

GREYHOUND RETIREMENT PREPARATION SCHEME (GRPS) APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS effective 15 January 2024

Who can apply for reimbursement under the Scheme?

The *Applicant* must be the *Licensed Person* responsible for the care of an *Eligible Greyhound* to apply to Tasracing for reimbursement under the Scheme.

What is an Eligible Greyhound?

An *Eligible Greyhound* is a canine of the greyhound breed which:

- A. Was registered pursuant to the Rules of a Controlling Body; and
- B. The Greyhound must be domiciled in Tasmania at the time of retirement; AND
- C. Has been bred in Tasmania; OR
- D. Has had at least one race start in Tasmania; OR
- E. Has been domiciled in Tasmania with a licensed person for a minimum of six consecutive months at the time of lodging wind-down notification
- F. Has completed at least 14 days of the winddown from the date that the notification of retirement has been lodged.

What supporting information do I need to provide with this Application Form?

An *Applicant* who applies to Tasracing for reimbursement under the Scheme will need to provide the following supporting documents. (all supporting documents MUST include official identification details of the greyhound (Ear Brand, Race Name or Microchip Number)

- A. Desexing Certificate; and
- B. Dental Certificate
- C. Vaccination Certificate (if applicable); and
- D. Clinical notes from the veterinarian detailing all treatment and procedures performed; and
- E. Itemised tax invoice (in the name of the *Applicant*) and receipt of payment for the *Specified Expenses* incurred.

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What are the Specified Expenses?

Specified Expenses include expenses for desexing, dental prophylaxis and treatment (including extractions), vaccination and pre-anaesthesia blood tests. (See below for the maximum reimbursement amount per procedure)

The above greyhound was checked for dental disease with the following findings:

Stage 1	Normal Healthy Teeth and Gums No treatment required, monitor at regular intervals.	
Stage 2	Mild Gingivitis and Plaque The margin of the attached gum is inflamed and swollen. Plaque and tartar are present. Dental cleaning is recommended within a month to remove buildup and prevent the progression of dental disease.	
Stage 3	Moderate Gingivitis Entire gum is inflamed and swollen. The mouth is painful and an odour is noticeable. Dental cleaning needed as soon as possible.	
Stage 4	Severe Gingivitis The gum is cherry red and bleeding, damaged by infection and calculus. Sore mouth and foul breath are evident. A dental cleaning is recommended immediately to remove calculus, along with antibiotics and pain medications. Extractions of teeth are likely to be required.	
Stage 5	End Stage Periodontal Disease Chronic infection is destroying the teeth, bone, and gums. Bacteria are constantly circulating throughout the body and can cause heart, liver, and kidney problems. Pain is constant. Dental cleaning is immediately needed. Extractions, antibiotics, and pain medication will be necessary.
