starts to buck
- It jumps out and does a left or right hand turn

RACEDAY PLATING AND REPLATING POLICY

Replating – Any required re-plate and/ or repair should be carried out as soon as possible and the horse must then be examined by the veterinary surgeon prior to racing. If a replacement/repair is required such work should be notified to stewards upon completion.

Unable to replace or repair – If a plate is unable to be replaced or repaired the following should take place:

- (1) Front standard plate A horse will not be permitted to start under any circumstances with either one plate or bare foot
- (2) Rear standard plate A horse will not start with only one rear plate. The following options will be undertaken:
- a) The trainer will be contacted to ask permission for the removal of the opposite plate to allow the horse to race barefoot.
- b) If the trainer cannot be contacted the jockey will be asked for permission to remove the opposite plate and allow the horse to race barefoot.
- c) If neither party grants permission, the horse will be scratched



RETIRING YOUR THOROUGHBRED

Notification forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.
