Thoroughbred features



35 and counting

Colin McNiff has earned the reputation as the voice of Tasmanian racing through his feats as a race caller and racing commentator.

His ability to paint pictures with his words throughout a race call has earned much praise from punters and radio listeners alike and while the late Bill Collins was the first caller to be dubbed "the accurate one", Col also has a brilliant record of getting it right in a tight photo finish.

In 2025, Col will call his 35th Hobart Cup and he is just as excited about standing behind the microphone in the caller's box in Hobart as he was when he was about to call Dark Intruder winning the 1986 edition of the 2400-metre Group 3 event.

Col was born in Victoria and raised in Mitcham in the eastern suburbs where he enjoyed a normal childhood until he reached his mid-teens.

At the tender age of 15 and unlike anyone else at school, he set his sights on becoming a race caller.

"I found a radio school that had a specialised racing flavour Lee Murray's Broadcasting School, and it was there that I started my journey into radio and racing," Col said.

"I was at the school with the likes of Ron Hawkswell, Rob Tester and Dan Mielicki, all of whom went on to become race callers, and it was that experience that paved the way for me getting a job with TNT in Launceston."

The role at TNT was primarily as a sports reporter but with a background in race calling the station often called on him to step in to call some feature races including Launceston cups.

Col's original plan was to come to Tassie and get as much experience as he could and then move on to greener pastures.

But like many before him he fell victim to the Tasmanian lifestyle.

"I gave myself two to three years to learn as much as I could then move on but 45 years later here I am.

"When I first moved to Tassie, I used to go back to Melbourne every two to three months for a weekend and I distinctly remember coming back after one of those short trips sitting on the plane thinking I wasn't leaving home but I was coming home.

It was a real significant moment in my life. I felt a sense of belonging."

That was a clear sign Col was in it for the long haul in his adopted state.

In 1985 he moved south to Hobart to take up the role of senior sports

reporter and news reader with TVT6 (now Win News) but with established race callers in all regions of the state Col had to bide his time and wait for an opening as a race caller.

The late Milton Pettit was still going strong calling thoroughbred races in Hobart when Col first arrived at TVT6, with Peter Gilligan owning the calling duties in the north and the late Shane Yates covering meetings on the North-West Coast.

Col's first Hobart Cup call (for TasTV) was in 1986, a call he remembers like it was yesterday.

"Bev Buckingham rode the winner (Dark Intruder) for her dad (the late) Ted Buckingham and it was Bev's first cup win, so being my first cup call and her first win in the race made it quite memorable."

Col called another eight Hobart Cups for television until 1999 when Milton Pettit retired and from the start of the new millennium he came into his own as a racing broadcaster.

This will be his 26th Hobart Cup as the full-time caller at Elwick and there have been many memorable moments along the way.

One of the stand-out Hobart Cups for Col was Geegees Blackflash's second cup win in 2015.



"Geegees Blackflash was an amazing horse and his second Hobart Cup win was incredible. He wasn't expected to win but calling the race I could see about the 600-metre mark he was travelling so well with Siggy Carr aboard and I was confident at that point he would win.

"As he neared the finish line, I excitedly said "Geegees BlackFlash, you bloody old marvel", and that conclusion to the race has probably been replayed more than any other in recent times."

Another calling quip that rang out as one of Col's pearlers was when the Darren Weir-trained Offenbach saluted in 2008.

When Craig Williams eased the gelding wide to make his charge, he cruised to the lead in the home straight and Col delivered: "Offenbach is off and gone."

Another stand-out cup win for Col was that of Our Dashing Dane in 2005.

"Our Dashing Dane was an outsider trained by Jason Clifford who was at that time a hobby trainer and the horse was ridden by a relative unknown Victorian jockey Christine Puls.

"I thought Our Dashing Dane had a good chance of winning, so I tried to buy him at the Hobart Cup Calcutta the night before the race, but I missed out."

Col still loves his job and doesn't tire of the early morning starts in winter when he faces the elements travelling from Hobart to Devonport or Launceston every other weekend.

"I love getting out of bed on race day mornings no matter where the races are that day.

"I'm responsible for letting everyone know what's happening at the track and in a race and it is a responsibility I gladly take on board – it's just part of my job."

When Paul and Elizabeth Geard's Gee Gee Horse Stud started to build in numbers Col wasn't sure how he would handle having three or four horses carrying pretty much the same colours with only varying cap colours to decipher one from the other.

"At first the multiple Gee Gee horses bothered me but what it did was make me concentrate even harder and, in a way, I guess it helped to make me a better caller."

Col's preparation for his milestone Ladbroke's Hobart Cup call will not alter from the routine he has followed for over three decades.

"I'll treat Sunday's cup call as just another race. The plan is to get to the track at least an hour before the first race which gives me plenty of time to get set up and make sure all the equipment is working properly and then it's business as usual until cup time."

New Code of Practice for racehorse welfare successfully launched

Animal welfare in the Tasmanian racing industry is of critical importance to the Tasmanian racing industry.

The new enforceable Code of Practice has been developed after extensive consultation with industry participants and stakeholders.

The Code covers key aspects of the care, welfare and health of racehorses kept in Tasmania, and applies to all people with responsibility for the care and management of registered racehorses.

It not only provides guidance to racing industry participants but also an assurance to the broader Tasmanian community of the critical role animal welfare oversight plays in the industry.

The new Code of Practice contains standards that are enforceable under the rules of racing, as well as guidelines based on industry best practice.

It provides whole-of-lifecycle welfare coverage from breeding to retirement and the rehoming of racehorses.

"Racehorse ownership is a long-term responsibility and owners must make provisions for the horse's eventual retirement from racing", said Dr Martin Lenz, Tasracing's Chief Veterinary and Animal Welfare Officer.

"Most horses will be suitable for a second career in a competitive discipline (dressage, show jumping, eventing, showing, endurance or carriage driving) following a period of let down and re-training, while others will make good therapy horses or paddock companions".

The Code of Practice covers both thoroughbred and standardbred horses.

Froggy makes a summer splash

There's hardly anything champion jockey Craig 'Froggy' Newitt hasn't accomplished in Tasmanian racing, but even by his standards, the 24/25 Ladbrokes Summer Racing Festival has been particularly special.

The summer started with a game second aboard The Inevitable in the state's premier sprint race, the Listed Newmarket Handicap (1200m); however, Newitt's post-race comments later proved to be a premonition.

"Good luck beating him for the rest of the summer," Newitt said.

At least for the next two starts, that prediction proved correct as The Inevitable showed he's still a force with Listed wins under weight-for-age (WFA) conditions in the Conquering Stakes (1400m) and Tasmanian Stakes (1600m).

"I didn't ride him early doors, but I'd say he's going better now than he ever has," said Newitt after The Inevitable's Tasmanian Stakes win.

As he did in 23/24, The Inevitable aims to complete a clean sweep of the state's black-type WFA races, and that quest remains in tact entering February, where he'll contest the Thomas Lyons on Hobart Cup Day (1400m) and Hellova Street Stakes on Launceston Cup Day (1600m).

The 2025 Thomas Lyons promises to be one of the races of the summer, with emerging superstar Durazzo making the jump to WFA company as a winner of seven of his nine career races.

Newitt was in the saddle for Durazzo's best victory to date, a brilliant victory in the \$109,000 Ladbrokes Carpet Charge on Devonport Cup Day.

"He's one of the best I've ridden down here," said Newitt following that victory.

Newitt is committed to The Inevitable for the Thomas Lyons in a race that sees the proven champ up against a host of worthy challengers.

Of course, it seemingly wouldn't be a Tassie summer without another Froggy Newitt Devonport Cup winner, delivering for the second year in a row with the Glenn Stevenson-trained Ashy Boy.

It came down to the judge's verdict in a photo between Kaliuwaa Falls and Ashy Boy, with the outcome being a record ninth Devonport Cup for Newitt.

"Hopefully, it's a record I can keep building on; I had to compose myself; it's pretty special," an emotional Newitt said after the win.

The highlights weren't just on the track for Newitt, marrying long-time partner Breeana Smith in late January.

At his first Tasmanian meeting back after the wedding, Newitt duly delivered a winning treble on Magic Millions Race Day in Launceston, including feature wins aboard Sanniya (2YO Classic) and Asva (Sydeston Cup).

Entering February, Newitt has 30 career black-type victories in Tasmania, covering all the state's best races. With the great form he continues to ride in, that figure will only continue to swell in the coming years and months.

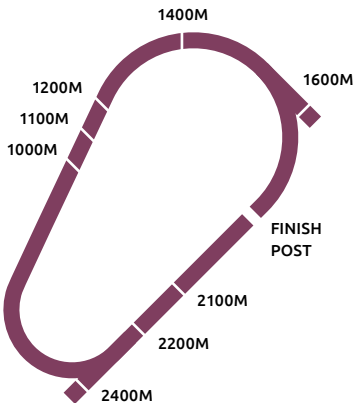
Hobart Racecourse

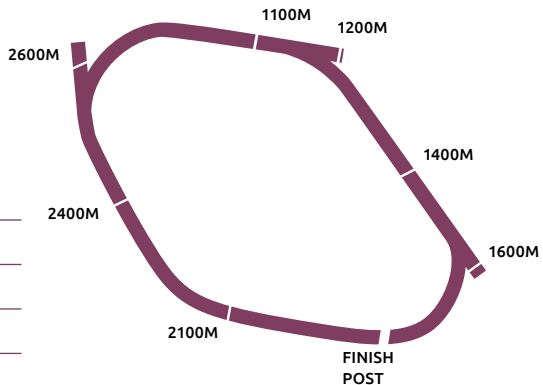

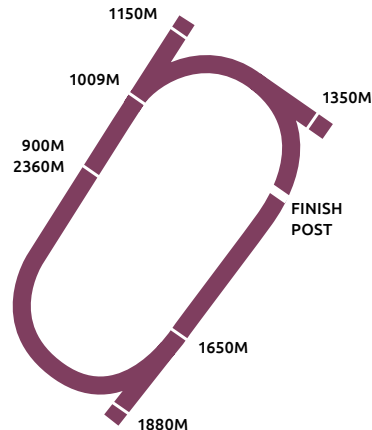
Devonport Racecourse

Reminder to trainers horses that have not started for 12+ months

Policy

Where a horse has not raced for 12 months or longer, a satisfactory veterinary clearance must be obtained and the horse must trial satisfactorily before being granted permission to nominate for a race.

Definitions

Qualified veterinary surgeon means a veterinarian who is:

(a) registered with the Veterinary Practitioners Board (or equivalent regulatory body) in a State or Territory of Australia; and

(b) approved by the relevant PRA (including by way of permit, approval or licence) if required by a Local Rule of that PRA.

Protocols

1. Veterinary clearance before trialling

The trainer of a horse that has not raced for 12 months or longer must produce to the Stewards a veterinary clearance as well as any other information, examination or report they require, from a qualified veterinary surgeon indicating that the horse is suitable to resume trialling and racing.

Details of any injury or medical condition which might have caused the prolonged break from training or racing must be provided with the veterinary clearance.

Following receipt of a satisfactory veterinary clearance, the Stewards may grant written permission for the horse to be nominated for and participate in an official trial or jump-out.

2. Satisfactory trial

If permission to trial is granted by the Stewards, the horse must:

- (a) participate in an official trial or jump-out to the satisfaction of the Stewards; and
- (b) have a post-trial veterinary examination (conducted by a qualified veterinary surgeon) to ensure that the horse is suitable to continue its training regime.

3. Permission to race

Following a satisfactory trial and upon receiving the above satisfactory post-trial veterinary examination report, the Stewards may grant written permission for the horse to be nominated for and participate in a race.

Barrier Certificate Authorisation

1. In accordance with Local Rule 8.3, an unraced horse must not be permitted to start until it has been issued with a barrier certificate after performing satisfactorily in a trial, over at least 600 metres, with at least two other horses.

LR 8.3 Unraced horses must have a barrier certificate obtained in an official trial prior to the closing of acceptances.

2. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if it is seen to be tractable when entering, standing in and jumping away from the barriers.

3. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if:

- It is ridden into the barriers with minimal assistance (one attendant with a lead on the bridle and a gentle guide behind)
 - It stands without assistance with all four feet on the ground
 - It jumps out in a satisfactory manner
4. A horse will not be issued with a barrier certificate if:
- It has to be lifted into the barriers

- It is fractious or laying to excess on the side of the stall
- It rears or attempts to burrow under the front gates
- It stands flat footed and fails to jump away (2 lengths)
- It jumps out and starts to buck
- It jumps out and does a left or right hand turn.

5. Barrier Blankets

Application for approval of a barrier blanket must be made prior to acceptances for the race it is intended to start. The blanket must be placed on the horse prior to it being ridden into the barriers and it must be tractable when loading and standing in the barriers.

6. Blind fold and Stallion Chains

For safety reasons, it is Tas Racing Integrity Policy that horses using blind folds or stallion chains shall be loaded into the barriers riderless. Application for approval of a blind fold or stallion chain must be made prior to acceptances for the race it is intended to start. The horse must satisfactorily enter the barriers with the blind fold or stallion chain on.

7. Before issuing barrier certificates, the document of description must be supplied to the steward who must ensure that all brands and markings are verified against the horse.

Code of Practice for Racehorse Welfare

Trainers are advised to ensure that they abide by the new Code of Practice for Racehorse Welfare.

Retiring your thoroughbred

Notification forms

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.

Notification forms for retirement of horses should be completed

Named horse within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse from racing or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Unnamed horse within 1 month of the decision to not commence racing the horse, or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Thoroughbred breeding incentive scheme

The TasBred Incentive Scheme commenced in the 2018/19 Racing Season and replaces the tasBonus Incentive Scheme. \$1.54M in bonuses will be on offer to eligible 2, 3 & 4YO horses, distributed across 72* races.

Eligibility

Yearlings that qualify for the scheme are:

- A) **Tasmanian Sired**
- B) **Interstate Sired (Breedback)** (mare must be Tasmanian owned and was served by a stallion which stood in Tasmania during the following year's breeding season. – based on Australia Stud Book)
- C) **Tasmanian Reared*** (the foal and dam must have resided in Tasmania for at least 6 continuous months between when the foal was born and the foals first birthday as listed by the Australian Stud Book).

* Supporting documentation Required.

- All 2YO & 3YO Maiden races
- Selected 2YO, 3YO & 4YO Handicaps under \$50,000 prizemoney
